Welcome to Iowa State University

Beauty and activity are two hallmarks of the Iowa State University campus. Its 1,700-acre central campus resembles a park, and it is considered one of the three most beautiful university campuses in the nation by the American Association of Landscape Architects. Its 160 major buildings include historic landmarks, numerous restored architectural classics and many stunning examples of modern design. The university has one of the nation's largest public collections of art, much of which graces the outdoor landscape and building exteriors, including many sculptures by Christian Petersen, who was artist-in-resident at Iowa State for 21 years.

Iowa State's nearly 28,000 students come from all 50 states and 115 other nations. Many are outstanding scholars and leaders, including more National Merit Scholars than all but 11 other public universities, and more National Achievement Scholars than all but two other public universities. Students study in more than 200 undergraduate and graduate degree programs, and they participate in approximately 450 different student clubs and organizations. Iowa State is a learner-centered university where quality teaching and student success are the top priorities.

Iowa State has an outstanding residence system, which is undergoing an extensive renovation to give students more living options and amenities, such as more apartment-style living, as well as improved academic support programs and services and specialized houses for students with similar interests. A unique "house" system, in which each floor is considered an independent unit, turns the large residence halls into close-knit, smaller communities for students. The approximately 2,700 students who live in fraternities and sororities make Iowa State's Greek System one of the strongest in the nation, and city-university services such as the Cy-Ride bus system make off-campus living as convenient as on-campus living.

Iowa State offers an extensive program of intramural sports, and its

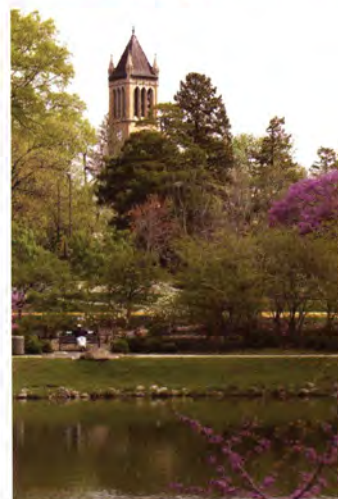
student participation rate is one of the highest in the nation. Competitions include all traditional sports, as well as such unusual activities as innertube water basketball, broomball and mud volleyball. The three-level, 220,000-square-foot Lied Recreation Facility encompasses 20 basketball courts, nine racquetball courts, a 300-meter ground-level track, an elevated jogging track, and extensive weight-training and aerobics facilities.

One of the qualities that makes Iowa State University such a dynamic living and learning environment is the number and variety of performing and visual arts opportunities offered. The Iowa State Center, which includes Stephens Auditorium, Hilton Coliseum, Fisher Theater and Scheman Continuing Education Building, hosts top performances throughout the year, including international orchestras and touring companies, popular music groups, theater events and art exhibits.

A more recent addition to the Iowa State campus is the Reiman Gardens, which opened in 1995. Located just south of Jack Trice Stadium, the 14-acre teaching and public garden complex includes an award-winning rose garden, children's garden, town and country garden complete with pond, several meeting facilities, and new 5,000-square-foot conservatory and 2,500-square-foot butterfly wing. Tens of thousands of people visit the Reiman Gardens each year, making it one of the most popular attractions in central Iowa.

Life at Iowa State is serious (it's the birthplace of the electronic digital computer and a leading research university), and it's fun (our students hold the Guinness World Record for making the largest Rice Krispies Treats cereal bar and organize VEISHEA, the largest student-run festival in the nation).

Adding to the enjoyment and quality of life at Iowa State University is Cyclone participation and success in Big 12 Conference, the nation's premier intercollegiate athletic conference. Iowa State University welcomes everyone to the campus and to this athletic event.

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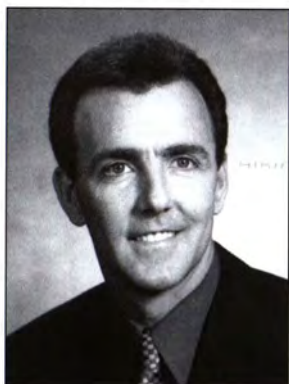

Cyclones vs. Longhorns



Iowa State's brutal 2003 schedule continues today when the Cyclones face No. 20 University of Texas. According to the latest NCAA statistics, Iowa State has the toughest schedule in the nation. The Longhorns will be the fourth ranked team Iowa State has played in the last five weeks. Texas Tech, Iowa State's last opponent, moved into the top-25 following its victory over the Cyclones last week. ISU and Texas meet for just the fifth time in series history, and will play only the second game between the schools at Jack Trice Stadium. Texas defeated Iowa State last season in Austin, 21-10.

Both teams are looking to bounce back from defeats last week. ISU lost to arguably the hottest team in college football, the Texas Tech Red Raiders, 52-21, in Lubbock last Saturday. The Longhorns were defeated by the top-ranked Oklahoma Sooners in the Red River Shoot-Out, 65-13.

The Cyclones offense racked up 355 yards last week, led by the efforts of record-breaking receiver Lane Danielsen. Danielsen had a career day against the Red Raider secondary, snaring eight receptions for a career-high 192 yards. His 80-yard touchdown catch from Cris Love in the third quarter was also a new career best for the senior from Dike, Iowa. Michael Wagner led the Iowa State rushing attack with 52 yards, while redshirt freshman Stevie Hicks added 40. Cris Love saw the most extensive playing time of his career at quarterback, throwing for 262 yards on 15 completions, including two touchdown passes.

The Texas offense, though held in check by a stifling OU defense last week, presents a number of threats. Cedric Benson, one of the top running backs in the Big 12, leads the ground game for the Longhorns with 358 yards on the season. Both Vince Young and Chance Mock have seen time behind center for Texas this season. Mock has recorded 833 passing yards, while Young leads the Longhorns with 391 rushing yards. Young registered 127 of those against Oklahoma last week. The Longhorn receiving corps is led by all-American Roy Williams. Williams is averaging over 80 receiving yards per game in 2003, including five touchdown catches.

The Iowa State defense looks to recover after facing two red-hot offenses in successive weeks. JaMaine Billups and Brandon Brown will be charged with shutting down Benson and the Texas rushing attack. The secondary was busy last week, as three of the top four tacklers in that game were defensive backs, with Ellis Hobbs and Marc Timmons leading the way with 10 tackles each. Nick Leaders leads the defensive linemen this season with one sack and five quarterback hurries.

The Longhorn defense is also looking to rebound after surrendering 65 points to Oklahoma. Linebacker Reed

Boyd led UT against the Sooners, recording 10 tackles in the game. Defensive back Nathan Vasher and linebacker Derrick Johnson have each recorded three interceptions this season.

Iowa State's special teams continue to provide stellar individual efforts. Placekicker Adam Benike remains perfect in 16 PAT attempts and has missed only one field goal attempt this year. Punter Tony Yelk is averaging 43.0 yards per kick in 2003, and has landed 11 punts inside the opponents 20-yard line. Todd Miller handles punt return duties, while Ellis Hobbs and David Banks-Bursey will return kickoffs for ISU.

The Texas return units are led by Selvin Young. Young has returned a punt and a kickoff for touchdowns this season, and averages over 30 yards per return on kickoffs. Nathan Vasher is the primary punt return man for Texas, averaging over 15 yards per attempt. Dusty Mangum has hit both of his field goal attempts this year, while Richmond McGee averages over 40 yards per punt for the Longhorns.



Lane Danielsen added another memorable performance to his already illustrious career last week against Texas Tech. Danielsen caught eight balls for 192 yards, including an 80-yard touchdown catch from Cris Love in the third quarter.

Iowa State faces a ranked team for the 11th time in the last 21 games, the most difficult stretch in school history. The Cyclones and Longhorns meet for the first time in Ames since 1999. ISU lost to the 12th-ranked Longhorns, 44-41 on a last-second field goal. With a talented young team gaining experience every week, and some injured veterans poised to return to the lineup, Coach McCarney and his Cyclones hope that the total effort needed for an upset can be put together in front of a roaring Jack Trice crowd today.

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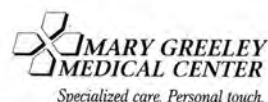

Cy's Favorite Alum



Since 1955, the Iowa State Athletic Department has annually named a graduate, supporter or contributor of Iowa State athletics whose accomplishments and loyalty have earned special distinction the "Cy's Favorite Alum" award. Iowa State would like to honor this year's recipients, Dick and Sandy Horton of Ames.

