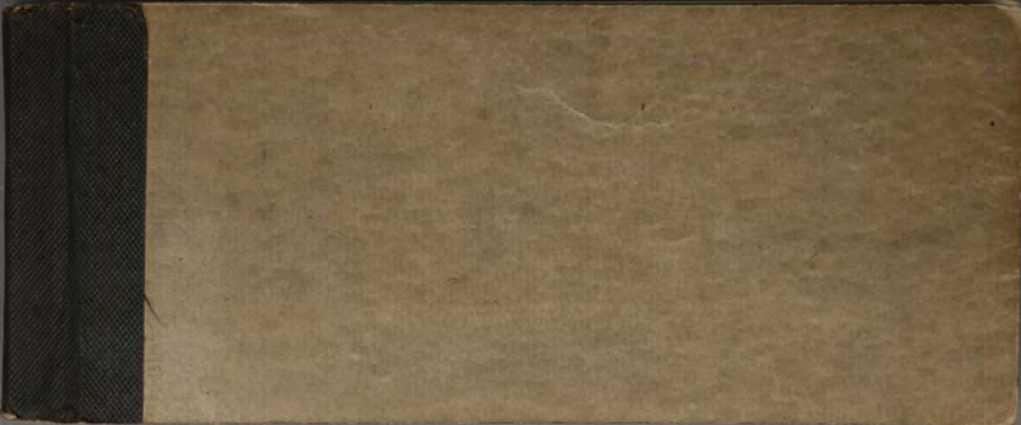




The front cover is left blank for Boy Scout Symbols and inscriptions.
