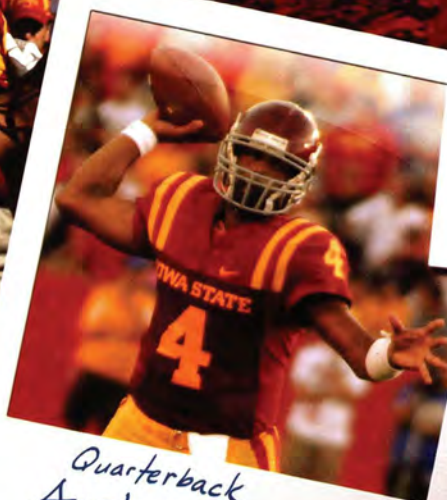

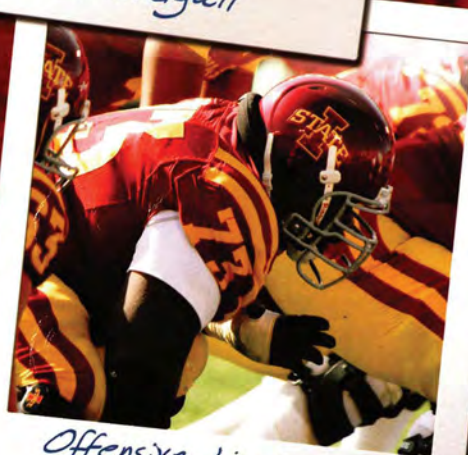

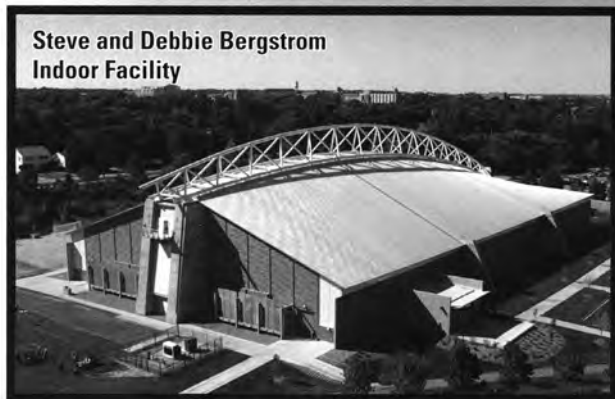

JACK TRICE STADIUM

Without a doubt, the 55,000-seat Jack Trice Stadium is one of the most beautiful football venues nationally. Jack Trice Stadium, which offers an unobstructed view of the playing field as well as remarkably easy access and plentiful parking, was completed in less than two years, from the ground breaking on Oct. 26, 1973, to the first game, a victory over Air Force, on Sept. 20, 1975. A record 55,518 fans watched the Iowa State-UNI game Sept. 30, 2006.

The special football atmosphere at Jack Trice Stadium has been enhanced with a number of additions throughout the years. A natural grass playing field was added in 1996 and a \$6.2 million three-level press tower was introduced in 1997. In 2002, a state-of-the-art video/scoreboard, permanent lighting and additional seating in the south endzone improved its gameday experience.

Another makeover occurred in 2008, as the stadium went through its \$19.5 million first-phase remodeling project. The overhaul included the renovation/construction of suites and the addition of restroom and concession buildings on the west concourse. The club section on the east side of the stadium was also entirely renovated. Renovation included the addition of a brand new 100 percent bluegrass sod playing surface.

In 2009, the second phase of the Jack Trice Stadium renovation began. The \$11.5 million project includes the addition of restrooms,

concessions stands and merchandise posts as well as widening the concourse to double its previous width on the east side of the stadium. The latest phase also includes the creation of the Jacobson Plaza, which is a large patio/entertainment space at mid-field on the stadium's east side exterior, and replacing the exterior fencing with a decorative iron fence.

STEVE AND DEBBIE BERGSTROM INDOOR FACILITY

The \$9.6 million Steve and Debbie Bergstrom Indoor Training Facility opened for football practice in March 2004. The 92,000-square-foot building was constructed over the existing turf practice field as a part of the Johnny Majors Practice Complex west of Jack Trice Stadium. Funding for this project was from private gifts to the athletics department and the ISU Foundation.

