

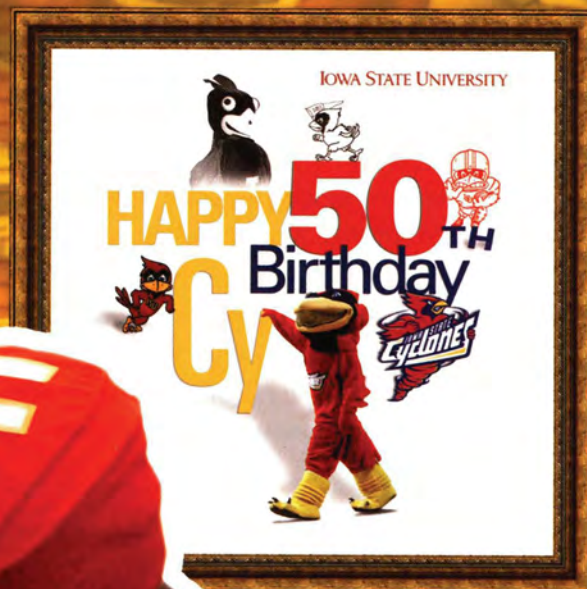

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Welcome to Iowa State University

Iowa State University is an exciting place! With Big 12 Conference athletics, frequent performances by some of the world's top music and theatrical headliners, lectures by international figures and 600 student clubs and organizations to get students involved, the Iowa State campus is in constant motion.

Iowa State is also a quiet and beautiful place. Named one of the three most beautiful campuses in the nation, Iowa State's expansive central campus is very much like a park, with many places to relax and enjoy the natural beauty. The Reiman Gardens, located just south of Jack Trice Stadium, provides a truly breathtaking and enjoyable nature experience with its 14 acres of award-winning gardens, butterfly wing and conservatory. The campus is also an architectural and artistic treasure, with more than 100 major buildings of many different styles and genres, including some on the National Historic Register, and the largest collection of public art in the nation.

Iowa State is rich in tradition. It's where George Washington Carver received his education, John Vincent Atanasoff invented the electronic digital computer and some of the most important discoveries in modern agriculture and science were made.

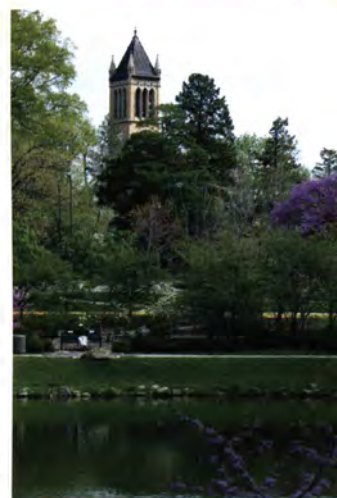
In addition to being a university with an outstanding academic reputation, Iowa State prides itself on the overall quality of living and learning environment it provides for students. Both the Greek and residence hall systems are strong, and services such as the Cy-Ride bus system make living off campus almost as convenient as on-campus living. Nearly 9,000 students live in university-owned housing, which is undergoing a comprehensive makeover to provide students with more options and amenities, such as apartment-style living and much more variety in food service options. Several residence halls have been renovated; new apartment units have been constructed; and two new suite buildings and a community center with many different varieties of food service have been added to the Union Drive complex. About 1,400 students live in fraternities and sororities, many of which are national award-winning chapters.

Nearly half of Iowa State's freshmen enter as part of learning communities, which have been shown to markedly improve the likelihood of students staying in school and graduating. Students are grouped either by major or special area of interest, such as multiculturalism. This fall, a new learning community begins for students interested in entrepreneurship. Iowa State also helps its students after they graduate, with nationally recognized career services and exceptional placement rates.

High-tech learning facilities can be found throughout the campus, including the new Gerding Business Building and Engineering Teaching and Research Complex. Iowa State is a leader in moving to wireless communication and was recognized as one of the 20 "most unwired" campuses in the nation by Intel.

Support and recreational services and facilities for students at Iowa State are among the best in the nation. The Thielen Health Center has a staff of doctors and nurses and an on-site pharmacy. The 220,000-square-foot Lied Recreation Center offers a wide range of recreational facilities, including 20 basketball courts, nine racquetball courts, a 300-meter ground-level track, elevated track and extensive weight-training and aerobics equipment. About 80 percent of Iowa State's students participate in intramural sports, which range from the traditional to the very popular broom ball and inner tube water basketball.

