READ DESCRIPTION OF BATTLE ON OTHER SIDE.



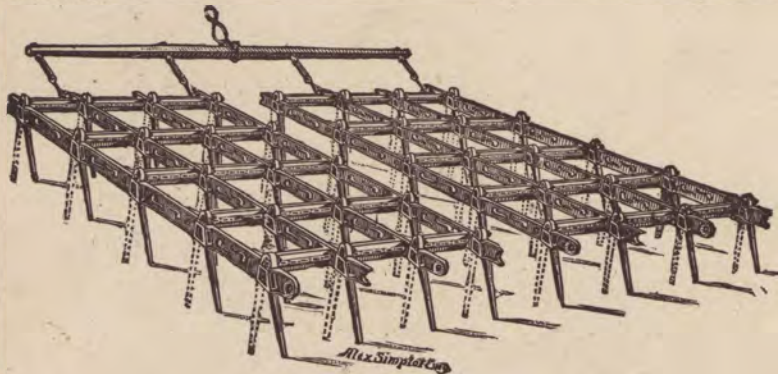
