

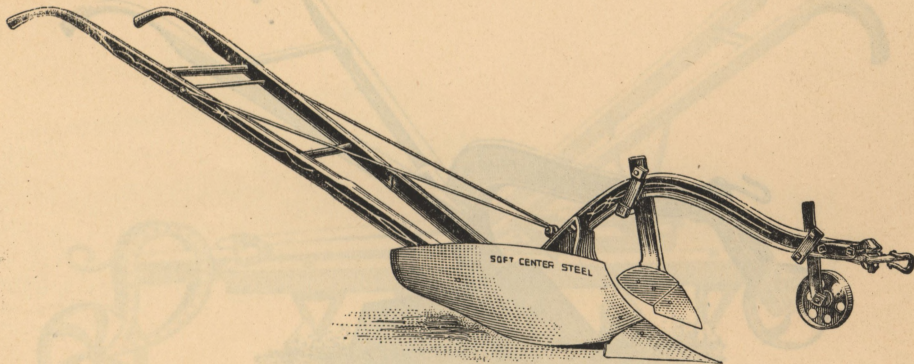

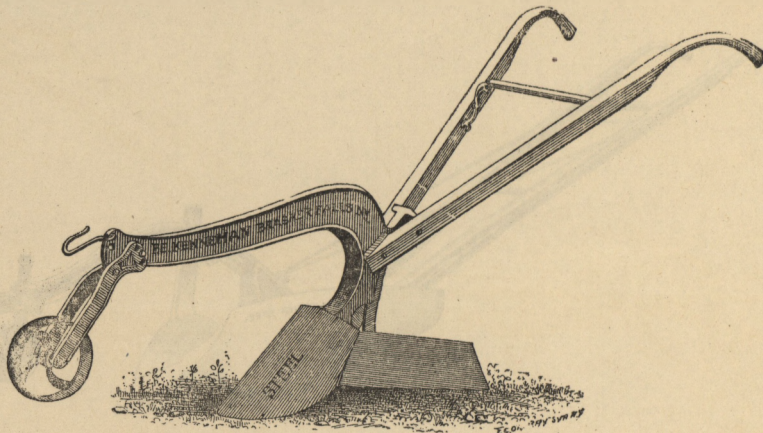

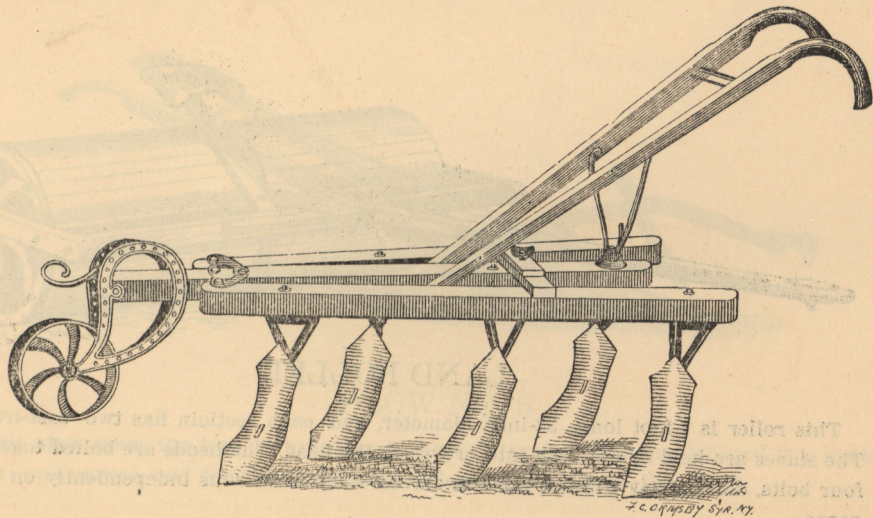
PLOW No. 35, HIGH BEAM

This plow combines all the good qualities of our No. 6 plow with the advantages of having a high beam, working equally well on old or new ground. It is a very light-draft plow and adapted to heavy soil.

