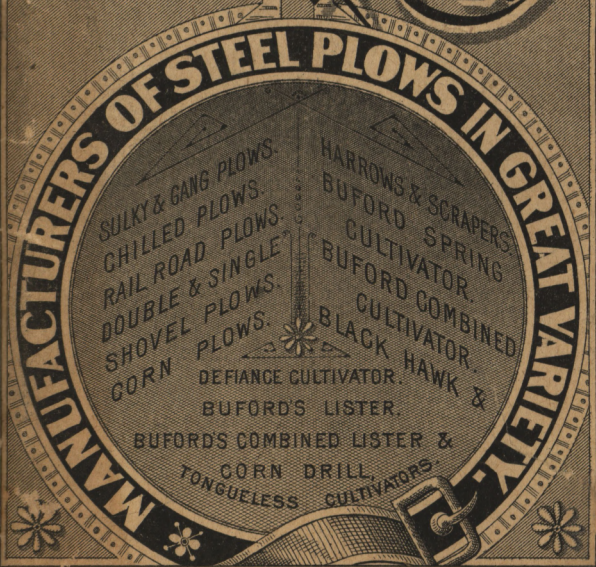

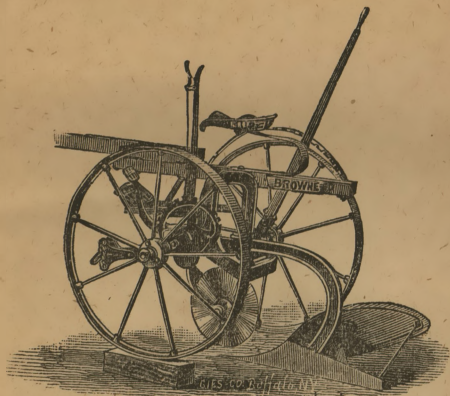

With the Buford Sulky Plow, in its present improved and simplified form, a boy can do the work of a man.

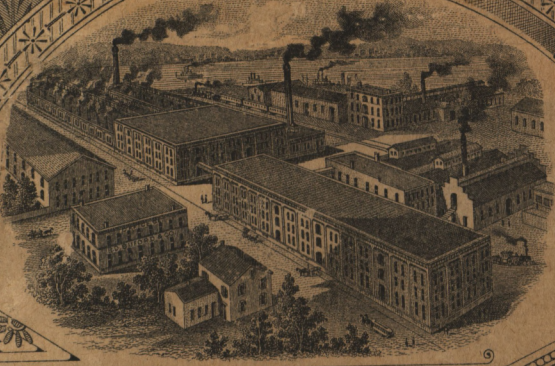
It is made entirely of iron and steel, in sizes to cut 12, 14, and 15 inches.
