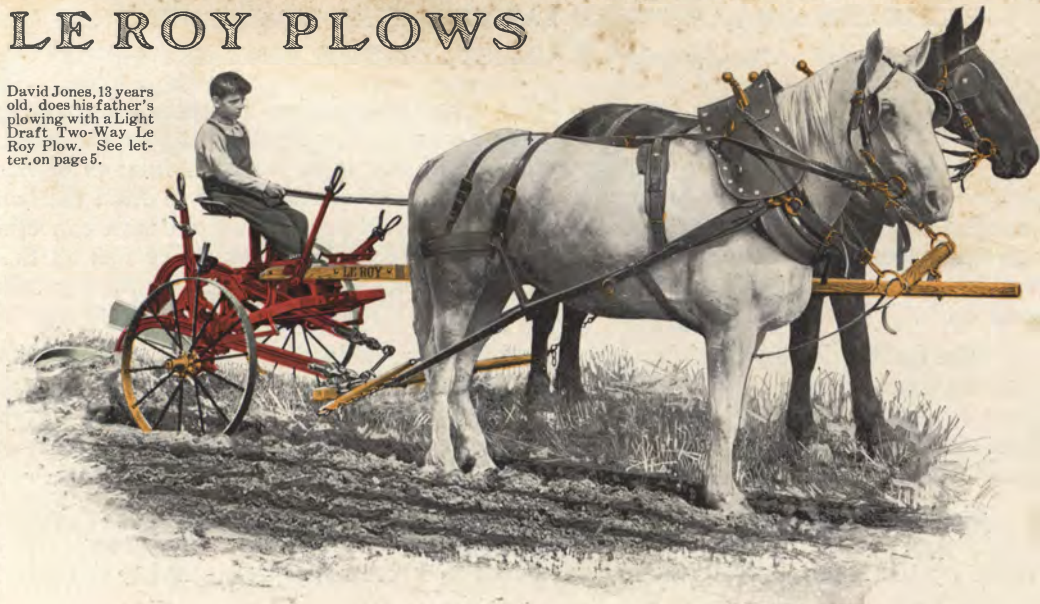

The Light Draft Le Roy Two-Way Sulky is especially designed to satisfy the most up-to-date Farmers throughout the Middle East and New England States who require a plow which will save driving around the ends, leave no dead furrows or back furrows, permit the operator to drop dead furrows where it is necessary to drain the land, and also be so easy to handle that a small boy like David Jones or an old man can operate it without any trouble. The Light Draft Le Roy Two-Way Sulky fills all these requirements and is guaranteed to do better work than any other two-way sulky plow built.

The Le Roy is very light draft, steady, durable, reliable, pays for itself quickly, saves walking 7 miles to the acre, and does good work in all the various conditions of sod, stubble, clay, hard, stony, or gravelly soils. It will work equally well where there are stumps, fast stones or large loose stones, where the ground is uneven and where the fields are small or of irregular shape.

In use, one Plow is raised while the other turns the furrow. At the end of the furrow, by pressing down on the Foot-trip or lower handle of the Lever, this Plow is mechanically raised by the horses, leaving the driver's hands free to manage them. After the turn is

made and the other Plow lowered, the Whiffletree hitch draws into place and remains there.

The Frame is made of the best steel and malleable iron, making it light, strong and unbreakable, and is extra wide to prevent tipping over on side hills. Both Wheels are strong, made of steel with stagger spokes. All Levers and Castings, excepting the Plow Bottoms, are made of the best malleable iron.

Our Pole Adjustment (Patent Applied for) is the simplest and most efficient on the market, and is operated by a Lever directly in front of the driver, enabling him to make an easy shift to obtain the Full Width of the furrow while plowing on side hills or around curves. The Plow Beams can also be turned to the left or to the right, to take more or less land, by loosening four bolts under the Beam Plate.

The Pole is quickly changed from a two- to a three-horse hitch by bolting it on the opposite side of the Stub Pole, the balance being so carefully adjusted that the pole is steady but will not drag down on the horses' necks.

The Foot-trip is operated by pressing down the pedals in front of the driver, is simple, durable, reliable, and is guaranteed to be the best working Foot-trip made.

The No. 73 right and left chilled Bottoms are duplicates of the Nos. 110 and 510; the No. 71 right and left are one size smaller. The No. 70 right and left are duplicates of the Nos. 108 and 508. The combination Bottoms have soft center crucible steel Moldboards, solid steel landsides, with cast shoe and solid steel or cast Share.

