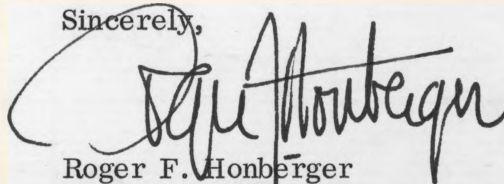
Dear Mr. Ink:
