PRIVATE NOTE FOR RUFUS MILES:

Attached is a copy of our suggestions for Frank concerning a special ad hoc recruiting machinery which we believe would be helpful in meeting their immediate needs.

I failed to mention on the phone the references in the last paragraph of my "confidential" memo to Keppel, which states that you and the Civil Service Commission are going to make available six classifiers to augment the present staff for several months. I understand that the Civil Service Commission will make one available, leaving five, if the need is great, from HEW. (I believe Gil Schulkind has discussed this with you and it is acceptable from your standpoint. Let me know if there is any problem.)

The "confidential" covering note to Frank should, I believe, be held very closely. The attachment can be used as necessary within the staff.