If you have attended an Iowa State athletic event over the last 40 years, you have probably crossed paths with the Hortons. As enthusiastic fans or diligent gameday volunteers, the Hortons have been fixtures at Iowa State sporting events and have given their valuable time to a number of athletic committees. Both have received national alumni recognition, as well as recognition from Iowa State as outstanding Greek Alumni. The Hortons are members of the National Cyclone Club and the Order of the Knoll.

Dick earned his bachelor's (1962), master's (1963) and doctorate (1967) degrees from Iowa State and has been a member of the faculty for 40 years as a professor of electrical and computer engineering, receiving ISU Faculty Citation in 1989 and the Regents Faculty Excellence Award in 1998.

His services to Iowa State go beyond teaching, however. Dick is on the National Cyclone Club Advisory Board and has been a member of the ISU Athletics Council since 1997, serving as chair the last five years. He was co-chair on the NCAA Division I Certification Committee and has been a part of numerous search committees for coaches, staff and athletics directors. Dick helped select the first video board for Jack Trice Stadium over 20 years ago and has operated the video and facia boards since that time. He has not missed a home football game since 1958. During basketball season, he is even busier, serving on the official statistics crew for ISU men's and women's basketball games since 1996.

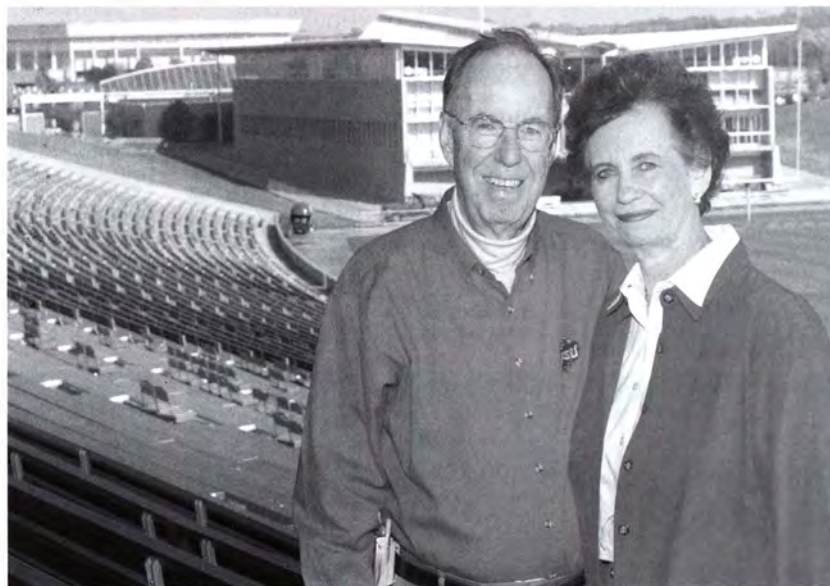
Sandy, a 1962 Iowa State graduate in child development, is a past president of the ISU Family & Consumer Science Alumni Board and a past member of the ISU Alumni Association Board of Directors. She is a member of the Delta Zeta sorority and Dick is a member of the Theta Delta Chi fraternity.

Cyclone Tribute



Pete Taylor
1945-2003

For 33 years, Pete Taylor's radio play-by-play voice defined Iowa State athletics. The highs, the lows, the triumphs, the defeats. Nearly all of us have a story

about where we were and what we were doing as Pete called an unforgettable Cyclone moment. In the fields, in our cars, at home with the TV sound down and his voice turned up, we listened as he called it as he saw it. Taylor died March 5.

Pete's contributions to Iowa State University went far beyond his play-by-play responsibilities. After 22 years as sports director at KCCI-TV in Des Moines, Pete joined the athletic department in 1990. His official title was associate athletics director for external affairs. His real title was mentor, co-worker and friend.

For the last 13 years, he was an anchor of steady influence in the athletic department. An experienced, credible Iowa State ambassador, he never flaunted his popularity and had a smile for all those who crossed his path.

In athletics, the public limelight showcases your achievements and exposes your shortcomings. It is this public experience that binds coaches, staff and student-athletes. Pete thrived in the limelight, but did so without fanfare. The respect he earned was affirmed by how staff, students and fans everywhere returned his loyalty with great affection. From Majors to Bruce, through Duncan and Criner, Walden and McCarney, he was the constant. John, Trickey, Nance, Orr, Floyd and Eustachy all were fortunate to call him friend. We all are better for having known Pete Taylor.

Our memories of how he touched us in so many ways will sustain his unique legacy, and the echoes of his voice will resonate in our hearts for a lifetime.



Ennis Haywood
1979-2003

He was a key pillar in the foundation of Iowa State football. His powerful straight-ahead running style allowed him to carve

out his own mark in the Cyclone tradition. He was twice the first-team all-Big 12 running back. The fifth all-time career rushing leader in Iowa State history with 2,862 yards from 1998-2001, he led the Big 12 in rushing during ISU's 2000 season. For all his on-the-field accomplishments, Ennis Haywood will be remembered, first, for his big smile.

Haywood, who had parlayed his football career into a roster spot with the Dallas Cowboys, died May 11. More than 1,500 people attended his funeral.

Haywood impressed McCarney immediately and the freshman saw action in all 11 games in 1998. But Haywood would have to earn his stripes. His time came in 2000. In the season opener against Ohio, Haywood sent a message, rushing for 159 yards. Haywood and his teammates went on to a 9-3 season that included the school's first-ever bowl victory in the Insight.com Bowl.

Haywood was a good blocker and could catch passes out of the backfield, with 60 career receptions for 548 yards in 2001. Haywood was one-of-eight semifinalists for the Doak Walker Award as the nation's top running back in 2001. He had a 125-yard effort on 20 carries against Alabama in the 2001 Independence Bowl. Iowa State finished the season at 7-5 and played in its second-straight bowl game.

After leaving Iowa State, Haywood signed a free agent contract with the Dallas Cowboys and was the team's leading rusher during the 2002 preseason. It was all coming together for Haywood. Married to wife Kristal, he cherished his time with daughter, Enica, and the couple was expecting its second child just weeks after he passed away. He had wanted to provide in the best way possible for his mother Carol, who drove 12 hours from Dallas to Ames for Iowa State football games.



Dexter Green
1957-2003

It was easy for Cyclone fans to root for Dexter Green. When hearing news of his death after losing a battle with cancer in May at the age of 46, it sent

shockwaves through the Iowa State community.

Known to his teammates and fans as "Money," Green became an icon to many Cyclone fans. In his three seasons as a starter, the Cyclones went 24-11 and appeared in two bowl games, as the shifty back rambled for a then-school record 3,437 career yards. He led the Cyclones in rushing for three-straight seasons. The Woodbridge, Va., earned first-team all-Big Eight honors as a junior (1977) and was a second-team pick, All-American and Heisman Trophy candidate (1978).

The 1977 Cyclones earned a Peach Bowl berth after an 8-3 regular season. Green started to gain national attention as a junior, ending the 1977 season with seven 100-yard rushing efforts, including an ISU bowl record 172 yards in the Peach Bowl.

Despite injuries, Green had an outstanding senior season, rushing for 991 yards and nine touchdowns, helping ISU to its second consecutive bowl game with a Hall of Fame Bowl invitation.

When his playing career ended, he entered the ministry. He later moved to Columbus, Ohio, where he was an assistant football coach at Linden-McKinley High School and a teacher of basic computer skills to underprivileged and undereducated adults and teenagers in the community. He was a minister for the Columbus Church of God and Christ and did motivational speaking for various community service programs.

Green was diagnosed with stomach cancer in 2001, which later spread to his colon. He spent the final two weeks of his life in hospice care, but his illness did not stop his positive viewpoint on life.



