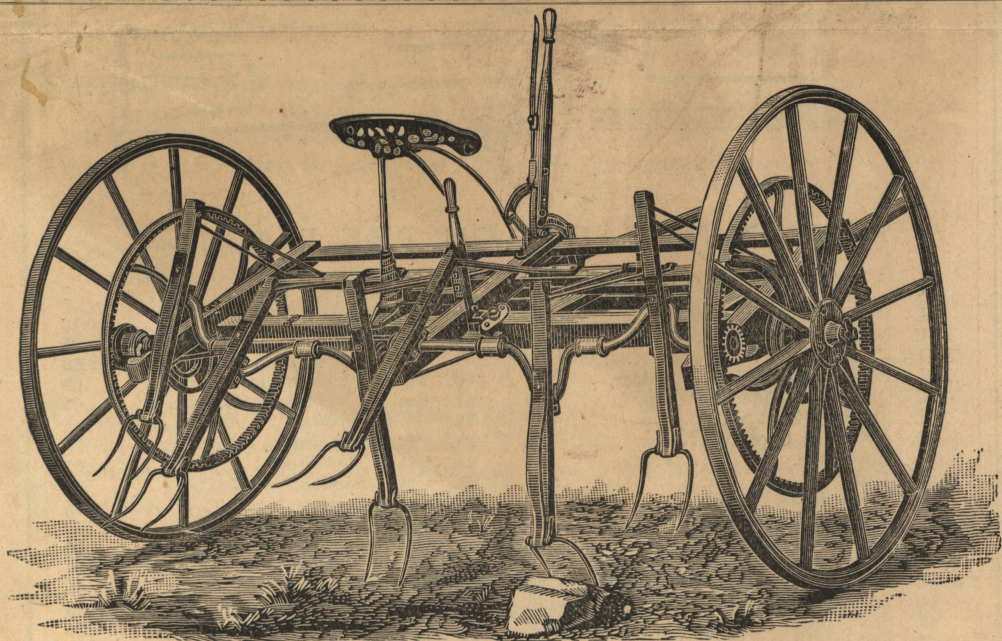

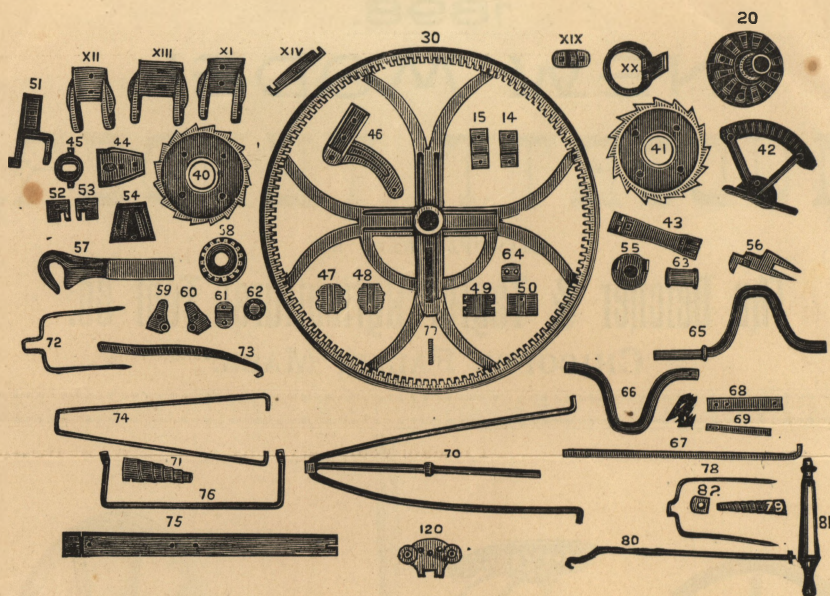

We use the volute spring under the seat, making it a very easy and safe seat for the driver.

The shipper for throwing in and out of gear, with handle easily reached from the driver's seat, is the simplest and most efficient in use.

The shafts are bent at the ends, so they will not chafe the horse's side. We can furnish combined shafts and pole, but do not recommend them as, when so used, the shafts are straight at the ends, which is objectionable.

WE CAN FURNISH TEDDERS

with either solid or divided cranks, but shall always send the divided crank unless otherwise ordered.

The forks remaining stationary when the Tedder is moved backward, the horse can be backed with perfect safety, without throwing the machine out of gear.

It has been proved that a boy with this Tedder can do work more rapidly and a great deal better, than can be done by ten men with forks.
