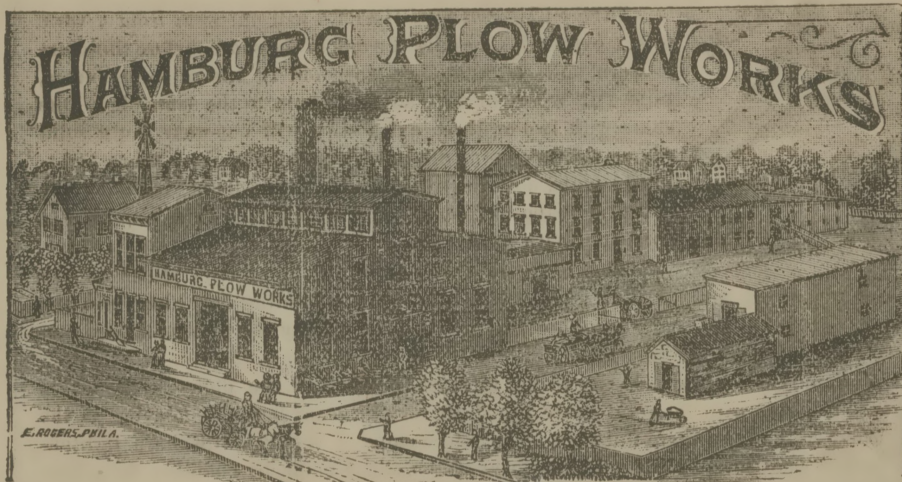

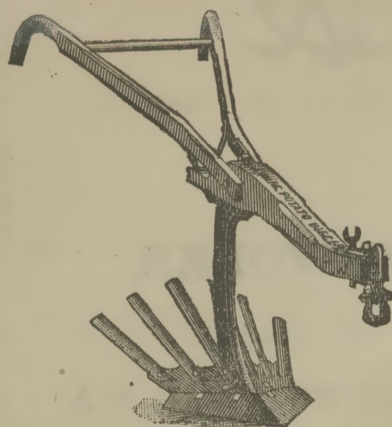

Our recently patented device to convenience setting up Plows is without a RIVAL.

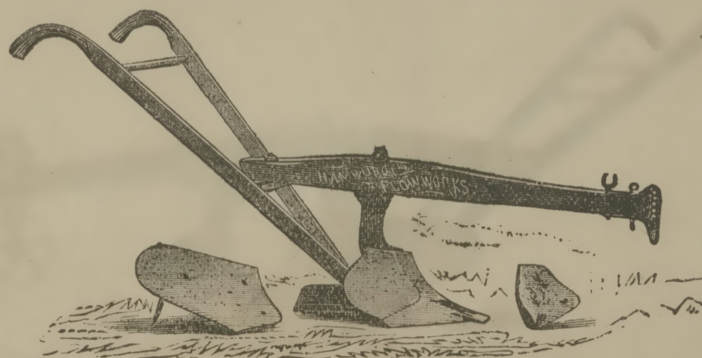

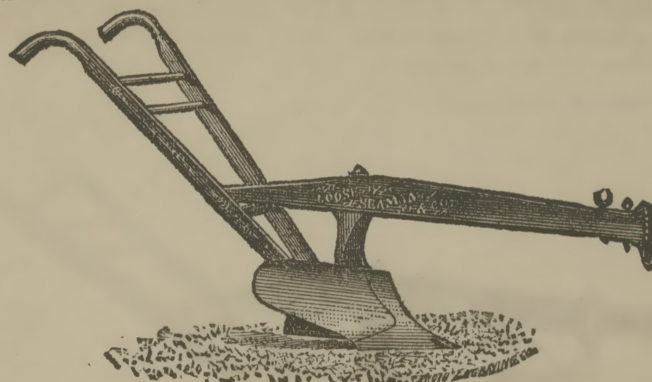

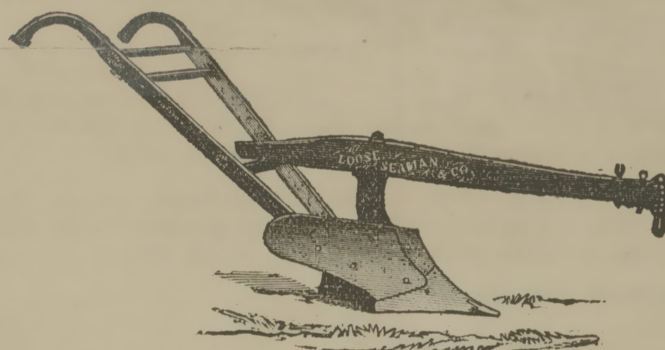


CABBAGE DAISY PLOW, with one Extra Moldboard, Reversible Slip-Share, and Extra Slip-Share. \$6.00.