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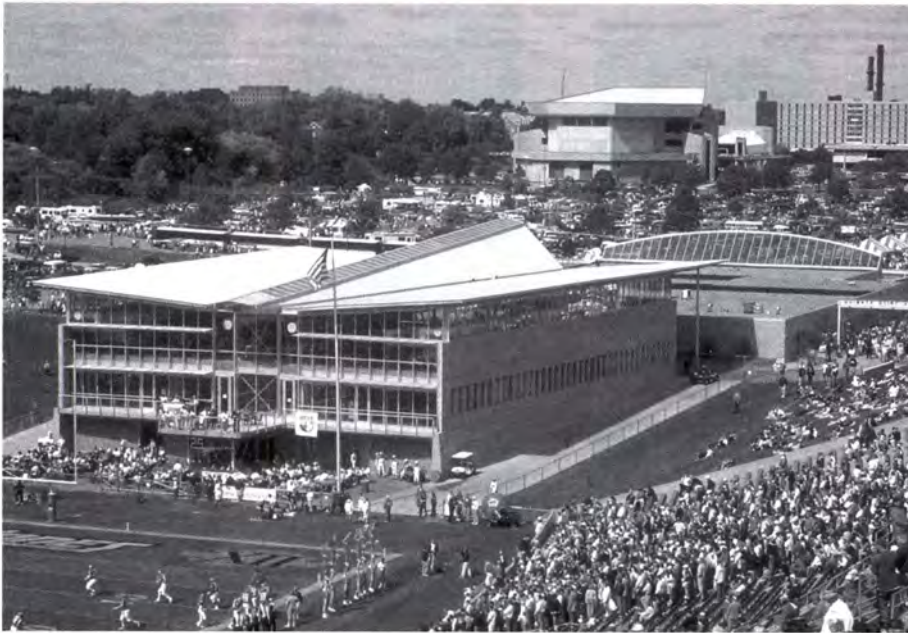
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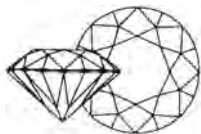


Underscoring Iowa State's commitment to a winning football program is the \$10.6 million Jacobson Athletic Facility (above), which opened to rave reviews in 1996. The Jacobson Athletic Building provides the ISU football program with a state-of-the-art office and training complex. The facility is located on the north end of Jack Trice Stadium.

The new \$10 million Stephen and Debora Bergstrom Indoor Training Facility (below) will open for football practice in November. The 92,000-square-foot building was constructed over the existing artificial turf practice field as a part of the Johnny Majors Practice Complex west of Jack Trice Stadium. Funding for this project was from private gifts by the athletic department and ISU Foundation.

Associate Head Coach/
Tight Ends

Terry Allen, an Iowa City, Iowa, native who was head coach at Northern Iowa and Kansas for 13 seasons before coming to Ames, is in his second year as the Cyclones' associate head coach and tight ends coach.

Allen owned a 95-59 record as head coach at Northern Iowa and Kansas. His UNI teams won seven-straight

conference titles and made the NCAA Division I-AA semifinals in 1992 and 1996.

An all-conference quarterback at Iowa City West, he went on to UNI, where he was a three-year starter at quarterback. Allen spent 22 years at Northern Iowa as a player, assistant coach and head coach.

Allen was named head coach at Northern Iowa in 1989 and guided his first team to an 8-3 record and a national ranking of 20th in the final I-AA poll. The 1979 graduate of Northern Iowa started his string of seven consecutive conference first-place finishes in his second season and also a streak of seven-straight qualifications for the I-AA national playoffs. Allen was named conference coach of the year five times and Region IV Coach of the Year twice. He was also recognized throughout the country when he was selected as a finalist for the national coach of the year in 1996.

Allen and his wife, Lynn, have a daughter Angela and sons Chase and Alex.



Tony Alford
Assistant Head Coach/
Running Backs

Tony Alford's return to the Iowa State coaching staff after a year at Washington solidified ISU's reputation as one of the nation's most successful programs in rushing the football. Alford returned to Ames as assistant head coach in 2002.

Alford earned honorable mention honors at Colorado State on *USA Today's* 1989 All-America team and

was named to the WAC first-team all-conference squad. The 1992 CSU graduate with a bachelor's degree in exercise and sport science set a conference single-game rushing record with 310 rushing yards against Utah and was nominated for the 1989 Doak Walker Award.

Alford went on to play for the NFL's Denver Broncos and the Birmingham Fire of the World League prior to entering the coaching profession.

Alford was the running backs coach at Mt. Union College in 1995 and at Kent in 1996. He helped the Raiders to a 12-1 record and the NCAA Division III semifinals. He has also served as an assistant coach at high schools in Lake Wales, Fla., and Fort Collins, Colo.

Alford and his wife, Trina, reside in Ankeny with their son, Rylan.

Steve Brickey
Offensive Coordinator/
Quarterbacks

In his first three seasons in Ames, Steve Brickey has coached two different NFL quarterbacks to a trio of the finest seasons ever enjoyed by any Iowa State signal caller. That success made him head coach Dan McCarney's first choice to assume duties as the Cyclones' offensive coordinator last season. It was a good move. Brickey tutored Seneca Wallace, one of the nation's best

performers last season and the Cyclones' all-time single season and career record-holder in total offense.

Brickey was the offensive coordinator at North Texas in 1999. He was an assistant coach at Texas from 1987-91, quarterbacks coach at Texas Tech in 1986, quarterbacks coach at Texas Christian from 1993-97 and quarterbacks coach at Indiana State from 1978-85. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Missouri (1976-77).

Brickey was the All-Metro quarterback at Affton High School in suburban St. Louis, Mo., graduating in 1972. He played both quarterback and defensive back at Missouri and received his degree in 1976.

He and his wife, Patti, have three sons: Chris, John and Mike.



John Skladany
Defensive Coordinator/
Linebackers

John Skladany has engineered major defensive reversals of fortune at Iowa State. ISU's performance against the run has improved every season since Skladany's arrival. During Dan McCarney's first season (1995), the Cyclones allowed 296.6 rushing yards per game; the figure stood at 174.6 yards in 2003. Skladany played football at Central Connecticut State, earning a

bachelor's degree in 1972. The Haverhill, Mass., native had NFL free agent tryouts as a defensive lineman with the New England Patriots in 1972 and the Washington Redskins in 1973. He played for the WFL's Birmingham Americans and spent the 1975 exhibition season with the Ottawa Roughriders of the CFL.

Skladany played a key role in turning the Colorado State defense into a unit that led the Western Athletic Conference after serving two seasons as the defensive backs coach at Northern Arizona (1990-92) and one campaign coaching the Lumberjack defensive line. Skladany coached at Ohio University from 1985-89, as secondary coach (1985-87) and then as defensive coordinator (1988-89). He began his coaching career at Ohio as a graduate assistant (1976-77). Skladany owns a master's degree from Ohio. He also coached at Maine (1981-84) and the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy (1980) after a two-year stint at Utica (Ohio) High School.

Skladany and his wife, Sharon, have two daughters, Laura and Stephanie.

Marty Fine joined the Iowa State coaching staff as offensive line coach before the 2002 season. In Fine's first year at ISU, center Zach Butler was a Rimington Award nominee and first-team all-conference selection. Right guard Bob Montgomery earned second-team all-conference honors.

In five years at Indiana, Fine coached offensive tackles and tight ends, served as special teams coordinator and did stints as passing game coordinator while overseeing the running game.

A former linebacker at Union College in New York State, Fine went to Indiana from Colgate, where he spent the 1996 campaign as the offensive line coach. Fine spent six years as the offensive coordinator (1993-95) and offensive line coach (1990-92) at Indiana State. Prior to his six-year stint at Indiana State, Fine was the head coach at U.S. Naval Academy Prep, Sonoma State, linebackers coach at Western New Mexico (1983) and offensive line coach and offensive coordinator at Westchester Community College (1981-82).

A 1985 graduate of Western New Mexico University with a degree in history, Fine and his wife, Betsy, have three children: Sarah, Lydia and Joseph.



Chris Ash
Secondary

Chris Ash, formerly the defensive coordinator at Drake, joined the Iowa State coaching staff in February 2000 and works with the ISU secondary. His efforts helped Iowa State's defenders post its best total defensive numbers in a decade in 2001. In 2002, Ash's defensive backs included strong safety Ja'Maine Billups, who earned all-conference honors after switching from tailback to safety during fall two-a-day football practices.

In Ash's first year as defensive coordinator at Drake, the Bulldogs won the 1998 Pioneer Conference title. Drake ranked eighth nationally in 1999 NCAA Division I-AA total defense in his second Bulldog season as four Drake defenders earned all-conference honors.

A native of Ottumwa, Iowa, Ash lettered twice as a safety at Drake. The 29-year-old Ash earned a bachelor's degree in secondary education from Drake in 1996. After working one year as a graduate assistant with the Drake secondary, he moved on to Princeton in the spring of 1997, where he worked with the Tiger secondary.

Ash and his wife, Jessica, live in Ames with their son, Tanner, and daughter, Jacey.

