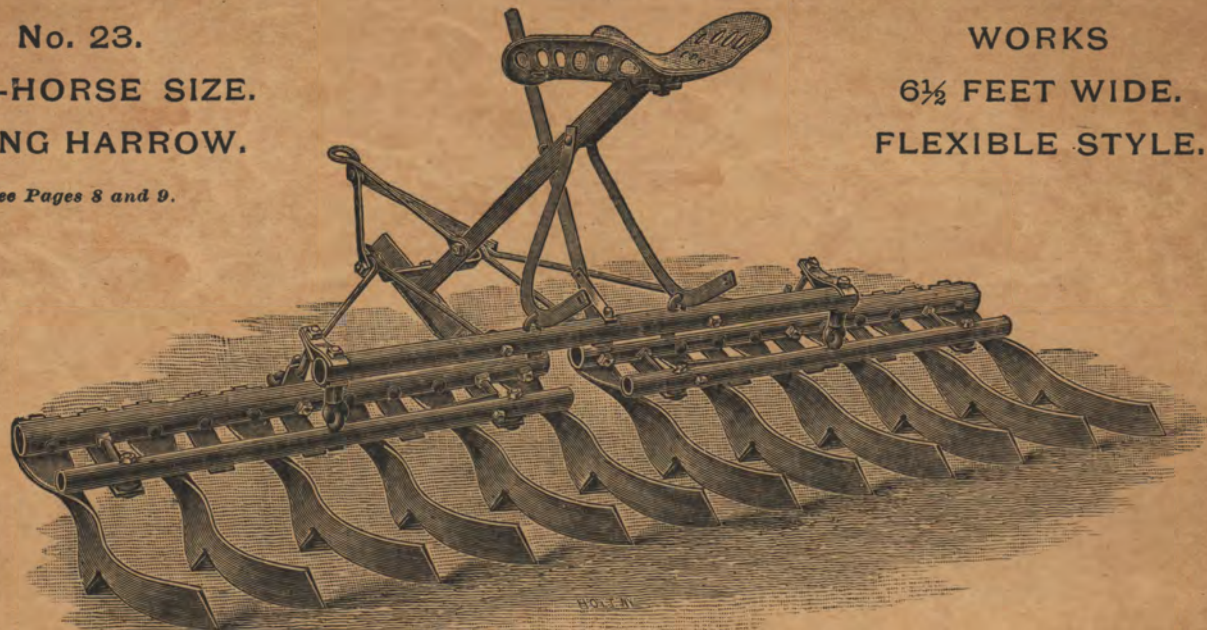

"ACME" Pulverizing Harrow, Clod Crusher and Leveler

Is not a special tool, as some have supposed, but, as its name implies, a general purpose harrow that will do the whole business, viz.: it will crush, cut, lift, turn, smooth and level, all in one operation.

While pre-eminently adapted for heavy, stubborn land, it can be adjusted by means of levers and runners to do perfect work on the lightest soil. The peculiar shape and arrangement of the Coulters insure the cutting over of the entire surface of the ground, and owing to the absence of spike, spring, or pointed teeth, there is little, if any, tendency to disturb sod or trash that has been turned under by the plow. It not only prepares a perfect seed bed, but will also cover seed in the best manner.

It will be observed that the Coulters all slope backwards, thus presenting the least possible resistance, and, as they are beveled and ground to an edge, the draft is reduced to a minimum.

A variety of sizes are made, working 3 ft. to 13½ ft. wide, adapted to small as well as large farms, and to the orchard, berry patch and garden.

As now made, the "Acme" is the cheapest RIDING harrow in use. We also make walking "Acmes" costing about the same as an ordinary drag. The "Acme" is, therefore, within the reach of all who have use for harrows.

Being made entirely of cast steel and wrought iron, it is practically indestructible. Nothing but the Coulters can possibly wear, and these are readily replaced at a trifling cost.

has Wrought Iron Tubular Bars, is provided with curved Cast Steel Coulters, supplemented by flat cast steel Crushing Spurs. The forward half of each Coulter is curved to the left, while the rearward half is curved to the right. By this arrangement of the Coulters, the whole surface of the ground is Cut, Lifted and Turned.

The “Acme” is adapted to both heavy and light soils. While very strong, it is extremely light, and is therefore susceptible of doing light surface work, such as finishing off for seeding, working onion beds, truck gardens, etc., which heavy harrows cannot do because of their great weight. When covering grain or doing heavy work it may be weighted with 25 to 60 pound, in the shape of a bag of earth or log, and when so weighted *it will do thorough execution in hard soil.*

Most of the sizes are provided with a seat.

No. 25. Two gangs, each working about $3\frac{1}{4}$ feet wide, are attached to the ends of a spanner or coupling bar, leaving a vacant space in the center. The gangs are adjustable, and when attached to the extreme ends of the spanner the width of spread is about 10 feet. On the return trip, between the trees the uncut space in the center will be worked so that in two passages the ground will be cultivated about 13 feet wide. If the gangs are attached to the inner holes of the spanner the ground will be cultivated about 12 feet wide in two passages.