JACOBSON BUILDING/OLSEN BUILDING

The stadium complex was transformed in 1995-96 with the construction of the state-of-the-art Richard O. Jacobson Athletic Building, which was significantly remodeled in 2008. The home of Iowa State's football program includes football offices, team meeting rooms, locker rooms and auditorium. The renovated Ralph A. Olsen Building is adjacent to the north end of the Jacobson Athletic Building. The Olsen Building houses the strength, equipment and athletic training facilities.

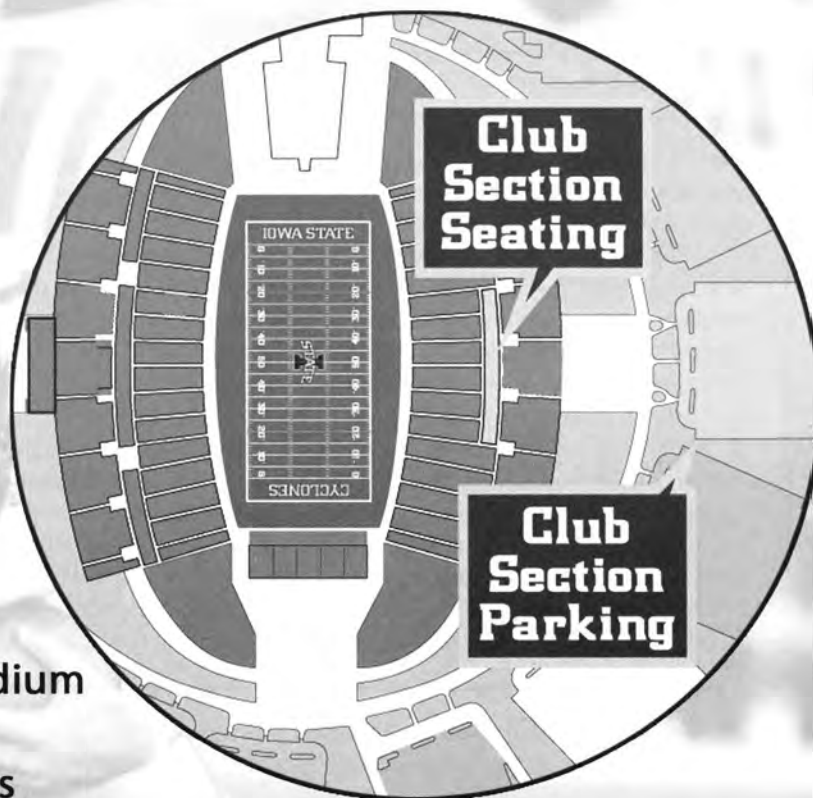

GAMEDAY SCOUTING REPORT

Iowa State: Iowa State was successful in Paul Rhoads' debut as head coach last week, as the Cyclones racked up 442 yards of total offense in a 34-17 win over North Dakota State. ISU outscored the Bison 17-7 in the second half to end a 10-game losing streak.

Junior quarterback Austen Arnaud threw for 227 yards and rushed for 78 yards to lead the Cyclone offense. He also tossed a pair of touchdowns and scored another on the ground. Arnaud's two touchdown strikes were to senior wide receiver Marquis Hamilton, who tallied 97 receiving yards on four catches. Junior running back Alexander Robinson's 18-yard touchdown run got ISU on the board first. Robinson finished the game with 83 yards on the ground, including 75 in the first half.

Jesse Smith led all Cyclone defenders with 15 tackles. The senior linebacker made one of the biggest plays of the game by stripping the ball loose from a Bison runner at the goal line, halting a potential NDSU score. The Cyclones recorded four sacks in the game, including two by senior rush end Rashawn Parker. Parker has eight sacks in his career.

Sophomore kicker Grant Mahoney had a great start to the season, drilling 2-of-3 field goals. Mahoney missed on a 57-yarder, but connected on a career-long 50-yarder in the third period. His boot tied for the 13th-longest field goal in school history.

Iowa: The Iowa special teams blocked two field goal attempts in the final seconds to help preserve a 17-16 win over Northern Iowa on Saturday. Iowa was down 13-3 early in the third quarter, but rallied with 14 unanswered points to take the lead for good.

