Strength, durability, ease of operation, and clean raking qualities are some features that have made this type Rake the favorite with hay growers.

"Eddy Yankee" Rakes are furnished with short, Guard Teeth and replaceable Pawl Pins on axles.

The simplicity in construction and its adaptability to rake anywhere, whether the fields are rough or smooth, or the hay green or dry make the "Eddy Yankee" Rake superior to other types.

No pressure bars are needed for holding down the teeth when raking, thus eliminating cramping and breaking teeth in passing obstructions; the steel spring applied separately to each tooth relieves the

strain on the tooth, allowing it to pass freely over rocks and stumps not higher than the axle. This feature alone will save money in broken teeth being done away with.

The shaped thills or shafts prevents tormenting and chafing the horse.

OPERATION

There is a hold down provided though it is seldom required. The power dump is operated by a slight pressure on the left foot. Once touched, the dumping is completed and returns to raking position without further attention. The rake may be held in a raised position by the right foot if so desired.

There is also a turned wooden hand lever provided for hand dumping.

Due to its many desirable and exclusive features and its light weight, as much hay is raked with one horse as is ordinarily raked with two horses and with no more work for the horse and much less for the operator.



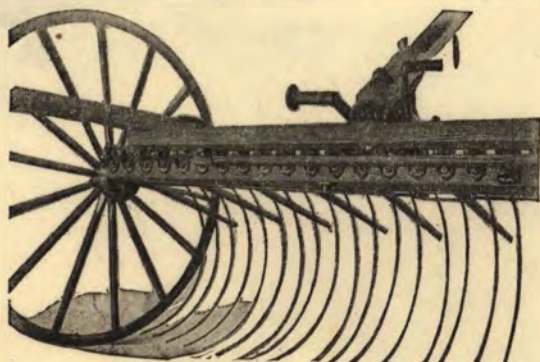
Heavy Cross Piece and Convenient Lever

FINISH

All parts are well finished and adjusted before leaving the factory. The wheels are first oil-filler primed and then painted.

The other wood parts are varnished and the iron parts painted in contrasting colors.

The "Eddy Yankee" Rake is built for one horse use only, as the draft is easy and only one horse is required. This type rake has been used by farmers for nearly half a century. It is superior to any Horse Rake on the market for quality of material and workmanship, for durability and ease of handling.
