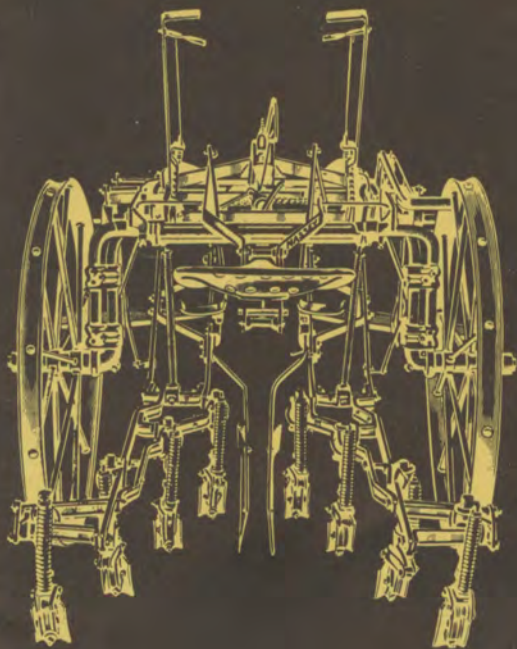


NEW MASSEY-HARRIS

PIVOT AXLE CULTIVATOR



Solves The Hill-Dodging Problem



● When cultivating time comes around, many farmers look wearily ahead to the tiresome job of hill-dodging present in almost all cultivating work. There is a way to make this task easier.

Hop up on the seat of a new Massey-Harris Pivot Axle Cultivator. Dodging hills that are out of line is easily done by merely shifting one of the foot pedals. Pressing on one pedal or the other causes the wheels to pivot, carrying the gangs easily over to the side desired. If you have hill-side cultivating to do, you'll especially appreciate how this shift feature counteracts the tendency of the wheels to slip down hill.

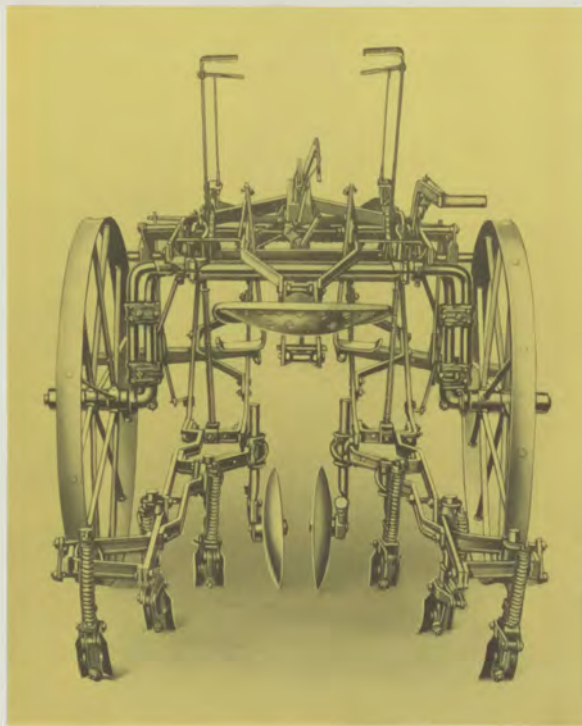
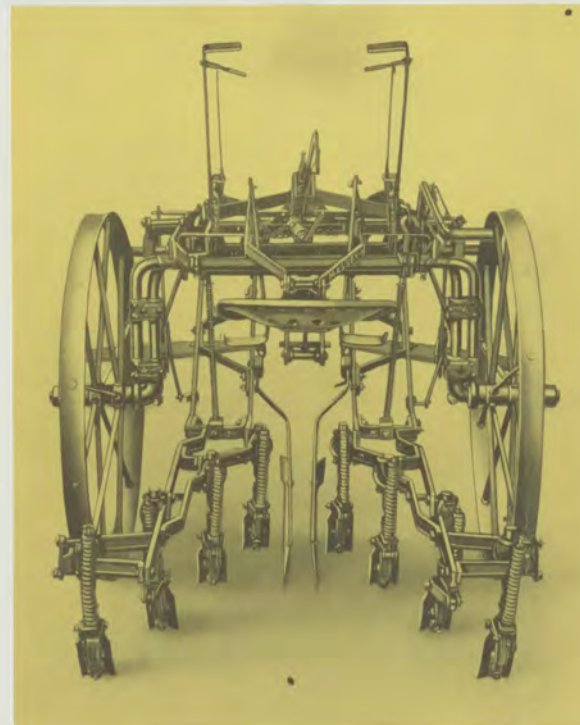


Illustration No. 2 shows the Massey-Harris Pivot Axle Cultivator equipped with disc hillers in place of the front shovels. Discs can be adjusted to throw the soil either to or away from the row as desired. Excellent for use where the young corn is overrun by morning glories or pea vines as the discs cut off the vines without harmful pulling or stripping.

