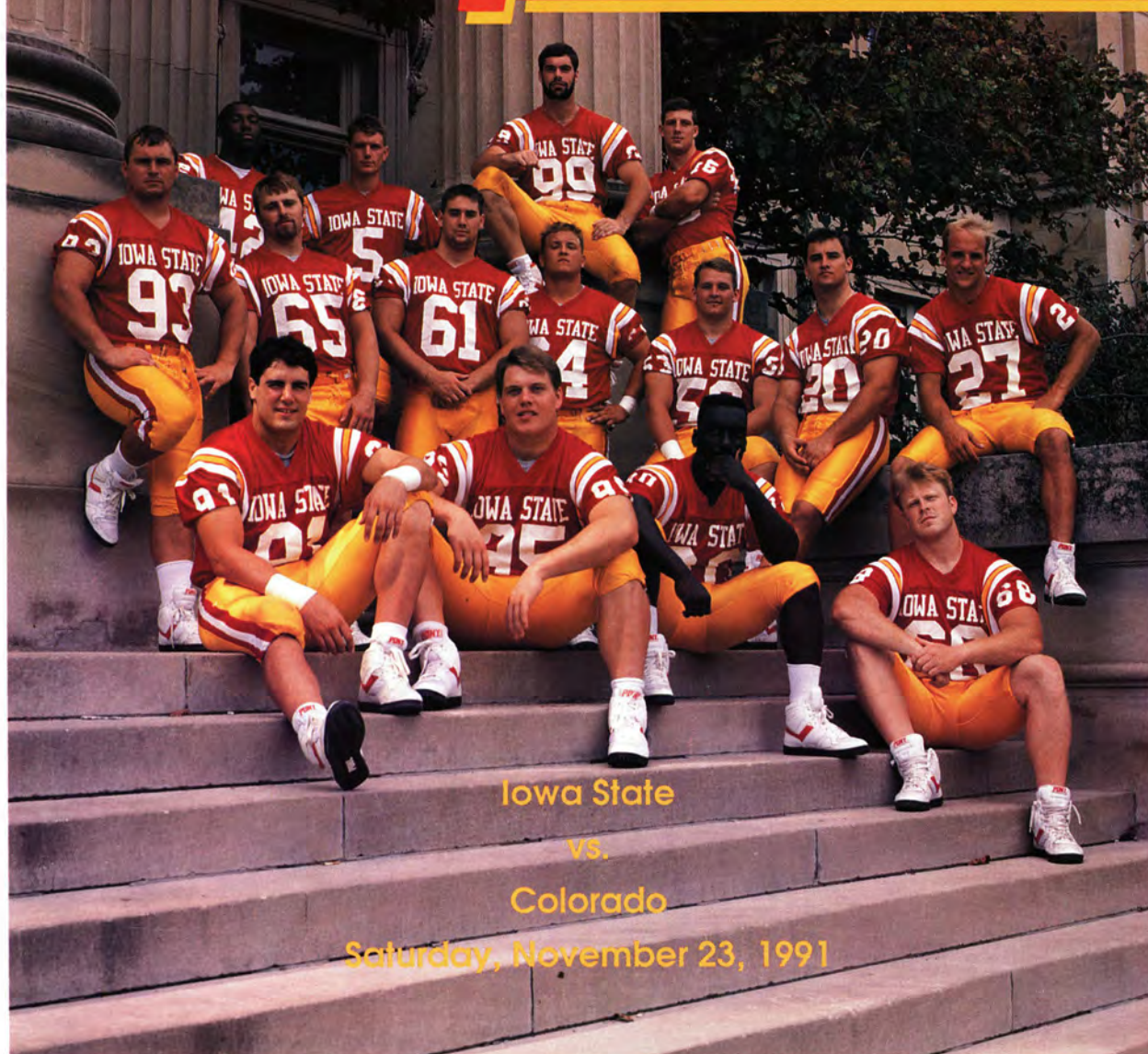

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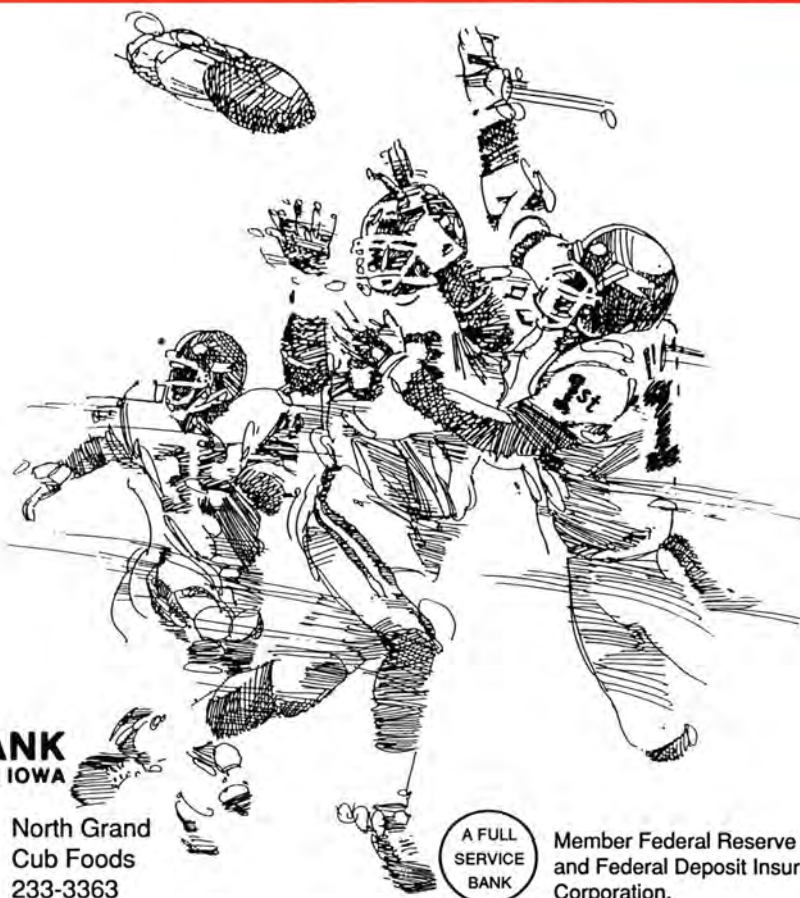
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Iowa State University was founded in 1858 under terms of the Land Grant College Act signed by President Abraham Lincoln during the Civil War. Since the beginning, Iowa State has been a co-educational "people's college."

As years passed, the University developed a reputation as an outstanding broad-based institution with academic emphasis in the humanities and the arts, while maintaining its position in the scientific and technical fields. Recently, Iowa State has become known as a leading research center, renowned in the fields of engineering and agriculture.

One of the largest institutions governed by the State Board of Regents, Iowa State is a major Midwestern center of learning for more than 25,000 students, from all 50 states and more than 100 other nations. Iowa State attracts a diverse student body with a wide range of undergraduate and graduate programs with, a student to teaching faculty ration of 18. More than 120 