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Since it opened in 1869, Iowa State University has been working for the state of Iowa. As Iowa's land-grant university, Iowa State has played an important role in the educational, economic, cultural and social development of the state and the nation.

Today, Iowa State is a broad-based university of international stature. With approximately 25,000 students from all 50 states and nearly 120 other nations, Iowa State is helping Iowa and the nation open doors to international exchange, trade and development.

Iowa State has been successful in attracting a diverse student body and has expanded the number of opportunities for students to travel and learn in other countries.

Students at Iowa State can choose from among more than 200 programs of study leading to baccalaureate degrees in the colleges of Agriculture, Business, Design, Education, Engineering, Family and Consumer Sciences and Liberal Arts and Sciences. The College of Veterinary Medicine offers the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree and graduate students can choose from among 200 fields of study leading to master's, doctor of philosophy and specialist degrees.

Students find a high quality of life when they become a part of the Iowa State University community. An award-winning lectures program, a comprehensive array of student support services and more than 400 student clubs and organizations were all reasons ISU was included in a recent national study of colleges and universities with a high quality of student life.

Both the Greek and residence hall systems at Iowa State are nationally recognized. About 2,700 students participate in fraternities and sororities, and ISU residence halls house more students than most colleges and universities. A unique "house" system,



with each floor named and considered a separate entity, makes residence hall rooms seem like home.

Students who are part of the residence hall system participate in dormitory-wide and intramural events. An extensive intramural program boasts one of the highest participation rates in the country, offering such unique events as innertube water basketball, broomball and mud volleyball.

Nearby dining halls serve a wide variety of good and nutritious food, and even accept favorite recipes from home as part of a regular contest, with the winning entry becoming a part of the food service menu.

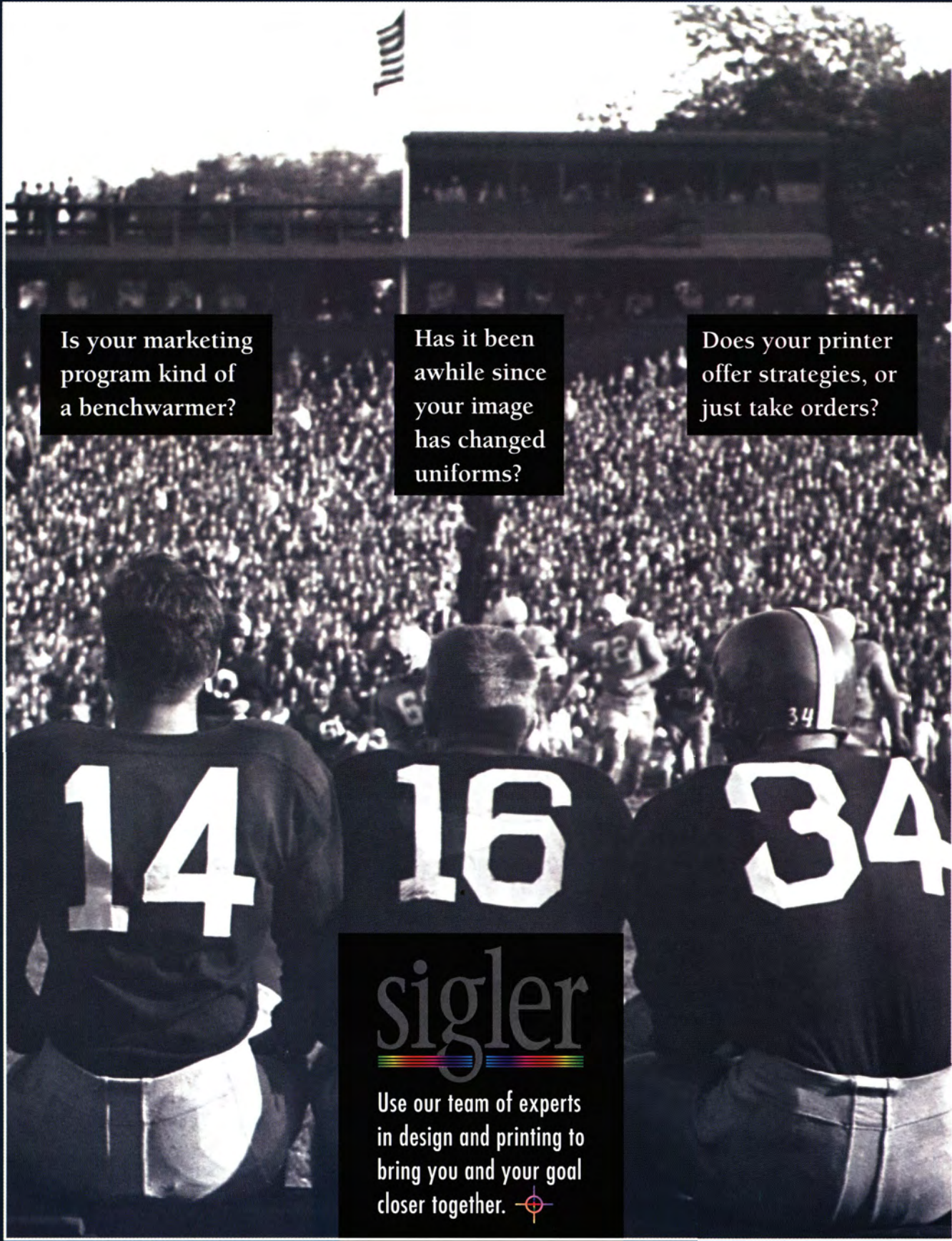
Students can exercise at the 220,000-square-foot Lied Recreation Athletic Facility. The ground floor of the three-level facility contains 20 recreational basketball courts, as well as nine racquetball courts.

The Iowa State Center, which boasts one of the nation's finest facilities of its kind, consists of C.Y. Stephens Auditorium, the J.W. Fisher Theater, the Scheman Continuing Education Center and the James H. Hilton Coliseum. Concert facilities draw some of the top names in entertainment.

The Iowa State campus is recognized as one of the most beautiful in the nation. The park-like setting of 1800 acres has more than 180 major buildings, including some beautifully restored structures from the late-1800s and early 1900s, as well as striking examples of modern architecture.

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Cyclones vs. Jayhawks

After two weeks on the road, Iowa State returns home for a matchup against Kansas. The 2-5 Cyclones travelled to Oklahoma State and Baylor the previous weekends and came up short in both games. The Jayhawks, suffering from a 63-7 rout by Nebraska in Lincoln last weekend, bring a 3-4 overall record into today's contest. Both teams sport 1-3 Big 12 marks.

For the second consecutive week, ISU tailback Troy Davis is leading the nation in rushing, all-purpose yards and scoring. The junior has been Big 12 Player of the Week three times in the last six weeks, but was held to just 135 yards in the 49-21 loss at Baylor. At Oklahoma State Davis ran for 238 yards on 36 carries and two touchdowns, but the Cyclones could not hold off a fourth-quarter surge by the Cowboys, falling 28-27 in Stillwater. With his numbers against OSU, Davis became Iowa State's all-time leading career rusher and all-purpose performer.

Stepping up the ranks on the Iowa State offense and special teams is younger brother Darren Davis. The true freshman has 189 rushing yards on 26 carries and four punt returns for a 7.8 yard average. He tallied 541 all-purpose yards in seven games this season, including nine kickoff returns for a 22.7 yard average. Davis also has eight receptions for 117 yards. In the 24-21 loss to Texas A&M, "Double D" made one of the greatest catches in Iowa State history, grabbing the ball on a 27-yard TD pass from Todd Doxzon.

Doxzon, Iowa State's starting quarterback, ranks eighth in the Big 12 in passing efficiency (.561). A former option quarterback, the Omaha, Neb., native has completed 83-of-148 passes for 1,020 yards and nine touchdowns this year. He has 165 rushing yards for two TDs. The senior was plagued by a reoccurring ankle injury last season, forcing him to miss five games. Although he was not 100 percent healthy in 1995, he finished the season as ISU's leading passer for the second straight year.

Doxzon's success can be attributed to some of the most talented receivers in the Big 12, namely Ed Williams, Tyrone Watley and Daman Green. Williams has 313 yards on 21 catches this season, ranking him 11th in the conference. The Opa-Locka, Fla., native totaled 46 receptions last year, the most by an ISU receiver since Steve Lester had 46 in 1989.

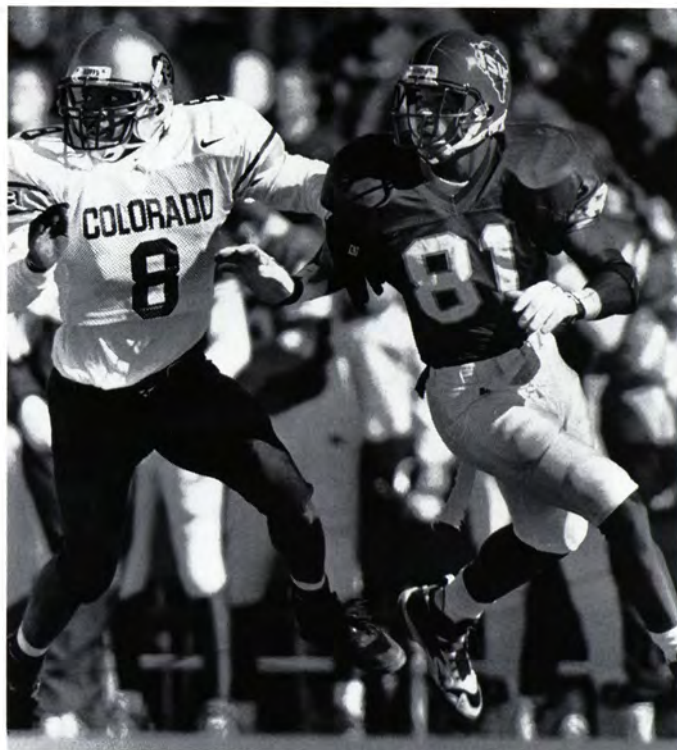
Transferring from the University of Pacific after the school dropped football, Watley is second on the receiving chart with 19 snags for 274 yards. He caught a fierce 20-yard pass from Doxzon to put Iowa State on top of Baylor in the first quarter last weekend. Watley has a 20.8 yard average on four kickoff returns this season.

A San Bernardino Valley Junior College transfer, Green has 12 receptions for 131 yards and a 10.9 yard average this year. Green earned all-Foothills Conference honors as a sophomore after gaining 531 yards on 30 catches and adding seven touchdowns.

The Jayhawk offense also has one of the top receivers in the Big 12, Isaac Byrd. With 28 receptions for 431 yards this season, Byrd is making his way to the top of KU career charts. He ranks 12th in career receptions, 14th in career yardage and fourth in all-time TD catches. In last week's loss at Nebraska, Byrd scored the only KU touchdown, a 77-yard reception from quarterback Matt Johnner in the second period. Byrd currently ranks fifth in the Big 12 in in receptions per game. He is bidding to become one of the few players in Kansas history to earn all-conference honors in two different sports, as he was named an all-Big Eight centerfielder for the Jayhawks last spring.

Johnner, KU's No. 1 quarterback this year, spent the last two seasons as a back-up to Ben Rutz and Mark Williams. The junior has completed 88-of-163 passes for 1,133 yards and 10 touchdowns in 1996. After suffering a torn anterior cruciate ligament in his left knee in spring drills, Rutz has seen limited action this season. He is 17-for-33 and has thrown two TD passes.

June Henley, KU's leading rusher, has gained 790 yards on 175 carries in six games this season, averaging 131.7 yards per game. The senior has consistently been among the best runners, ranking fourth in the Big 12 and eighth nationally.



Junior wide receiver Ed Williams ranks 11th in the conference with 313 yards on 21 receptions this season.

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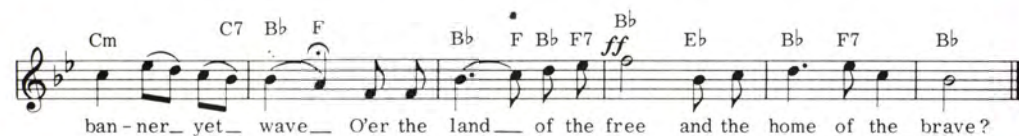
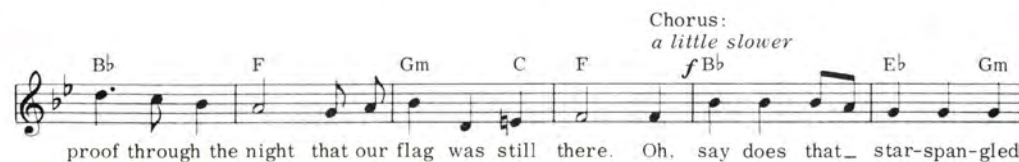
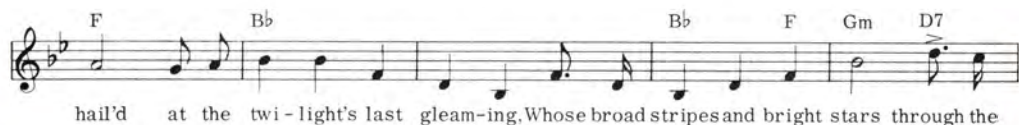
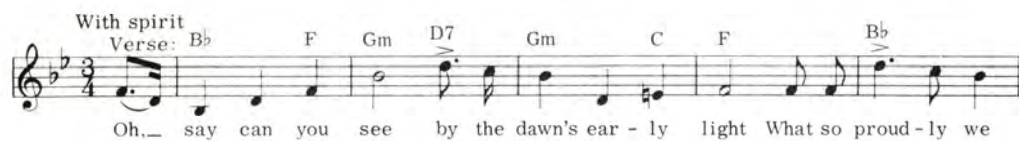

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Dr. Martin C. Jischke

PRESIDENT -- IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY



Iowa State University enters its sixth year under the direction of Dr. Martin C. Jischke. Under his leadership, Iowa State is making significant progress toward its goal of becoming the nation's premier land-grant university. Major improvements have been made in Iowa State's undergraduate programs; research programs continue to expand, particularly in agriculture, science and technology; and Iowa State's Extension and technology transfer programs have been reorganized to be more efficient and responsive to the needs of the people of Iowa.

