

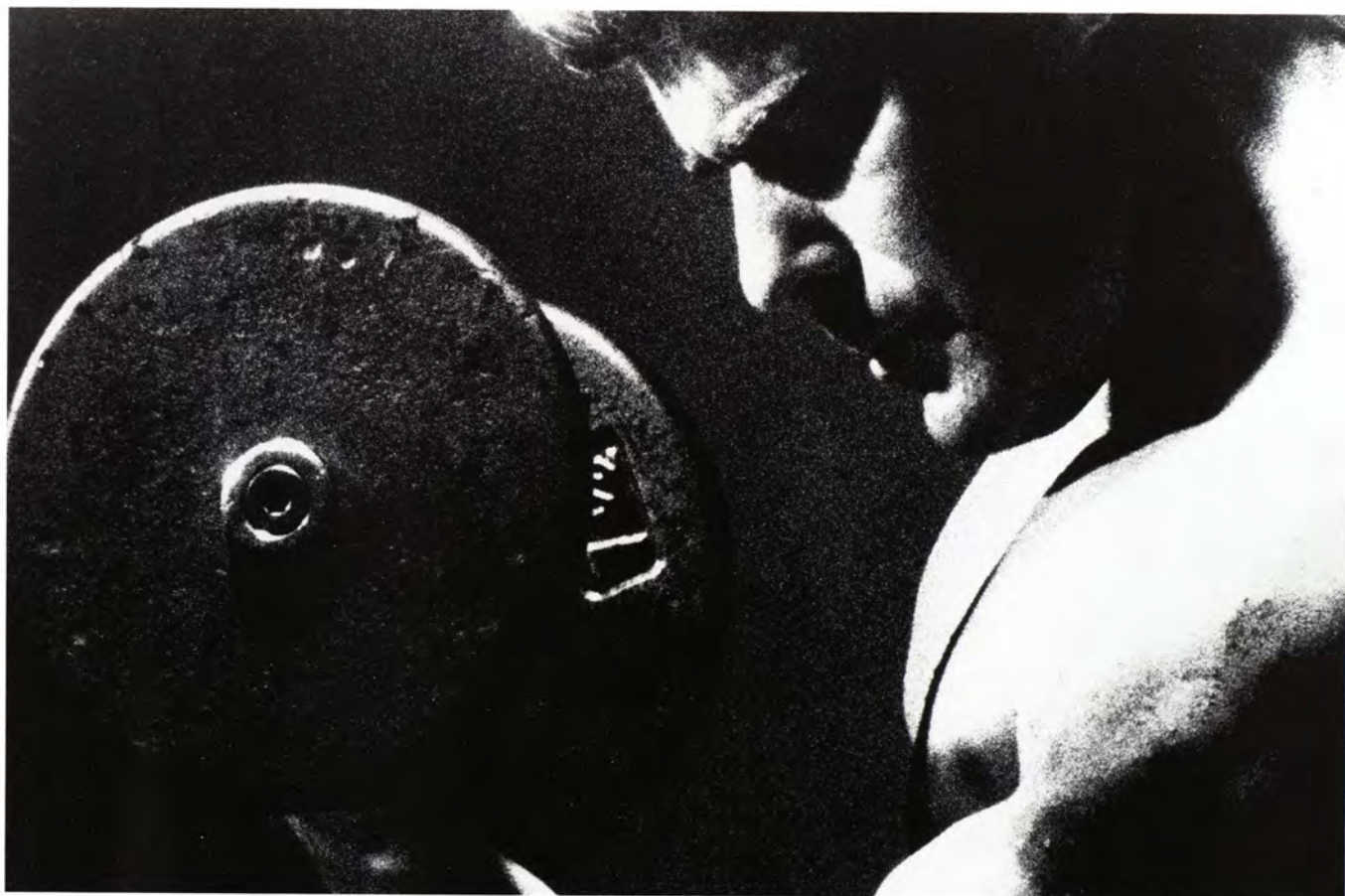

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Since it opened in 1858, Iowa State University has been working for the state of Iowa. As Iowa's land-grant university, Iowa State has played an important role in the educational, economic, cultural and social development of the state and the nation.

Both the Cooperative Extensive Service and agricultural experiment station system trace their beginnings to Iowa State University; the nation's first public school of veterinary medicine was established at Iowa State; and the electronic digital computer was invented at Iowa State.

Today, Iowa State University is a broad-based university of international stature. With more than 25,000 students from all 50 states and nearly 120 other nations, Iowa State is helping Iowa and the nation open doors to international exchange, trade and development.

Educating students for careers and lives in today's increasingly diverse and complex world remains Iowa State's highest priority. In recent years, Iowa State has been successful in attracting a more diverse student body and has expanded the number of opportunities for students to travel and learn in other countries.

Students at Iowa State can choose from among more than 100 programs of study leading to baccalaureate degrees in the colleges of Agriculture, Business, Design, Education, Engineering, Family and Consumer Sciences, and Liberal Arts and Sciences. The College of Veterinary Medicine offers the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree and graduate students can choose from among 200 fields of study leading to master's, doctor of philosophy and specialist degrees.

