KEOSAUQUA— Increasing reports of bald eagle sightings along the Des Moines River in Van Buren County were verified Tuesday by Todd Williams of Cantril and Greg McQuoid of Milton, who saw about 50 on an island upstream from Pittsburg.

Williams, 18, and McQuoid, 20, were paddling downstream in a

kayak owned by McQuoid's father, Marvin McQuoid, when they came upon the large flock which included one golden eagle.

Both avid nature lovers, they described the sighting as a real thrill. As a bonus, a sizeable flock of wild turkeys and several ducks flew overhead during their river trip.