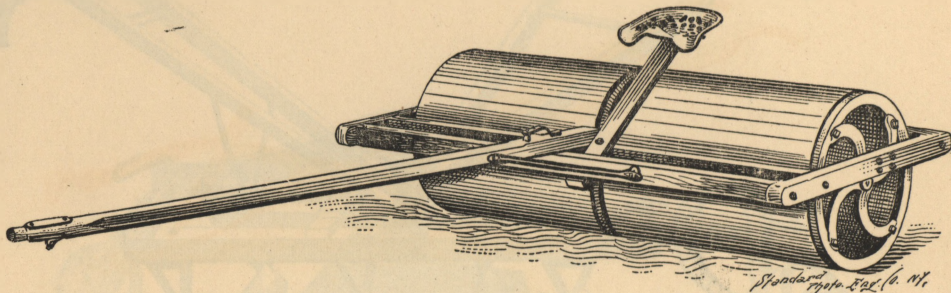


IRON BEAM HORSE HOE

This horse plow has cast steel adjustable wings for any width in potatoes, corn, etc. It has also a wheel and hanger which can be adjusted to run any depth required in light or gravelly soil, making it the best horse hoe in the market. There is a shoe on bottom of hoe which secures a steady motion and regulates the depth in connection with wheel.

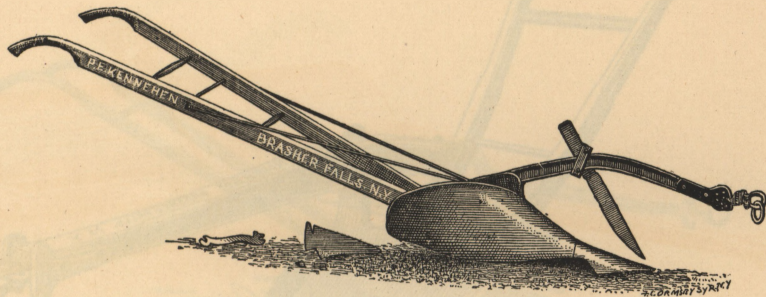


WOOD FRAME CULTIVATOR



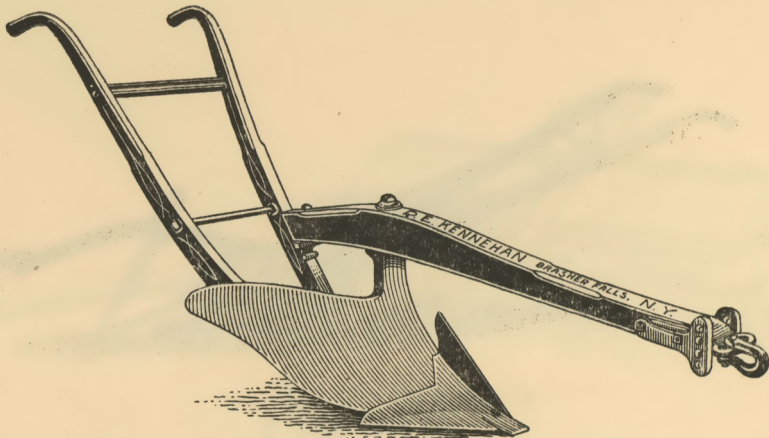
LAND ROLLER

This roller is 7-foot long, 32-inch diameter, and each section has two cast-iron heads. The staves are held by entering into grooves in the head. The heads are bolted together with four bolts, doing away with all bolts in staves. Each head runs independently on cast gudgeons.



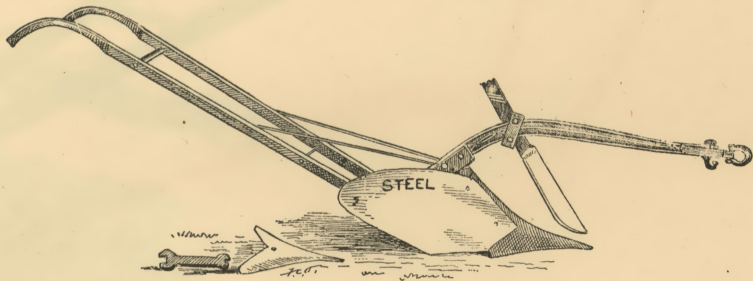
PLOW NO. 5

This plow takes the lead in breaking in heavy clay soil. The mouldboard is a model of grace and curves, and for cleaning qualifications is the best in the world.



