This concerns Mr. Tokutaro Matsumoto who visited Oak Ridge National Laboratory on Monday, October 14, 1963. He has written to me from Europe where he is continuing his tour that he senses what seems to him to be symptoms of exposure to radiation on his face and particularly eyes and cannot imagine any place other than Oak Ridge where he could possibly have been dosed. While he is not able to recall any specific occasion during his stay which could have occasioned such an exposure, we would be grateful if you could kindly check your records to see if anything abnormal might have been registered on the film badge worn by Matsumoto during his visit.

May I thank you in advance for the trouble and letting me know of your findings.
