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CLOSE HOME SEASON

Today's football game with Nebraska closes the home season for 1951. Some 15,000 fans are here in the stands to do honor to a fine team and to the parents of the students of Iowa State College.

Parents of the football players will have honored places during the game and will be guests of the athletic council and athletic department at a reception in West Stadium lounge after the game.

For the forty-seventh time since 1891, the Cyclones and Cornhuskers will do football battle with each other here today. Only ten times in the long series has an Iowa State team won. Thirty-five victories have gone to Nebraska while one game ended in a tie. Last Cyclone triumph was in 1945, 27-7.

So far this year the season has been a disappointing one to Nebraska. One tie and five losses are on the record. But don't let that record lull you into any sense of false security if you are a Cyclone fan. The fabulous Bobby Reynolds is back in action for the Nebraskans and getting tougher every game. Scout Ray Donels said earlier this week that Nebraska's play against Kansas had been the best shown by the Cornhuskers this year.

Only inopportune fumbles in that game kept the Cornhuskers from gaining victory No. 1 for 1951.

Reynolds needs little introduction for the average football crowd. Last year he started the season known only in the Big Seven area. Before three games had gone by he was a cinch for every all-American in the nation. He received more awards than any other first year man in the history of the game and became the greatest scorer in NCAA football history with 157 points.

Out with a shoulder injury early in the year, he is back running the Nebraska club in his old, dangerous fashion.

So far this year Iowa State has won four games, lost two and tied one. The victories

were over Wayne, 53-21; Kansas State, 32-6; Missouri, 21-14, and Drake, 13-0. The tie was with Marquette, 6-6. Losses were to Kansas, 33-53, and Colorado, 20-47.

Nebraska gained a 6-6 tie with Kansas State early in the year. Losses were to Texas Christian, 7-28; Penn State, 7-15; Minnesota, 20-39; Missouri, 19-35, and Kansas, 7-27.

The game will be the final one for seven lettermen. The list of lettered veterans who'll be playing their last games for the Cyclones today includes five who'll have won three letters each. They are Mal Schmidt, left end from Ames; Bob Jacobson, left tackle from Rochelle, Ill.; Stan Campbell, left guard from Rochelle, Ill.; Melvin Meling, left halfback from Rochelle, Ill.; and Maury Schnell, fullback from Carroll.

The other two men both will have won a pair of letters in football. They are Bob Voetberg, right end from Traer, and George Hess, defensive quarterback from Estherville.

The last game of the season for Iowa State comes up next week at Norman, Okla., where powerful Oklahoma is waiting in its usual role of about to be crowned Big Seven champions. That Nov. 17 contest will wind up the 1951 season as far as Iowa State is concerned although several other conference games will remain to be played. Other conference action today takes place at Lawrence, Kan., where the Jayhawkers are facing pass-conscious Loyola of Los Angeles; at Tulsa, Okla., where a great Tulsa team is to meet Kansas State; at Columbia, Mo., where the Tigers play host to the league leading Sooners, and at Boulder Colo., where the second place Buffs meet Utah.
