Winter 1983-84

We received a mixture of rain and snow on Nov. 26 covered by 8" of snow on Nov 28 with additional snow to a depth of approx. 11" during Dec. The weather bureau reported Dec. was 17.9 degrees F below normal with an average temp of 7.8 degrees.

Probably as a result of the snow cover I had an American Kestrel that I observed 3 times (twice I saw that he carried away a house sparrow) coming into my ~~yard~~ yard to catch a sparrow. He probably came other times I did not see.

The weather bureau reported January as 2.8 degrees above normal and our snow cover gradually decreased

I'm sure that Feb will average above normal although the last week was probably a bit below normal.

The severe winter storm of the weekend of Feb 18-19 went north of the Omaha-CB area and we received only a little snow.

The severe winter storm of the weekend of Feb 25-26 went south of the Omaha- CB area and we got only about 1" of snow.

I did not file a fall report and the only thing significant I should have reported was: A pair of evening grosbeaks on Nov. 29, 1983 *back yard feeder*

This was the poorest purple finch winter I've had in my 4 years here.

This was the best American goldfinch season I've had in those years

I saw no redpolls and only two Pine Siskins during the winter period.
