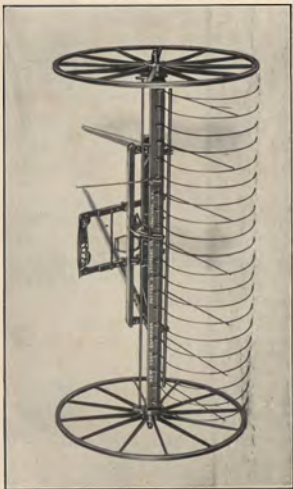

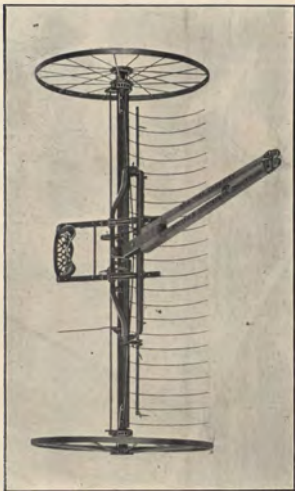
Combination pole and thills will be furnished for 8 ft. rakes at a slight extra charge.

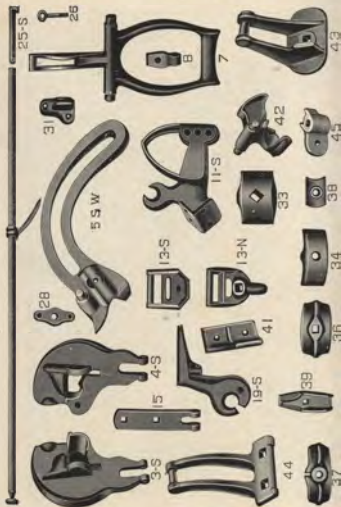
Note the pressed steel tooth holder in one continuous strip.

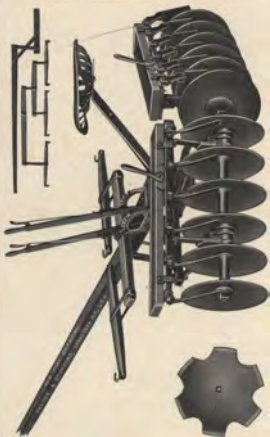

## New York Champion Disc Harrows.

With TWELVE 16 inch, 18 inch or 20 inch discs, either solid or cutaway. Ordinary pole for two or four horses. Set over pole for three horses.



**NO OTHER IMPLEMENT** will so thoroughly pulverize the ground and destroy weed roots.

Discs have square holes and are attached to square shaft so they can not get loose and revolve independently.

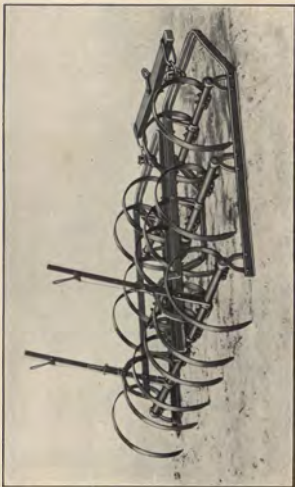
Ball bearings reduce the draft.

Notice the patent lever for moving the scrapers. When locked either on or off the lever is level with the frame and out of the way.

## Steel Frame Lever Harrows.

The Steel Angle comprising the Frame is in One Piece extending the full length of the Harrow, making this the Strongest Style on the Market.

With 15 or 17 Teeth.

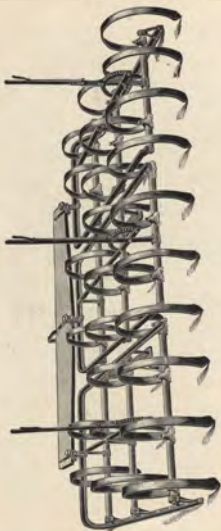


ONLY ONE SHOE ON THE GROUND IN THE CENTER and as our frame is elevated about one inch higher than any other, there is NO PLACE for roots and stones to GATHER AND CLOG

Teeth bars are  $1\frac{1}{4}$  in. steel tubing. Each tooth is held by two bolts and a small malleable casting which fits the tooth perfectly and thus does away entirely with any side motion. Set screw holders provided if desired.

## Three Section Steel Lever Harrows.

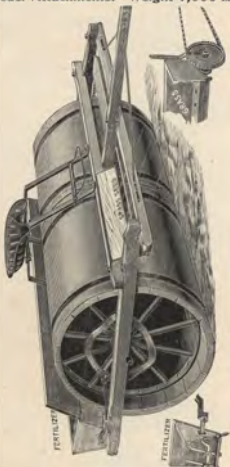

## New York Champion Land Rollers.

**No. 1. With or without Fertilizer and Grass  
Seeder Attachments. Weight 1,000 lbs.**



Height 37 inches. Length 7 feet. Seat and Foot Rest adjustable.

Wheels ALL HICKORY with iron hubs, each wheel banded with steel tire and let into staves  $\frac{1}{4}$  of an inch.

Staves of hard maple, three inches thick, bolted to wheels and then banded with heavy tire over bolt heads.

The FORCE FEED GRASS SEEDER attachment distributes the seed evenly in front and the roller covers it.

THE PLASTER SOWER ATTACHMENT is just the thing to sow plaster and other dry fertilizers.

## Wood Rollers.

**No. 2. Plain. No Attachments.**

Weight, 750 lbs.

Length, 7 ft. 6 inches.



Rolls 27  
inches high.

Each stave is of hard wood, bolted in the center to the cast iron heads, the bolts being about four inches from the end, so that the staves will not split.

Heads are set into gains in staves one quarter of an inch deep, thus giving added strength and stiffness to the roller and making it impossible for the heads to work loose.

Six inch axle bearings on each head, making twenty-four in all, thereby lessening the chance for grinding out the hubs.

**With 2 inch Staves and Pressed Steel Heads.**

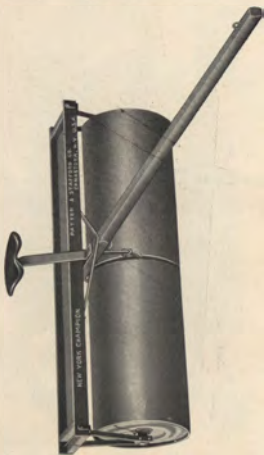

The rolls are of 70 carbon steel riveted to solid steel heads and with ordinary care will last a life time. Nothing to rot or dry or get out of order.

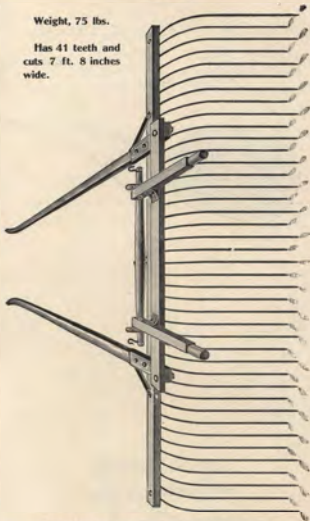
