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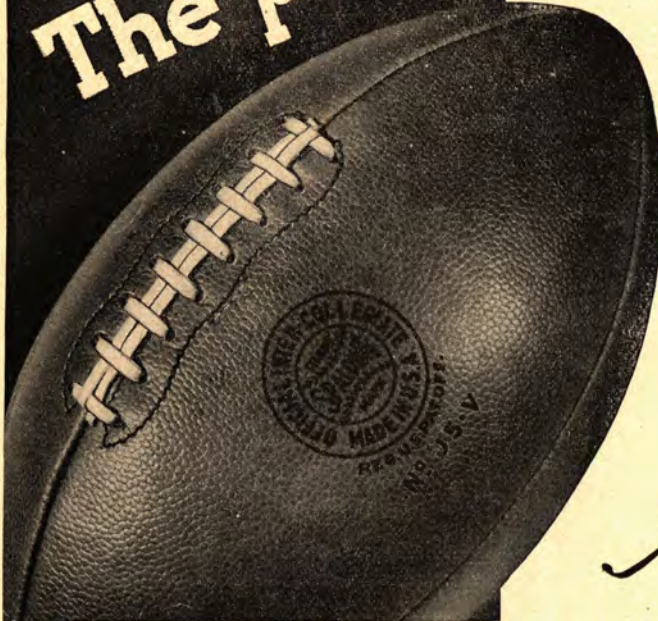

Tigers Invade The Cyclone Camp

Coach Don Faurot Makes Debut In Big Six Circles At Iowa State Homecoming

Two Big Six elevens, evenly matched and well coached, battling for their first conference victory of the season:

The Iowa State-Missouri game on State Field in 1935.

And while the fighting Cyclones are bound to do victory for Homecoming alumni this afternoon, the wily Tigers are equally determined to chalk up a win for their new mentor in his first Big Six clash.

Don Faurot, one of the institution's favorite sons, is guiding the destinies of the Tiger this year in an effort to restore Missouri to the gridiron glory that once was hers. During the last 5 years the Tigers have suffered



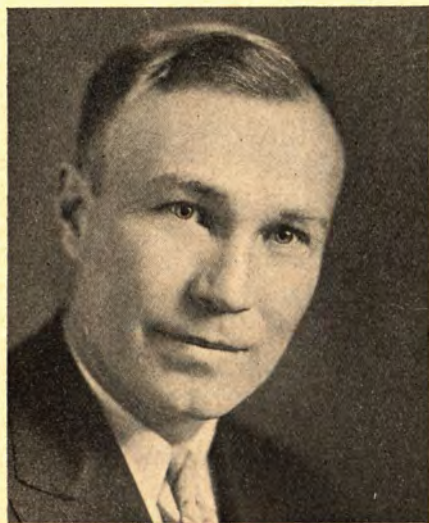

a humiliating series of defeats and on the youthful Faurot rests the responsibility of writing a new page into Missouri history.

Coach Faurot himself has played on State Field and since graduation has made football history coaching at Kirksville State Teachers College, Kirksville, Mo. Using what is known

as a moderated Warner System, which was good enough to run up twenty-six successive victories at Kirksville, Faurot employs the double and single wing-back formations.

The shift and method of calling signals which the Tigers will use on State Field this afternoon is the brain-child of the Tiger coach, and scouts

report it one of the most effective methods of covering up which way the play will go. Watch and see.

Ever since Coach George Veenker took over the Cyclone reins in 1931, Iowa State elevens have been consistently conceded as one of the best coached aggregations in the Big Six conference. Throughout his five years as Cyclone mentor, Veenker has relied upon speed, deception and smart football to win a majority of the games.

This year is no exception.

The Cyclones are one of the lightest teams in the conference and though outweighed and sometimes outreserved, they have yet to be outplayed. Their aerial attack, one of the chief weaknesses of early season, has shown consistent improvement and will add much to the Iowa State offense before the end of the schedule.

Fortieth Anniversary Clash

Iowa State's football relations with the University of Missouri Tigers are 40 years old today. During that time Cyclone battles with the Tiger has been more frequent than those with any other Big Six school.

Teams representing these two midwestern institutions have struggled against each other 28 times on the gridiron, 13 of the games resulting in victories for Iowa State, 12 in wins for Missouri, and 3 in tie scores.

Today on State Field these two traditional foes continue their competition before Homecoming fans. Since the beginning of relations back in the year when that famous Iowa State eleven won the sobriquet of "Cyclones," the rivalry between these two teams has been of the fiercest sort. In early games the Cyclones proved superior to the Tigers, then the tide turned and Missouri chalked up a series of wins, while since 1930 Iowa State has again dominated the situation.