COMBINATION DAISY PLOW, with two Extra Moldboards, Reversible Slip-Share, and Extra Slip Share. \$7.00.

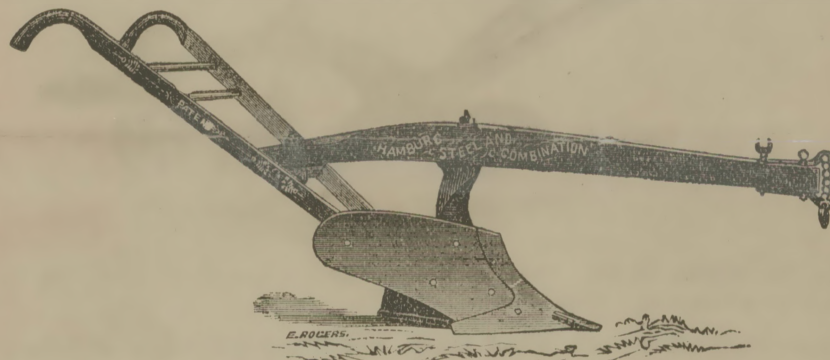


No. 6—RIGHT HAND. A Light One-Horse Plow, turns a furrow 5 to 10 inches. Price—Plain, \$5.50.

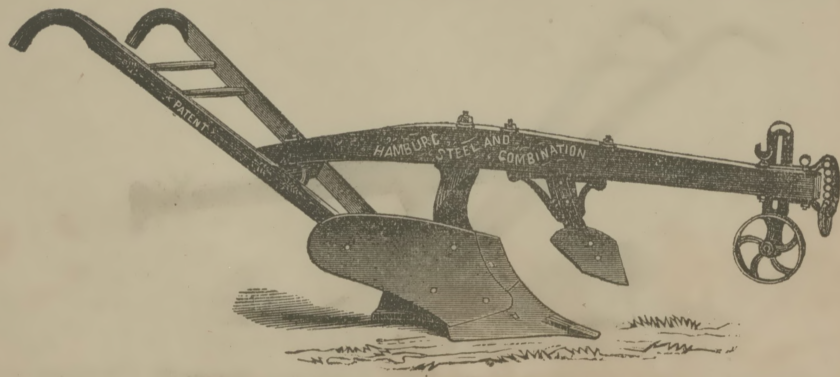

No. 21—LEFT HAND. CHILLED. A Light Two-Horse Plow, cuts 9 inches, turns a furrow 6 x 12 inches. Plain, \$10.00; with Wheel, \$11.00; with Wheel and Jointer or Coulter, \$13.00.

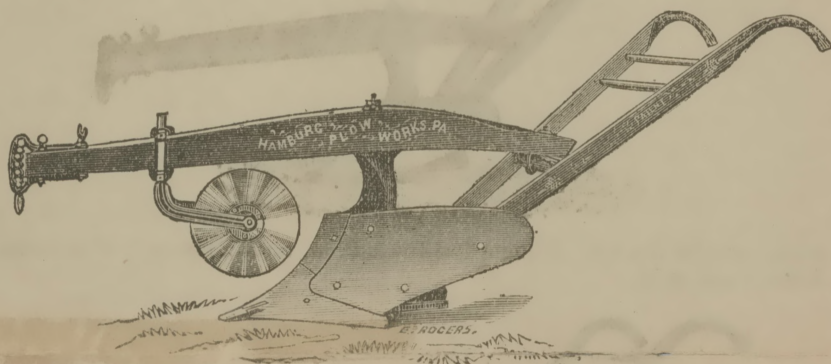

No. 24—LEFT HAND. CHILLED. A Two-Horse General Purpose Plow, cuts 10 inches, turns a furrow $6\frac{1}{2}$ x 13 to 14 inches. Plain, \$10.50; with Wheel, \$11.50; with Wheel and Jointer or Coulter, \$13.50.