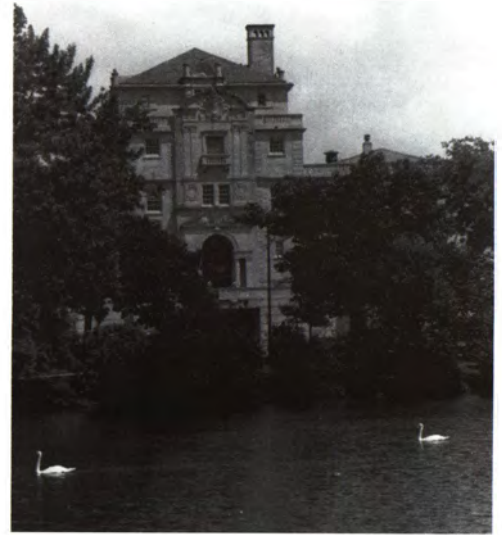
Students find a high quality of life when they become part of the Iowa State University community. An award-winning lectures program, nationally recognized residence hall

and Greek housing systems, a comprehensive array of student support services, and more than 400 student clubs and organizations were all reasons ISU was included in a recent national study of colleges and universities with a high quality of student life.

The Iowa State campus is recognized as one of the most beautiful in the nation. The park-like setting of 1,800 acres has more than 180 major buildings, including some beautifully restored structures from the late-1800s and early 1900s, as well as striking examples of modern architecture. Numerous pieces of art can be found throughout the campus, including sculptures by Christian Petersen and murals by Grant Wood.

The Iowa State Center on the south campus includes the 14,000-seat James H. Hilton Coliseum (where Cyclone men's and women's basketball, volleyball, gymnastics and wrestling teams compete), J.W. Fisher Theater, Scheman Continuing Education Building, and C.Y. Stephens Auditorium, hailed as one of the nation's finest concert halls. With these facilities, Iowa State regularly attracts headline entertainers and major international performing artists. Recently, Cyclone Stadium has played host to such notables as Genesis, the Rolling Stones, Paul McCartney, U2, Pink Floyd and the "Farm Aid '93" concert.

Athletics—both intramural and intercollegiately—play important roles in the life of Iowa State University. A member of the prestigious Big Eight Conference, Iowa State competes in 20 intercollegiate sports. Overall, Iowa State is consistently ranked among the top intercollegiate athletic programs in the nation, with several Cyclone teams and individuals earning high national rankings and



national championships in recent years.

Iowa State maintains an active intramural sports program, involving nearly 15,000 students each year. The expansive new Recreation/Athletic Complex provides ample space for intramural sports and individual fitness programs for all students, as well as practice and competition areas for several of ISU's intercollegiate teams.

Iowa State is busy working for the future by playing a leading role in revitalizing and modernizing the land-grant mission of education, research and service for the 21st century. Iowa State is a leader in the development of distance education programs to serve the continuing education needs of the people throughout Iowa, the nation and the world. Some of the country's most advanced technology development and technology transfer programs are the result of Iowa State's expanded research programs.

Iowa was the first state in the nation to embrace the land-grant concept in education, and Iowa State has been fulfilling that land-grant mission for Iowa for more than 124 years. TODAY'S MATCHUP

Iowa State will be put to a test today as it entertains Mid-American Conference favorite Western Michigan at Cyclone Stadium-Jack Trice Field. The Broncos, under eighth-year head coach Al Molde, have 45 of 54 total lettermen returning from last year's 7-3-1 team, including 18 of 22 starters, as well as their top punter and kicker.

Off to a 2-0 start after posting wins over MAC foe Miami of Ohio and Western Illinois, Western Michigan is averaging 528.5 yards of total offense, led by junior quarterback Jay McDonagh. An 1993 honorable mention all-MAC selection, McDonagh has connected on 33 of 52 passes this season (.635) for 468 yards and five touchdowns. Last year he set a new Bronco record, completing 61.5 percent of his passes.

Two of McDonagh's top targets are flanker Andre Wallace and tailback Jim Vackaro, both honorable mention all-conference picks last year. Wallace has 12 receptions for 166 yards, while Vackaro has tallied 166 yards on nine catches. Each has scored a Bronco touchdown. Vackaro, a junior, also leads the WMU ground attack, averaging 7.5 yards on 27 carries.

Today is the fourth time in six years that Iowa State has taken on a MAC foe. The Cyclones enter the WMU game with an 11-0 all-time mark against MAC foes, and 1-0 vs. Western Michigan. Iowa State head coach Jim Walden is 4-0 vs. the Mid-American Conference, winning his only battle with Western Michigan four years ago.

When the Broncos last visited Ames on Sept. 29, 1990, Iowa State tallied a 34-20 victory over Western Michigan. Although quarterback Chris Pedersen still was sidelined with a bad knee, tailback Blaise Bryant returned to play approximately two quarters and gain

83 yards. Bryant had missed the Iowa game the previous week after sustaining injuries at Minnesota in the second game of the season.