undergraduate programs of study are available from Iowa State's eight colleges: Agriculture, Business Administration, Design, Education, Engineering, Family and Consumer Sciences, Liberal Arts and Sciences and Veterinary Medicine.

The picturesque campus is comfortably situated in a central campus "park" - a splendid combination of conventional and contemporary architecture. ISU's classrooms and buildings are a blend of the old and then new, nestled amid thousands of trees and acres of greenery. The ultra-modern south campus is dominated by the Iowa State Center, Cyclone Stadium-Jack Trice Field, and the College of Veterinary Medicine.

The Iowa State Center, which boasts one of the nation's finest facilities of its kind, consists of the C.Y. Stephens Auditorium, the J.W. Fisher Theater, the

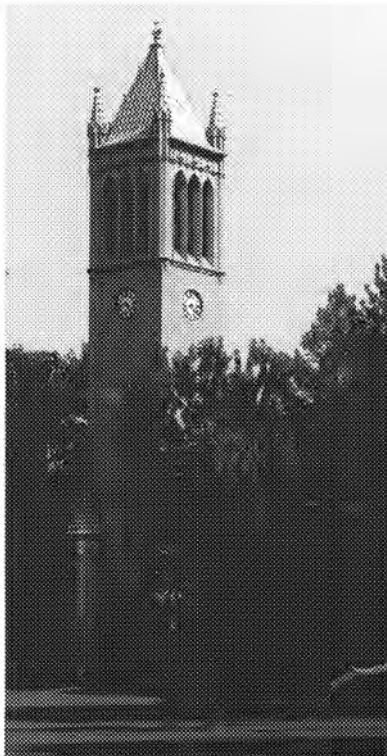
Scheman Continuing Education Center, and the James H. Hilton Coliseum. Concert facilities draw some of the top names in entertainment. Bruce Springsteen, Tina Turner, Bill Cosby, the Rolling Stones, Paul McCartney, Billy Joel, and the Broadway hit "Cats" have been featured on campus.