DeMontie Cross Outside Linebackers

DeMontie Cross, the all-time leading tackler in Missouri history, has made an immediate impact on Iowa State's defense after joining the Cyclone coaching staff in March 2001. Cross' linebackers contributed to Iowa State's best total defensive effort since 1992, as the Cyclones ranked 34th nationally in 2001.

Cross spent the 2000 season coaching a defensive backfield at Sam Houston State that ranked second

nationally. Cross' Sam Houston State pass defense ranked second among 122 NCAA Division I-AA teams in 2000, allowing just 121 passing yards per game. Cross coached outside linebackers at Missouri in 1998 and 1999.

As a player at Missouri, Cross was team captain in 1996 and was named the team's defensive player of the year that season. He was selected to play in the 1996 Blue-Grey All-Star Game.

A 1997 Missouri graduate with a bachelor's degree in business management, Cross made 415 career stops at free safety for the Tigers from 1994-96. Cross led Missouri in tackles as a junior and senior. He received second-team all-conference honors from the Big Eight in 1995 and the Big 12 in 1996. Cross, who played prep football at Hazelwood East High School in St. Louis, Mo., received the Athletic Director's Leadership Award in 1996.

He lives in Ames with his wife, Erika, and daughter, Jadyen.



Mike Grant Wide Receivers

Mike Grant made a profound impact as running backs coach in 2001 and turned his efforts to the ISU wide receivers last season. Under Grant, wide receivers Lane Danielsen, Jack Whitver, Lance Young and Jamaul Montgomery have developed into a corps of pass catchers that may be the best in Iowa State history. Danielsen set an ISU single-season record with 1,073 receiving yards last season. Young ranked 10th on the single-season list with 681 receiving yards in 2002.

Grant joined the Iowa State staff as assistant secondary coach before 1998 spring practice. Grant, who lettered at quarterback on three Nebraska bowl teams, came to ISU from James Madison University, where he coached tight ends and wide receivers.

Grant was an academic all-Big Eight quarterback on Nebraska teams that earned three Orange Bowl berths, in addition to Fiesta and Citrus Bowl appearances, during his playing career. The native of Tampa, Fla., earned a pair of bachelor's degrees from Nebraska. Grant was a graduate assistant coach working with the Husker tight ends and wide receivers from 1994-96. This experience included being a part of two Nebraska national championship teams. Grant assisted the Nebraska recruiting coordinator in 1993.

Grant, his wife, Nina, and daughter, Mireia, reside in Ames.

Matt McGettigan Strength & Conditioning

The work of strength and conditioning coach Matt McGettigan received the ultimate affirmation when he earned recognition as the 2001 National Collegiate Strength and Conditioning Coach of the Year by the Professional Football Strength and Conditioning Coaches Society.

The stature of Iowa State's football program has literally grown by leaps and bounds since Dan McCarney came to Ames. Most of the credit for those improvements must go to Cyclone strength coach Matt McGettigan. McGettigan came to Iowa State with head coach Dan McCarney after serving as assistant strength and conditioning coach at Notre Dame since 1990.

Prior to his work with the Fighting Irish, McGettigan served as the strength and conditioning coordinator for the University of Wisconsin-Platteville from 1987-90. McGettigan earned his master's degree in 1989.

McGettigan completed his undergraduate work in physical education at Luther College in Decorah, Iowa, in 1987, where he was a member of the football team. He is a member of the National Strength and Conditioning Association. In January 1989, McGettigan received his certification as a Strength and Conditioning Specialist.

A native of Darlington, Wis., McGettigan is married to the former Darla Hook of Charles City, Iowa. They have a daughter, Mariah, and a son, Colin.



Mike Nelson Defensive Line

Mike Nelson's impact on the Iowa State defense was immediate and has remained constant. In 1997, his first season at ISU, Nelson's defensive line racked up 21 sacks, the highest Cyclone single-season total in 10 years.

Nelson has served as defensive line coach at Missouri (1985-86) and Kansas State (1989). He also spent three seasons coaching linebackers and the defensive line for Edmonton of the Canadian Football League. Nelson began coaching at Southern Illinois before spending one season in the Ohio high school ranks. He worked as defensive coordinator at Norfolk State (1972) before returning to, Dayton, in 1973. He then moved to Virginia (1975-76) as the secondary coach and Ball State, where he was outside linebackers coach. Nelson spent five seasons as outside linebackers coach at Wisconsin.

Nelson jumped to the CFL for three seasons before moving to Missouri and then San Diego State, where he coached inside linebackers and the defensive line. He was the defensive line coach at Rutgers (1993-95) for three seasons before going to Oregon State.

Nelson earned his bachelor's degree from Dayton in 1969. He was a four-year letterwinner for the Flyer football squad and also lettered in hockey. He earned his master's degree at Southern Illinois in 1970.

Nelson and his wife, Betsy, have three sons: Kurt, Eric and Mark.

Director of Operations

Don Knock, a member of the Iowa Football Coaches Hall of Fame, returned to Iowa State in 2002 as director of football operations after a year at Nebraska-Omaha. Knock coached Cedar Rapids Kennedy to six state playoff berths at the Cougar helm and coached Grundy Center to the 1984 Iowa Class 2A state high school title.

Knock played on Central's 1974 NCAA Division III national title squad and was a captain of the 1975 Central squad. He earned a bachelor's degree in 1976. Knock signed a free agent contract with the Oakland Raiders after graduation and joined the Central College coaching staff later that fall.

Knock began coaching at Rockwell-Swaledale in 1977, where he taught and was head football coach for three years. Knock then spent one academic year at South Dakota, where he was a graduate assistant while earning a master's degree.

Knock moved to Grundy Center in 1981, where his teams compiled a 48-11 record and twice qualified for the state playoffs under Iowa's old eight-team bracket formula. He moved on to Cedar Rapids Kennedy in 1987, where his teams were 66-61.

Knock and his wife Cindy have four children; Kyle, a former tight end for ISU; Scot, a student administrative assistant to the ISU football staff; Beau, a senior at Ames High School and Jordan, a third-grader at Sawyer Elementary School in Ames.

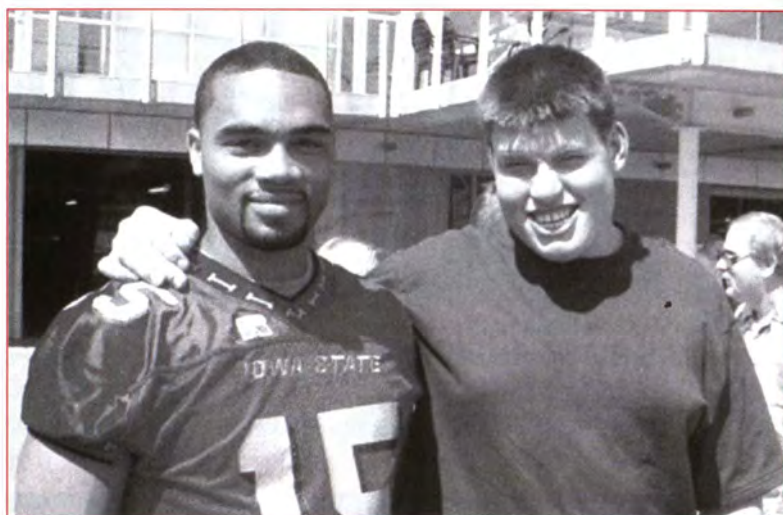
Brian Woods

ISU Football Gameday Information

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium video cameras, bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team and removal from the stadium.

Coolers & Chairs

As a courtesy to neighboring guests, spectators are asked NOT to bring stadium chairs, lawnchairs or coolers into the stands. Back chairs made for Jack Trice Stadium seats are accepted.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will have hand marked for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-entry. No pass outs will be allowed before kickoff.

Public Telephones

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands along the concourse walkway.

Field Access

The athletic department asks that all fans refrain from going on the playing field at any time. Any person(s) entering the playing field will be subject to arrest and prosecution.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Assistant Athletic Director Frank Randall (Jacobson Building) before noon on the day prior to the game. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Restrooms

Restrooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Smoking Policy

In accordance with Iowa State's smoking policy, there will be no smoking in areas where the general public congregates at Jack Trice Stadium. There is no smoking allowed in the seating areas or by the concession stands, but some designated smoking areas are located near restrooms.

Distractions

We want to make football a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage fans to be respectful of those around them in the stadium. In the event there is an unreasonable distraction, please take the following steps to help control the undesirable behavior:

- Note the seating section, row and seat numbers and inform the usher in the section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and take appropriate action.

- If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvements of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.

- An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation.