The Cyclones were sluggish early, surrendering a 7-0 lead to the Broncos at the end of the first quarter. ISU then scored three consecutive touchdowns to grab a 21-7 lead with 2:03 left in the first half. Sherman Williams, Sundiata Patterson, and Bryant each crossed the goal line from one yard to provide ISU with its winning momentum.

Bryant scored again from one yard out in the third quarter, and Jeff Shudak booted field goals from 28 and 30 yards out. Western Michigan narrowed the margin with 3:26 left in the game on a one-yard run by running back Dan Boggan.

The Cyclones netted 453 yards of total offense, but allowed 411 defensively, including 265 through the air. Freshman Bob Utter received the starting quarterback nod with the injury to Pedersen. Utter, a Michigan native, threw for 246 yards and completed 16 passes.

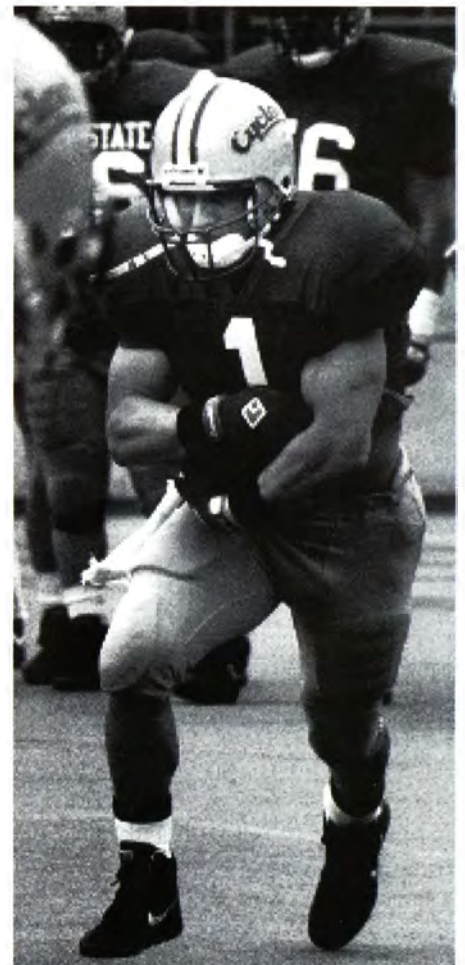
Although several current ISU fifth-year seniors were on the sidelines during its most recent win over MAC foe Ohio University in the 1992 season-opener, none saw action.

Coming off a 37-9 loss at Iowa last Saturday, Iowa State will be looking to eliminate turnovers in today's contest. The Hawkeyes capitalized on three Iowa State turnovers in the first four possessions of the second half, breaking open the close halftime score. Iowa had a 13-3 lead at the intermission, but was ahead 30-9 at the end of the third quarter. Iowa out-gained Iowa State, 383-233.

Calvin Branch led Iowa State with 58 yards rushing on eight carries, while sophomore quarterback Todd Doxzon scored ISU's only

touchdown on a 1-yard run with 7:48 left in the game. In his first action of the 1994 season, redshirt freshman Robby Duncan came off the bench against the Hawks and promptly led Iowa State on a 12-play, 55-yard drive that set up a 23-yard Ty Stewart field goal.

USA Today-Florida Gatorade Player-of-the-Year Troy Davis and Ed Williams also made their debut in the Cardinal and Gold last weekend. Davis had five carries for 14 yard vs. the Hawks and caught one pass for eight yards, while Williams made three receptions for 36 yards. True freshmen Kemp Knighten and Mike Hudson, also from Florida, have seen action this season.

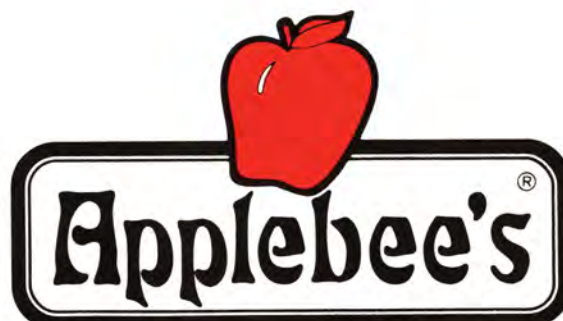
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GENE SMITH

Athletics Director — Iowa State University



Promising to make Iowa State "one of the premier athletic programs in the nation," Gene Smith began his tenure as Iowa State's 12th

athletic director on July 1, 1993. He is already making good on that commitment, leading the Iowa State athletic department through success and adversity.

"My goal is to provide a program that wins," said Smith at his initial press conference. "We will do it with integrity, with fiscal integrity, and with a great deal of fire and desire. We will do everything we can to become a dominant force in the Big Eight Conference."

Under Smith, the Iowa State athletic department not only recovered from a devastating flood that struck the state of Iowa, but went forward with implementation of his vision for Cyclone athletics.

In the first 12 months of his tenure, Smith:

- Led a nearly-completed \$8 million drive to finance construction of a new 60,000-square-foot three-story athletic office and training facility.