When rows of trees are more than 14 feet apart, simply make more passages, but whatever the width between the rows may be, one end of the cultivator can be made to run *under the limbs and near to the trunks of the trees*, and at the same time the horses will be away from the branches.

The gangs may be set close together, so as to cut all the space about 6 feet 6 inches wide, and when thus set the tool becomes a Harrow, as shown on page 11.

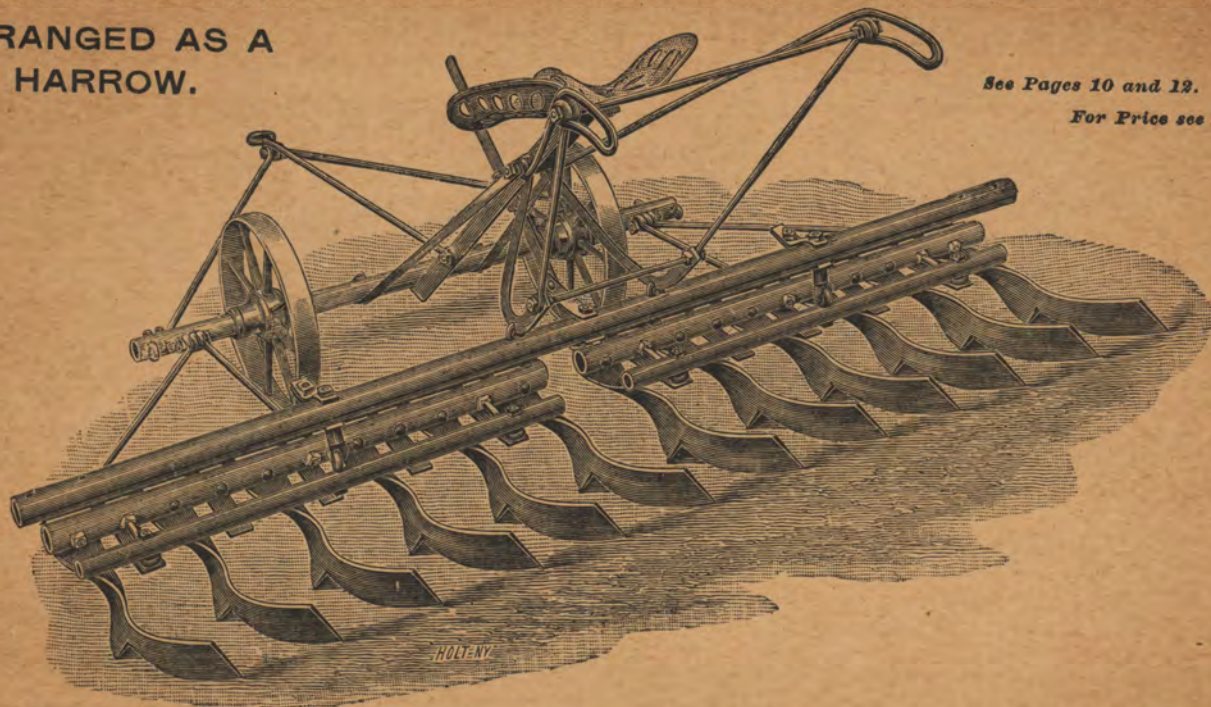

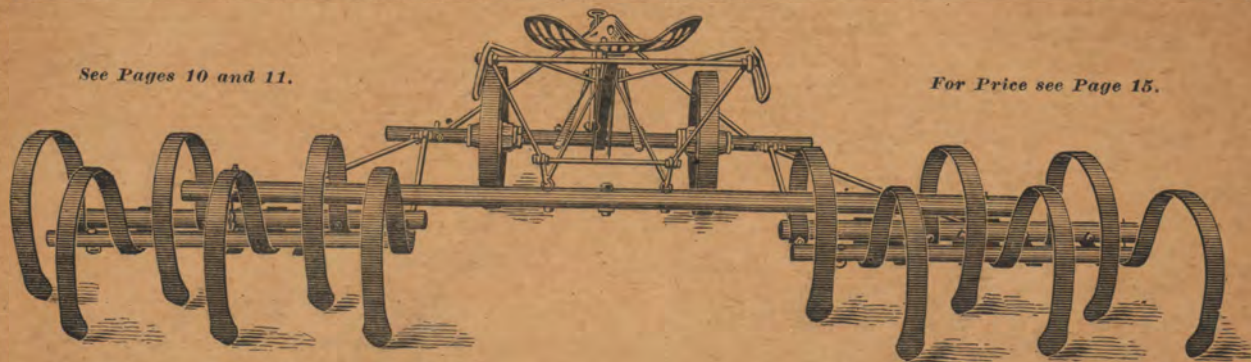

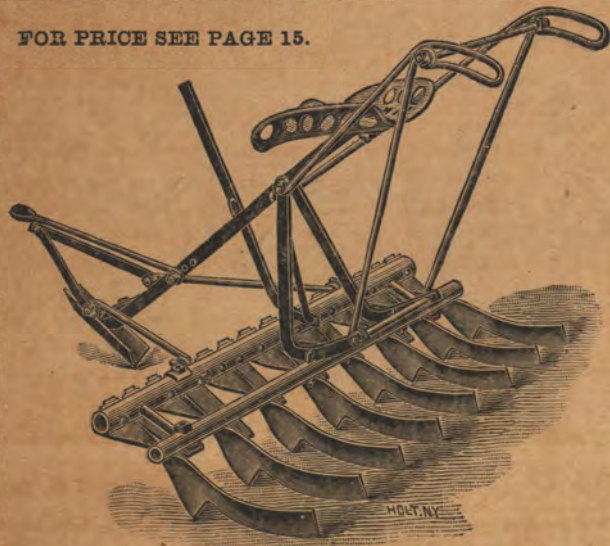


Orchard Cultivator with Spring Teeth.

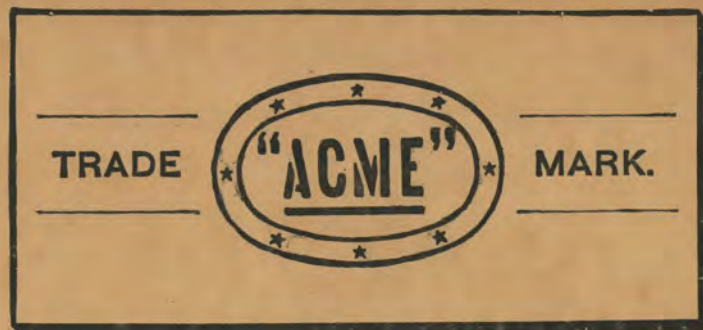
Size G. One-Horse Cultivator.

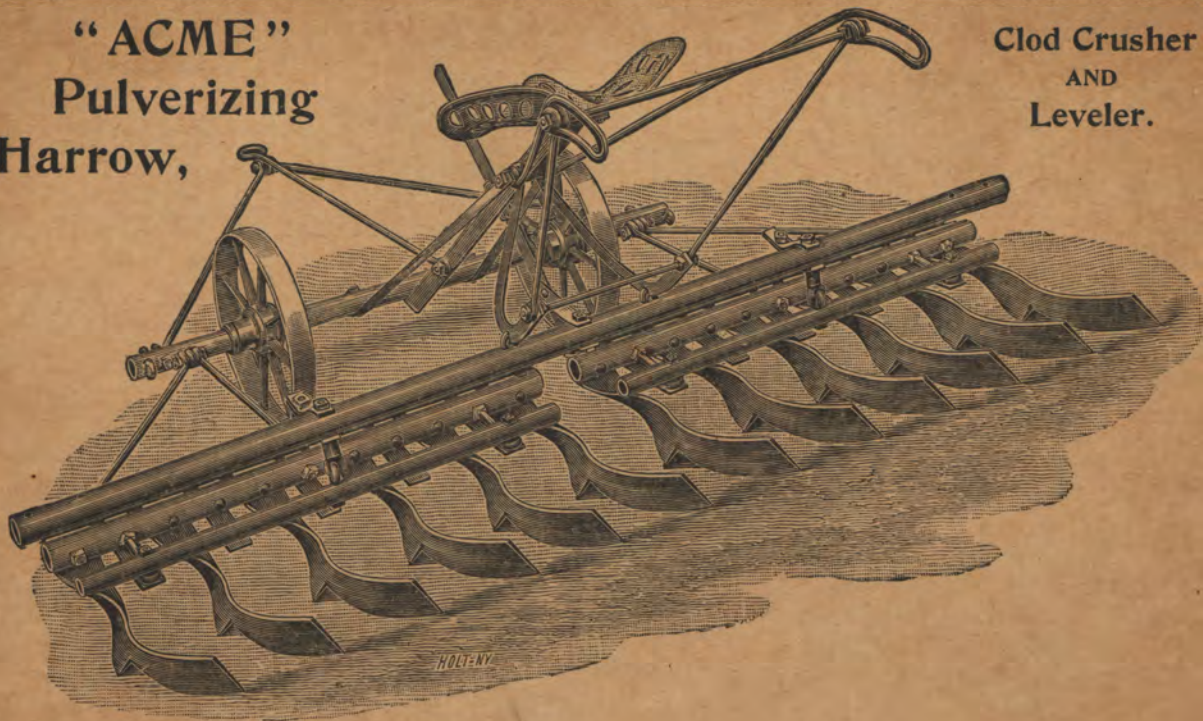