Under Jischke's leadership, Iowa State has set new records in several important areas, including:

- Enrollments of minority students, graduate students and high achieving students.
- External funding for research and educational programs.
- Private fundraising.
- Income from intellectual property.

Jischke, 54, came to ISU from the University of Missouri, Rolla, where he had served as chancellor for five years. He spent 17 years as a faculty member and administrator at the University of Oklahoma, serving as director of the School of Aerospace Mechanical and Nuclear Engineering, Dean of the College of Engineering, and, in 1985, interim president.

A native of Chicago, Jischke earned the B.S. in physics, with honors, in 1963 from the Illinois Institute of Technology, an M.S. in 1964 and his Ph.D. in 1968 in aeronautics and astronautics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He is trained as a fluid dynamicist and has expertise in heat transfer, fluid mechanics, aerodynamics, and problems related to high-speed aircraft and spacecraft. The author or co-author of 31 archival journal publications and 21 major technical reports, Jischke is also co-editor of a book.

He served research fellowships with NASA and the Donald W. Douglas Laboratory and received research grants from the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Air Force, NASA, the National Institutes of Health, National Severe Storms Laboratory and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. During 1975-76, he served as White House Fellow and Special Assistant to the Secretary of Transportation.

A big supporter of intercollegiate athletics, Jischke is immediate past president of the Council of Big 12 Conference Chief Executive Officers. Jischke is a member of the board of directors of the National Association of State Universities and Land-Grant Colleges (NASULGC) and the American Council on Education (ACE). In 1993, he received the Centennial Medallion from the American Society of Engineering Education. He is a fellow of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics and the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

Gene Smith

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR -- IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY



Promising to make Iowa State "one of the premier athletic programs in the nation," Gene Smith began his tenure as Iowa State's 12th athletic director on July 1, 1993. He starts his fourth year at ISU having already made good on that commitment. The past president of the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) has left an indelible mark at Iowa State, engineering an unprecedented financial and competitive performance that has prepared the Cyclone athletic department for entry into the Big 12 Conference and the 21st century. This summer, the athletic department moved into its new home, the Jacobson Athletic Building, completing the largest athletic capital fund raising campaign in school history.

In the first three years of his tenure, Smith:

- Led a successful \$12 million drive to finance construction of a new 60,000-square-foot, state-of-the-art athletic office and training facility and installation of natural grass at Jack Trice Field. The Jacobson Building, which opened in July, allows nearly the entire athletic staff to be housed under one roof for the first time in decades.
- Oversaw a successful \$900,000 project to construct new offices and meeting rooms at Hilton Coliseum for the ISU men's and women's basketball programs. Further capital improvement included the construction of a new soccer field and new press boxes at the baseball and softball fields. Iowa State played host to the NCAA Cross Country Championship on its new course, unique nationally in its design.
- Continued implementation of his comprehensive five-year financial plan, the first such effort in department history. Incorporated into the plan are new revenue sources solicited by Smith's leadership, including corporate sponsorships, group ticket sales and fund raising initiatives. Smith created a marketing unit that annually generates \$1 million in corporate commitments to Iowa State athletics, which fund state-of-the-art improvements to Cyclone Stadium and address other department needs.

- Increased academic student support that resulted in the highest student-athlete graduation rate in the Big 12 Conference. A total of 117 student-athletes earned a spot on the 1995-96 Big Eight academic honor roll. The department produced six academic All-Americans in the last school year and two Big Eight post graduate scholars.

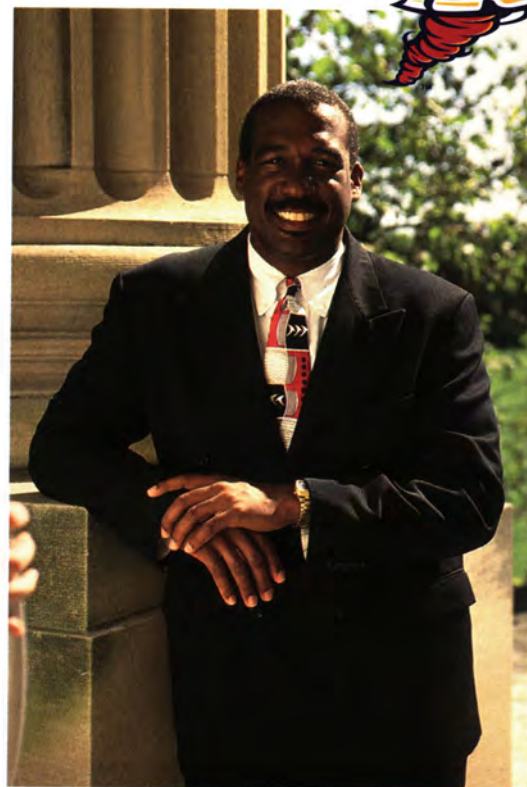
- Successfully worked in a cooperative effort with the university's student body to reallocate financial support for Iowa State's 20 intercollegiate athletic teams.

- Hired two of the nation's top young basketball coaches, Tim Floyd and Bill Fennelly. Floyd coached the Cyclone men to school records of 23 and 24 wins, respectively, in his first two seasons, as ISU advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament both years. Fennelly's first women's team won 17 games, the most by an ISU team in 10 years.

- Hired the energetic Dan McCarney to take over the Iowa State football program, producing a significant attendance increase as All-America running back Troy Davis was a Heisman Trophy Finalist last season.

Prior to his arrival in Ames, Smith served as athletic director at Eastern Michigan University for seven years. Under his direction, EMU made great strides in facility improvements. New football, basketball and administrative offices were built with other coaches' offices renovated at that time. Smith oversaw major renovations at Rynearson Football Stadium. The \$15 million project began in 1991 with the installation of a new game field and continued through the summer of 1992.

Smith earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Notre Dame in 1977. He received three varsity football letters as a defensive end at Notre Dame, and was a member of the 1973 Associated Press national championship team.



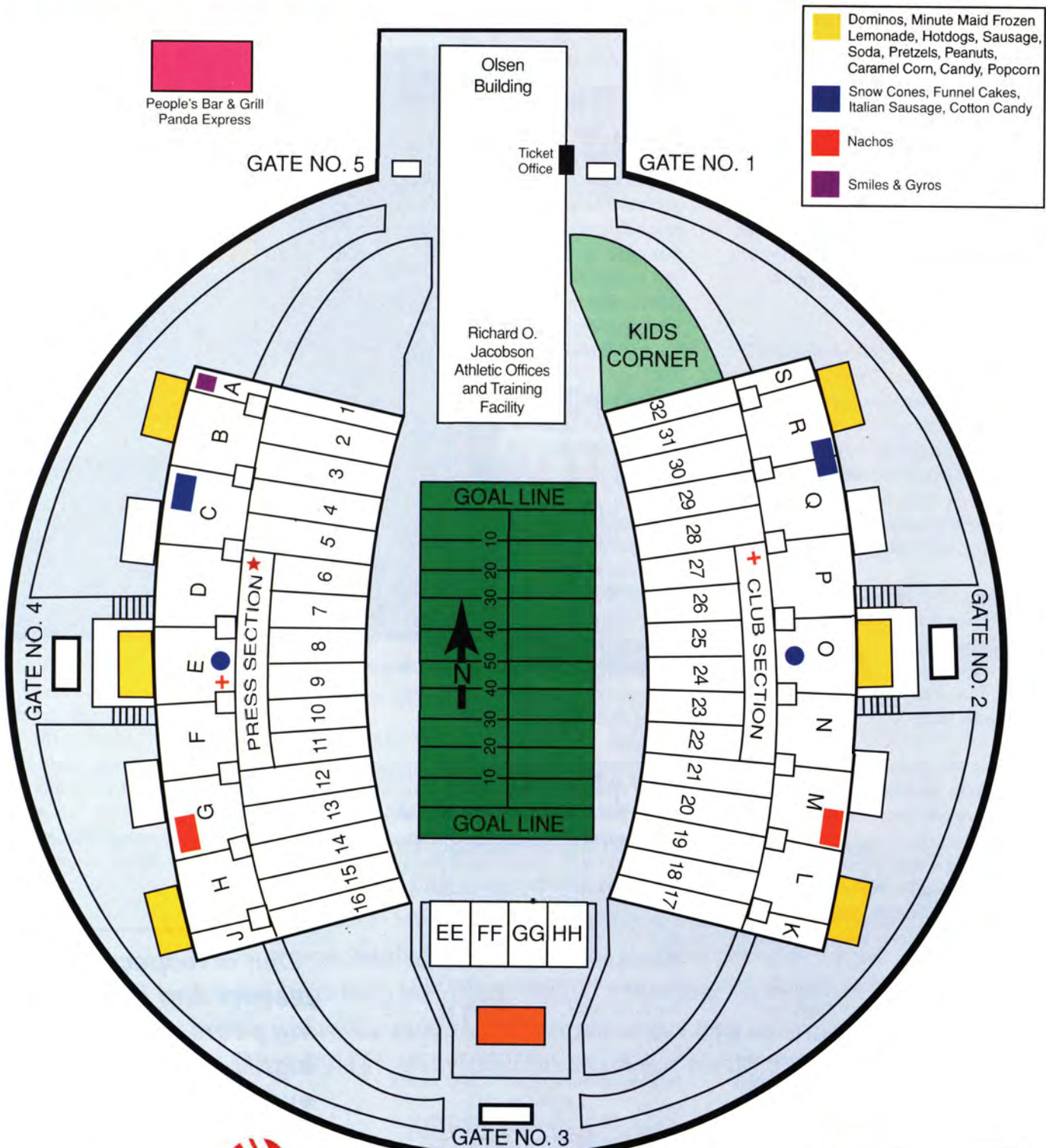
Smith served as an assistant football coach at Notre Dame from 1977-1981, being part of the 1977 undisputed national championship squad. He went to work for two years as a marketing representative for IBM prior to joining Eastern Michigan in April 1983.

The Cleveland, Ohio, native, who was born Dec. 18, 1955, has three daughters: Nicole (18), Lindsey (14) and Summer (13).

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Dan McCarney

HEAD FOOTBALL COACH -- IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

In just his first season as the architect chosen to rebuild the Cyclone football program, Iowa State head coach Dan McCarney extended contagious intensity that created new enthusiasm with ISU fans and players. McCarney's first season at Iowa State was one of the most memorable in school history. In his first year as Iowa State's head coach, his Cyclones put themselves on the national football map by:

- Breaking a slew of school offensive records as Heisman Trophy finalist Troy Davis received unprecedented national attention, rushing for an NCAA sophomore record 2,010 yards, while leading the nation in rushing and total yards. Iowa State, ranked ninth nationally in rushing, averaged a school record five yards per rush.
- Ending a 13-game winless streak with a 36-21 win over Ohio University in the season-opener.
- Recording wins over UNLV and Oklahoma State.
- Leading No. 14 Oklahoma and No. 9 Colorado in the fourth quarter before surrendering in hard-fought games.
- Generating a wave of renewed enthusiasm in Cyclone football as attendance was up 2,000 fans per game and student season-ticket sales doubled.

McCarney's staff brought a Big 12-caliber recruiting class to Ames last spring as Iowa State prepared for the fall as a member of the Big 12 Conference -- the nation's premier collegiate football league. The Cyclones moved into their new home, the Richard O. Jacobson Athletic Building -- adjacent to Cyclone Stadium-Jack Trice Field this summer. The move underscores the Iowa State administration's commitment to McCarney's vision for making the ISU program a blueprint for success.

Anyone who watched McCarney's rise in the coaching ranks would not be

surprised by the effort of his national-caliber coaching staff. A native of Iowa City, McCarney was instrumental in rebuilding efforts that produced Big Ten titles and Rose Bowl berths at both Iowa and Wisconsin, two schools that regularly finished near the bottom of the league before his arrival.

McCarney, 43, coached at Iowa for 13 seasons (1977-89), including a decade under Hayden Fry, before becoming the defensive coordinator at Wisconsin under Barry Alvarez in 1990.

McCarney's defense was the foundation of the Wisconsin rebuilding effort. In the four seasons prior to his arrival, the Badgers had a 9-36 record and attendance was at its lowest mark since World War II.

