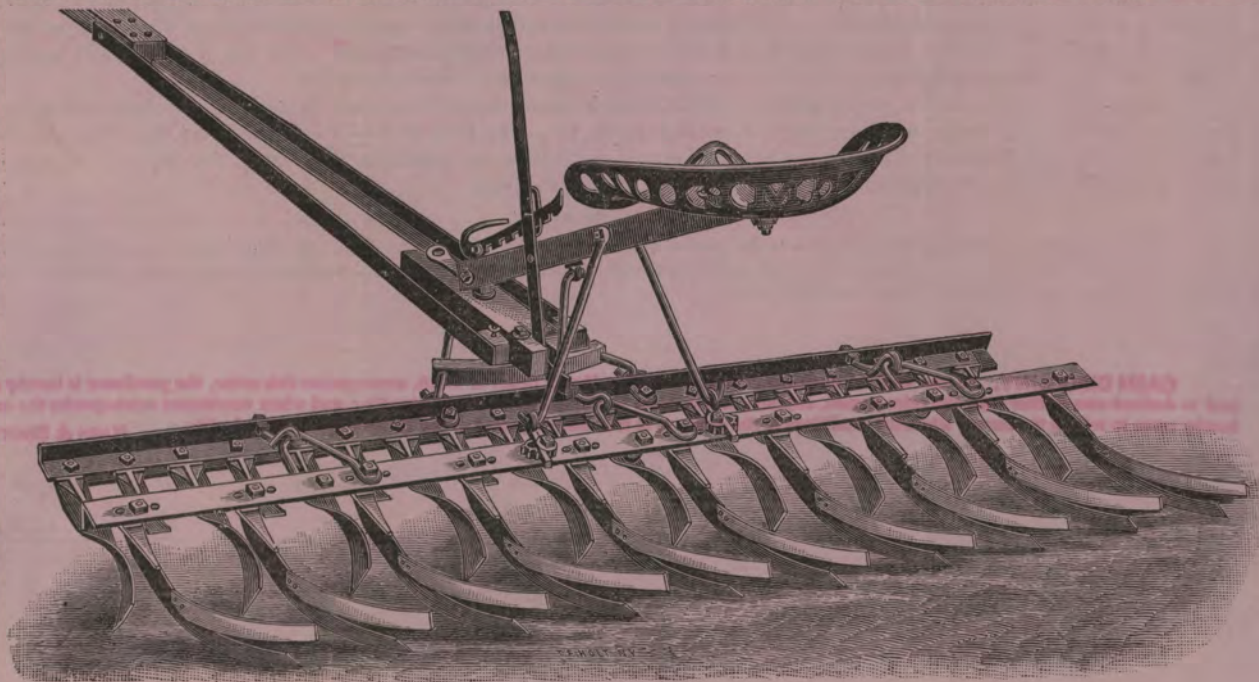

J., Shipping Receipt or Bill of Lading, you to pay return freight from my station.

If it works to my satisfaction, or if I neglect or fail to return it immediately after one half days trial as stated above, I agree to send you by Post Office Money Order on Millington, N. J., or Harrisburg, Pa., or by Draft on New York, Harrisburg, Pa., Philadelphia or Boston, the list price, viz: **Twenty-five** Dollars, or to send my note for that amount, payable at Bank, on the first day of November next; said cash or note to be given immediately after the trial referred to above.