Courtesy Carts

Iowa State offers courtesy cart service from Gates 1, 3 and 5 beginning one and one-half hour before kick-off until 10 minutes into the first quarter and resuming midway through the fourth quarter. Anyone needing transportation during the game should go to the NE entrance of the Club Section (east side) or the main entrance of the Concourse Suites (west side) for assistance.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in all sections are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts. Please notify the ticket office prior to game day to obtain tickets.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked in the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact an usher to request medical assistance.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located throughout the stadium parking areas.

Parking

Lots open six hours before kickoff. Overnight parking is available. Contact Frank Randall. RV parking is available. See map for location. Parking prices are as follows: automobiles (\$7), R.V.s (\$25), buses (\$30).

National Cyclone Club Parking

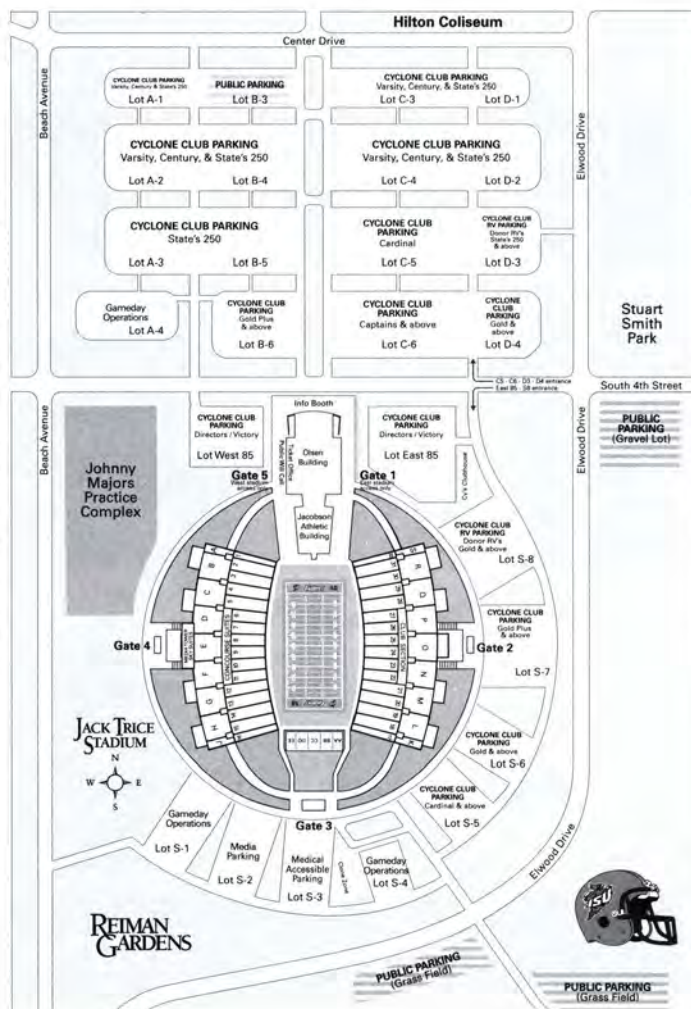

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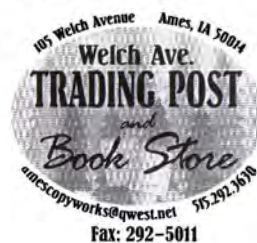
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President Gregory L. Geoffroy



Gregory L. Geoffroy became president of Iowa State University on July 1, 2001. He also holds the rank of professor of chemistry.

Dr. Geoffroy began his academic career as an assistant professor of chemistry at the Pennsylvania State University in 1974, advancing to associate professor in 1978

and professor in 1982. He was appointed head of the Department of Chemistry in 1988 and dean of the Eberly College of Science at Penn State in 1989.

In 1997, Dr. Geoffroy was appointed senior vice president for academic affairs and provost at the University of Maryland, College Park where he was responsible for the academic development of the campus. He administered the university's strategic planning and budgeting processes, and in July and August of 1998 he served as interim president of the university.

Iowa State University's aspiration is to become the best university in the nation in fulfilling its land-grant responsibilities, through excellence in learning, discovery and engagement. In leading Iowa State on this quest, Dr. Geoffroy has outlined three top priorities:

- pursuing academic excellence by having more of the university's programs recognized as among the best in the nation;
- providing the best possible education to Iowa State's students, through outstanding academic programs and learning environment; and
- becoming a fully "engaged" university with the people of Iowa, through expanded distance education, economic development and community development initiatives.

To these ends, Dr. Geoffroy has made recruitment and retention of top faculty, staff and students a major focus, and he led a two-year private fund-raising initiative called "Investing in People" that created several new endowments for faculty positions, graduate assistantships and student scholarships.

Only the second of Iowa State's 14 presidents to come from a chemistry background, Dr. Geoffroy is a nationally acclaimed researcher in organometallic chemistry. He has published more than 200 research articles in referenced journals; presented more than 200 invited lectures in the United States and nine other nations; is co-author of the book *Organometallic Photochemistry* and has directed the work of 37 Ph.D. students and 15 post-doctoral scholars. He also has made special efforts to involve undergraduate students in research by providing opportunities for more than 50 undergraduate students to join his research group.

Dr. Geoffroy's teaching and research have earned him fellowships from the Alfred P. Sloan and John Simon Guggenheim Foundations, visiting professorships to major universities in Germany and France, the Dreyfus Foundation Teacher-Scholar Award, and, in 1991, election as a Fellow in the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He has served in various leadership capacities in the Association for Universities for Research in Astronomy and in the American Chemical Society's Division of Inorganic Chemistry. In 1997 he was named an Alumni Fellow of the University of Louisville.

Dr. Geoffroy earned the B.S. With Honors from the University of Louisville in 1968. He served as an officer in the U.S. Navy from 1969 to 1970 and then earned his Ph.D. in chemistry in 1974 from the California Institute of Technology. He and his wife, Kathleen Carothers Geoffroy, have four children.



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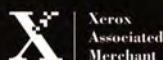

2003-04 Cyclone Basketball Preview

Cyclone Tip-Off

The 2003-04 Iowa State men's and women's basketball teams will be on display for ISU fans following today's football game. The teams will debut in the annual Cyclone Tip-Off in Hilton Coliseum.

This year's Tip-Off will feature a few traditional activities, along with some new twists, including the interactive Fanfest in the Hilton Coliseum outer concourse. In addition to the Fanfest, players will be available for autographs, and will participate in 3-point contests, slam dunk competition and team scrimmages. The ISU spirit squad and pep band will also be present throughout the festivities.

Doors open to the event at 2:30 p.m., with formal ceremonies to commence about 30 minutes after the conclusion of the Iowa State-Texas football contest. Tickets are \$5, and can be purchased at Hilton Coliseum entrances.

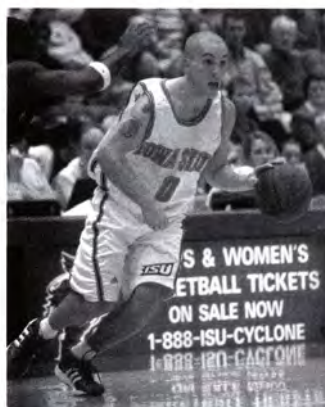
Men's Basketball

The Iowa State men's basketball team enters the first year of the Wayne Morgan era in 2003-04. Morgan, who takes over the reins at ISU after one year as an assistant coach with the Cyclones, returns a stable of experienced players to join a highly regarded recruiting class.

Iowa State will be led by senior Jake Sullivan, one of the best pure shooters ever to have worn an Iowa State uniform. Sullivan, from Oakdale, Minn., is currently the second-ranked three-point shooter in Big 12 history, shooting at a 44.4% clip. Sullivan was the leading scorer for the Cyclones a year ago, pouring in 17.0 points per game.

Veterans Marcus Jefferson, Jackson Vroman and Jared Homan return for the Cyclones. Jefferson, an athletic swing man, averaged 8.4 points per contest last year. Vroman is Iowa State's top returning post player, having ranked in the top-seven in four Big 12 statistical categories, including rebounding, field goal percentage, double-doubles and blocks. Homan, a physical defender, recorded the third-best block shot total in school history.

Morgan's first recruiting class has gained national recognition and will excite Cyclone hoop fans this season. Will Blalock, a 5-11 guard from Boston, Mass., and Curtis Stinson, from Bronx, N.Y., will provide athletic depth at the

guard slots. Damion Staple, from Kingston, Jamaica, will back-up Vroman and Homan on the blocks. The 6-8, 230-pound power forward averaged 15.3 points per game last season at Southeastern Illinois Community College while earning All-American honors. Reggie George, a 6-9 center, will also see time at the post positions for the Cyclones this season.