One of the highlights of the year occurs in spring as the campus blooms with tulips and apple blossoms just in time for the Veishea celebration. "Veishea" is ISU's annual open house and the largest student-run festival in the nation, complete with parade, exhibits and thousands of alumni. The campus is also breathtaking sight in the fall, when autumn colors and leaves make it a cardinal and gold show place.

Sports are a vital part of the life at Iowa State, as the Department of Intercollegiate Athletics offers 21 men's and women's sports and the extensive intramural program boasts one of the highest student participation rates in the country. A number of Cyclone intercollegiate teams have been nationally ranked in recent years and several have brought home national titles. Iowa State has also produced 24 Olympians, three of whom captured gold medals. While athletics remain in the spotlight, the academic side shares equal time.

The opportunities that Iowa State offers stretch beyond the lengths of academics and athletics. There are ample opportunities for students to participate in theater, music, dance and intramural sports, as well as numerous academic and campus organizations. The Greek system is strong, as are the residence halls. Both have been nationally recognized, along with the top notch academic advising program.

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Bowl Bound Buffs Mark Final Game For Cyclone Seniors

For the 12 Iowa State football players making their final appearance in a Cyclone uniform this afternoon, the success of their opponent and the implications of the outcome of today's game have little bearing. For this group of student-athletes, today is their last first-hand college football experience. That alone will make this day memorable. But let there be no doubt, the 15th-rated Colorado Buffaloes will present a significant challenge and will have special motivation of their own.

Among the Cyclone seniors is tight end Paul Schulte. The former Des Moines Roosevelt prep has made 14 catches for 180 yards and a big touchdown this season. Schulte caught an 11-yard scoring toss from fellow senior Chris Pedersen late in the Rice game that was a key in ISU's come-from-behind 28-27 victory. Pedersen's collegiate career was cut tragically short by injury. But the Ankeny native left his own mark. He ranks 10th on the Iowa State career passing chart with 2,258 yards. His 3,187 career total offense yards total is 11th all-time at ISU.

Eight Cyclone defensive players, including five who have seen starting action, are making their last Cardinal and Gold effort. The major portion of the ISU defensive line, including defensive end Mark Dunn and linemen Matt Grubb, Travis Block and Matt Rehberg will be playing in their final game. Dunn, a former walk-on from State Center, has made 92 career tackles at defensive end, including 49 solo stops. Grubb, who played high school football at Indianola, has been a three-year starter at defensive tackle and has 141 career tackles. Block walked on to the Cyclone roster after playing prep football at Maquoketa. A native of Zwingle, Block is a three-year starter with 141 tackles during his ISU career. Rehberg has been a team leader all season, and leads the ISU down linemen with 68 tackles, including 4 stops for losses of 9 yards. Another defensive standout, linebacker Larry Ratigan, has been a three-year starter. The former Council Bluffs St. Alberts all-stater has made 211

career tackles. Other ISU seniors include offensive linemen Lance Henkel and Bill Wilkinson, linebacker Mike Malloy and cornerbacks Lant Doran and Steve Weron, each of whom have made extensive special teams contributions.

Several underclassmen have also figured for the Cyclones this season. Freshman Kevin Caldwell moved back to quarterback for the Oklahoma State game and has responded as ISU's second-leading rusher with 416 yards on 128 carries. Junior Sherman Williams rushed 10 times for 60 yards last weekend at Nebraska. Sophomore James McMillion is the Big Eight's top punt returner, averaging 14.8 yards per attempt. His 55-yard return against Nebraska last weekend set up an Iowa State touchdown. Junior Dan Milner made 16 tackles against Nebraska after getting a team season-high 18 tackles against Kansas State. He has made 219 over the past two seasons.

Colorado comes into today's game with hopes of making a third consecutive Orange Bowl appearance. Pending the outcome of next Friday's Nebraska-Oklahoma contest, the Buffaloes could also end up representing the Big Eight Conference in the Blockbuster Bowl (which will feature the Big Eight's runner-up) against Alabama on Dec. 28 or the Gator Bowl (featuring the Big Eight's third-place team) on Dec. 29 against Virginia.

Backup quarterback Vance Joseph rallied Colorado from a 24-10 third quarter deficit against Kansas last weekend. He led the Buffaloes 80 yards in a snowstorm for fullback James Hill's scoring plunge with 40 seconds left to down Kansas, 30-24 in Boulder, Colo. Colorado pushed across 20 unanswered points in the last 21 minutes of the game. The Buffaloes escaped disaster for the second successive game — they got a touchdown on a fake field-goal play in the closing seconds on Nov. 9 to squeeze past Oklahoma State, 16-12.