- Oversaw a \$900,000 project to construct new offices and meeting rooms at Hilton Coliseum for the ISU men's and women's basketball programs.

- Restructured the ISU athletic department management structure to ensure effective communication, fiscal accountability, maximum utilization of resources and a strong commitment to gender equity.

- Created a marketing and promotions department that in its first year, has generated more than \$1 million in corporate commitments to Iowa State athletics, which include state-of-the-art improvements to Cyclone Stadium.

- Hired one of the nation's top young coaches, Tim Floyd, to direct ISU's nationally known men's basketball program.

Smith's strong reputation among his peers was affirmed in June 1994, when the Notre Dame graduate was named president of the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA). Smith also serves on the NCAA President's Commission Liaison Committee.

Prior to his arrival in Ames, Smith served as athletic director at Eastern Michigan University for seven years.

Smith earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Notre Dame in 1977. He won three varsity football letters as a Fighting Irish defensive end, and was a member of the 1973 Associated Press national championship team.

A native of Cleveland, Ohio, Smith has three daughters: Nicole (16), Lindsey (12) and Summer (10).

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DR. MARTIN C. JISCHKE

President — Iowa State University



Iowa State University enters its fourth years under the direction of Dr. Martin Jischke. Under his leadership, Iowa State is making

significant progress toward its goal of becoming the nation's premier land-grant university.

Major improvements have been made in Iowa State's undergraduate programs; research programs continue to expand, particularly in agriculture, science and technology; and Iowa State's Extension and technology transfer programs have been reorganized to be more efficient and responsive to the needs of the people of Iowa.

Under the leadership, Iowa State has set new records in several important areas, including:

- Enrollments of minority students, graduate students and high achieving students.

- External funding for research and educational programs, with

\$175.7 million raised in 1993-94.

- Private fund-raising, with the Partnership in Prominence campaign raising \$215 million in the six-year period ending June 30, 1993 and \$61 million in 1993-94.

- Income from intellectual property, with more than \$22 million earned in the past two years.

Jischke, 52, came to ISU from the University of Missouri, Rolla, where he had served as chancellor for five years. He spent 17 years as a faculty member and administrator at the University of Oklahoma, serving as director of the School of Aerospace Mechanical and Nuclear Engineering, Dean of the College of Engineering, and, in 1985, interim president.

A native of Chicago, Jischke earned the B.S. in physics, with honors, in 1963 from the Illinois Institute of Technology, and M.S. in 1964 and Ph.D. in 1968 in aeronautics and astronautics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He is trained as a fluid dynamicist and has expertise in heat transfer, fluid mechanics, aerodynamics, and problems related

to high-speed aircraft and spacecraft. He is the author or co-author of 31 archival journal publications and 21 major technical reports, and is co-editor of a book.

He has served research fellowships with NASA and the Donald W. Douglas Laboratory, and has received research grants from the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Air Force, NASA, the National Institutes of Health, National Severe Storms Laboratory, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. During 1975-76, he served as White House Fellow and Special Assistant to the Secretary of Transportation.

Jischke is a member of the board of directors of the National Association of State Universities and Land-Grant Colleges and the board of trustees of the University Center for Atmospheric Research. In 1993, he received the Centennial Medallion from the American Society of Engineering Education. A leading presidential voice in intercollegiate athletics, he is the 1994-95 chair of the Association of Big 12 Universities.

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JIM WALDEN

Head Football Coach — Iowa State University

Eight years ago, the Iowa State administration began a search for a new Cyclone football coach. The quest was not only for a football coach, but for a new direction, a new personality, and a new attitude for the Iowa State program. Iowa State found all those ingredients in Jim Walden. On December 16, 1986, the former Washington State mentor became Iowa State's 28th head football coach. It was a great match.

The 1993 Cyclones, in their second year running the triple-option offense, gained 2,667 yards rushing, the second-highest total in school history. ISU ranked 11th nationally in rushing and second in the Big Eight Conference. Offensive tackle Doug Skartvedt, a Ratcliffe, Iowa, native, became Walden's fourth All-American in four years at Iowa State.

The personable native of Aberdeen, Miss., led his first ISU team finished 3-8 and demonstrated consistent improvement throughout the season. His 1988 team improved to 5-6 and challenged for a winning season. The team finished fifth in the Big Eight Conference and took a 5-5 mark into the final game against Oklahoma State.

Walden recorded a winning season in just his third year at the helm, despite fielding only slightly more than 50 scholarship players throughout most of the 1989 campaign. Iowa State finished 6-5 overall and 4-3 in conference play. His 1989 team ranked 17th nationally in total offense and fielded the Big Eight Conference's offensive leaders in nearly every category.

His 1990 squad tied for fourth place in conference play. The squad highlighted the campaign by recording a 33-31 upset victory at nationally-ranked Oklahoma. The Cyclones recorded over 4,000 yards in total offense for the second consecutive season, and crowned the Big Eight Conference's total offense leader in quarterback Chris Pedersen.