Women's Basketball

Iowa State women's basketball head coach Bill Fennelly reloaded his roster, bringing in a group of six newcomers for the 2003-04 season. This group must make immediate contributions in order to replace the loss of four letterwinners, including starters Lindsey Wilson and Mary Cofield. Wilson, a three-time all-conference performer, led the Big 12 Conference in scoring (20.8 ppg) in league games, while Cofield averaged 7.4 points and 25.7 minutes per game last season.

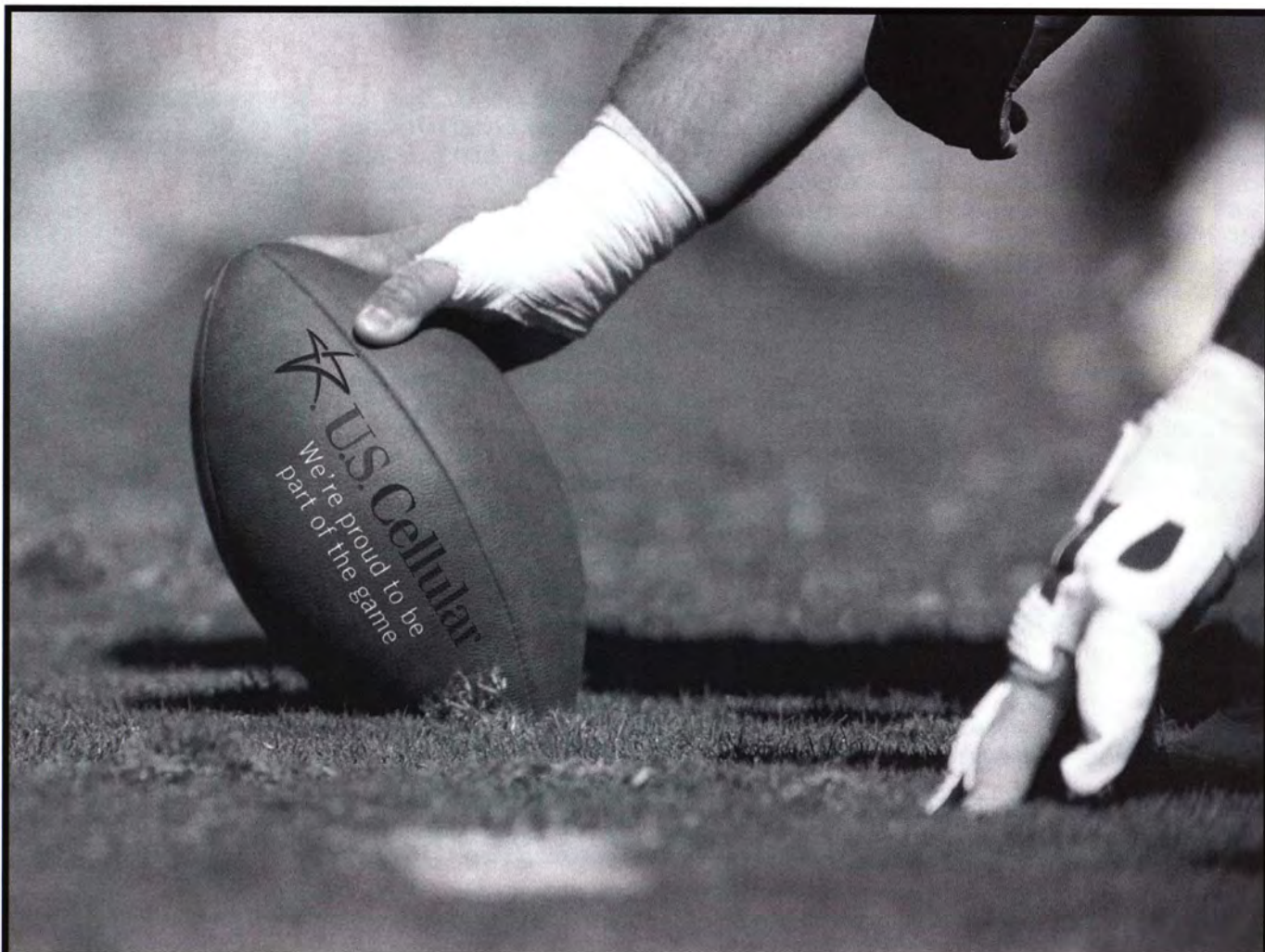
Erica Junod, the Cyclones' only senior, is joined by a seasoned crop of juniors that were battle-tested last season. Iowa State's potent 3-point attack returns with Junod and juniors Anne O'Neil and Tracy Paustian providing experience in the backcourt. True freshmen Lyndsey Medders, Megan Ebel, Megan Ronhovde and Abby Reinert add to ISU's offensive arsenal.

Junior Lisa Kriener and sophomore Brittany Wilkins return inside, a duo that combined to average 13.7 points and 8.3 rebounds per contest last year. Iowa State's inside game is beefed up with the addition of 6-3 freshman Jane Horkey and 6-2 transfer Katie Robinette, who will join the squad at semester's end. Sophomore walk-on Kandice Beenken adds depth for the Cyclones.

Iowa State will be tested immediately in nonconference action with a trip to the Virgin Islands for the Paradise Jam with opponents Virginia Tech, Mississippi State and Indiana. Other nonconference foes include Washington, Wisconsin and instate rivals Iowa, Drake and Northern Iowa. The Big 12 remains one of the nation's toughest conferences. League foes Texas Tech, Oklahoma, Colorado, Kansas State, Missouri, Baylor, Nebraska and Kansas will all make trips to Hilton Coliseum.

IOWA STATE CYCLONES



Athletics Director Bruce Van De Velde



Bruce Van De Velde's progressive leadership has spanned three years of unprecedented athletic achievement at Iowa State University. His vision for the future of Cyclone athletics is affirmed by the success of Iowa State student-athletes in collegiate competition, the classroom and by the continued expansion of Iowa State's state-of-the-art facilities.

"Iowa State University's Athletic Department is making great strides under Bruce's leadership," ISU President Gregory L. Geoffroy said. "We're very proud of the

accomplishments of our Cyclone student-athletes, coaches and staff, and Bruce and his staff work very hard to create an environment that supports and encourages high achievement in athletics and academic work."

Van De Velde's tenure at Iowa State already includes an unprecedented three-straight bowl appearances and the highest national AP football poll ranking (ninth) in school history. Total attendance for 2002 home football games exceeded 300,000, the highest ISU watermark since 1985. The emergence of the Cyclone football program on a national level with Van De Velde at the department helm was affirmed in 2002, when Iowa State was chosen to play Florida State in the Eddie Robinson Classic. The game marked the Cyclones' first ever preseason classic appearance in school history. The ISU men's and women's basketball teams made NCAA Tournament appearances in his first year in Ames and were crowned Big 12 champions in 2001.

Recent success under Van De Velde's leadership has positioned ISU for future achievement. During Van De Velde's tenure at Iowa State the men's and women's basketball teams have won Big 12 Championships. The ISU football, gymnastics, wrestling, women's track and women's and men's basketball teams have been nationally ranked.

Iowa State was recognized by the NCAA in 2002, receiving full certification for operating its athletic program in compliance with the operating principles of fiscal, academic, diversity/equity and rule/governance.

Van De Velde has focused on generating new revenue for an increasing operating budget and has balanced Iowa State's annual operating budget in each of the last four fiscal years. Iowa State's actual operations budget increased 28 percent, from \$19.6 million in fiscal year 2000 to \$27.1 million in fiscal year 2003. Revenue generated from the Big 12 Conference in fiscal 2003 reached an all-time high of \$5.9 million.

Cyclone athletic success is not limited to the playing field: Iowa State student-athletes graduate.

Iowa State's graduation rate of 90 percent for student-athletes that complete their eligibility leads the Big 12 Conference. During Van De Velde's tenure, 38 Cyclone student-athletes have been honored as Academic All-Americans and 290 student-athletes have been recognized as academic all-Big 12 performers.

