EXPLANATORY.

We build *New York Champion Rakes* of both wood and steel and with either thills or combination pole and thills. Our wheels are interchangeable, i. e., wood wheels can be used on steel rakes or steel wheels on wood rakes.

Our thills and combinations are also interchangeable, that is, either thills or combinations will fit all rakes.

Our 20th Century Improvement (which is fully described on page 5 of this pamphlet) is a valuable feature and is completely covered by patents so that other manufacturers who have attempted to imitate some of the other parts cannot use our new device, as we shall apply to the courts for protection and damage in case they attempt to infringe.

Our regular sizes are 8, 9, 10 and 12 ft., with number of teeth varied to the work required.

Before setting up rake, read carefully printed instructions on every axle.

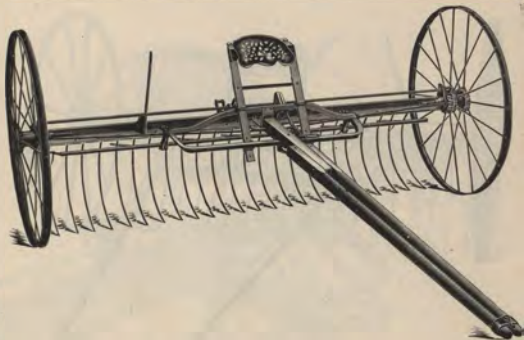

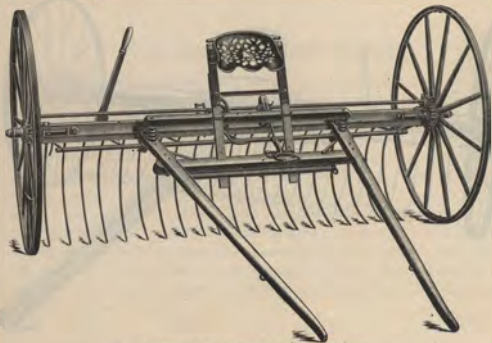
OUR 20th CENTURY IMPROVEMENT.

Our 20th Century Improvement consists of a valuable device which effectually prevents the hooks or pawls catching into the ratchets after the rake is dumped.

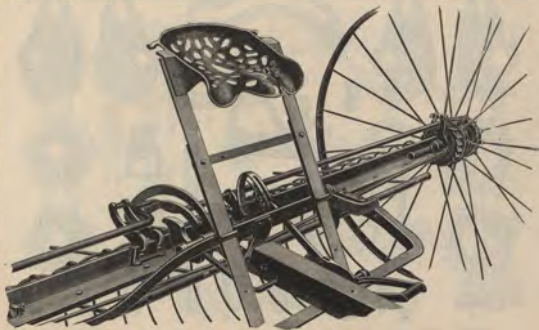
It also enables the operator to hold up the teeth with either foot—that is, he can continue pressure on dump lever with right foot or use No. 7 foot lever, as heretofore, as he prefers. It also warns the operator (by slightly raising the dump lever) just when to remove his foot to allow the teeth to drop at the proper time. The improvement is simple and durable, being a latch fastened to cross-board in same way as the dump circle and adjacent thereto, and a catch attached to the axle in such a manner that when the rake is dumped and the foot pressure is continued, the hooks are thrown out and the teeth are held up until foot pressure is removed, when they drop instantly. The dump circle is so made that the dumping lever can be detached from latch and bolted to the dump circle and the rake dumped as formerly, if from any cause it is desirable to do so.