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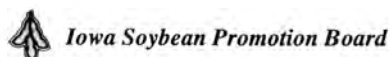

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When Martin Jischke became Iowa State University's 13th president on June 1, 1991, he brought to ISU an impressive record of administrative service and scholarly achievement spanning nearly 25 years.

Before his appointment at ISU, Dr. Jischke served five years as chancellor of the University of Missouri-Rolla. Under his leadership at the UMR, an enrollment decline was reversed, sponsored research increased by 50 percent, the number of private donors doubled, more than \$60 million in new facilities were added to the campus, and a major program of manufacturing research and technology transfer was initiated.

Dr. Jischke was a faculty member and administrator at the University of Oklahoma, Norman, for 17 years, serving as dean of the College of Engineering from 1981 to 1986, interim president in 1985, director and professor of the School of Aerospace, Mechanical and Nuclear Engineering from 1977 to 1981, and professor of aerospace, mechanical and nuclear engineering from 1968 to 1975.

He received the B.S. in physics, with honors, in 1963 from the Illinois Institute of Technology, Chicago, and the master's degree in 1964 and the Ph.D. degree in 1968 in aeronautics and astronautics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge. He is trained as a fluid dynamicist and has expertise in heat transfer, fluid mechanics, aerodynamics, and problems related to high-speed aircraft and spacecraft. He was a research fellow for NASA at Moffett Field in the summer of 1973, a research fellow at the Donald W. Douglas Laboratory in the summer of 1971, and a research engineer at the Battelle Northwest Laboratory in the summer of 1970.

Dr. Jischke is the author or co-author of 31 archival journal publications, 21 major technical reports and the co-editor of one book. He has received research grants from the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Air Force, NASA, the National Institutes of Health, the National Severe Storms Laboratory and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

From 1975 to 1976, he was a White House Fellow and Special Assistant to the Secretary of Transportation in the U.S. Department of Transportation with a special emphasis in the area of automobile safety. He is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and an Associate Fellow of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics. He is listed in "Who's Who in America," "Who's Who in Engineering," "American Men and Women of Science" and "Outstanding Educators of America."

Dr. Jischke and his wife, Patty, have two children, Charles 14, and Mary, 10. Patty Jischke earned the Bachelor of Arts degree in social work in 1970 and the Juris Doctorate in 1971 in 1975 from the University of Oklahoma Bar Association.

IOWA STATE HEAD COACH—JIM WALDEN



Nearly five years ago, Iowa State University began the search for a football coach. The Cyclones were looking for a new direction, a new personality and a new attitude for the Iowa State program. ISU found all of those ingredients in Jim Walden, and on December 16, 1986, the former Washington State mentor became Iowa State's 28th head football coach.

The personable native of Aberdeen, Mississippi arrived at ISU with "no magic formulas," just a promise to "come in here and do the best I can and to work as hard as I know how." Walden proved to be a man of his word, bringing

greater success both on and off the field to each of his Cyclone squads.

His first ISU team finished 3-8-0 and demonstrated consistent improvement throughout the season. His 1988 unit improved to 5-6-0 and challenged for a winning season. The Cyclones finished fifth in the Big Eight Conference.

The third time proved to be a charm. Walden's 1989 squad went 6-5 for the school's first winning season under his direction. ISU's 4-1 road record was its best since 1978. Iowa State ended the year ranked among the nation's top 25 teams in rushing and total offense.

In 1990, Walden guided the Cyclones to fourth-place finish in the Big Eight, a conference that featured national powerhouses Colorado, Oklahoma and Nebraska. ISU also defeated the Sooners for the first time since 1961.

As the head coach at Washington State for nine years, Walden compiled a 44-52-4 record against tough Pacific 10 Conference competition. During that time, Walden guided the Cougars to three winning seasons and four first-division conference finishes.

The 53-year-old Walden was at Washington State for 10 years, first serving as an assistant to Warren Powers. When Powers left WSU following the 1977 season, Walden was tabbed as his replacement and began building the Washington State program. The culmination of a four-

year plan came when Walden took the Cougars to the 1981 Holiday Bowl, WSU's first bowl appearance since the 1931 Rose Bowl. WSU finished the season with an 8-3-1 mark, needing only a win in the regular-season finale to go to the Rose Bowl.