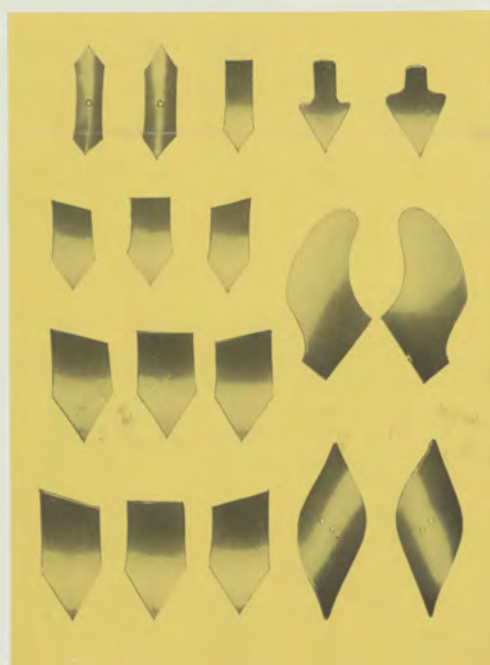
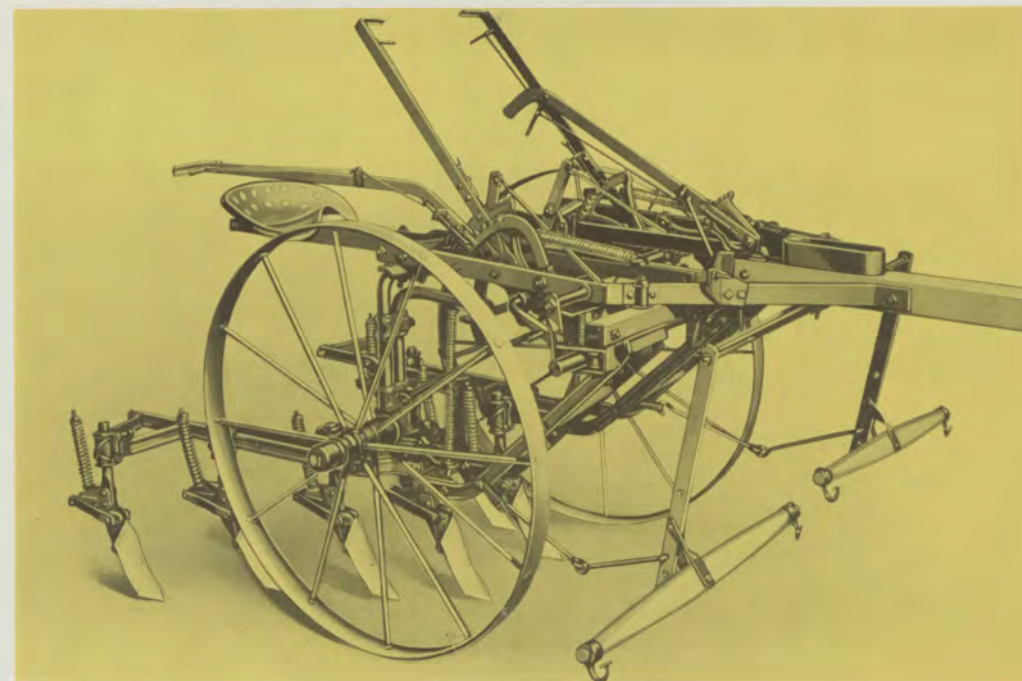


Cultivator with 8 shovel gangs. Shovels may be set in straight ranks or zigzag, as preferred. Shovel posts are attached to the gang frames by clamps, providing greater adjustment and avoiding weakening the beams with numerous bolt holes. The 40" high wheels are provided with oil tight boxes and have wide concave tires that prevent settling or side slipping.

Every farmer has his preference in shovels best adapted to his needs. Make your selection from these shovels and points available for the Pivot Axle Cultivator. Plain shovels without shovel backs are used on this cultivator making replacements very inexpensive.

Both gangs are raised and lowered by a single master lever placed at the right and convenient to the operator. This lever is of the correct length to give you an easy leverage and works in conjunction with two powerful lifting springs which carry the weight when the gangs are raised.

Once the master lever is adjusted, the gangs remain at a uniform depth for every row. Pressure may be applied with the master lever when the ground is hard and yet not affect the depth adjustment.

Each gang is provided with a separate depth gauge lever which permits each gang to cultivate deep or shallow independently of the other gang. These levers are positive in their action and have a wide range of adjustment for every requirement. Easily accessible control keeps all of the shovels of each gang working at the same depth.

A simple adjustment moves the wheels and the bar in or out, adapting the cultivator to work in rows as narrow as 28" or as wide as 4 feet. A convenient hand lever directly in front of the seat quickly and easily changes the space between the two gangs to fit the row, that is being straddled. Wheels may be kept from pivoting by locking this lever.

A quick acting, hand tilting lever mounted on the rear end of the pole keeps your cultivator in absolute balance under any field conditions.

The almost exclusive use of steel and the strongly braced construction assure perfect alignment even after long usage.