Walden's 1992 squad wrote its name in school's history books as the team that upset No. 7 and Big Eight champion Nebraska. *Sports Illustrated* dubbed the Cyclones' 19-10 win over the Cornhuskers as the biggest upset during the 1992 season.

As the head coach at Washington State for nine years, Walden compiled a 44-52-4 record against tough Pacific-10 Conference competition. During that time, Walden guided teams to three winning seasons and four first-division finishes in the conference. He was one of only two WSU coaches to record more than one winning campaign, and only one other coach in Cougar history won more games or served longer as head coach than Walden.

Walden's Washington State teams became known for the upset victory. No opponent took a WSU team lightly, as the Cougars upset Pac-10 powerhouses USC, UCLA and Washington during his years at the school. In fact, Washington State had great success against intrastate rival Washington, knocking the Huskies off in three of Walden's last five years in Pullman, Wash.

The 56-year-old Walden actually was at Washington State for 10 years, first serving as an assistant to Warren Powers. When Powers left WSU following the 1977 season, Cougar officials tabbed Walden as his replacement. The culmination of a four-year plan came when Walden took the Cougars to the 1981 Holiday Bowl, WSU's first bowl appearance since the 1931 Rose

Bowl. WSU finished the season with an 8-3-1 mark, needing only a win in the regular-season finale to go to the Rose Bowl.

His success did not go unnoticed by his peers. Walden earned Pac-10 Coach-of-the-Year honors in 1981 and 1983. In 1981, he was the UPI West Coast and AFCA/Kodak District IX Coach-of-the-Year.

Despite spending 10 years in the Pac-10, Walden was familiar with Big Eight Conference football. He started his collegiate coaching career in 1969 at Nebraska under his former college coach, Bob Devaney. For the next four seasons, Walden was a defensive coach for the Cornhuskers. During those years, Nebraska won two national championships.

From Nebraska, Walden moved to Miami (Fla.) in 1973 as an offensive backfield coach for Pete Elliott, and was later named defensive coordinator under Carl Selmer. Walden joined Warren Powers' Washington State staff as backfield coach for the 1977 season, and took over the head coaching job in 1978.





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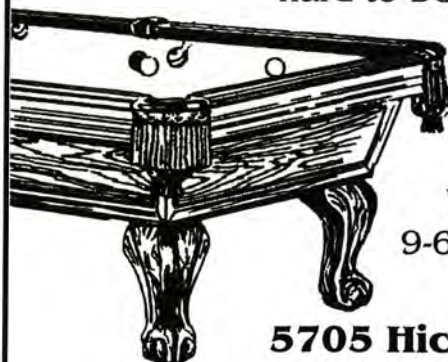

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SCOUTING REPORT

THE SERIES: Iowa State won the only other meeting with Western Michigan, a 34-20 victory in Ames in 1990. WMU coach Al Molde's Broncos carry an unblemished 2-0 record with them heading into Saturday's game at Cyclone Stadium-Jack Trice Field.

OFFENSIVELY: Western Michigan is strong offensively, racking up 71 points through the first two games this season. Junior signal-caller Jay McDonagh returns at the helm, having started the last eight contests during the 1993 campaign. McDonagh completed 62 percent of his passes last year, and ranked second in the Mid-American Conference in total offense, averaging 209 yards per game. The Broncos also boast a very threatening running attack manned by tailbacks Dave Madsen and Jim Vackaro. Sophomore tailback David Miller, who racked up 101 yards on 12 carries, will also see action. Vackaro rushed nine times against Western Illinois as the Broncos ran away with 390 rushing yards and a 43-7 victory. Western Michigan also returns four offensive linemen, averaging 279 pounds, from a squad that has posted two consecutive season records of 7-3-1. Senior speedster Andre Wallace poses a major offensive threat at flanker. Wallace was fourth in the MAC in receiving, hauling down 55 receptions for 599 yards.

DEFENSIVELY: The Bronco defense returns eight starters from a unit that ranked second in the MAC for rushing (134.1 ypg) and also scoring (17.0 ppg) during the 1993 season. The Broncos will be strong up front with nine returning lettermen on the line. Linebacker Peter Tuffo was the ninth-leading

tackler in the conference with 131 stops, and he ranked third in the MAC with 15 tackles for losses. Tuffo, an All-American Candidate, also collected six sacks for losses of 44 yards. Western Michigan's defensive storm pummeled Western Illinois last week, surrendering just 14 rushing yards on 22 attempts. Other big-play makers for the Broncos include junior linebacker Willis Porter who picked off passes against Purdue and Miami (Ohio), and senior linebacker Rufus Harris, who was second on the squad with 98 tackles. The Broncos pass defense could be a question mark, as Western Illinois gained 300-plus yardage, but defensive coordinator Rob Kuhlman feels the unit is solid throughout.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior placekicker Kevin Knope was second among MAC field goal leaders. Knope's 60-point season tied him for second in the league for scoring, and a 51-yard boot against Akron tied as the third best in school history. Knope was a perfect two-for-two in last week's victory, nailing marks of 22 and 38 yards. Cornerback Marcus Wagstaff will see duty returning punts for the Broncos. Wagstaff was sixth last year among MAC players. Wallace and William Atwater will share time returning kicks.