Walden's success did not go unnoticed by his peers. He earned Pac-10 Coach-of-the-Year honors in 1981 and 1983. In 1981, he was the UPI West and AFCA/Kodak District IX Coach-of-the-Year. Following the 1981 season, he was asked to be an assistant coach for the West squad in the Japan Bowl and at the East-West Shrine Game that year. He was the head coach of the victorious West squad in the 1985 East-West Shrine Game, and was an assistant at the 1986 Hula Bowl.

Despite spending 10 years in the Pac-10, Walden came to ISU familiar with Big Eight Conference football. He started his collegiate coaching career in 1969 at Nebraska under his former college coach, Bob Devaney. For the next four seasons, Walden was a defensive coach for the Cornhuskers. During those years Nebraska won two national championships.

From Nebraska, Walden moved to Miami (Fla.) in 1973 as an offensive backfield coach for Pete Elliott, and was later named defensive coordinator under Carl Selmer. Walden joined Powers' Washington State staff as backfield coach for the 1977 season.

As a collegiate quarterback at Wyoming, Walden guided the Cowboys to a pair of Skyline Conference titles. Following his college career, Walden signed with the British Columbia Lions of the Canadian Football League and coached Amory High School in his native Mississippi for five years before going to Nebraska.

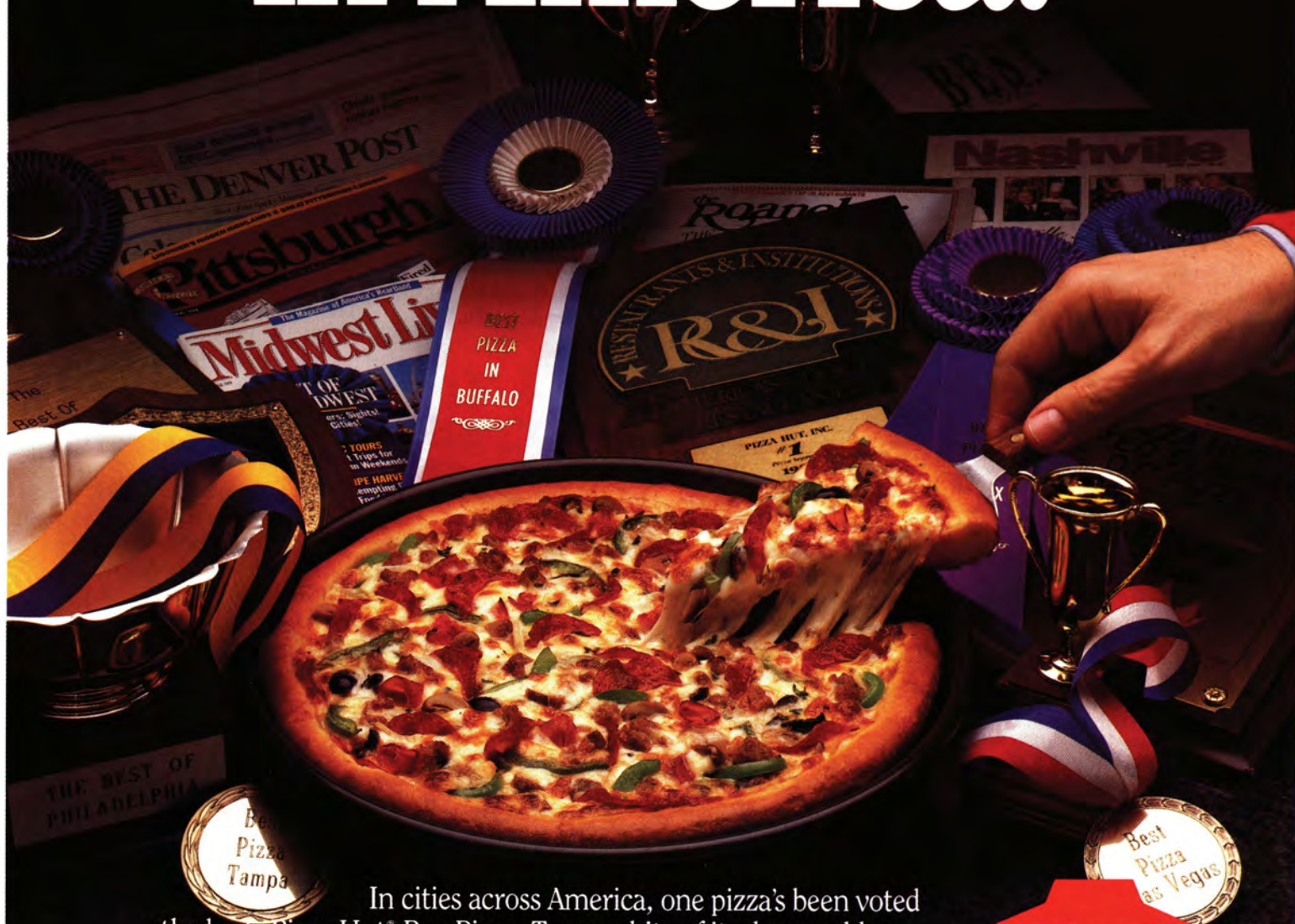
An excellent speaker, Walden is in demand for outside engagements. The NCAA has selected him twice as a guest speaker at its annual College Football Preview, in 1983 and 1985. Since coming to ISU, he's become a popular figure with both students and fans in appearances across the state. Since the day he was hired, Jim Walden has proved that he was the "right person" to bring a new direction, new attitude, and new personality to the Iowa State football program.