Van De Velde's 21st century vision for the future of Iowa State athletics can be seen in the continued funding and construction of first-class facilities to support ISU's 18-sport program. The \$10 million Stephen and Deborah Bergstrom Indoor Multi-Purpose Facility will open in late November. Van De Velde crafted a partnership with Musco Lighting of Oskaloosa to install permanent lighting in Jack Trice

Stadium and in the Cyclone Soccer Complex in 2002. A state-of-the-art video board, new scoreboard and expanded seating and parking lots made their debut with the 2002 season and dramatically enhanced the gameday atmosphere at Jack Trice Stadium. The men's and women's basketball lockerrooms and offices in Hilton Coliseum have been remodeled. Improvements have been made to the basketball and volleyball practice facility. New permanent seating and equipment for the ISU softball complex were ready for the 2003 season. Van De Velde also oversaw the addition for a short range golf practice facility at Veenker Golf Course.

Annual giving by the record 5,100 members of the National Cyclone Club reached \$3.5 million in 2002. Including major gifts and scholarship endowments, \$14 million has been raised for ISU student-athletes during Van De Velde's short tenure. Fundraising has been completed for the \$10 million Stephen and Deborah Bergstrom Indoor Athletic Training Facility.

Van De Velde negotiated a \$7.2 million, five-year multimedia marketing rights contract with ESPN/Clear Channel Sports. The contract strengthened the Cyclone Radio Network including the addition of 100,000-watt radio station WMT-FM in Cedar Rapids in Eastern Iowa for football and KMA-AM in Shenandoah in Southwest Iowa. The Cyclones opened the 2002 college football season on national television in the Eddie Robinson Classic against Florida State from Kansas City, Mo., in ISU's first-ever preseason football game. Over 30,000 Cyclone fans have traveled to bowl games with the Iowa State football team over the last three years.

Iowa State's 2002 football attendance reached its highest watermark in 18 years and 2003 football ticket sales are on pace to be the best at ISU in two decades. The catalysts for season-ticket growth were winning football and marketing initiatives, including group sales efforts and Cyclone Business Partners, which brought more than 80 new businesses into the ISU fold. The Iowa State football team appeared on television 10 times in 2002. Men's and women's basketball attendance ranked Iowa State among the top 25 programs nationally. The combined average of men's and women's basketball ranked Iowa State seventh nationally among more than 320 NCAA Division I institutions.

Recognizing that program continuity and leadership have been major contributors to Iowa State's competitive success, Van De Velde renegotiated the contracts of football coach Dan McCarney and head women's basketball coach Bill Fennelly. Van De Velde hired men's basketball coach Wayne Morgan and head women's soccer coach Rebecca Hornbacher.

Van De Velde currently serves on the NCAA Championships and Competition Cabinet and the NCAA Football Issues committee. He has served on the NCAA Division I-A Athletics Directors Strategic Planning Committee, the NCAA Committee for Financial Aid and on peer review teams for NCAA certification. He currently serves on the Big 12 Conference Finance, Game Management and Officiating and Bowl Game Committees.

Van De Velde's last stop before returning home to Ames was at the University of Oklahoma, where he served as senior associate director during the Sooners' 2000 national football championship run. Van De Velde directed the Campaign for Sooner Sports, a \$100 million capital campaign to fund facility improvements and scholarship endowments. Van De Velde has also held senior administrative positions at the University of Missouri, Kansas State and Utah State Universities.

Van De Velde, a Sterling, Ill., native and his wife, Debbie, have a daughter, Ashley, born May 12, 2000. Debbie is a graduate of Kansas State University. An Iowa State graduate, Van De Velde earned a master's degree from the University of Iowa and has completed course work toward a doctorate in education from Kansas State.

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Head Coach Dan McCarney



When 2001 Big 12 Coach of the Year Dan McCarney laid out his vision for the future of Iowa State football at a press conference to announce his arrival in Ames nine years ago, he stressed that the program's transformation would not occur overnight. McCarney possessed enthusiasm, unwavering optimism and a seemingly endless source of energy. His

background in college football programs that had gone from perennial losers to consistent winners made him a perfect choice for the Cyclone helm. There were more than a few skeptics. Iowa State was coming off a winless season, hadn't had a winning campaign since 1989 and the Cyclones' last bowl trip was in 1978.

Last fall McCarney took Iowa State where it had never been before; a third-straight bowl game, despite playing the toughest schedule in school history. ISU owns a 23-15 record since the start of the 2000 season. Underscoring its new national status, the Cyclones opened the season in the Eddie Robinson Football Classic against Florida State. The 2002 campaign was one to remember. The Cyclones beat intrastate rival Iowa for the fifth-straight season and third-straight time in Iowa City. Iowa State's 36-14 win over Nebraska was the Cyclones' biggest margin of victory in the series since 1899. ISU's No. 9 position on The Associated Press poll in October was the highest in school history. The Cyclones' eight-week tenure in the AP top 25 equaled ISU's longest stay in school history. They said it couldn't be done at Iowa State. The naysayers didn't know Dan McCarney.

Powered by a singular sense of purpose, McCarney steadily molded Iowa State's football program, bringing in a top-notch coaching staff and the best recruiting classes in recent memory. Backed by a university administration committed to providing state-of-the-art facilities, McCarney relentlessly exorcised the demons that had plagued Cyclone football. After his first teams laid a foundation for success, the 2000 Iowa State unit, led by 25 seniors who had bought into McCarney's vision, remained undeterred by the skeptics. Following McCarney's blueprint, coaches and

players went where no Cyclone team had gone; winning nine games, including a 37-29 victory over Pittsburgh in the Insight.com Bowl. Under McCarney, the 2000 AP Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year runner-up, that success continued in 2001, despite the loss of 15 starters. A 7-5 Iowa State earned an Independence Bowl berth, marking the school's first back-to-back bowl appearances since the 1977-78 seasons.

Anyone who has watched McCarney's rise in the coaching ranks would not be surprised by the effort of his national-caliber coaching staff. A native of Iowa City, Iowa, McCarney was instrumental in rebuilding efforts that produced Big Ten titles and Rose Bowl berths at both Iowa and Wisconsin, two schools that regularly finished near the bottom of the league before his arrival.

McCarney, 50, coached at Iowa for 13 seasons (1977-89), including 11 years under Hayden Fry, before becoming the defensive coordinator at Wisconsin under Barry Alvarez in 1990.

McCarney's defense was the foundation of the Wisconsin rebuilding effort. In the four seasons prior to his arrival in Wisconsin the Badgers had a 9-36 record, and attendance was at its lowest mark since World War II.

In 1993, Wisconsin went 10-1-1, claimed its first Big Ten title in 31 years and scored a 21-16 win over UCLA in the Rose Bowl. Attendance at Wisconsin's Camp Randall Stadium climbed more than 30,000 a game, and sellouts of more than 77,000 were the norm.

During Wisconsin's Rose Bowl season, the Badgers ranked 19th nationally against the rush, allowing just 130.3 yards per game, the sixth-best mark in school history. The team allowed an average of 16.3 points per game, its best effort in 30 years. The Badger defense also intercepted an NCAA-best 23 passes and created 34 turnovers, including six against UCLA in the Rose Bowl.

A 1975 graduate of Iowa, McCarney coached the Hawkeyes in eight consecutive bowl games, including the 1982 and 1986 Rose Bowls. The three-year letterman on the offensive line for Iowa (1972-74) was captain of the 1974 Hawkeye squad. A member of the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) for 25 years, McCarney is a past member of the AFCA's rules committee. McCarney and wife, Margy, reside in Ames with daughters, Jillian and Melanie, and son, Shane.



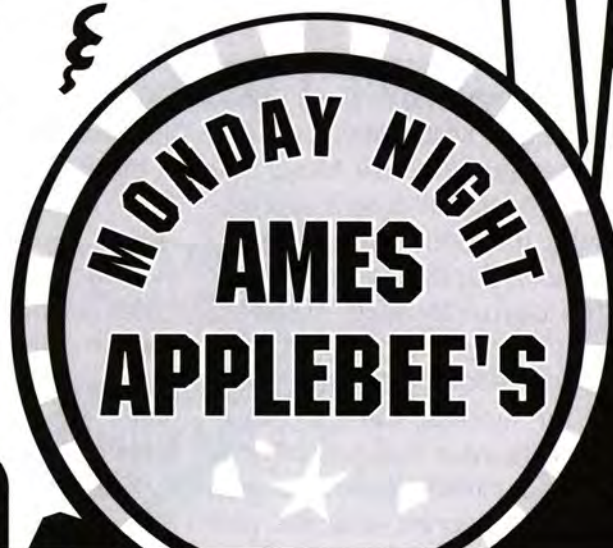

Gameday Scouting Report

The Series: Texas leads the all-time series, 4-0. Today's game is only the second time that the teams have met in Jack Trice Stadium, with Texas winning the first one on a last-second field goal in 1999, 44-41. The Longhorns beat ISU in Austin a year ago, 21-10.

