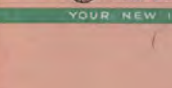

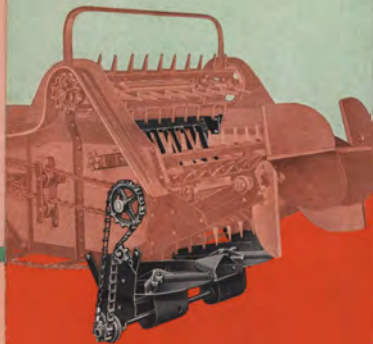

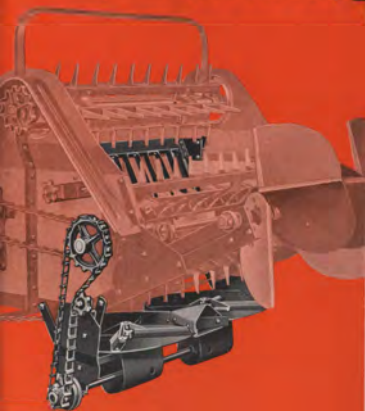

The **NEW IDEA** Lime Spreader can be installed in less than 30 minutes on any **NEW IDEA** Manure Spreader built since 1924. It spreads an even covering of 15 to 20 feet in width, and may be used for spreading lime, marl, rock phosphate, compost and other pulverized materials.

No extra help is required. Spreading lime with the **NEW IDEA** is a one-man job. No shoveling from a wagon into a hopper, eating a lot of dust and getting an uneven spread—no walking back of a small capacity drill box—no lime thrown into the air—no dust for the driver. It's **NEW IDEA** and it's right!

Easy to operate. The **NEW IDEA** Lime Spreader receives the lime at the logical place, at the end of the bottom, on rapidly rotating discs that spread it out in wide, even covering from 15 to 20 feet in width. The stationary tine rake in front of the beater prevents packing. The end board serves as a loading gauge and prevents leaking when driving into the field. Hung close to the rear axle.

Very little power is required to operate the **NEW IDEA** Lime Spreader. It weighs only 140 pounds, but is ruggedly built to last for years. Steel gears are of special pitch design, heat-treated and carburized. Bearings are self-aligning and provided with pressure lubrication fittings. Performance is smooth and efficient.

The feed is controlled so as to apply the lime at any desired rate from $\frac{1}{2}$ to $5\frac{1}{2}$ tons per acre of pulverized limestone. With lighter material the rate of application per acre is less.

Lime materials

Pulverized Limestone, Marl, Rock-Phosphate, Compost and other pulverized materials may be used. We do not attempt to specify any particular type of liming material or specify the amount to be used and on what fields to use it. This information is readily obtainable from your county agent who will test your soils for acidity and recommend the proper materials. We can say, however, that the **NEW IDEA** Lime Spreader has been developed to handle all types of liming materials more satisfactorily and with less labor. No farmer can afford to neglect to build up his soil, especially when such help as the famous **NEW IDEA** Spreader and **NEW IDEA** Lime Spreading Attachment are available.