Today's will be the fourth game of the 1935 season for the Tigers but it will mark their first appearance in conference competition. Outside the Big Six they boast a perfect record of 3 wins in as many starts: Missouri 7-Warrensburg 0; Missouri 20-William Jewell 0; Missouri 20-Colorado 6.

The Cyclones, swinging into their conference competition in early season, have suffered defeat at the hands of Nebraska and Oklahoma, while defeating Upper Iowa 23 to 0 and tying Cornell 6-6.

Welcome, Mr. Edgar, and salutations for a job well done.

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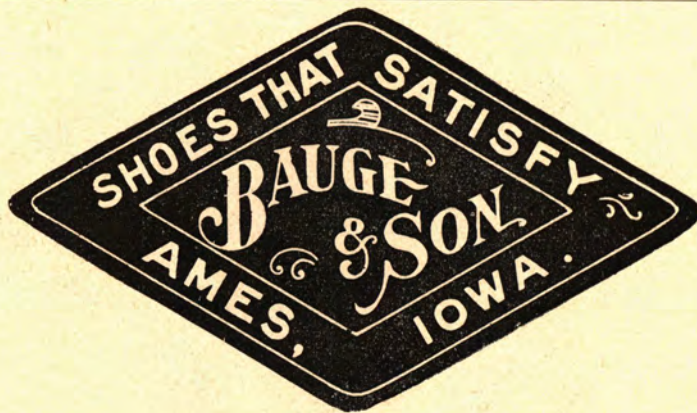

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Statement

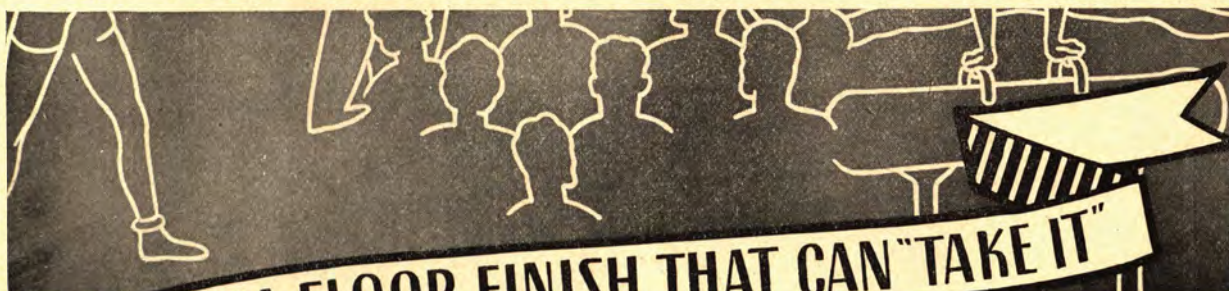
Some time ago the Federal Congress passed an act providing for a tax on admissions to athletic events, the tax being ten per cent (10%).

Attorney General Edward L. O'Connor has ruled that this tax does not apply to athletic contests and exhibitions of Iowa State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts. However, a test suit has been instituted by the govern-

ment in West Virginia and pending the outcome of this suit, ten per cent (10%) will be held in trust. In case the Court rules in favor of the government, this ten per cent (10%) will be paid to the government. If the Court sustains Attorney General Edward L. O'Connor's position, then this ten per cent (10%) will be returned to the purchaser.



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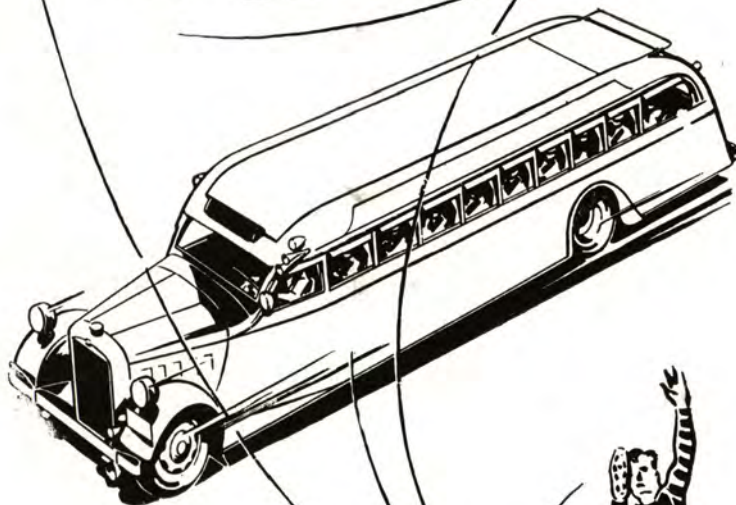
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