In 1993, Wisconsin went 10-1-1, claimed its first Big Ten title in 31 years and scored a 21-16 win over UCLA in the Rose Bowl. Attendance at Wisconsin's Camp Randall Stadium was up more than 30,000 a game and sellouts of more than 77,000 were the norm.

During Wisconsin's Rose Bowl season, the Badgers ranked 19th nationally against the rush, allowing just 130.3 yards per game, the sixth-best mark in school history. The team allowed an average of 16.3 points per game, its best effort in 30 years. The Badger defense also intercepted an NCAA-best 23 passes and created 34 turnovers, including six against UCLA.



A 1975 graduate of Iowa, McCarney coached the Hawkeyes in eight consecutive bowl games, including the 1982 and 1985 Rose Bowls. A three-year letterman in the offensive line for Iowa (1972-74), he was the captain of the 1974 Hawkeye squad. McCarney has three children, Jillian, Melanie and Shane.

"Dan is respected by his players and his coaching peers, and he was highly recommended by everyone I talked to. Our success last season affirms our conviction that he was the perfect man for the job."

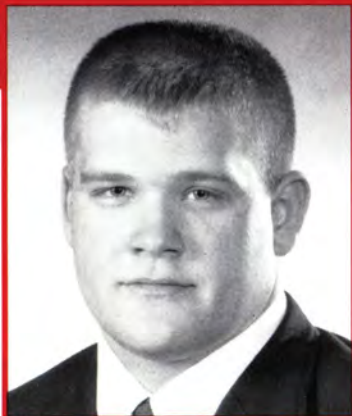

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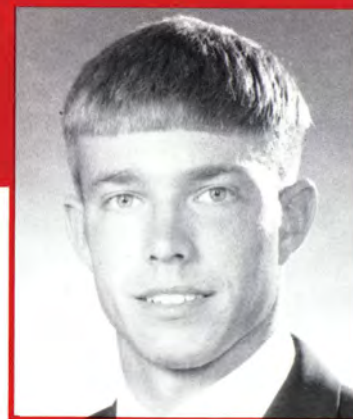
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Tara Gunderson

Shooting from the three-point arc, Iowa State women's basketball senior Tara Gunderson, known as "Gunny" to her teammates, bedazzles opposing teams, incites fans to stand up and cheer and sometimes amazes herself with her accuracy.

"Gunny has become one of those people you're surprised to see miss a basket," ISU head women's basketball coach Bill Fennelly said.

The coach may be right. Last season Gunderson was the leader in NCAA Division I women's basketball, averaging 3.4 three-point baskets made per game. She was the recipient of AT&T's Long Distance Award for that distinction.

In a game against Oklahoma last season, the Lake Park, Iowa, native made 8-of-9 shots from outside the three-point line en route to a career-high 27 points. She was definitely "in the zone."

"The game at OU says a lot about her," Fennelly said. "We played Oklahoma State the night before and she struggled, but the next night she comes out and goes 8-of-9 ... she made them from every spot, whether she was guarded or unguarded.

"The kids did a great job of getting her the ball," he said. "It was the type of night that shooters dream about, but very few realize."

"I didn't really notice what I was doing because we were struggling," Gunderson said. "We ended up losing the game, so it didn't mean that much."

However, it meant that Gunderson was becoming recognized around the Big Eight conference – as well as the nation – as a zone-busting threat from anywhere on the court.

"She's hit some big, big shots ... she has a tremendous gift," said Fennelly. "I equate it to Troy [Davis]. Gunny didn't get to play a lot her freshman year."

Gunderson enters into her final season confident about the team and her ability to play well enough to make the NCAA Tournament. The Cyclones have not been invited to the NCAA post season tournament since its inception in 1983.

Teams make the big dance by the way they practice, and Coach Fennelly wants his players to practice hard – just as if it was a game situation.

At practice, on the creaky wooden floors of State Gym, Gunderson lights up the venerable building from behind the red tape that signifies the three-point line.

When she releases the ball her arm extends and her hand dangles in the air waving good-bye as the ball is sent on its mission to hit the target. Her pinky finger is extended to the side as if she were a "blue-blood" drinking a cup of tea. She knows the the scoreboard will tally three more points to her team's score.

What seem like prayers to many are layups to her. In a shooting drill at the end of a practice, the 5-8 point guard sank 61 percent of her shots from the land few care to test their skills – or the coach's patience.

She hit 25-of-41 shots after running drills, free throws, rebounding drills and half-court game situations. Her shorts sagged and sweat beaded on her face, but she still continued to shoot the ball with the automatic precision of Michael Jordan or Larry Bird.

"I've always loved to shoot," she said. "As a kid, I can remember staying after every practice in high school 30 minutes to an hour shooting baskets. "Like Coach Fennelly said, 'you can't win if you don't score,'" Gunderson said.

Winning is an exhilarating feeling for a young team with a first-year coach, and the Cyclones were excited with Gunderson's play after the Missouri game last season.

She hit the game-winning basket from guess where – outside the arc. With time expiring and the buzzer getting ready to make its closing remark, Gunderson released one of her accurate missiles to send the game into overtime.

"It was my most memorable game because they [Missouri] had beaten us the year before on our home court," she said.

The women's basketball version of William Tell will be aiming her accurate arrows at the baskets of Hilton Coliseum and arenas around the Big 12 Conference, helping the Cyclones to another season of excitement for ISU fans and disappointment for opposing defenses.

The Cyclones open the 1996-97 season on Monday, Nov. 11 with an exhibition game against Latvia-Lithuania at 7 p.m.

Stadium Information

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be stamped for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-entry. No pass outs will be allowed between noon and 1 p.m. or one hour before kickoff.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 16, 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked in the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact the nearest usher to request medical assistance.

Rest Rooms

Restrooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Smoking Policy

In accordance with Iowa State's smoking policy, there will be no smoking in areas where the general public congregates at Cyclone Stadium. That means people will not be able to smoke in the seating areas or by the concession stands. There may be designated smoking areas near the restrooms.

Service for Physicians

Doctors anticipating calls during the game are urged to register at the first aid quarters under the west stands, leaving their exact seat location. The management will see that all calls are delivered without delay.

Public Telephones

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands.

Coolers, Chairs Discouraged

As a courtesy to neighboring guests, spectators are asked NOT to bring stadium chairs, lawnchairs, or coolers into the stands.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Assistant Athletic Director Elve Everage (Jacobson Building) before noon on Friday prior to the home games. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Emergency Road Service

Iowa State University and Iowa AAA Motor Club will provide basic Emergency Road Service for persons attending home football games. This service will be in effect during and within two hours after the game throughout the season. The phone number for the service is 233-6636. Proof of game attendance (ie. ticket stub) may be requested. Basic emergency road service includes starts, tire changes, gas delivery and unlocks.

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium any bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located in strategic spots throughout the stadium parking area.