Junior quarterback Ricky Stanzi had a solid afternoon, throwing for 242 yards on 22-of-34 attempts, including the go-ahead TD toss to tight end Tony Moeaki in the fourth quarter. Moeaki, a senior from Wheaton, Ill., led all Hawkeye receivers with 10 catches for 83 yards. Iowa's tough offensive line, led by preseason All-American Bryan Bulaga, is one of its strengths. The line opened up lanes for freshman running back Adam Robinson, who came off the bench to rush for 63 yards and a one touchdown.

Pat Angerer and Brett Greenwood totaled 12 tackles each to pace the Hawkeye defense. Angerer, a senior linebacker from Bettendorf, Iowa, is on both the Ronnie Lott and Chuck Bednarik Award preseason watch lists. Angerer also tallied one tackle for loss vs. the Panthers. The Iowa defense recorded five tackles for loss and two sacks in its season opener. Interior defensive linemen Christian Ballard and Karl Klug each had a sack in the win.

Kicker Daniel Murray was 1-for-2 on 3-pointers vs. UNI, connecting on a 39-yarder in the first quarter. Punter Ryan Donahue averaged 42.8 yards on five kicks.

ACCESS TO JACK TRICE STADIUM

All gates will open 90 minutes prior to game time. Management reserves the right to eject and revoke tickets to future events without refund for persons who violate any of the terms of the license (refer to back of ticket) or any state, local, or federal laws. Violators are subject to immediate arrest, prosecution, and permanent revocation of this license.

COURTESY CARTS

Courtesy cart service will be available at Gates 1, 3 and 5, beginning 90 minutes before kickoff until 10 minutes into the first quarter. Service resumes midway through the fourth quarter. Courtesy cart service is not available outside the stadium. Courtesy carts will not run on the concourse during peak times.

CYCLONE EXPERIENCE

Located North of Lot 5-8, this family friendly environment includes inflatable attractions for kids, Cy, the spirit squad and concessions.

CYCLONE TENTS AND GROUP TICKETS

Cyclone Tents and group ticket discounts are available prior to the day of the game. For more information on purchasing tents or group tickets, call (515) 294-3558 or go to cyclones.com.

CUSTOMER SERVICE HOTLINE

Do you have a problem in your seating area? Call the customer service hotline (515-296-7849) to have a member of the event staff come to your aid. Please note the stadium section, row and seat number(s) of the disruption. Operation hours for the hotline are from gates opening to 30 minutes prior to the conclusion of the game.

FIELD ACCESS

The Athletics Department asks that all patrons without proper credentials refrain from entering the field level at any time. Violators will be subject to arrest and prosecution.

FIRST AID

An ambulance is parked by the first aid headquarters on the west side of the stadium. If you are in need of first aid please see the nearest usher for assistance. First aid locations inside the stadium are:

West side - outside Section 14 at the south end of the Concourse Suites

East side - outside Section 30 on the north end of the Club Section.

GUEST SERVICES

Patrons in need of assistance can go to the guest services location on either concourse. Locations are below Section B on the west concourse and below Section L on the east concourse. Patrons may also request assistance by calling the in-stadium customer service hotline.

LOST AND FOUND

Lost and found is located at the Athletic Ticket Office, north of Gate 5 on the west side of the Olsen Building. Items lost or found should be reported to an usher. Unclaimed items will be discarded at the end of the season.

LOST CHILDREN

Parents/guardians with a lost child should contact the nearest police officer or event staff member. That person will then contact the proper personnel to insure the quickest remedy to the situation. If the child knows his/her seat location, the child will be returned to that location.

PARKING

Medical Accessible Parking- Parking Lot S2, south of Gate 3, is available to fans with a medical accessible parking permit issued by the State of Iowa DOT on a first-come, first-serve basis. Recreational vehicles and buses will not be admitted to lot S2.

Cars- All paved and grass parking located north and east of Jack Trice Stadium is reserved for National Cyclone Club (NCC) members. For weekend games, NCC lots will open at 7 a.m. or 6 hours prior to kickoff, whichever is earlier.

General Public Parking- General public parking is located in the grass areas south of Jack Trice Stadium along South 16th Street. Limited parking is located around Hilton Coliseum. All general public parking lots open six hours prior to kickoff.