Offensively: Iowa State's Lane Danielsen will lead the passing game against the Longhorn defense. Danielsen, ISU's all-time leading receiver, had 55 yards against Texas a year ago. Texas has been more vulnerable to a good rushing attack this season, giving up nearly 190 yards per game on the ground. Michael Wagner, Iowa State's leading rusher, and highly touted redshirt freshman Stevie Hicks will look to establish a strong ground game for the Cyclones. Cris Love and freshman Austin Flynn have each seen time at quarterback for ISU. Flynn is a more mobile, athletic quarterback, while Love is a more traditional pocket passer.

Texas averages nearly 200 yards per game on the ground, mostly behind running back Cedric Benson. Benson burned ISU for 199 yards a year ago, but has averaged only about 60 yards per game this season. Chance Mock and Vince Young are quarterbacks who can move the ball with their legs as well as through the air. Roy Williams, a tall, athletic receiver, will present a challenge to ISU's defensive secondary.

Defensively: JaMaine Billups and Brandon Brown, ISU's leading tacklers in 2003, patrol the middle of the field for the Cyclones. Each recorded 10 tackles

against Texas last year, with Billups adding an interception. Nick Leaders, Jason Berryman, Jordan Carstens and Cephus Johnson will look to pressure the young quarterbacks for the Longhorns. Containing Benson and shutting down Williams will be the keys to the Iowa State defensive effort.

Texas has given up 341.2 yards per game defensively, surrendering 189 yards per game on the ground. Derrick Johnson will be charged with holding down the ISU passing game, he had eight tackles against Iowa State a year ago. The Longhorn defense has a number of highly talented players, including lineman Marcus Tubbs and defensive back Nathan Vashar.

Special Teams: Iowa State's special teams units have been solid throughout the season. Adam Benike is 5-of-6 in field goal attempts this year, and had a 40-yarder against Texas last year. Tony Yelk averages 43 yards per punt for ISU.

The Longhorns have a dangerous return man in Selvin Young, who has two touchdowns as a kick returner. Nathan Vashar averages 15 yards per punt return for Texas.

Coaches: Dan McCarney is searching for his first win against the University of Texas in his fourth try. Mack Brown has been involved in all four ISU-Texas battles. Brown has won three as the head coach at Texas, and was an assistant at Iowa State in the first clash between the schools, a Longhorn win in 1979.

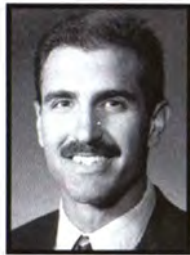

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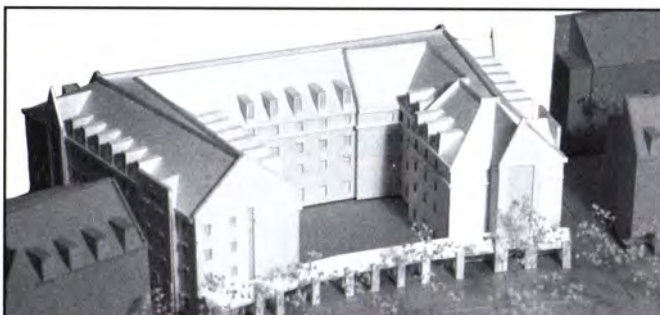


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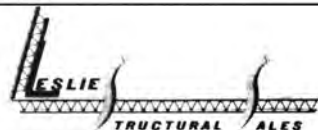

Tutorial Services

Lowell and Geraldine Mattox Memorial Athletic Scholarship

(Established by Geraldine Mattox)

Established in 1979, the Lowell and Geraldine Mattox Memorial Athletic Scholarship is awarded annually to a member of the football, basketball or wrestling teams, Lowell Mattox's three favorite sports.

Richard S. Grant Endowed Scholarship

(Established by Richard Grant)

The Richard S. Grant Scholarship Fund is awarded to a student-athlete who is an undergraduate in the College of Engineering. First awarded in 1990, the scholarship is available to members of the football, men's basketball, wrestling or track teams.

Engel Football Scholarship Endowment

(Established by Raymond and Kathryn Engel)

Established in 1991, the Engel Football Scholarship Endowment is awarded to a member of the football team annually. The late Raymond (B.S. '29) and Kathryn Engel are longtime supporters of ISU athletics.

Jordan L. Larson Jr. Endowed Quarterback Scholarship

(Established by Jordan Jr. and Colleen Larson)

Started in 1992, the Jordan L. Larson Jr. Quarterback Endowed Scholarship is awarded annually to the starting quarterback by Colleen & the late Jordan (B.S. '47) L. Larson Jr.

William Vinson Bibb Endowed Scholarship

(Established by Vincent Beacom)

Established in 1993, the award is given annually to an African-American student-athlete who plays football and is majoring in engineering. This award is established to honor William Vinson Bibb, who befriended 1950 Iowa State football captain Vincent Beacom.

Mike Michalske Endowed Football Scholarships

(Established by Lawrence and Mary Tollenaere)

Started in 2000, the Mike Michalske Football Scholarships are awarded annually to one offensive player and one defensive player. The scholarships are named in honor of "Iron" Mike Michalske, Lawrence Tollenaere's (B.S. '44) football coach at ISU.

Barney Simmons Memorial Scholarship

(Established by Patricia Simmons, Zeidlers and the Northeast Iowa Cyclone Club)

Established in 2001 in memory of Barney Simmons, a 1950 alum and longtime Cyclone supporter. The scholarship benefits the football and men's basketball teams, which were Barney's two favorite sports.

Ed and Ruth Bock Endowed Athletic Scholarship

(Established by Edward and Ruth Bock)

Established in 2002, this scholarship is awarded annually to a student-athlete majoring in engineering or family and consumer sciences. Ed, who is member of the College Football Hall of Fame, was Iowa State's first consensus football All-American in 1938.

Al and Sara Sorensen Football Scholarship Fund

(Established by Al and Sara Sorensen)

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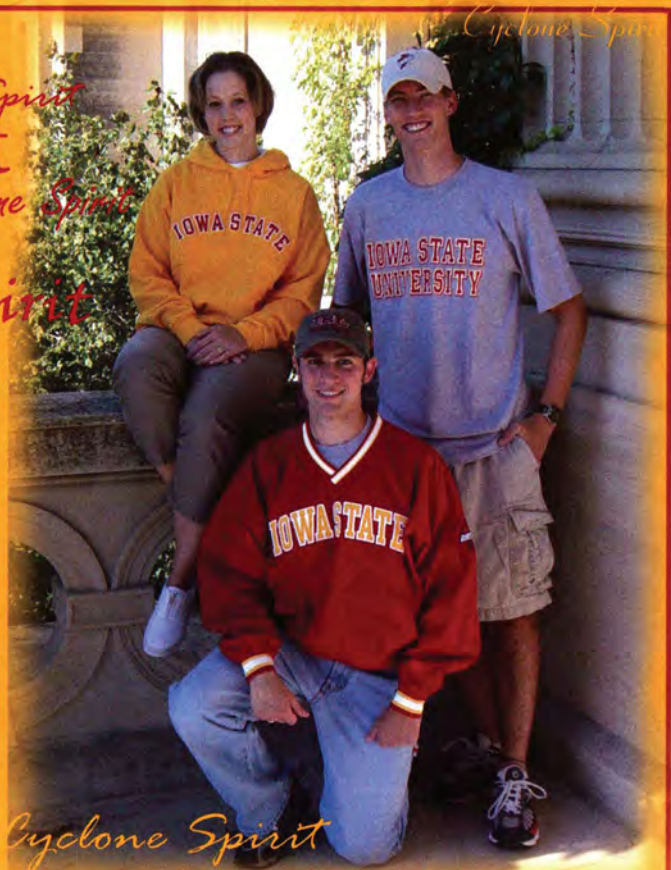

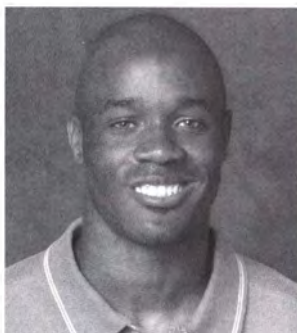