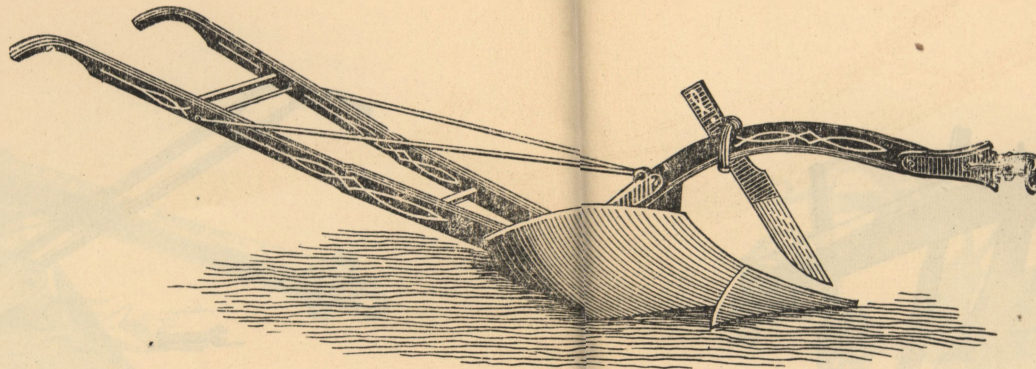
ONE HORSE PLOW No. 19 1-2

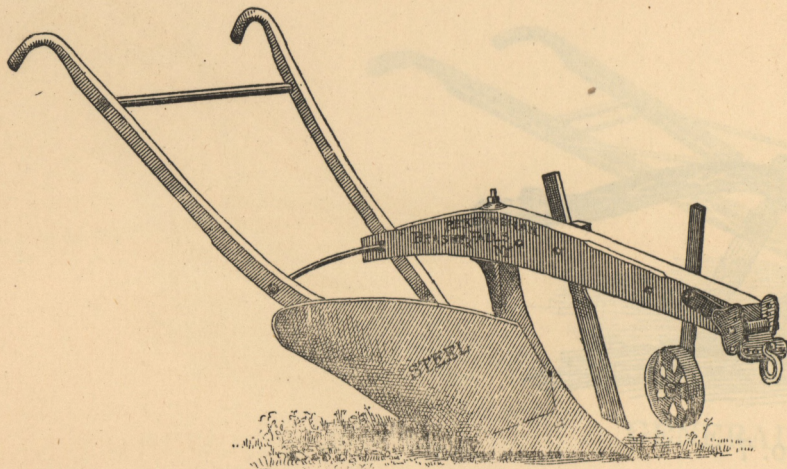
PLOW NO. 40

This plow has medium length handler, is a general purpose plow, works well in old ground, and is also a very good sod plow.