Recreational Vehicles- National Cyclone Club members issued a RV permit will park in either D2, D3, D4 or S8. Permit holders may gain access to their assigned lot from 5 p.m. to midnight the night before a game, or when the lots open on game day. General public bringing recreational vehicles the night before football game days will be directed to park at the ISU Veterinary Medicine College (Lot 93).

Charter Buses- Charter bus parking, fee of \$50 per bus, is located on Stadium Drive south of lots S4, S3 & S2 on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please contact Brian Honnold at (515) 294-5527 to make arrangements.

RESTRICTED ITEMS & SEARCHES

All bags, backpacks, video cameras, large cases, fanny packs and purses (larger than 10" by 10") are prohibited and banned. Only those items required for medical, family or child care needs plus empty, clear personal-sized containers suitable for drinking water will be permitted. All carried items and entrants are subject to search.

Prohibited items must be returned to the owner's car or discarded. Any unlawful items are subject to confiscation.

Prohibited items include: Alcoholic beverages, artificial noisemakers, backpacks, fanny packs, large purses (larger than 10" by 10"), beach balls, cameras (professional equipment or cameras with long telephoto lenses), chair backs or stadium seats (cushions are allowed), coolers or containers, food and beverages, pets (with the exception of service animals used by disabled guests), strollers, toilet tissue, umbrellas, video cameras and weapons.

RE-ENTRY POLICY

Patrons must have a ticket stub and their hand stamped (received upon exit) for re-entry into the stadium. Re-entry will be allowed only at gates 2 and 4. Re-entry will not be allowed before kickoff or after the start of the fourth quarter.

SMOKING POLICY

In accordance with the State of Iowa Smoke Free Air Act, there will be NO smoking allowed in Jack Trice Stadium.

SPECIAL SEATING REQUIREMENTS

Reserved ADA seating is located in Sections 1, 3, 5, 7, 10, 12, 14, 16, 17-21, 28-32 and AA-EE for spectators in need of seating assistance. Please notify the ticket office prior to game day to obtain ADA seating.

STADIUM RULES

Unauthorized solicitation, inside or outside the stadium, is prohibited. Throwing objects onto the playing field is prohibited and punishable by state and local law. Violators are subject to immediate arrest, prosecution, and revocation of tickets.

STADIUM SIGN POLICY

All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University and approved by the Events Staff (294-5527) prior to the game. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger patrons. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

TAILGATING POLICIES

Limit your tailgating to one parking space. Please do not block the path for other vehicles to park. Please remember to clean up your area before you leave. No glass bottles, kegs or open fires are allowed in parking lots. Tents are be limited to 10'x10'.

TICKET INFORMATION

Will-Call for the general public is located at the Athletic Ticket Office, north of Gate 5 on the west side of the Olsen Building. Single-game tickets may be purchased at one of the ticket booths located on the north side of the Jacobson/Olsen Building. Group Tickets are not available the day of the game.

JACK TRICE STADIUM



THE STORY OF JACK TRICE

Jack Trice Stadium is named in honor of Jack Trice, Iowa State's first African-American student-athlete. Trice died from injuries he sustained in a varsity football game vs. Minnesota in October 1923.

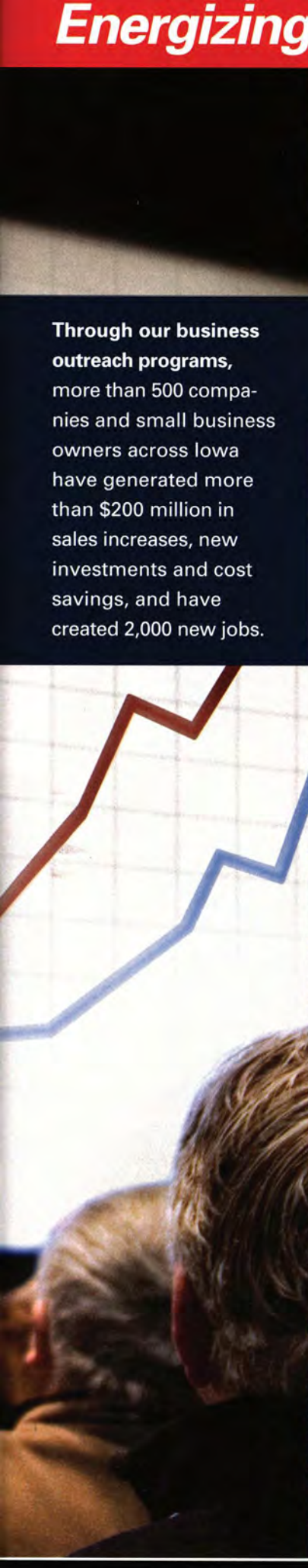
Trice was an excellent student and a stellar performer in the interior line. He played on the freshman team in 1922, and the following year was considered to be by many all-conference caliber.