CYCLONES' CROSS COUNTRY TEAM AIMS HIGH

If consistency of top-flight performance is a primary measure of greatness in athletic competition, then Cyclone cross country star Jonah Koech and the Iowa State men's team on which he runs have already been assured of a special niche in NCAA history. Koech, the Cyclones, and head coach Bill Bergan will try to build on that success story Monday at the 1991 NCAA Cross Country Championship in Tucson, Ariz.

Koech raced to the individual title at last year's NCAA meet as Iowa State finished second to Arkansas. The Cyclone senior picked up where he left off last season, defending his Big Eight Conference and NCAA Region V titles this fall as ISU raced to the team title in both events. Koech has not lost a race since placing second to teammate John Nuttall in the 1989 NCAA Championship. That 1-2 finish helped propel the Cyclones to the NCAA team title. With junior Jon Brown, the fourth-place NCAA finisher last season, and freshmen Ian Robinson and Paul Patrick having great seasons, Bergan has the firepower to challenge top-rated Arkansas for the first-place trophy.

"Arkansas and Providence, among others, have really strong teams," Bergan said. "Arkansas, in particular, has considerable depth. But I think we have another good race in us and can give those teams a real challenge."

Bergan should know. His cross country teams have made 12 NCAA appearances, including sixth-, first-, and second-place finishes the past three seasons. The Cyclones have won four straight Big Eight cross country titles, including the 1991 conference meet on Nov. 2 in Lawrence, Kan. On a snow-covered course and against a wind chill of 17 degrees below zero, Koech led a pack of five Iowa State runners who finished among the top six finishers as ISU tallied a record low Big Eight score of 16 points. Colorado was second with 86 points. The Cyclones' winning margin of 70 points was the largest in conference history. It also marked the 20th Big Eight title claimed by Bergan's teams since 1974. Koech covered the five-

mile course in 29:14. Two weeks later Koech led four Cyclones who placed among the top five finishers to win the Region V meet on Nov. 16 in Wichita, Kan., earning another NCAA bid.

Koech, the two-time NCAA indoor defending 5,000-meter champion and record-holder is not a one-man show. Brown, a junior, was on the 1989 NCAA title team and placed fourth at last season's NCAA meet in a field of 181 runners. He has been second to Koech at the Big Eight NCAA region meets. But the key to Cyclone success this season has been the addition Robinson and Patrick and the continued improvement of senior Sean Mulheron.

Robinson was redshirted last season, but has been a front-runner this fall, placing third behind Koech and Robinson at the Big Eight and Region V meet. Patrick, the Australian junior record-holder in the 5,000-meter run, was fourth at the Big Eight meet and fifth at the Region V Championship. Two Iowans, Bryan Runyan of Indianola and Dean Colony of Iowa City, round out the ISU top seven.

The key to Cyclone success may be Mulheron. The Baldwin, Wis., native placed sixth at the Big Eight meet and 18th at the Region meet. The ability of these five Cyclones to run together will figure prominently in Iowa State's final standing.

The Iowa State women placed third in their Region V meet. Coached by 1990 Big Eight Coach of the Year Dick Lee, the Cyclones got a fourth-place finish from All-American Karen Glerum and an eighth-place effort from Jo Fairclough on Nov. 16 as the Cyclones placed third overall.

