I understand you are interested in the list of recommendations which we gave to Frank Keppel and Secretary Celebrezze concerning the Office of Education.

I would stress that we have gone to considerable length to "low key" our operation and to handle the matter in such a way that the public attention would be focused upon the constructive steps taken by the Office of Education, rather than the flagging by the White House Task Force of areas in need of strengthening. Consequently, most of the rationale and the detail was covered in memoranda from me to Frank Keppel and in conference with him and Secretary Celebrezze.
