Our Shaft Ends are made of a HEAVIER Sheet Steel than it has heretofore been possible to use.

By substituting this HEAVY Sheet Steel in place of the LIGHT Sheet Steel these Socket Shaft Ends were formerly made of, the only weak point the Butt End Filler Socket Shaft Ends ever had has been overcome.

Japanning is a very essential feature and a great deal of attention has been given to this part of the work. Two coats of Japan are applied to these Shaft Ends, using a grade that gives a good finish and will not flake off.

Nickel Plated Steel Shaft Tips are used.
