Attached for your information are clips from the San Francisco area newspapers on the arrest of four demonstrators at the Lawrence Radiation Laboratory, Livermore, on August 9, 1960. Also attached is a copy of a statement distributed by the demonstrators.

News media representatives stationed themselves six to ten feet from the spot of the arrest. Radio men were not present, but the arrest story was covered factually in newscasts. The news media also covered the arraignment at Santa Rita.