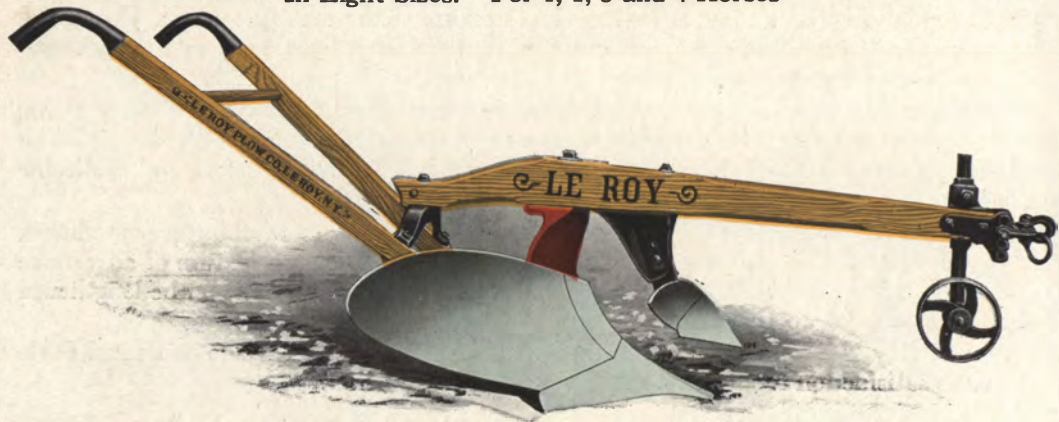

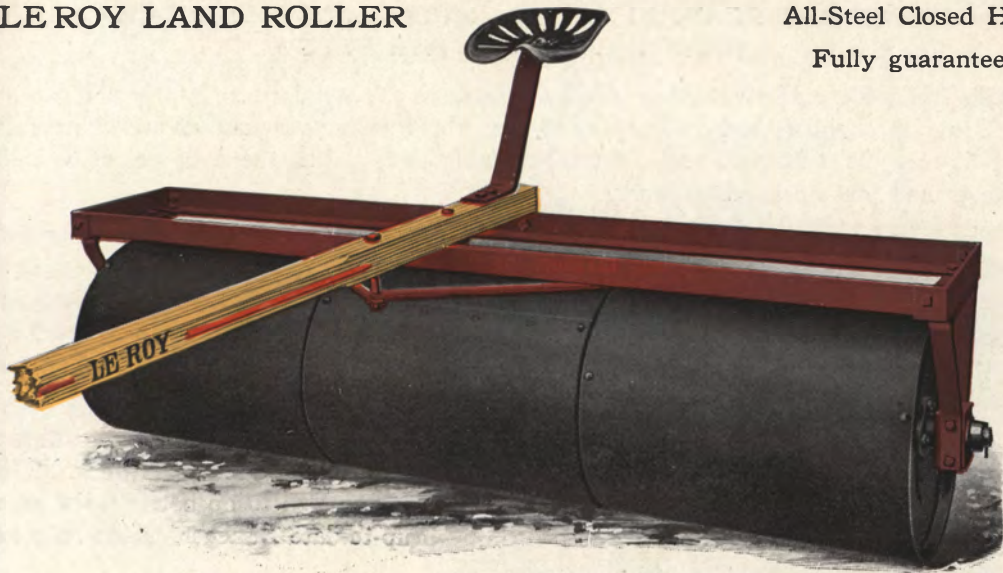

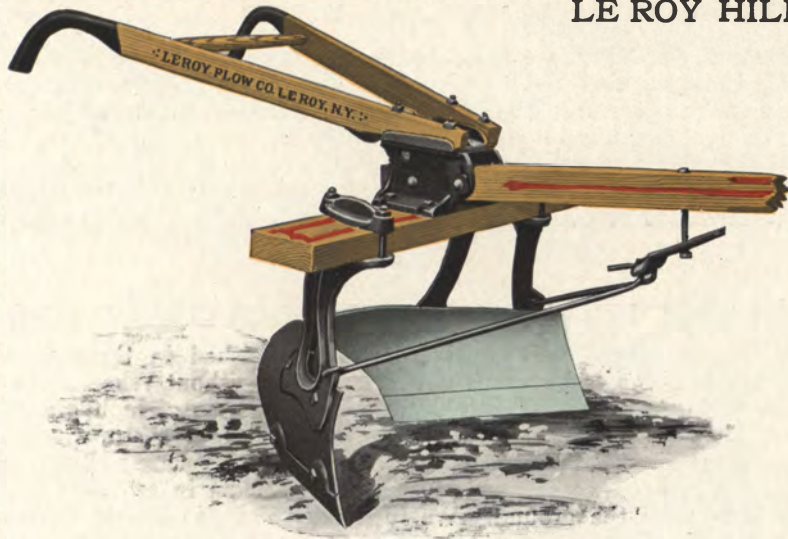