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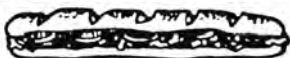
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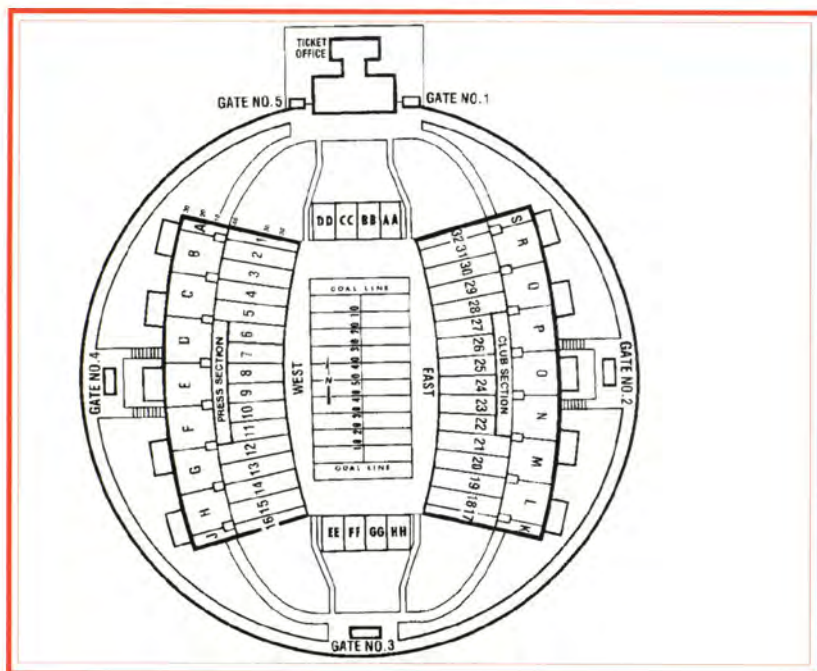

STADIUM INFORMATION



First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact the nearest usher to request medical assistance.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked at the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be stamped for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-admission. No pass outs will be allowed between 12:30 and 1 p.m. or 1/2 hour before kickoff.

Service for Physicians

Doctors anticipating calls during the game are urged to register at the first aid quarters under the west stands, leaving their exact seat location. The management will see that all calls are delivered without delay.

Lost and Found

A lost and found service is maintained in the Athletic Ticket Office in the Olsen Building at the north end of the stadium. Articles found should be turned over to an usher or left at the Athletic Ticket Office.

Public Telephone

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands.

Refreshments

Refreshments are served in the stands and at locations around the stadium.

Iowa State Souvenirs

An attractive array of Iowa State souvenirs is available at conveniently located novelty sales booths throughout the stadium and from vendors in the parking areas.

Radios, Stadium Chairs, Umbrellas

As a courtesy to neighboring ticket holders, spectators are asked not to bring radios, stadium chairs and umbrellas into the stands.

Rest Rooms

Rest rooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Public Address System

No appeals will be made over the public address system except under special circumstances. The public is asked not to request this service.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts.

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium any bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team.

The State of Iowa code prohibits the use of alcohol in the Stadium. The Athletic Department asks our patrons to behave responsibly and in compliance with the State code.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located in strategic spots throughout the stadium parking area.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. Signs are to be displayed on the south end of the Olsen Building and on the walls of the stands, both upper and lower desks. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Iowa State's Athletic Department. For sign approval, see Bill Goldring, Room 137 Olsen Building before noon on Friday prior to the home games. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Emergency Road Service

Iowa State University and Iowa AAA Motor Club will provide an Emergency Road Service for persons attending home football games. This service will be in effect during and within two hours after the game throughout the season. The phone number for the service is 292-2303. Proof of game attendance (i.e.; ticket stub) may be requested.

Distractions

We want to make football Saturday a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage you to be respectful of those around you in the stadium. This attitude of cooperation can help to insure a pleasant enthusiastic game atmosphere. In the event you feel there is unreasonable distraction in your seating area, we ask you to take the following steps to help us control undesirable behavior:

—Note the seating section, row and seat numbers, and inform the usher in your section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and request it to stop, if appropriate.

—If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvement of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.

—An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation in next season's ticket assignment.

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SCOUTING REPORT

The Series: Colorado has a 33-11-1 lead in the series. The Buffaloes have a 17-6 lead in Ames. Last season in Boulder, Colorado held a slim 14-12 halftime lead, but pulled away in the third quarter to win the game 28-12. The Buffaloes have defeated ISU seven consecutive times dating back to 1984.

Last Weekend: Playing for the injured Darian Hagen, sophomore quarterback Vance Joseph drove the Buffaloes 80 yards in the final minutes and sophomore fullback James Hill dove over the goal line with 40 seconds left as Colorado kept their Orange Bowl hopes alive with a 30-24 victory over visiting Kansas. The Jayhawks outgained the Buffaloes in total yards 430 to 312, but that wasn't enough as Colorado scored 20 unanswered points in the final 21 minutes of the game.

