

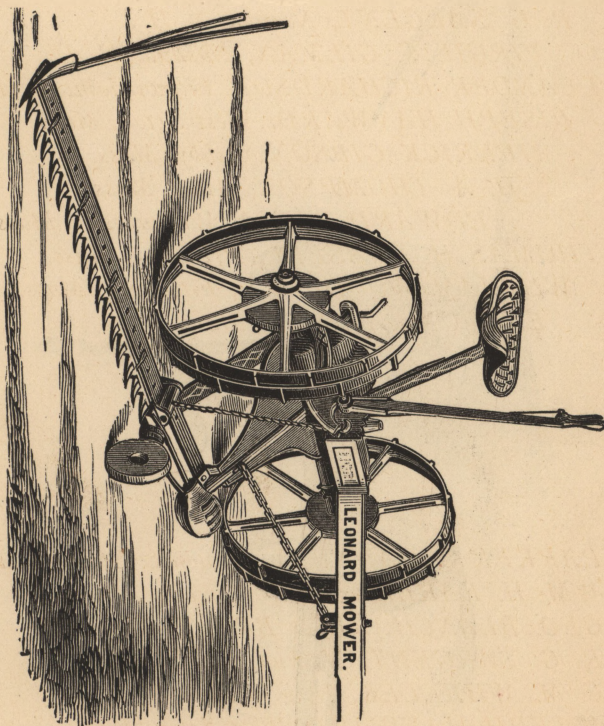

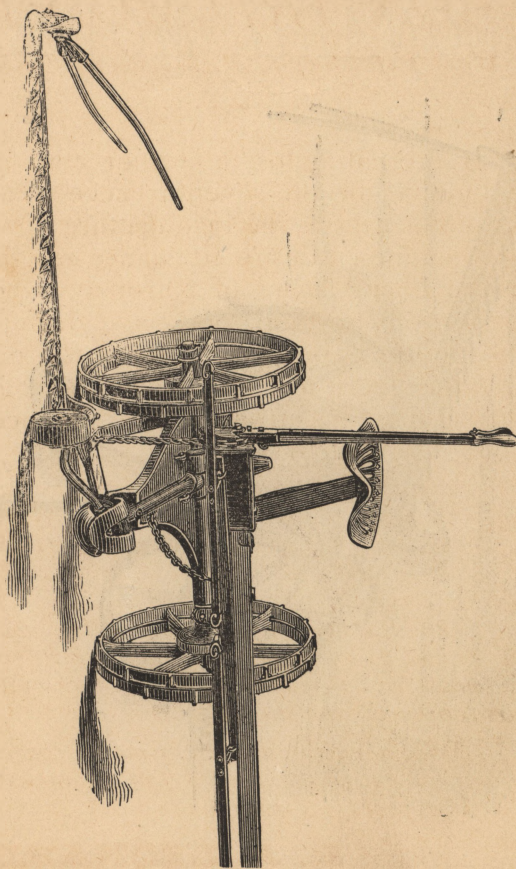

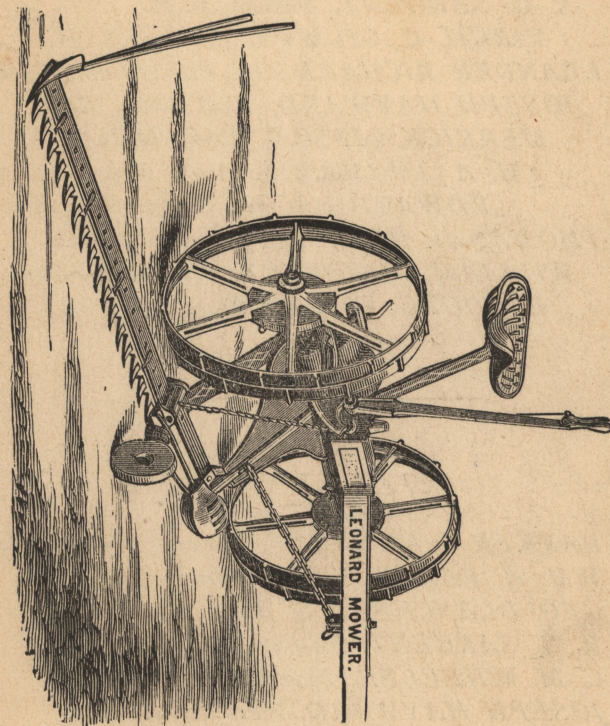
TWO-HORSE MOWER.
