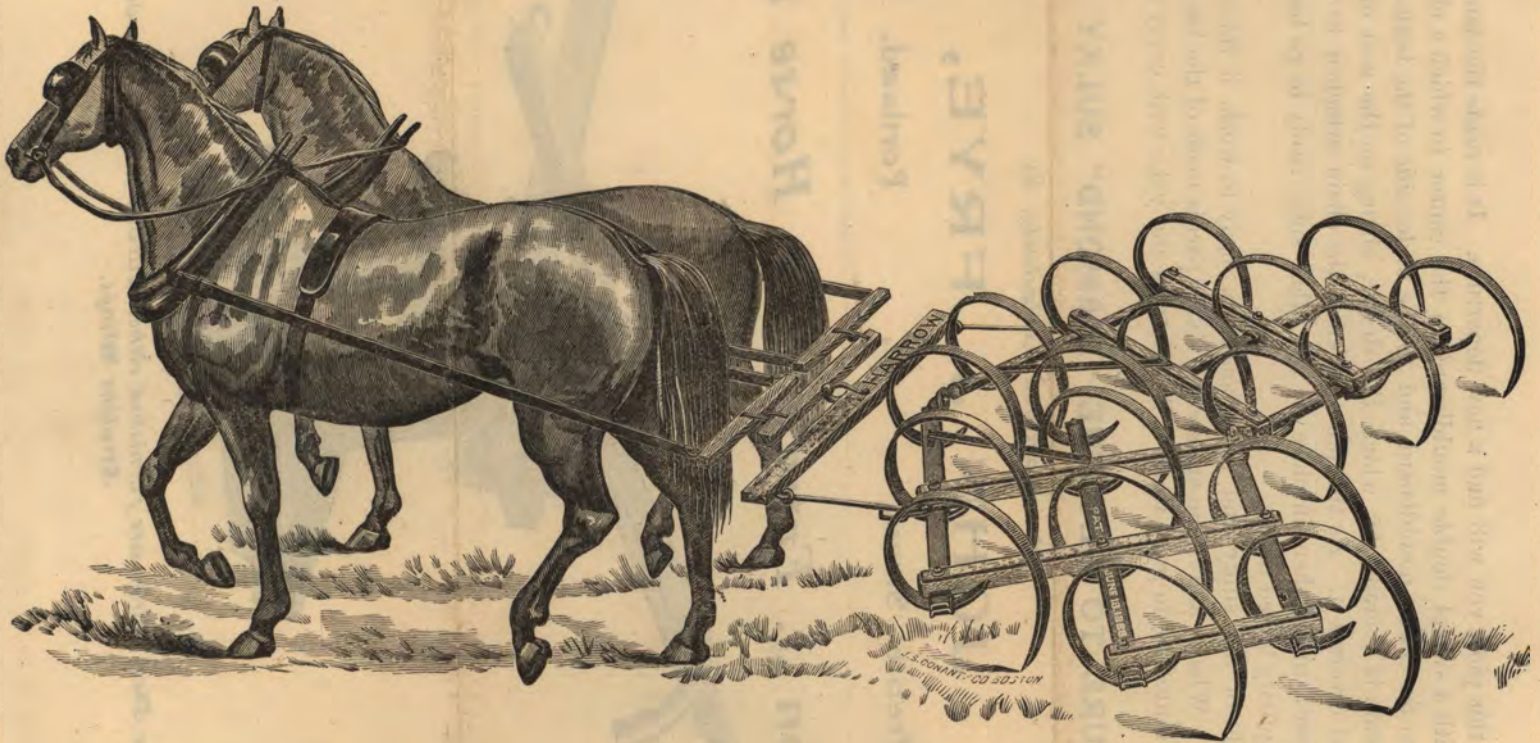

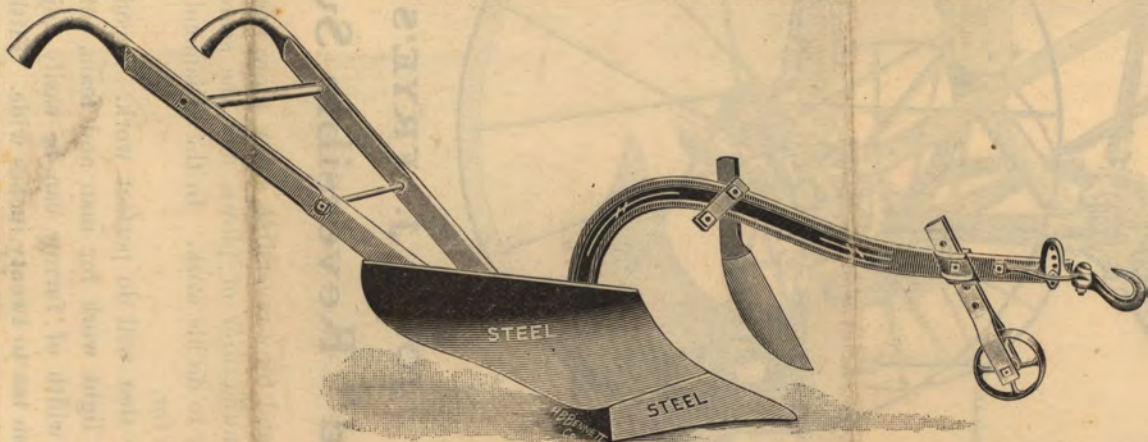

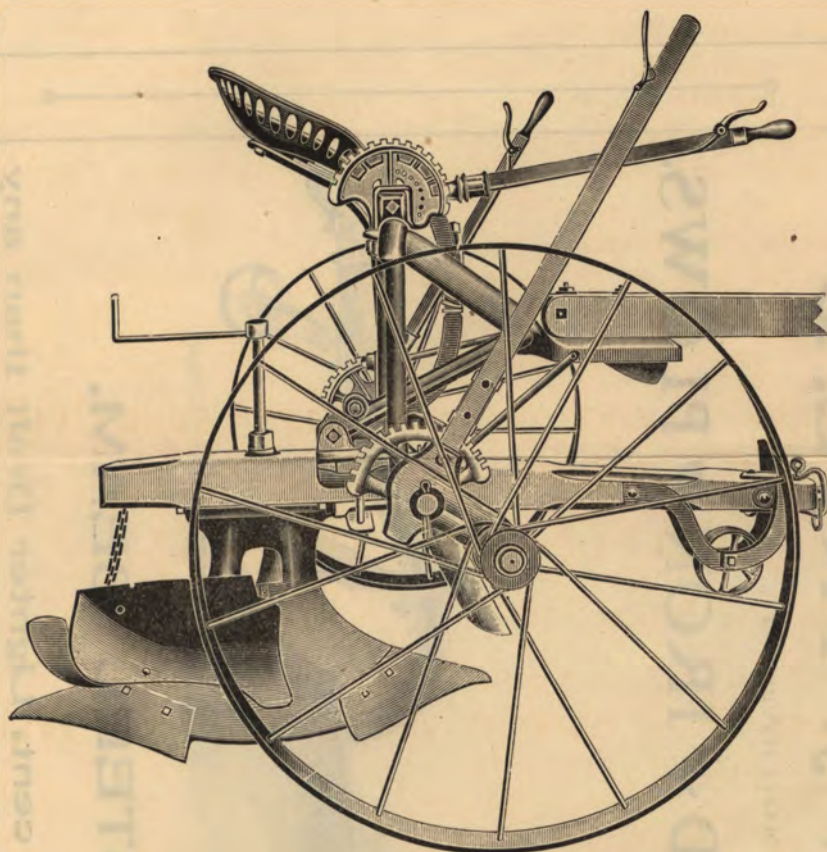

"Diamond" Reversible Sulky Plow.

The great demand for a reversible sulky plow has claimed the attention of nearly every manufacturer of plows, and the scarcity of help drives the farmer to machinery to do his work. In the "Diamond" sulky the farmer will find the long looked for.

First, the plow that will do perfect work. Second, perfect center draft both ways. Third, light work for man and team, only one plow to handle. Fourth, depth and width of furrow can be easily adjusted from four to ten inches deep, and from ten to twenty inches wide. Fifth, the simplest sulky on the market, any plow can be used with it, so if you break one plow you can use any other kind, or the plow can be left out and a harrow or cultivator used, thus combining several useful tools in one.

In this plow you will find a new departure. It is made the same at both ends, with a swivel double mouldboard, in the center to which a chain is attached to the center mouldboard, and to the under side of the beam. On top of the beam is a crank by which the driver, sitting on the seat unlocks the plow and reverses it. As the plow reverses the chain attached to the center mouldboard throws them in place on the other side, ready to go back. It is just simplicity boiled down.

Weight of the sulky and plow complete, ready to work, is three hundred pounds. Wheels and frame are steel. Every part is made of the best of stock, and warranted to do good work. Whiffletrees and yoke with every sulky.
