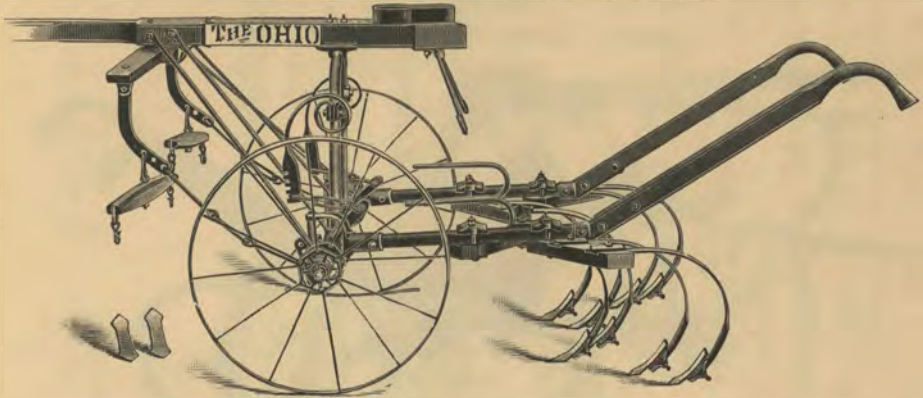
SPECIAL NOTICE.

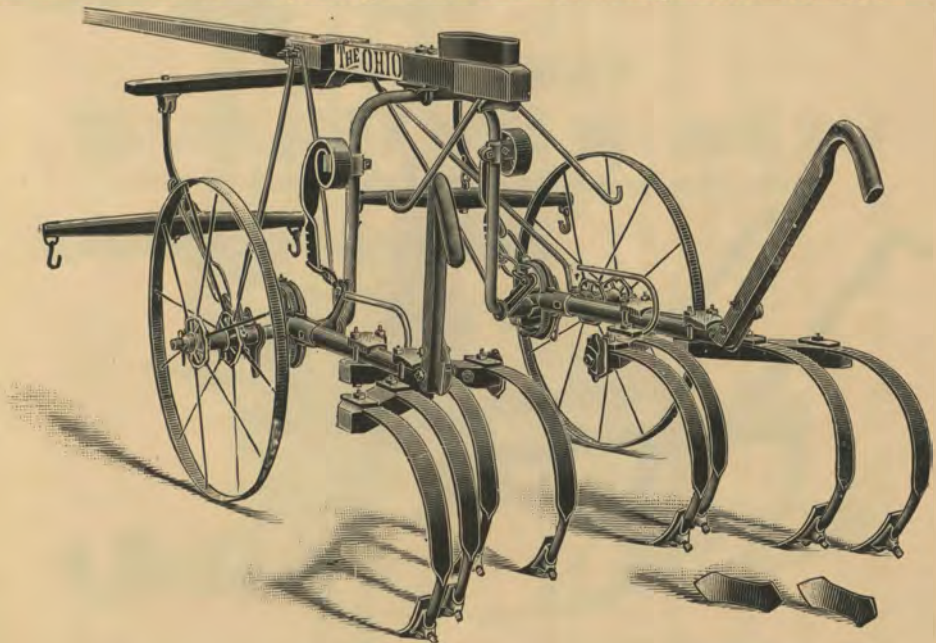

SHOWING OUR PATENT TOOTH.

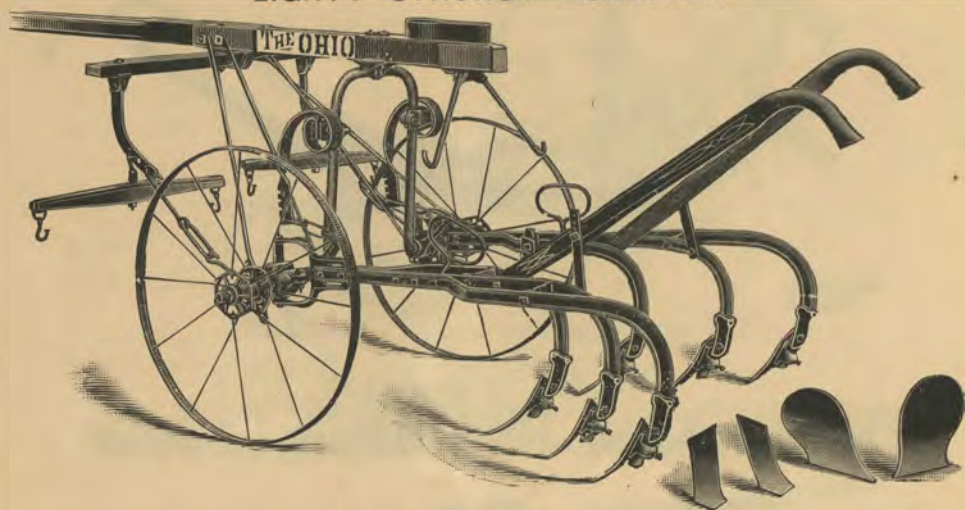


REAR VIEW OF
The Ohio Spring Tooth Walking Cultivator.