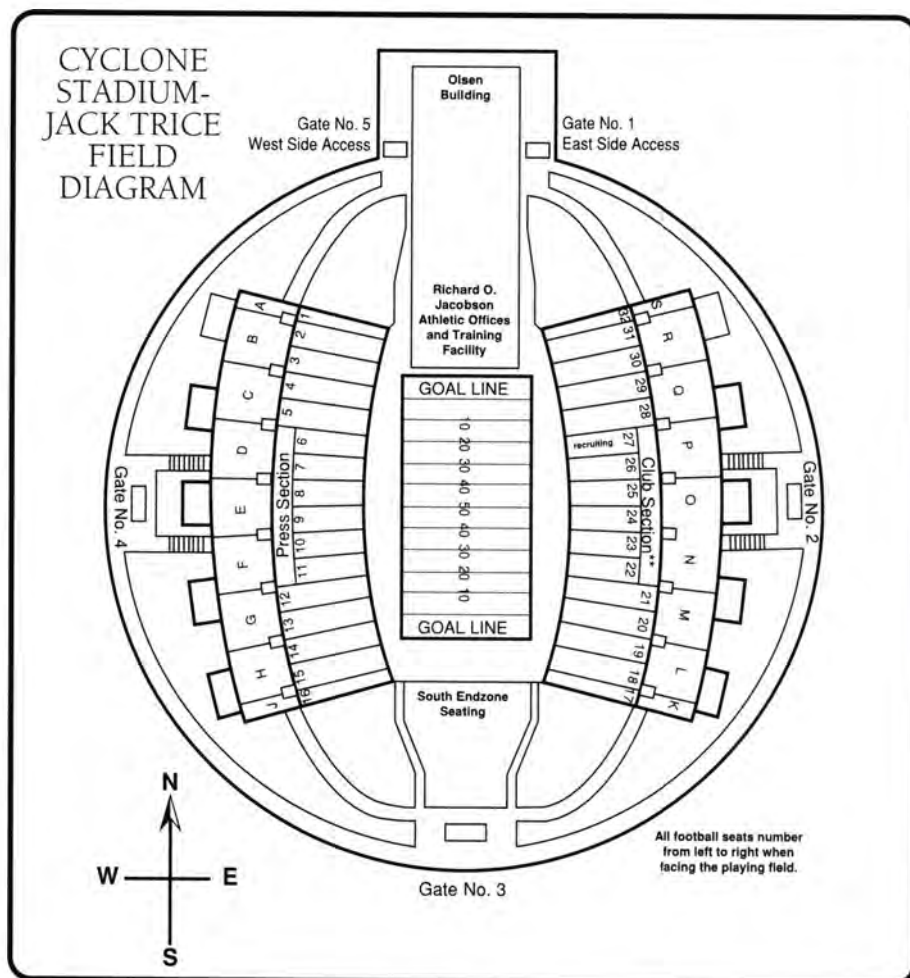
Distractions

We want to make football Saturday a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage fans to be respectful of those around them in the stadium. In the event there is an unreasonable distraction please take the following steps to help control the undesirable behavior.

- Note the seating section, row, and seat numbers and inform the usher in the section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and request it to stop, if appropriate.
- If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvements of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.
- An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation in next season's ticket assignments.

Courtesy Carts

Iowa State will offer courtesy cart service from Gates 1, 3, and 5 beginning two hours before kick-off and resuming midway through the fourth quarter. Anyone needing transportation during the game should go to the NE entrance of the Club Section (east side) or the SW entrance of the Press Box (west side).



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Often considered the hub of the students' social scene. Campustown is located approximately one mile west of the stadium. The area features a variety of shops, restaurants, cafes, theaters, and nightclubs. Campustown has undergone a multimillion dollar renovation project making the area even better than before!

West Ames ❸

Two shopping districts are located on the west side of town -- Colorado Junction and the Lincoln Way Plaza. Just two miles west of the stadium is the state's largest Hy-Vee of its kind as well as several restaurants and specialty shops.



Ames Main Street District ❷

Located northeast of the stadium, downtown Ames offers a wealth of shopping and dining areas. The area features scenic inset parks, book stores, coffee shops, nightclubs, restaurants, and many unique and charming stores.



North Grand ❹

Just two miles north of the stadium on Grand Avenue is North Grand Mall with over 50 specialty stores, several restaurants and movie theaters. The mall is anchored by Sears, Younkers and J.C. Penney.

South Duff Avenue ❻

To the east of the stadium is the South Duff development area. It features several new restaurants and a K-Mart superstore. A new Sam's Club outlet store has also recently opened in this area.

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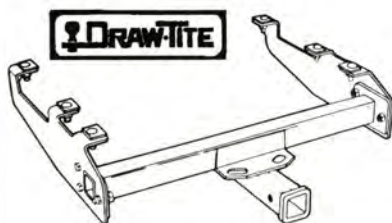

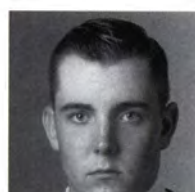

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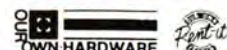
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1971 Sun Bowl Reunion

"Our goals are to have the winningest team in modern Iowa State history, finish in the top division of the Big Eight Conference and to go to a bowl game."

When Coach Majors set these goals, he knew they were lofty. An Iowa State squad had not experienced a winning season since 1960. In addition, Majors lost more than 20 lettermen, including eight defensive starters, from his 1970 team that finished 5-6. Even more insurmountable, a Cyclone team had not made a post-season appearance since ISU's first snap of the football in 1892.

Majors was notorious for his optimism, and he piloted his team through a rugged Big Eight Conference slate that included the nation's top three teams—Nebraska, Oklahoma and Colorado. Following ISU's 54-0 thrashing of Oklahoma State, the Cyclones achieved their ultimate goal when Athletic Director Lou McCullough accepted an invitation to the 1971 Sun Bowl.

"This has been the greatest year of our lives," Majors said following the season. "A lot of great things have happened to our players, coaches and fans."

Twenty-five years later the Iowa State Athletic Department is honoring the competitive spirit and determination of the 1971 Sun Bowl squad this weekend. One member of the team who will be attending the game is ISU assistant coach Steve Loney.

"It's great to have, back in Ames, the people who took us to our first bowl game," Loney said. "When these guys were at the top of their game, I was just trying to survive on the scout team, but they blazed a trail of success for all of us. So it is very special to welcome Coach Majors and the members of the 1971 Sun Bowl team back to Ames."

Looking back on the 1971 season, one can clearly see why such fond memories exist. After defeating Kansas and Kansas State in conference action, the Cyclones faced the task of battling No. 1 Nebraska and No. 2 Oklahoma back to back. Although they lost both contests, the Cyclones gave valiant efforts. Despite "holding" Oklahoma to 679 yards (in the previous week, OU had rushed for 785 yards), the Sooners stayed undefeated with a 43-12 win.