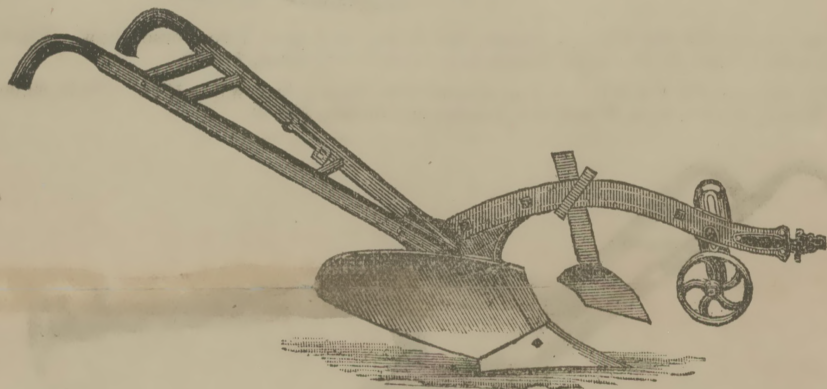

No. 18—RIGHT HAND. CHILLED. Two to Three-Horse Plow, cuts $11\frac{1}{2}$ inches, turns a furrow $7\frac{1}{2}$ to 8 x 14 to 15 inches. Plain, \$11.00; with Wheel \$12.00; with Wheel and Jointer or Coulter, \$14.00; with Rolling Coulter, \$15.00.

No. 27—LEFT HAND. CHILLED. Two to Three-Horse Plow, cuts $11\frac{1}{2}$ inches, turns a furrow $7\frac{1}{2}$ to 8 x 14 to 15 inches. Plain, \$11.00; with Wheel, \$12.00; with Wheel and Jointer or Coulter, \$14.00; with Rolling Coulter, \$15.00.

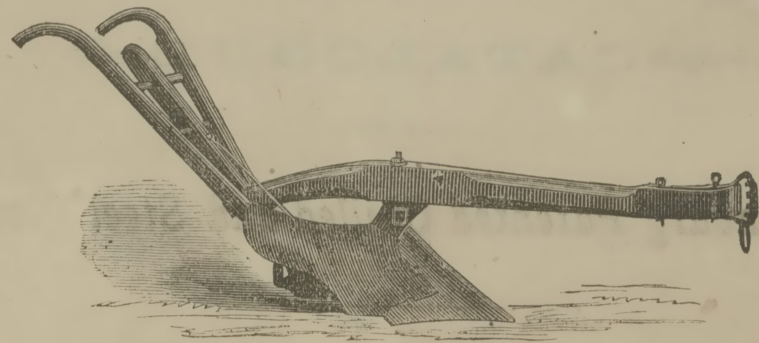


No. 115—STEEL BEAM. CHILLED MOLDBOARD. A Two-Horse Plow, cuts 10 inches, turns a furrow $6\frac{1}{2}$ x 13 to 14 inches.

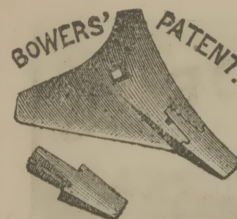

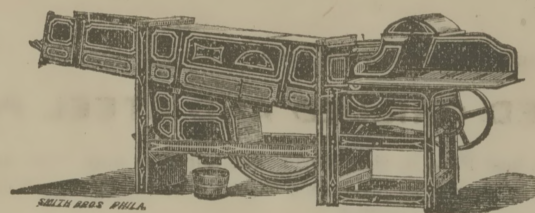


REVERSIBLE SLIP-POINT SHARE

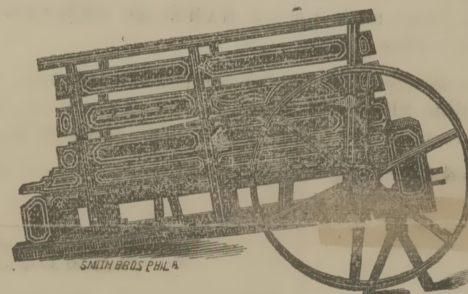
THE SLIP-POINT SHARES will out-wear from THREE to SIX extra slips, besides the one in the share, before the share is worn out. EVERY SLIP worn out in one of these shares, DOES THE WORK OF TWO SOLID SHARES to the same plow. One share with two or three extra slips will out-wear FOUR solid shares. Every extra slip-point worn out in these shares, costing 14 cents, does the work of two solid shares, reducing the cost of plowing to 7 cents per share for each extra slip used as compared with solid shares.

The Reversible Slip-Point Share always sticks to the ground, it will not run out, thus avoiding the hard work of holding the Plow into the ground. It will always cut a level bottom furrow, consequently the plowman need not tire himself by steadying the Plow.

A share that is always sharp will not increase the draft of the plow as the share wears. Whereas with the solid share the draft for the team becomes heavier as the point and wing of the share dubs off. The gentle slope of the R. Slip-Share lightens the draft. The Reversible Slip-Share always has a sharp point, by enabling the plowman to turn over the point when one side rounds up. The wing or edge of share is SHARP until worn out.