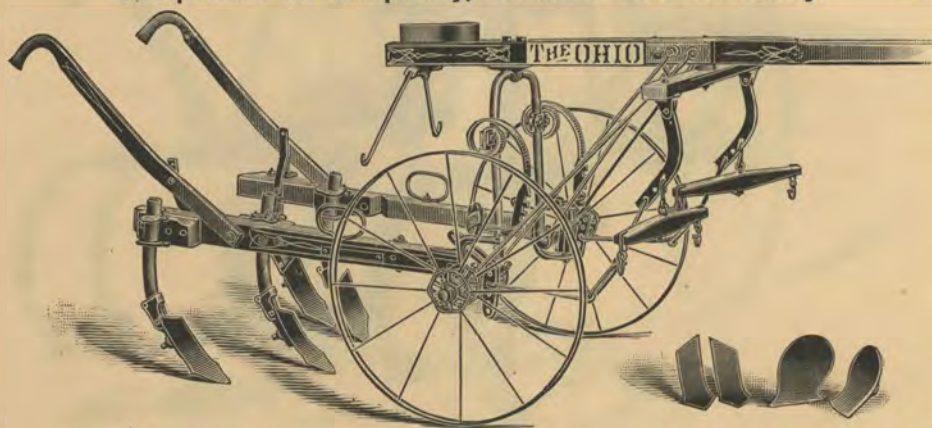

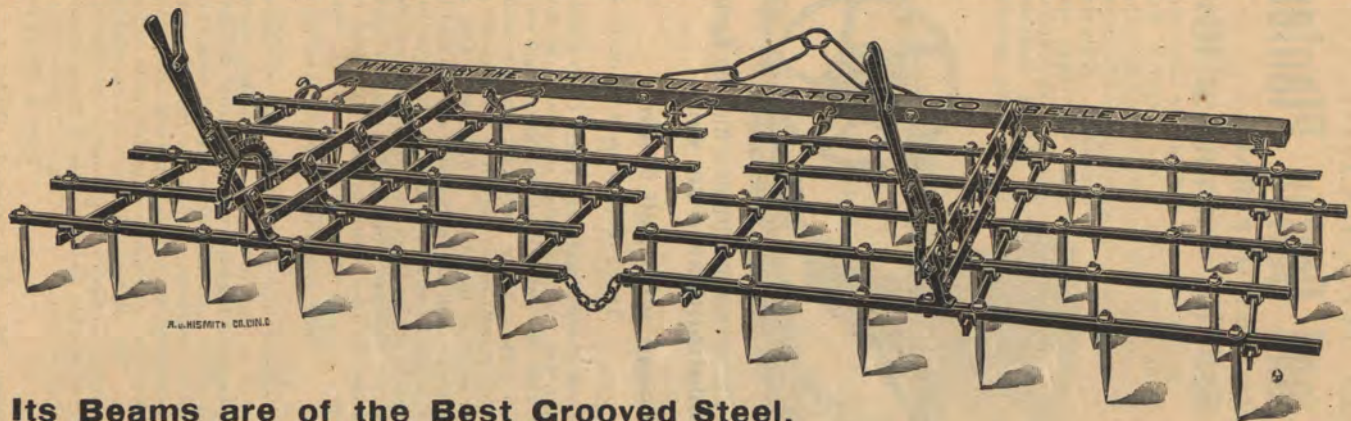

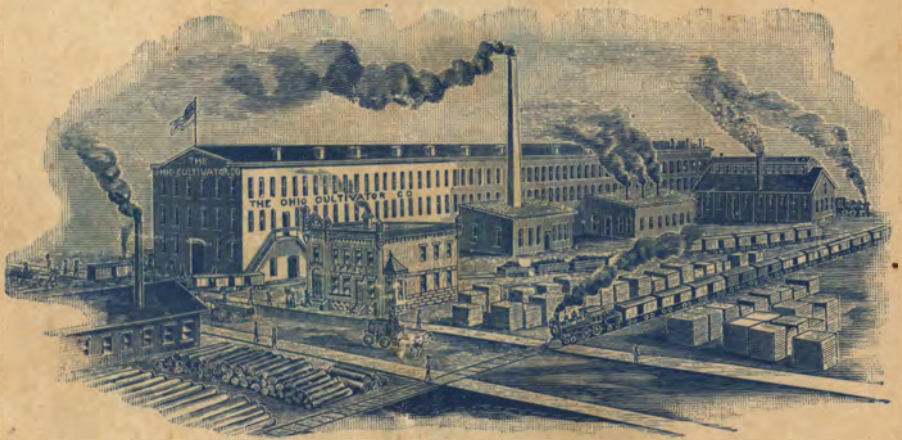