The next weekend, the Cyclone defense, playing without the services of all-Big Eight standout Matt Blair, held top-ranked Nebraska to 10 points for 26 minutes before the Huskers exploded for a 37-0 victory.

After falling to the national powerhouses, the Cyclones rebounded with a 45-17 win over Missouri, giving ISU a victory over the Tigers for the second consecutive year. Iowa State had not defeated MU in consecutive seasons since George Veenker led his 1933 and 1934 squads over the Tigers.

Majors rode off Clyde Williams Field on the shoulders of his players after Iowa State's win over Oklahoma State. The fourth Big Eight victory gave ISU an upper-division finish for the first time since 1965. Prior to the 1971 season, the Cyclones had tallied four Big Eight wins over the past four seasons.

In the game, Amundson rushed for four touchdowns and passed to Willie Jones for another to earn Big Eight Player of the Week honors. ISU gained 596 total offensive yards in the matchup.

"That was as fine of a football game that I've ever had a team play," Majors said. "I've never had a happier time in my life. There's the special ones, but you always have those moments that stand out in your life and that's one of them."

Cyclone Blair recovered a fumble at the OSU 49-yard line on the Cowboys' first play from scrimmage. Carlson's 49-yard TD pass to Ike Harris on ISU's first chance gave the Cyclones a 7-0 advantage.

"We also planned to try for a big play...a knockout punch...on our very first play. Ike Harris just engulfed that ball...like an octopus...or something that simply gobbles it up," Majors said.

Iowa State recorded 556 total yards, including 310 through the air, as the Cyclones down San Diego State, 48-31, in San Diego the next weekend. It was the first time since 1906 that an ISU squad had tallied eight wins in a season.

Making their first-ever national television appearance, the Cyclones fought a tough battle in the Sun Bowl, but lost to No. 10 Louisiana State, 33-15, to close the book on one of Iowa State's finest seasons ever.

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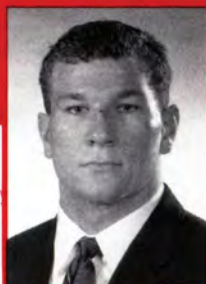
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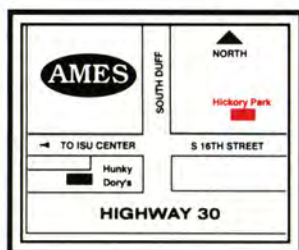
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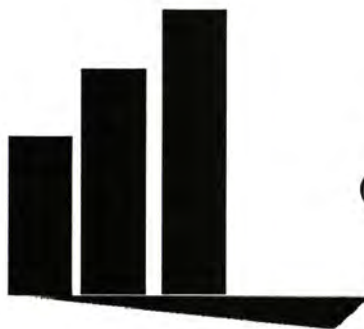

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Gary Thompson



Gary Thompson became Iowa State's first two-sport All-American, excelling in basketball and baseball.

January 14, 1957, is to many people the most noteworthy day in the history of Iowa State athletics. That was the day that the underdog Cyclones faced the Goliath of college basketball, Kansas.

The Jayhawks were led by the most famous basketball player of that era, 7'1" Wilt "The Stilt" Chamberlain. The Cyclones countered with 5'10" Gary "The Roland Rocket" Thompson. In a stunning upset at the Iowa State Armory that has reached legendary proportions, the Cyclones fought to a 39-37 victory with Thompson outscoring Chamberlain.

Thompson has remained in the public eye ever since, first as a player and coach for the Phillips 66ers AAU team and more recently as one of the nation's leading basketball analysts. He's also remained a constant supporter of Iowa State athletics with his most recent contribution being a major donation to the Jacobson Athletic Building project.

His generosity has allowed the construction of an area just inside the main doors of the facility that will be known as the Gary Thompson Hall of Honor, which will house a changing exhibit that recognizes people from the sports arena who have brought honor to Iowa State University.

Thompson met his future wife Janet, with whom he recently celebrated 41 years of marriage, while he was a prep star at Roland high school. He went on to become a first-team basketball All-American at Iowa State during his senior year. He was instrumental in the Cyclones' first championship in the then-Big Seven pre season basketball tournament and starred on the Cyclone baseball squad, helping the team to its first-ever appearance in the College World Series.

No matter what's on his resume, however, it's that Kansas basketball game that sealed Thompson fame as a Cyclone. "Everybody seems to remember that game," Thompson said. "If all the people who told me they saw that game had actually been there, then that place would have had to hold a lot more than 6,500.

"It's tough not to call it one of the biggest wins ever because you had the No. 1 team in the country. Wilt was the No. 1 player of the half-century. He came in to the league with all the hype and press that they were going to win three national championships and would never be beaten."

Thompson actually outscored Chamberlain in all three games Iowa State and Kansas played that season, as the Cyclones lost a 58-57 decision in the tournament and fell by 11 points in a close game in Lawrence. After the 1957 season, the Minneapolis Lakers of the NBA drafted Thompson in the 15th round, but he decided to join the Phillips AAU team instead.

"In those days, pro ball was kind of a dog's life," Thompson recalled. "That was in the days when AAU basketball leagues were real strong and were backed by corporations. Phillips only offered me \$50 a month, but I took it. It was one of the best decisions I ever made."

After playing for the 66ers for five years, Thompson returned to Iowa as a district sales manager for Phillips. The Iowa State physical education graduate had an unsatisfied urge to coach, however, so when the 66ers came calling, Thompson returned to Oklahoma for a four-year stint at the helm of the AAU team.

In 1968, he bought the Phillips Petroleum distributorship in Ames. Today, Thompson Oil Company not only distributes petroleum products, but also owns and manages a chain of convenience shops called Swift Stops, besides owning and leasing various commercial properties in the Ames area.

- Thompson credits his son, Rick, who has worked with him for 15 years, for much of the success of the business. Another son, Scott, a Certified Public Accountant, shares office space and does work for the company, and daughter Kim's husband joined the firm a few years ago.

Having a family business has allowed Thompson to fulfill another lifelong dream, as a nationally recognized basketball color analyst for the Big Eight and NCAA tournament telecasts. To this day, Cyclone Television Network viewers can see his familiar face during the broadcasts.

"Broadcast journalism was something I had originally gone to school for," Thompson said. "Now, it's ended up as a hobby. You have one of the best seats in the house, get paid for it and have great relationships with coaches from all over the country."