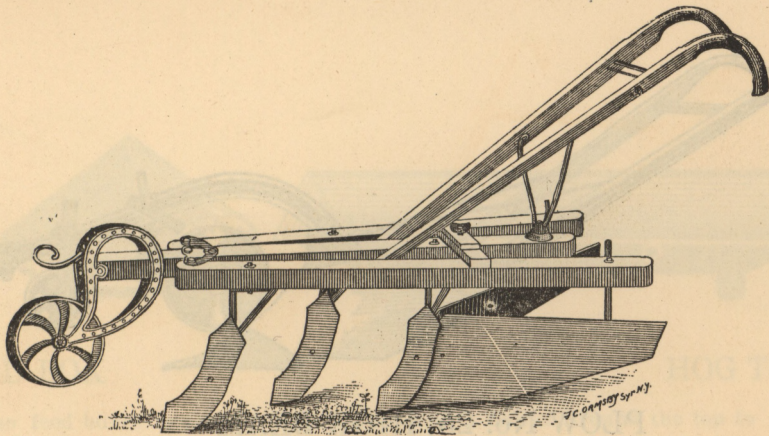
GENERAL PURPOSE PLOW No. 7

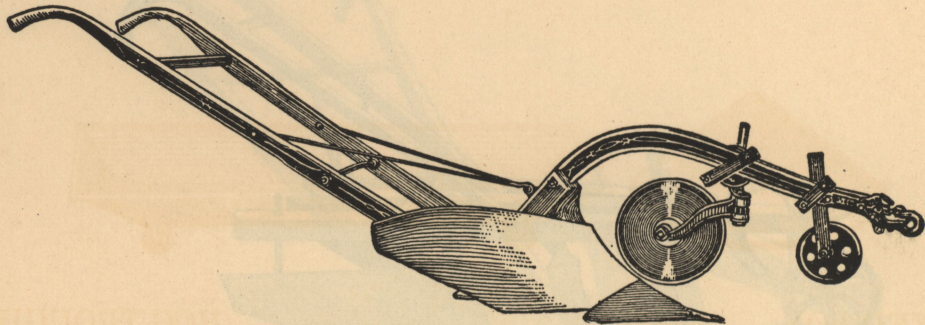
PLOW NO. 4

This plow is made with either steel or chilled mouldboards, is adapted for any kind of soil, and is just the thing for breaking, or stubble.



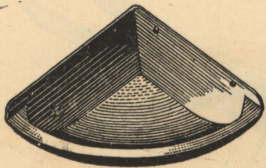
WOOD FRAME CULTIVATOR WITH WRIGHT'S HILLER

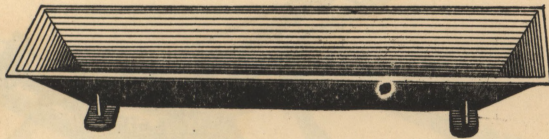
PLOW No. 25, HIGH BEAM

This is one of our best plows for general work. It has medium length handles with a high beam. It cannot be excelled in stubble ground or in breaking up in rough ground.



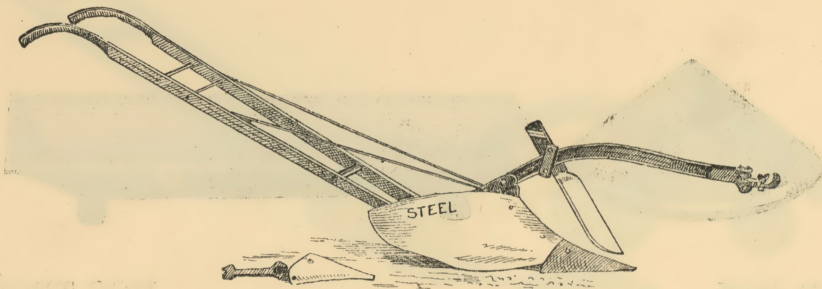
FEED BOX

These feed boxes are made extra heavy with a flange around the top to prevent the horse from throwing the grain out of the box.



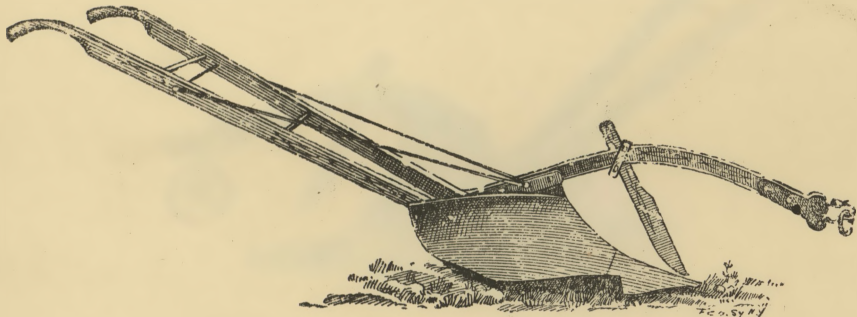
HOG TROUGH

The hog troughs are made in three, four, five and six foot lengths.



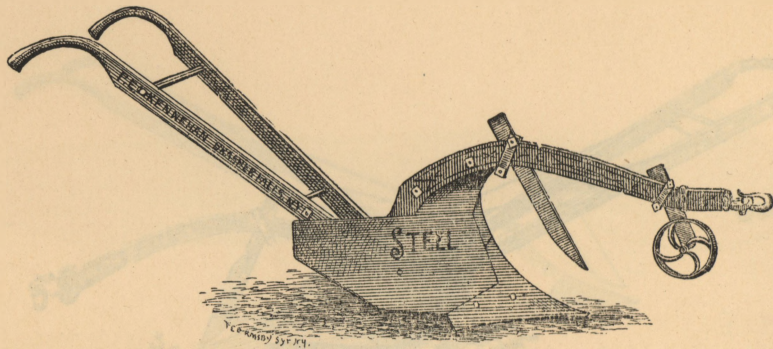
PLOW NO. 6