The Iowa State Center is the pride of Iowa State's entertainment and conference service program. Stephens Auditorium plays host to some of the world's premier orchestras and performers. Hilton Coliseum, in addition to being home for Iowa State athletic events, attracts the top touring popular music groups. Fisher Theater provides a smaller, more intimate setting for student stage productions and other events. And the Scheman Continuing Education Building is the site for a large number of conferences and continuing education programs each year.

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Cyclones vs. Aggies

Iowa State (2-2, 0-1) returns home to face Texas A&M (3-1, 1-0) in the third-ever night homecoming game at Jack Trice Stadium. Iowa State is 18-10 in its last 28 home games (.643), the school's best 28-game mark in Jack Trice Stadium history (1975-), and the school's best overall home stretch since Oct. 2, 1915, to Oct. 7, 1922 (18-9-1).

This is the 92nd Homecoming game in Cyclone history, and 30th at Jack Trice Stadium. Iowa State is 14-13-2 in Homecoming contests at Jack Trice Stadium.

A stingy Iowa State defense against the rush has allowed just 427 yards rushing through the season's first four games, ranking fifth in the Big 12 (106.8 ypg.). The last time an Iowa State defense allowed under 427 yards rushing in its first four games was in 1985 (384). In last Saturday's 36-7 loss at Oklahoma State, the ISU run defense held OSU to 189 rushing yards on 55 carries, 144 below the Cowboys' average.

The Cyclone rush defense ranks 29th nationally, but eighth in Division I-A in terms of yards allowed per carry (2.41). Michigan (1.53 ypc) and Nebraska (1.82) are the nation's top two teams.

Texas A&M has committed only one turnover, a fumble last week against Kansas State, while forcing 11 turnovers. The Aggies' rank third in the nation in turnover margin (+2.50/gm). A&M converted four Kansas State turnovers into 21 points. A&M held the ball for only 19:32 and ran just 43 plays to Kansas State's 90 plays, but each of the six Aggie touchdown drives was less than two minutes long.

Last week, after a scoreless first quarter, Oklahoma State opened with a 22-yard field goal to take a 3-0 lead. ISU fumbled on the ensuing possession, allowing OSU to

start at the Cyclone 7-yard line. The Cowboys added a quick touchdown to go up 10-0. The next two ISU drives ended in punts, and OSU started in ISU territory both times, tacking on a field goal and a touchdown to make the score 20-0. Another ISU fumble led to a third Cowboy field goal and a 23-0 halftime lead. After a missed OSU field goal in the third quarter, ISU drove 73 yards in seven plays, capped by a Todd Blythe touchdown to cut the margin to 23-7. OSU responded with a touchdown, and added a score late in the fourth quarter for the final margin of 36-7.

Blythe's TD grab was his sixth in four games as a Cyclone. He is the fifth Cyclone with a TD reception in four consecutive games and is only two touchdowns shy of tying the ISU single-season mark of eight receiving touchdowns, set by Tracy Henderson (1983) and matched by Ty Watley (1997). Blythe also ranks third in Division I-A with six touchdown catches, and is second among freshmen in receiving yardage per game (67.50).

Wide receiver Jon Davis continued his solid play, making five catches at Oklahoma State. Davis leads the ISU receiving corps with 20 catches, and has led the team in receptions in each of the last three games. He is averaging just under 12 yards per catch in 2004.

Linebacker Erik Anderson led the ISU defense in Stillwater, making a career-high 11 tackles, including 2.5 for loss (-17 yards) and a sack (-9 yards). Cornerback Ellis Hobbs made his fifth career interception, and the sixth pick of the year for ISU. Through four games, the ISU defense has six interceptions, 35 tackles for loss and 10 sacks. In all of 2003 (12 games), ISU had eight interceptions, 66 tackles for loss and 14 sacks.

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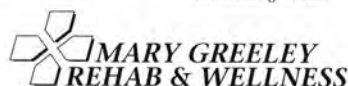

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Iowa State Football Facilities



The new \$10 million Stephen and Debbie Bergstrom Indoor Training Facility (below) opened in March for spring practice. The 92,000-square-foot building was constructed over the existing artificial turf practice field as a part of the Johnny Majors Practice Complex west of Jack Trice Stadium. Funding for this project was from private gifts to the athletic department and ISU Foundation.

Underscoring Iowa State's commitment to a winning football program is the \$10.6 million Jacobson Athletic Facility (above), which opened to rave reviews in 1996. The Jacobson Athletic Building provides the ISU football program with a state-of-the-art office and training complex. The facility is located on the north end of Jack Trice Stadium.