Offensively: Colorado gained 312 yards, 176 of which came on the ground. Freshman tailback Lamont Warren led the rushing attack with 94 yards on 20 carries. Warren leads Colorado with 662 rushing yards. Joseph, a sophomore, completed 7-of-11 passes for 85 yards and one touchdown. His touchdown pass covered 20 yards to freshman wingback Michael Westbrook. Hagen, a senior, leads the Buffaloes with 1,205 yards passing and 11 touchdowns.

Defensively: Junior linebacker Greg Biekert has 123 tackles through 10 games this season. Biekert

led the Buffs and the Big Eight last year with 150 tackles. His total ranked him third in the nation last season. He was honorable mention all-conference in 1990. Junior linebacker Chad Brown is second in tackles with 115. Brown is also second on the team with 7.5 sacks for losses totalling 37 yards. Sophomore linebacker Ron Woolfork is fourth with 67 tackles, but leads the team with 10.5 sacks for 82 yards lost.

Kicking: Junior place-kicker Jim Harper paces Colorado in scoring with 54 points. He has made 30-of-33 extra-point tries this season. Harper is 8-of-13 on field goal attempts with a long of 50 yards. Sophomore Mitch Berger takes over the punting duties this season with the departure of Tom Rouen. Rouen was first team all-Big Eight in 1989. Berger has punted 54 times this year for an average of 38.8 yards per punt.

The Coach: Bill McCartney (Missouri '62) is in his 10th year as head coach of the Buffaloes. He has a career record of 64-48-3. McCartney spent eight years at the University of Michigan, under Bo Schembechler before coming to Colorado in 1982. In 1985, the Buffaloes finished 7-5 and won the NCAA's Most Improved Team award. In 1989 and 1990, McCartney was selected as the Coach-of-the-Year and he guided his 1990 team to Colorado's first national championship.

VEISHEA 1992 Honors Beirut Hostages as Grand Marshalls

In the 70th year of the VEISHEA celebration, the 1992 VEISHEA Central Committee has chosen to honor Iowa State graduates Terry Anderson and Thomas Sutherland as Co-Grand Marshalls.

Sutherland was released by Lebanese captors in Beirut earlier this week. Captured June 9, 1985, Sutherland was the Dean of Agriculture at the American University of Beirut when he was taken hostage. He received his master's degree in 1956 and his doctorate in 1958, both in animal science, from ISU. Sutherland and Anderson have represented ISU internationally through their accomplishments.

Anderson has been held longer than any other hostage. Captured March 16, 1985, Anderson was Middle East correspondent for the Associated Press at the time of his capture. He graduated from ISU with a double major in journalism and mass communication and political science.

The central committee has drafted a formal invitation to Anderson and Sutherland, which has been signed by Gov. Terry Branstad, Ames Mayor Larry Curtis, ISU President Martin Jischke, Government of the Student Body President Mike Noble and all of the undergraduate college deans. The invitations will be sent to the hostages' families the first week of December, 1991. Fans attending today's game are encouraged to sign the invitations that are placed near the concession stands and at the exits from Cyclone Stadium.

ISU faculty members have remembered Anderson, Sutherland and the other hostages through many articles in

ISU publications as well as the tollings of the carillon in the Campanile. Members of the journalism department have worked for the hostages' release and the College of Science and Humanities (now the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences) has bestowed honors upon Anderson. VEISHEA 1992 is proud to continue this tradition of showing support for these great men.

For the past 69 years VEISHEA has honored distinguished guests as Grand Marshalls of the now largest student-organized festival in the nation. The list includes Ronald Reagan in 1958, Dr. James Hilton in 1965, Iowa Gov. Robert Ray in 1971, Bruce Jenner in 1977, Roxanne Conlin in 1981 and Michael Gartner in 1991.

The 1992 VEISHEA committee anticipates Anderson's release in the very near future and hopes that both men will be able to participate in the spring festival. It hopes that all of the ISU family—students, faculty, alumni and supporters will join in demonstrating commitment to Anderson and Sutherland by signing the invitations. Take a moment to show your ISU spirit and let these alumni see your concern.

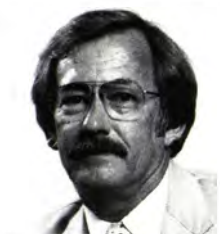