THE COACH: Head coach Al Molde brings a very experienced team with him, after returning 45 of 54 total lettermen and 18 of 22 starters from the 1993 season. Molde carries a 46-30-2 record through seven years of coaching at Western Michigan, and a 152-87-8 overall mark.

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THE CENTER OF ATTENTION

CYCLONE SENIOR CO-CAPTAIN TONY BOOTH

In football, the center position is generally just a thankless effort. Few fans praise centers for their importance in the offensive scheme. Some players would be upset by this lack of notoriety, but Iowa State's Tony Booth seemed to enjoy the anonymity. However, the 6-3, 293-pound co-captain has become a center of attention. Booth is one of 22 fifth-year seniors that ISU head coach Jim Walden is calling on to provide leadership for the 1994 Cyclones.

Booth burst onto the media scene last season when he became the first Big Eight offensive lineman in the last six years to be named the conference's offensive player of the week. The Cyclone center earned the honor by leading ISU to a 27-23 upset over No. 18 Kansas State. Booth was in the middle of the line that paved the way for ISU's running attack. With the Cyclones' All-American lineman Doug Skartvedt out of the game an injury, ISU ran behind Booth 20 times for 121 yards

and two touchdowns to fuel the comeback.

The incredible rushing numbers behind Booth would have been enough to earn him attention, but they were insubstantial in comparison to the play that would make Booth a name among Cyclone fans. Trailing 17-12, the Cyclones faced a third-and-six situation on the K-State 49-yard line. ISU quarterback Todd Doxzon dropped back to pass, but his throw was deflected by a KSU lineman. Booth leaped into the air and pulled down the pass and bulled forward with the help of his teammates for seven yards and a first down. The Cyclone drive resulted in the go-ahead touchdown.

"I just happened to look up and grabbed the ball," Booth said after the game. "That was my first instinct, go for it." His instinct thrust him into the limelight. Booth was not only named the player-of-the-week, but earned honorable mention all-Big Eight honors after the 1993 season. He was a key ingredient in the

Cyclone offense that averaged 242.5 yards rushing per game. Iowa State's per-carry mark of 4.6 yards was the second-best in 101 years of ISU football.

Booth's honors and his "catch" are history. The new season provides new challenges for the co-captain. Booth is called on to be one the leaders for the Cyclone offense. He humbly shys away from calling himself a leader.

"I don't consider myself to be a leader," Booth said. "I do everything just as hard as I can during practice. I just do what I have to do."

Sophomore quarterback Todd Doxzon disagrees. "He is a leader that you really respect," Doxzon said. "He doesn't lead with his words, he just goes out there and gives it his all. Tony is a model of consistency for everyone. He just goes out and does a great job every snap, no matter if it is a game or a practice."

The Iowa State center is a true model of consistency. He has started in 25 straight games, but has played several different positions. Last season Walden said, "He is the most consistent player on our team in terms of grading, but yet he's probably not as dominating as Doug Skartvedt."

Few players are as dominating as Skartvedt. But like Skartvedt, Booth has dreams to play professional football. He told *Cyclone Illustrated*, "I would like to be at the next level. Seeing some of the other guys on the team go on and play at the next level, for me, that's something to shoot for. I'm not expecting it, but if I have a good season I'll get a chance. That's all you can ask for."

Booth's stardom has been a journey. He came to Iowa State in 1990 as a walk-on after a distinguished prep career at Cedar Rapids Kennedy. Booth wasn't just honored as a football player, he was also an all-metro center in basketball by the *Cedar Rapids Gazette*. In baseball, Booth was a three-time all-conference and all-district baseball player and was chosen to play in the Iowa High School Baseball All-Star game.

When Booth stepped on the Iowa State campus, he decided to concentrate on his education and football. His efforts earned him first-team academic all-Big Eight honors in 1991. Just as Booth's persistence has paid off in rising from a walk-on to a starter, his hard work will result in a degree in transportation and logistics in the spring.

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Each year the squads make approximately 80 appearances representing Iowa State throughout the state. Squads appear at all

football games, all home men's and women's basketball games, and various other athletic events throughout the year.

Iowa State is well known around the country for producing excellent spirit squads. The varsity cheersquad has qualified for the NCA Cheerleading

Championships four of the past five years, finishing in the top 10 each time, and achieving a sixth-place finish in 1993. The pom pon and varsity cheersquad attend camps each summer, where they always finish among the top squads, receiving many team awards and all-America honors.

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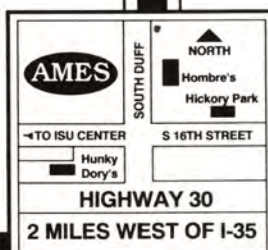

STADIUM INFORMATION

First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact the nearest usher to request medical assistance.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked in the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be stamped for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-entry. No pass outs will be allowed between noon and 1 p.m. or one hour before kickoff.