After his untimely death, classes were postponed and a funeral service was held before 4,000 students and faculty on central campus. In 1984, ISU officials changed the name to the football stadium complex to Cyclone Stadium/Jack Trice Field. It was permanently dedicated as Jack Trice Stadium during a ceremony honoring the former Cyclone in August of 1997.

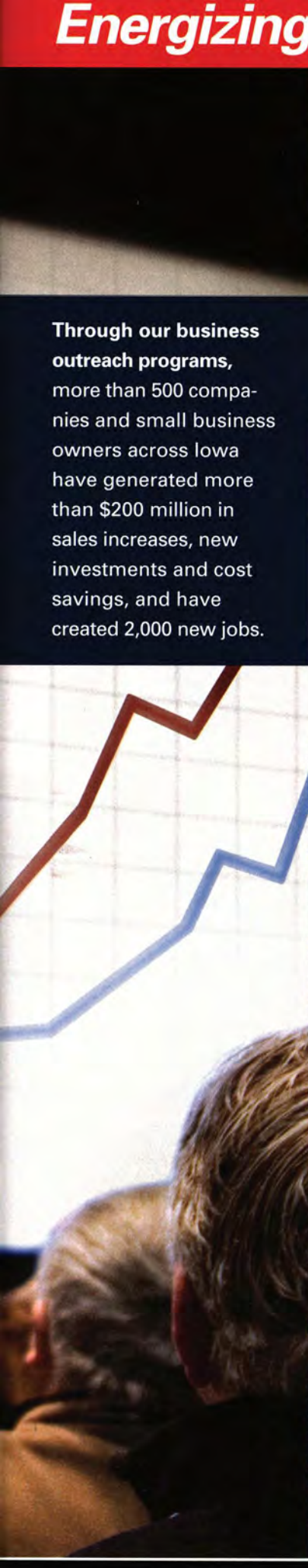
A statue in his likeness was moved to the east side of the Jacobson Building in 1997, greeting visitors as they enter the stadium.

ISU PRESIDENT DR. GREGORY L. GEOFFROY



His teaching and research have earned him fellowships from the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation and John Simon Guggenheim Foundation, visiting professorships to major universities in Germany and France, the Dreyfus Foundation Teacher-Scholar Award, and, in 1991, election as a Fellow in the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He has served in several leadership capacities in the Association for Universities for Research in Astronomy and the American Chemical Society's Division of Inorganic Chemistry, and from 2005 to 2008, was a member of the NCAA Executive Committee. He currently serves on the FBI's National Security Higher Education Advisory Board, Big 12 Conference Board of Directors, World Food Prize Advisory Committee, National Merit Scholarship Board of Directors, and Iowa Business Council, and is president of the Iowa 4-H Foundation. He is an avid Cyclone and intercollegiate athletics fan, and he served on the NCAA Executive Committee from 2005 to 2008.

Dr. Geoffroy received a bachelor's degree with honors from the University of Louisville in 1968, served as an officer in the United States Navy from 1969-70, and earned his doctorate in chemistry from the California Institute of Technology in 1974. He was named an Alumni Fellow by Louisville in 1997. He and his wife, Kathleen Carothers Geoffroy, have four children (Susan, Janet, David, Michael).



Dr. Gregory L. Geoffroy became the 14th president of Iowa State University on July 1, 2001, after serving as provost and senior vice president at the University of Maryland, College Park, for four years, and as a faculty member, department head and dean at Penn State University for 23 years. He also holds the faculty rank of professor of chemistry at Iowa State.