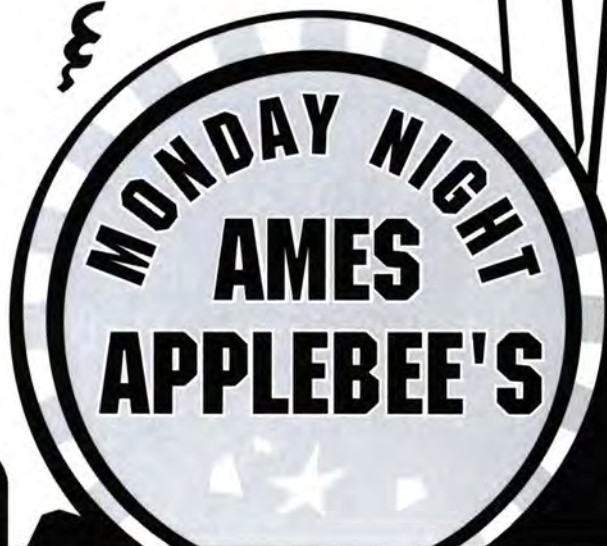
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Gameday Scouting Report



The Series: Texas A&M leads the series, 6-0. Four missed field goals by ISU and a disputed Aggie touchdown loomed large in 2001, as A&M prevailed 24-21 in College Station. The two teams first met in 1978 at the Hall of Fame Bowl.

Offensively: ISU wide receiver Todd Blythe has made an immediate impact as a redshirt freshman. Blythe has six touchdown catches in ISU's first four games. WR Jon Davis leads all ISU receivers with 20 receptions. Stevie Hicks leads ISU rushers, averaging 71.5 yards per game. Bret Meyer and Austin Flynn have combined to complete 54 percent of their passes for 731 yards and seven touchdowns.

Dual-threat quarterback Reggie McNeal leads the Aggie offense. McNeal is averaging 203.8 ypg passing and 85.2 ypg rushing, and has accounted for six touchdowns (four rushing, two passing). Tailback Courtney Lewis has scored five touchdowns in three games, averaging 90.3 ypg. The main receiving threat is senior Terrence Murphy, who has 13 catches for 257 yards and one touchdown.

Defensively: The Cyclones have recorded 10 sacks and 35 tackles for loss already this season. The ISU defense tallied 14 sacks and 66 tackles for loss in all of 2003. DB Nik Moser leads the ISU defense with 32 tackles. The ISU defense has intercepted six passes this season after having eight picks in 2003. Moser and LB Matt Robertson each have two interceptions.

DB Jaxson Appel is the Aggies' leading tackler, making 29 stops in four games. DB Byron Jones leads the team with 4.5 sacks, and also has an interception and a fumble recovery. The Aggie defense has intercepted eight passes and recovered three fumbles.

Special Teams: Punter Troy Blankenship dropped three of his six punts at Oklahoma State inside the 20-yard line, including a season-best 53-yarder. Blankenship is averaging 40.0 yards on 24 punts, and has pinned opponents inside the 20 eight times. Ellis Hobbs and Tyease Thompson have combined to average nearly 22 yards per kickoff return.

Texas A&M PK Todd Pegram has been perfect this season, making 16-of-16 PATs and 3-of-3 FG. Murphy and Jason Carter are averaging 20 yards per kickoff return. Jacob Young is averaging 34.5 yards per punt, but 11 of his 26 punts have resulted in fair catches.

Coaches: Today's game marks the third meeting between Iowa State head coach Dan McCarney and Texas A&M head coach Dennis Franchione. McCarney holds an 0-4 record against A&M, while Franchione has a 2-0 record against ISU. Franchione was a first-year coach at TCU in 1998, when the Horned Frogs defeated ISU in Ames, 31-21. Franchione was the head coach at Alabama in the 2001 Independence Bowl, a 14-13 Crimson Tide victory.

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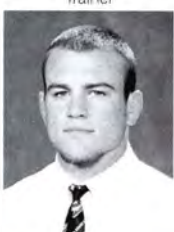
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Homecoming Memories

Welcome to Homecoming 2004! Because Homecoming is traditionally a time when old friends get together and reminisce, let's take a step back in time to Homecomings past, and remember some of the great Homecoming games in Jack Trice Stadium history...