Service for Physicians

Doctors anticipating calls during the game are urged to register at the first aid quarters under the west stands, leaving their exact seat location. The management will see that all calls are delivered without delay.

Lost and Found

A lost and found service is maintained in the Athletic Ticket Office in the Olsen Building at the north end of the stadium. Articles found should be turned over to an usher or left at the Athletic Ticket Office.

Public Telephone

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands.

Iowa State Souvenirs

An attractive array of Iowa State souvenirs are available at conveniently located novelty sales booths throughout the stadium and from vendors in the parking areas.

Coolers, Thermoses Discouraged:

As a courtesy to neighboring guests, spectators are asked NOT to bring stadium chair, coolers, or thermoses into the stands.

Rest Rooms

Restrooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Public Address System

No appeals will be made over the public address system except under extenuating circumstances. The public is asked not to request this service.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 16, 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. Signs are to be displayed on the south end of the Olsen Building. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Associate Athletics Director Elve Everage (129 Olsen Building) before noon on Friday prior to the home games. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Emergency Road Service

Iowa State University and Iowa AAA Motor Club will provide Emergency Road Service for persons attending home football games. This service will be in effect during and within two hours after the game throughout the season. The phone number for the service is 233-6636. Proof of game attendance (ie. ticket stub) may be requested. Basic emergency road service includes starts, tire change, gas delivery and unlocks.

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium any bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team.

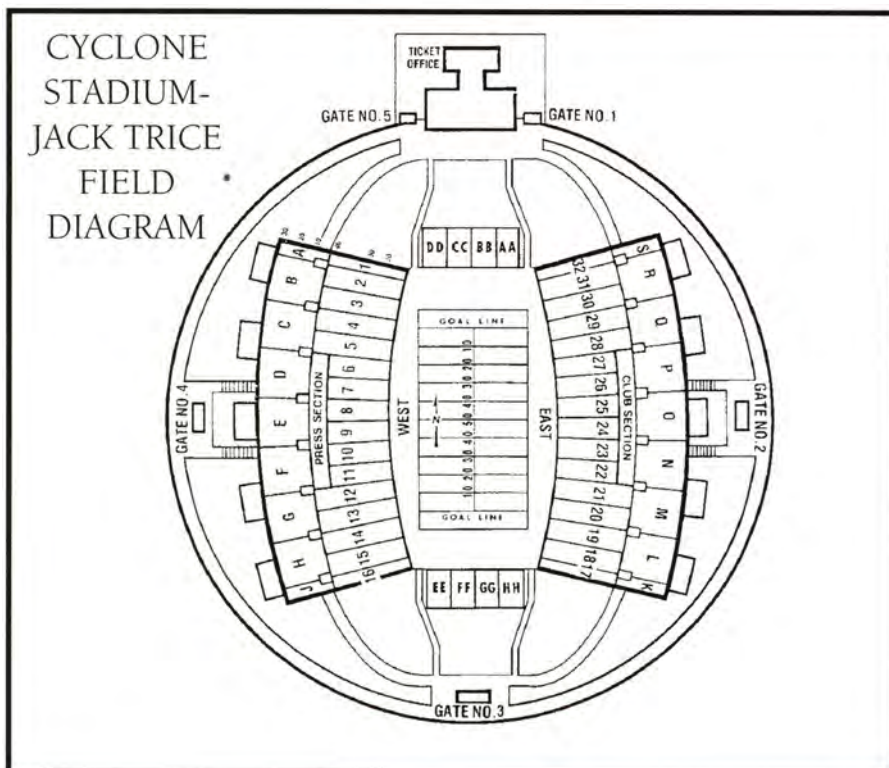
Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located in strategic spots throughout the stadium parking area.

Distractions

We want to make football Saturday a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage you to be respectful of those around you in the stadium. In the event that you feel there is an unreasonable distraction in your seating area, we ask you to take the following steps to help us control undesirable behavior.

- Note the seating section, row, and seat numbers and inform the usher in your section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and request it to stop, if appropriate.
- If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvements of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.
- An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation in next season's ticket assignments.