Dr. Geoffroy is leading Iowa State in advancing the land-grant ideals of education, research and service, and putting science and technology to work. Under his leadership, Iowa State is strengthening its position as a leading international research university, as a student-centered university that provides a top quality education to students, and as an invaluable resource for Iowa, the nation and the world. A nationally known researcher in organometallic chemistry, he has published more than 200 research articles in refereed journals and presented more than 200 invited lectures throughout the United States and in nine other nations. He is co-author of the book *Organometallic Photochemistry*, and has directed the work of 37 doctoral students and 15 post-doctoral scholars.





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ISU ATHLETICS DIRECTOR JAMIE POLLARD



Jamie Pollard, Iowa State's Director of Athletics since 2005, has made a career out of dreaming big, thinking outside of the box and stretching beyond personal comfort zones.

Pollard's leadership has boosted pride and raised expectations in the fan base, improved facilities dramatically and set the Cyclones up for success on the field and in the classroom.

Pollard has made it a personal mission to improve the department in all areas and his tenure has been marked by a relentless work ethic, "don't-cut-the-corners" approach to problem solving and a belief that Iowa State can excel both academically and athletically.

The former certified public accountant (CPA) has demonstrated a flair for marketing and his creativeness has lifted the athletics department's operating budget a staggering 55% despite no additional state or institutional support.

Some of the highlights of his tenure include:

- A record for annual donations (surpassing \$6 million for the first time);
- New marks for season football (36,000) and men's basketball (10,000) tickets sold;
- More than \$53 million in facility upgrades and construction (including a sparkling new basketball practice complex);
- More competitive teams (five sports ranked in the nation's Top 20 last season for the first time since 1996-97);
- Strong performance in the classroom (athlete GPA of 3.0 since 2005);

His arrival at ISU was preceded by three years as Deputy A.D. at Wisconsin, where he worked alongside Barry Alvarez, who was serving in the dual role of A.D. and football coach. A former national champion long-distance runner, Pollard's competitive drive was channeled into an athletics administration career by his mentor, Maryland Athletics Director Debbie Yow. Pollard received a 2003 Street & Smith's "Top Forty Under 40" award, which goes to the most influential individuals in athletics under the age of 40.

Jamie and his wife, Ellen, have four children and reside in Ames.



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HEAD COACH PAUL RHOADS



When Iowa State Athletics Director Jamie Pollard brought Paul Rhoads back to his native state and the Cyclone football program, Pollard called on an Iowan whose ISU roots are only exceeded by his exemplary resume.

Born in Nevada, Iowa, just 10 minutes from Jack Trice Stadium, Rhoads came back to Iowa State after most recently coaching as defensive coordinator at Auburn. His stellar track record complements his Iowa roots. The man who was valedictorian at Ankeny High School, one of the largest schools in the state (located just 20 minutes south of Ames), Rhoads was the ideal individual to take control of the ISU football program.

Rhoads coordinated the Pitt defense for eight seasons (2000-07) before moving to Auburn in the same role last season.

His resume includes a 2004 Big East Conference championship with the Panthers. Five of the defenses he coordinated ranked in the nation's Top 30 for scoring and three in the NCAA's Top 12 for fewest yards allowed. His aggressive philosophy allowed Pitt to score 10 defensive touchdowns from 2004-06.

His last two defenses (Auburn in 2008 and Pitt in 2007) ranked 15th nationally in scoring defense and fifth in total defense, respectively. *The Sporting News* named him the best defensive coordi-

nator in the Big East Conference two years ago. His Panther teams led the league in scoring defense, total defense and pass efficiency defense once each during his tenure. One of the highlight games of his Pitt tenure was the 13-9 upset of No. 2-ranked West Virginia in 2007. The Mountaineers gained 183 total yards, 292 below their season average.

At the end of the 2005 season, Pitt ranked second nationally in pass defense, yielding just 152.82 yards per game, and sixth in pass efficiency defense with a 99.36 rating. During Pitt's victorious Insight Bowl season in 2002, the unit played at its highest level in decades. The Panthers ranked among the nation's top 25 in an impressive seven different categories and allowed their fewest points in a season since 1988 despite playing in a school-record 13 games.

In 2001, the Panthers gave up just 7.4 points and 182.6 yards heading into the Visit Florida Tangerine Bowl. The unit ranked among the nation's top 30 in five different categories at season's end. Additionally, Pitt finished with 38 quarterback sacks, its highest total since 1987.

