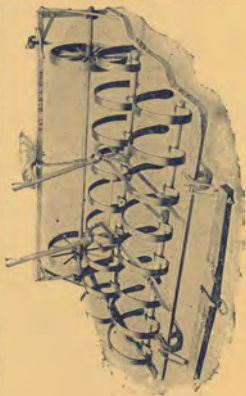

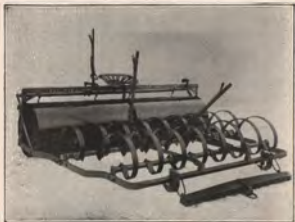

This cut shows our No. 3 Combined Implement.

The first or second row can be raised or lowered, while in operation, with a compression leverage, by a boy.

We guarantee the draft to be no heavier than on any other harrow of the same dimension; our machine throws the draft on the roller.

The Implement is built of the best material, and guaranteed for one year.

The frame is thoroughly braced together; all working parts are interchangeable, and can be had at a moderate cost. You will notice that the roller has a scraper on; this will always keep it clean in case of the ground being damp.

Our Dumping Device.

We want to call special attention to the dumping device of our harrow.

You will first dump the front row and then the hind row of any rubbish it contains, same as you dump any ordinary hay rake. By so doing you will not miss one inch of ground in a 20 acre field that is not cultivated.



Sections Under Perfect Control.

The sections are always under perfect control, and will run at any depth required while working.

Easily Moved from Place to Place.

In taking the machine from the barn to the field, simply throw both rows up, and the bearing will be on the front slides and the roller.

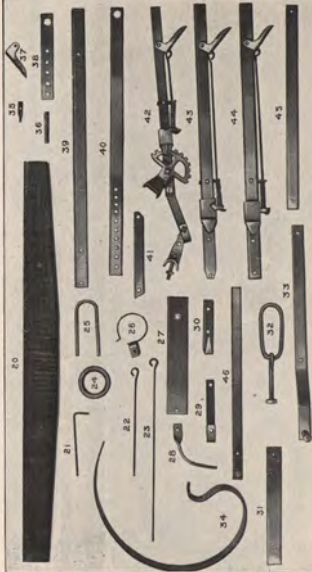

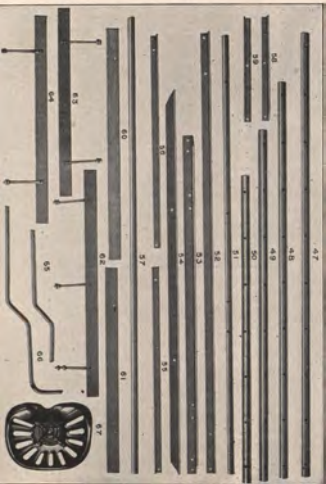