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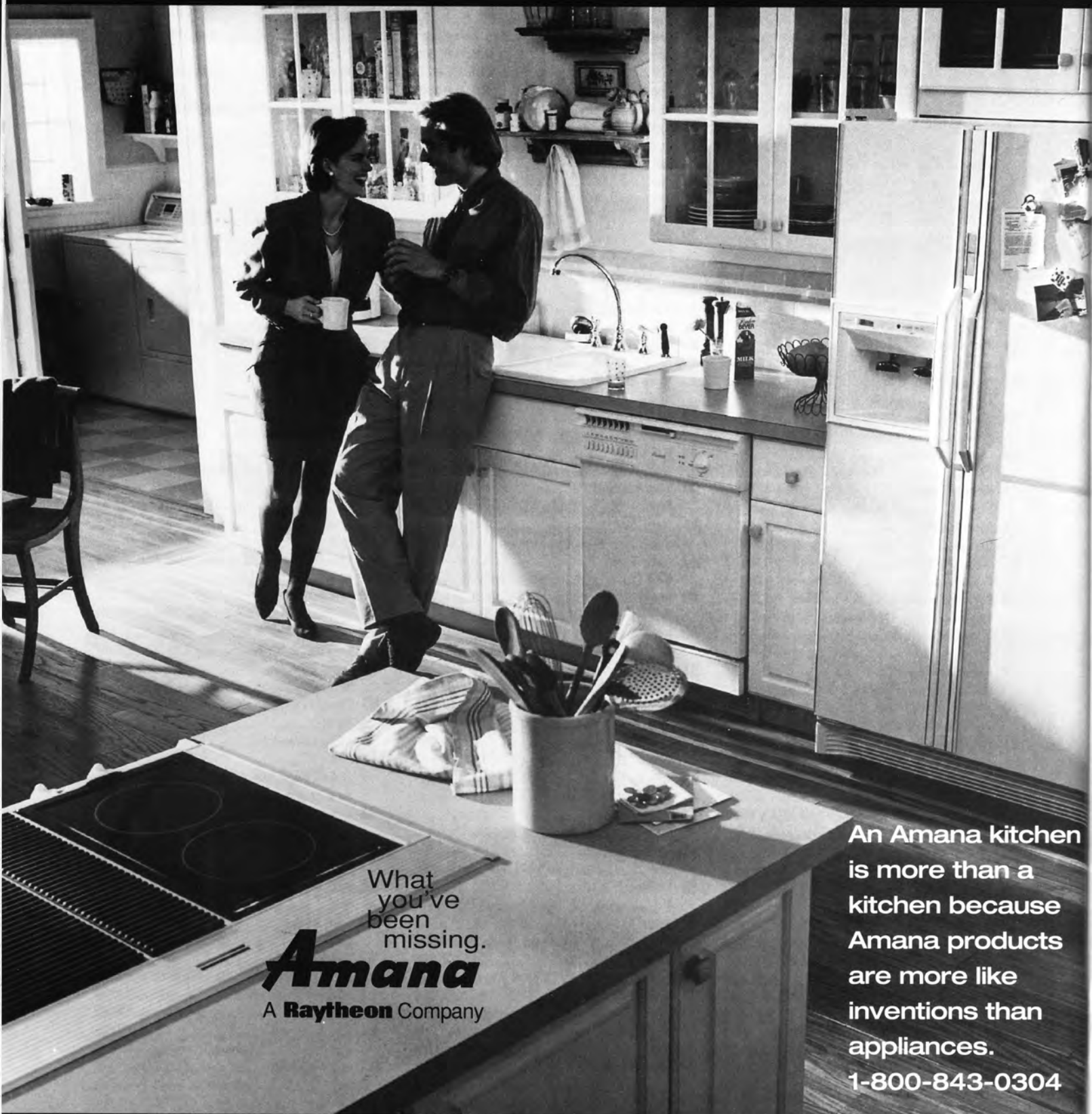

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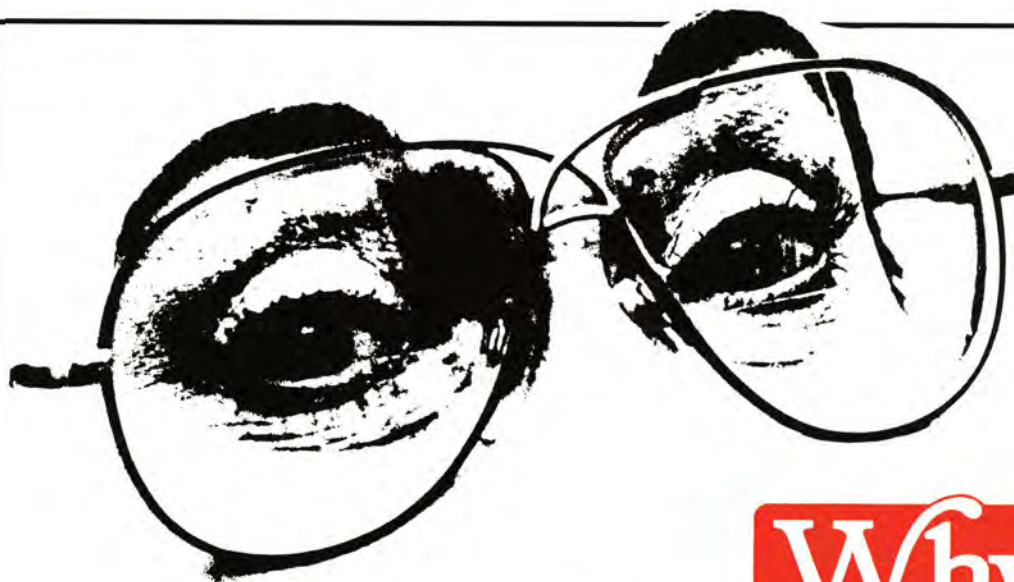