Rhoads coordinated defenses for both Walt Harris and Dave Wannstedt at Pitt. He was approached by Auburn's Tommy Tuberville to move to Auburn in 2002 after two spectacular seasons at Pitt but turned down the offer. Tuberville again offered Rhoads his top defensive coaching position prior to last fall and he accepted.

Rhoads familiarity with Iowa State goes back to his youth growing up in central Iowa but also includes a five-year stint as inside linebackers (1995) and secondary (1996-99) coach with the Cyclones. He was a member of Dan McCarney's first staff at ISU.

During his playing days, Rhoads earned special mention all-state honors as a safety at Ankeny High School. He lettered three seasons (1986-88) as a defensive back at Missouri Western.

Rhoads earned a bachelor's degree in economics in 1989 at Missouri Western and was the recipient of the Chris Faros Scholarship, which honors the football team's top senior student-athlete. Rhoads added a master's degree from Utah State in 1991.

His father, Cecil, was a high school coach for 3½ decades and has been inducted into the Iowa High School Football Coaches Hall of Fame. His mother, Mary, was a teacher and homemaker. Rhoads is the youngest of five children.

Paul and his wife, Vickie, a former basketball player at Missouri Western, have two boys (Jacob and Wyatt).

IOWA STATE REMEMBERS THE DIRTY THIRTY



All-American Dwight Nichols was the heart and soul of one of ISU's greatest teams, the "Dirty Thirty."

The Iowa State Athletics Department is honoring the 50th anniversary of the "Dirty Thirty" at today's game. A total of 19 members of the storied 1959 Cyclone squad attended a reunion last night and will be introduced to the crowd this afternoon.

No team in ISU's history so captured the nation's imagination as the 1959 "Dirty Thirty." This small group of Iowa State student-athletes would perform their magic against a backdrop of cathartic change in America and on the ISU campus. Nineteen members of that team will be introduced at today's game.

The biggest of on-campus change was up front and obvious in September of 1959. Iowa State, on the heels of its centennial celebration, was now Iowa State University, and its 9,500 students returning to campus couldn't help but see the difference. The Iowa State Daily reflected on the change in its first edition of the 1959-60 school year:

"The word 'college' is being rubbed out – almost everywhere. From the inch-deep engraved 'Iowa State College' over the Beardshear pillars to the ISC stickers on every microscope and manhole covers owned by the University, the change is on. Stationary, decals, pennants, and other articles that advertised Iowa State College have been or are being sold out."

When fall camp opened for the 1959 season, Iowa State head football coach Clay Stapleton was starting his second season in Ames. There were reasons for cautious optimism heading into the 1959 season. Halfback Dwight Nichols, the pride of Knoxville, Iowa, returned as the unquestioned team leader.

Nichols was not the most talented member of the team, but his fierce determination and astute decision-making abilities set him apart from most others.

"Dwight was the best, a truly tough, intelligent player who had the desire to play at the highest level for 60 minutes," Stapleton said. "He could pass, run or kick but his heart carried him on the field."

Throughout preseason practice, Iowa State's roster continued to shrink through two-a-day workouts. As the Cyclones rode down to Drake for their first game on Sept. 19, there were just 30 players. In the game at Drake

Stadium, Tom Watkins' breakaway speed and the passing and running of Nichols led ISU to a 41-0 Saturday night victory over the Bulldogs. The field was wet and muddy, but Watkins gained 137 yards on 23 attempts.

Following the contest, as the team entered the locker room area, ISU trainer Warren Ariail greeted them:

"Here comes the Dirty Thirty!"

The tag was an instant hit. The jubilant team gave Ariail the game ball.

On another wet field the following Friday at Denver, the Cyclones rallied to post a 28-12 come-from-behind victory.

Stapleton's utilization of the old single-wing formation allowed Iowa State's smaller teams to compete in the Big Eight Conference. The Cyclones were often out-weighted by 20 pounds per man in 1959.

"This group of little men have to play the single-wing for two reasons," Stapleton said. "They are not big enough to handle man-on-man blocking. We have to use two-man blocks, the key of single-wing play. Single-wing football has to be played by hard-nosed youngsters. That is why the Dirty Thirty like playing the single-wing."

After a 14-0 loss to Missouri on Oct. 3, the Cyclones got back on track the following Saturday, Oct. 10 at South Dakota with a 41-6 win.

