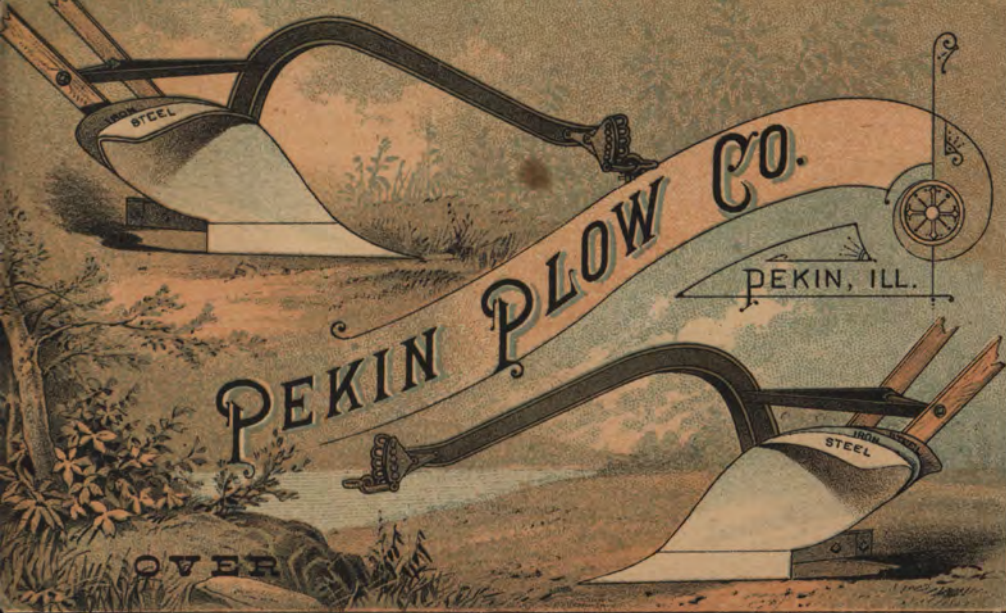

The illustrations on the other side of this card, shall make plain to you the different kinds of steel used by manufacturers in making plows.

The first plow shows the Iron-backed Steel used by the Pekin Plow Co., *on all their Plows.*

The second plow shows the Iron center Steel used by nearly all of the other plow manufacturers.

The reason Iron Center Steel is used by most of the manufacturers, is because it is easier worked than Iron-backed Steel and there is less per-centage of loss in hardening it.

The wearing thickness of the steel of the first plow is just double that of the second, as the steel in front of the iron is twice as thick as on the second plow.

When the wear reaches the iron the plow will no longer scour, and the steel on the back of the mould-board of the second plow is lost.

The steel used on the first plow we make much harder, and of a finer polish than the Iron Center Steel can be made and it will *always* scour in any soil.

Examine closely before purchasing, and be not deceived, for the difference of the steel is not easily discernible after the plow is painted.

Ask for the Pekin Plow.