That kind of relationship led Cyclone Athletic Director Gene Smith to enlist Thompson's help when it came time to hire a replacement for the retiring Johnny Orr. "Gene was a football guy and I think he leaned on me because I had a lot of contacts in basketball," Thompson said. "There are a lot of athletic directors whose egos are so big that they are not going to take advantage of a resource. But Gene and ISU President Dr. Jischke took all the help we could give them.

"It was a lot of fun to be involved in getting Tim (Floyd) to come here and now see him have success. Our tournament win last year against Kansas reminded me a lot of our win over them back in 1957. Both games were the ultimate of seeing a game plan put into effect, executing it, and coming away with a big win," Thompson said.

Big wins are a way of life for Gary Thompson — from his days at Roland High School, his legendary career as a Cyclone, as a nationally recognized broadcaster to those as a successful business and family man. Iowa State, however, is the biggest winner in the Thompson saga. His contributions in time, energy and money to ISU athletics are just as legendary as his career.

"My wife and I are just happy to give something back to this community," he said. "We have been blessed with good people supporting us in our business endeavors. I have always said I have been a lucky person. I have seemed to be in the right place at the right times."

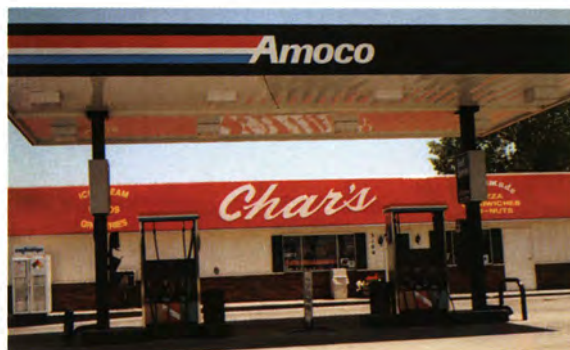

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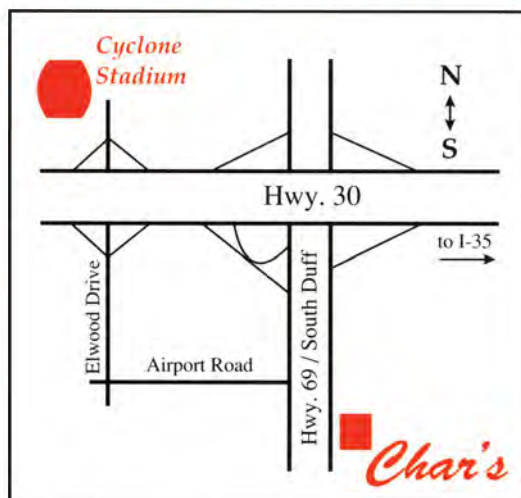

Scouting Report

THE SERIES: Kansas leads the series 40-29-6 and has a five-game winning streak against the Cyclones. The last Iowa State win came in 1989 when ISU downed the Jayhawks, 24-20, in Lawrence. The game featured over 1,000 yards of total offense, including 411 yards passing by Kansas quarterback Kelly Donohoe, a record in the ISU-KU series. When the teams met in 1995, the Jayhawks were unbeaten and ranked in the top 10. The Kansas defense limited ISU tailback Troy Davis to 120 yards and held the Cyclones to just one touchdown on the day, handing Iowa State a 34-7 loss.

OFFENSIVELY: Senior wide receiver Isaac Byrd leads the Kansas offense with 431 yards on 28 catches. He is averaging 15.4 yards per reception. After topping all KU receivers last season with 48 catches for 604 yards and five touchdowns, Byrd earned honorable mention all-Big Eight status. Junior quarterback Matt Johner has completed 88 passes for 1,133 yards and 10 TDs this season. June Henley, KU's leading rusher, tallied 790 yards on 175 carries and 13 TDs in six games and is currently ranked fourth among conference rushers and eighth nationally. Second on the Kansas rushing chart is running back Eric Vann, averaging 3.3 yards per carry. The junior has 147 yards on 44 attempts and one TD. Vann ran for 235 yards and two touchdowns last season, including a 67-yard scoring run against UCLA in the Aloha Bowl.

DEFENSIVELY: Kansas ranks first in the Big 12 and fifth nationally in turnover margin. The Jayhawks have forced 19 turnovers, resulting in 59 points. Kansas has 10 interceptions this season, including three from Tony Blevins. Cornerback Jason Harris has three interceptions and two fumble recoveries. Senior linebacker Ronnie Ward leads the defense with 76 total tackles, including 56 solo stops. He totaled a career-high 21 tackles against Texas Tech this season and had 14 stops against Colorado.

Ward spent the 1995 season as a redshirt, rehabilitating from a shoulder injury, but he topped the team in 1994 with 92 total efforts. Second on the team is junior Maurice Gaddie with 51 tackles. Gaddie led the secondary last season in tackles with 93. Jason Thoren is fourth on the team with 43 stops, including 26 solo efforts. Thoren emerged as one of the Big Eight's top linebackers last season, registering 119 tackles, the most by a Jayhawk since Roger Robbin tallied 146 in 1989.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Handling all punt return duties this season, Byrd is averaging 29.7 yards on six returns. He ran one punt back a school-record 94 yards for a touchdown against Oklahoma and had a 57-yard return against Colorado. Vann has 12 kickoff returns for a 25.4 yard average, including one return 100 yards for a touchdown. Place kicker Jeff McCord is 29-of-29 in point-after attempts this year and is second on the team with 38 points. He led the squad last season with 60 points, going 9-of-12 in field goals and 33-of-36 extra-point tries. McCord's longest field goal, 46 yards, was against North Texas in 1995.

THE COACH: Voted 1995 Big Eight Conference Coach of the Year, Glen Mason is in his ninth year at Kansas. Mason engineered one of the most impressive success stories last season, leading a young and inexperienced team to a 10-2 record, a second-place tie in the league and a win over UCLA in the Jeep Eagle Aloha Bowl. Last year marked the first time the Jayhawks won 10 games since 1905. The Jayhawks had played 15 consecutive conference games without a victory and had won a combined four games in the previous two seasons prior to Mason's arrival. With today's game, Mason's 99th game as head coach at KU, he has now served as head coach for more games than any other coach in school history. He was the head coach at Kent State, (1986-87) after assisting at Illinois (1977), Iowa State (1975-76), Ball State (1974) and Allegheny College (1973).

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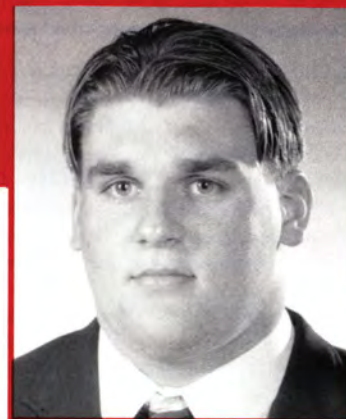