Iowa State's defense was in high gear the next weekend (Oct. 17) as the Cyclones recorded a 27-0 shutout at Colorado. The Dirty Thirty played so flawlessly against the Buffaloes that the coaching staff would rank it as the team's best game of the season. This was Stapleton's first conference victory, and his players carried him off the field.

Kansas State was the Cyclones' third shutout victim of the season Oct. 24, falling 26-0 before 13,899 fans, the largest Homecoming crowd in ISU school history. A major battle was expected the following weekend at Kansas. It was then that the weather threw Iowa State a curve. The Cyclones were at the Des Moines Airport Oct. 30 waiting for a plane that never came. Forced to board a bus, they didn't arrive in Kansas City until 2 a.m. In a hard-fought contest the next day, Kansas prevailed 7-0.

On Nov. 7 against Nebraska, Watkins deserved the spotlight. He rushed for 108 yards on 21 carries, including a 32-yard TD dash in an 18-6 victory. Watkins and Nichols now ranked first and second, respectively, on the conference rushing list.

The Cyclones were still in the Big Eight title chase. But ISU's last home game was against San Jose State Nov. 14 in frigid conditions the likes of which the SJSU players had never experienced. The opening kickoff was fielded by Iowa State's Don Webb at the 23-yard line. He flew down the west sideline and made for the endzone and a touchdown. Iowa State went up 13-0 moments later when San Jose fumbled the ensuing kickoff and Nichols followed with a 3-yard run for a TD. The rout was on and ISU won 55-0.

Iowa State would close the season at Oklahoma Nov. 21. An ISU victory would send the Cyclones to the Orange Bowl.

The Sooners jumped to a 21-0 halftime lead behind the running of Prentice Gautt. ISU closed the gap to 21-12 after three quarters but most Cyclone football players were on the field for most of the game. Oklahoma would substitute liberally by the rules of the time, sending in numerous replacements between quarters.

Although the Cyclones were denied an Orange Bowl bid, the national acclaim secured the squad a place among ISU's greatest teams. Nichols was named all-conference, All-American, and was tabbed academic all-conference, along with end Jon Spelman. Watkins and Webb were also named all-conference.

"I'd rather be coach of the Dirty Thirty than president of the United States," Stapleton said during the season.

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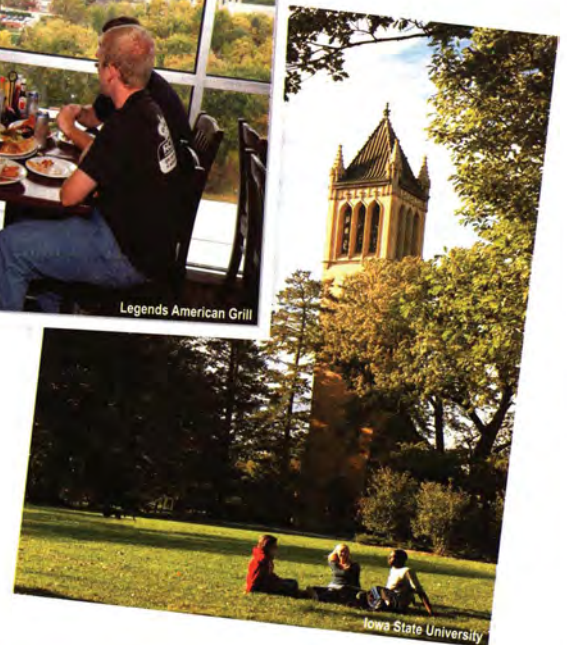
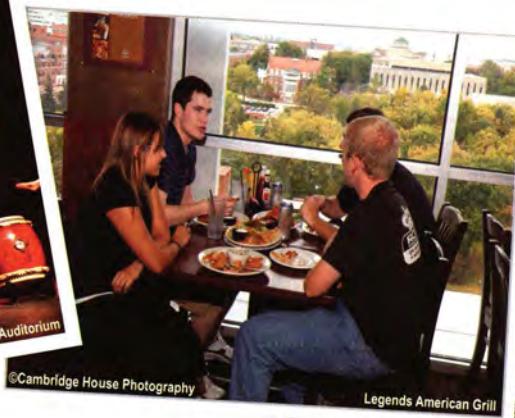
