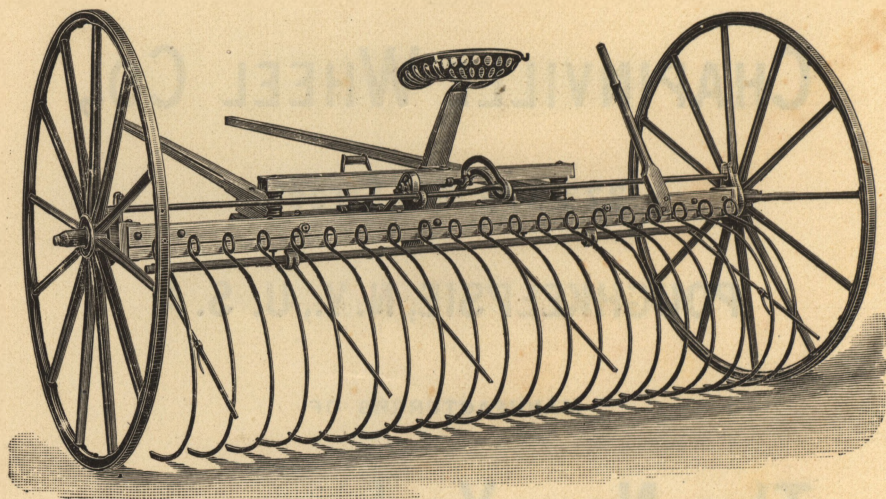

IT RAKES THE HAY BUT DOES NOT ROLL

IT IN A ROPE.

A very important feature in a rake is the way it gathers the hay. Some roll the hay over and over, leaving it when dumped in a rope.

The New Yorker has a small spur on the two end cleaner rods, **which prevents rolling**, and enables the hay to be slid along on the ground, and when dumped leaves the damp part on top.

THE SHAPE OF THE TEETH IS SUCH

that they do not scratch up the ground but **rake the stubble** and leave all rubbish on the ground.

The teeth on our rake are not liable to break, as they are **very evenly hung**, and have a spring which allows them to be bent back without breaking.

We only use the **best of teeth** and spare no expense in getting a tooth that will stand, and one that **has stood the test of years**, and has proved itself reliable.

The New Yorker has the **most accurate** as well as the **most durable** dumping arrangement of any rake on the market. The dump is not only positive but **is at all times under perfect control**.

The driver has simply to press the dump lever lightly with the foot and the teeth raise high in the air, and when the teeth reach the proper point they return **without any effort** on the part of the driver.

OSCILLATING CLEANER.

Our rakes are all fitted with our Oscillating Steel Cleaner Rods (patent applied for), which are made from the **best of steel** and finished in **first-class style**. We call especial attention to the movement of this cleaner, which by its **up and down**

motion keeps the hay in a **compact windrow**, and raises as the hay gathers, the weight of **the cleaner pressing down the hay**.

The ratchets on the hubs are so **covered and protected** that the **hay can not wind** in the wheel.

The rake is dumped by **either wheel alone** and without side draft, and **can be dumped in any position** the rake may be drawn.

The New Yorker is fitted with **steel seat**, large and easy to ride on.

It has a **steel seat spring** attached to wood standard, which can be **raised or lowered** to suit the driver.

The New Yorker is provided with a **foot lever** by which the **teeth can be held down** to their work in carrying a large load, and by the same lever the teeth can be held in a raised position, and the rake driven anywhere on the road and across the fields. This will be found very convenient in bunching windrows.

We have **no springs to break** and get out of order, which is very important in a hay rake.

Our axle is so hung to the thills that there is **no jar on the thills** in dumping, and the thills work as freely as any carriage.

We believe our rake is **the simplest** as well as **the best rake** on the market, and is so simple and easy to manage that **a boy can handle it** without trouble.

Our prices are **as low as can be afforded** and still keep up the standard of quality, which is our aim at all times.
