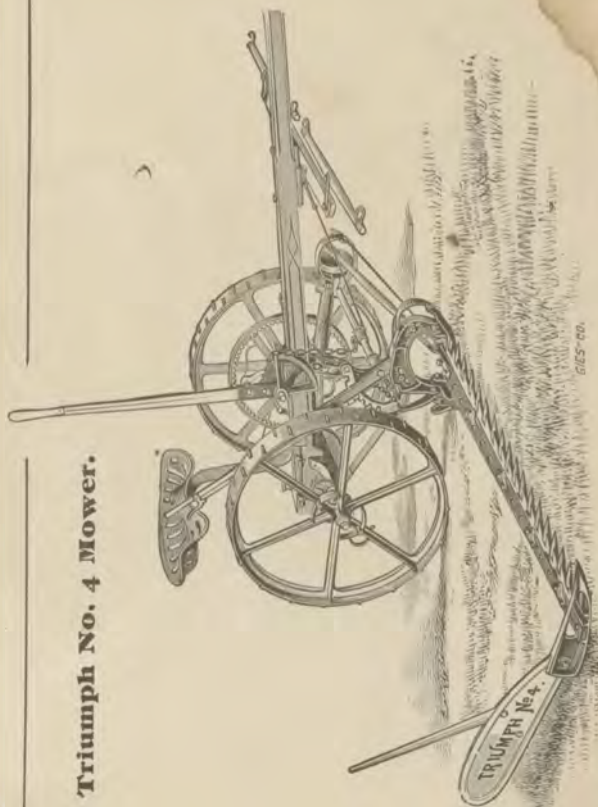
TRIUMPH No. 8, STEEL FRAME BINDER.