Oct. 30, 1976 - Iowa State 45, Kansas State 14

During the bicentennial year, fireworks weren't limited to Independence Day celebrations. The high-powered Cyclone offense averaged over 439 yards per game (ranking second nationally) en route to an 8-3 record. Homecoming 1976 saw the Cyclones run roughshod over Kansas State on a cold, misty day, piling up 347 yards on the ground and scoring all six touchdowns via the run. In all, ISU ran 99 plays on offense, totalling 503 yards. Iowa State led 38-0 before KSU got on the board in the fourth quarter. Buddy Hardeman led the ISU ground attack, rushing for 108 yards and two touchdowns. Wayne Stanley added 110 yards through the air. The Cyclone defense forced seven turnovers. Mark Settle led the ISU defense with eight tackles.

Oct. 17, 1981 - Iowa State 34, No. 8 Missouri 13

Donnie Duncan's Cyclones entered Homecoming 1981 with a 3-1-1 record, having tied No. 5 Oklahoma two weeks prior in Norman. The next week, ISU took a No. 12 ranking to San Diego State, and lost a 52-31 shootout to the Aztecs. That set up the Homecoming tilt with the 5-0 Missouri Tigers. ISU tailback Dwayne Crutchfield scored twice from one yard out in the first half, as the Cyclones built a 21-7 lead at the intermission. A third touchdown run by Crutchfield in the fourth quarter extended the lead to 31-13, and Alex Giffords added a 47-yard field goal to provide the final margin. Crutchfield finished with 98 rushing yards on 32 carries. John Quinn completed 20-of-32 passes for 226 yards, including a 41-yard touchdown strike to Vinny Cerrato. Linebacker Chris Washington made 11 tackles to pace the Cyclone defense. Doug Fischer added nine stops, and Darren Longshore picked off two Tiger passes.

Oct. 20, 1984 - No. 2 Oklahoma 12, Iowa State 10

The first night game in Jack Trice Stadium history was indeed a memorable one. ESPN carried the contest live nationwide, and the country saw a valiant effort by the Cyclones fall just short. The Iowa State defense kept Oklahoma's wishbone attack in check for most of the game, limiting OU to just 233 yards on 53 attempts. Oklahoma led 3-0 in the second quarter before a scrambling Alex Espinoza found fullback Kirk Thomas in the end zone to give the Cyclones a 7-3 lead with less than two minutes to play in the half. Neither team was able to score in the third quarter. ISU's Marc Bachrodt missed a 46-yard field goal, and the Cyclone defense held Oklahoma on downs inside the ISU 25.

The momentum swung into Iowa State's favor early in the fourth quarter. Cyclone linebacker Jim Luebbers forced a fumble on a punt return, and ISU took over at the Sooner 35-yard line. Bachrodt nailed a 45-yarder, and ISU had a 10-3 lead with 11:22 to play. On the next possession, OU broke a reverse for 56 yards to the Cyclone 14. The Cyclone defense held OU to a field goal, and the lead was cut to 10-6. Iowa State was forced to punt from deep in its own territory on the next possession, and Oklahoma ate up 3:59 on a nine-play, 40-yard drive before scoring from seven yards out. The snap on the extra-point attempt was fumbled, leaving the margin at 12-10. All ISU needed was a field goal. Espinoza kept the drive alive on an improbable 10-yard scramble on fourth-and-seven. The Cyclones advanced to their own 44-yard line before an Espinoza fourth-down pass was intercepted with 1:19 to play, sealing the win for the Sooners. Jeff Braswell (13), Lester Williams (11) and Anthony Davis (10) led the Cyclone defense in tackles. Espinoza threw for 147 yards, and Richard Hanson ran for 66 yards in a Homecoming classic.

Sept. 28, 1996 - Iowa State 45, Missouri 31

The Troy Davis Show made its 10th appearance in Ames one for the ages. Davis, a junior, was coming off a sophomore season in which he racked up 2,010 yards. Davis had already run for 539 yards in the first three

games of 1996. He had carried the ball an improbable 53 times the previous week against UNI, scoring a school record-tying five touchdowns.

The TD-o-Meter got a workout during Homecoming 1996, but not from the start. ISU led 3-0 after the first quarter, and Davis had only carried three times for 14 yards. The running lanes opened in the second quarter, as Davis had five carries of 10 or more yards. He amassed 114 yards and a touchdown in the second quarter alone. Iowa State led 17-14 at halftime, and the third quarter brought more of the same for Davis. He carried the ball eight times for 75 yards in the third frame, including a 38-yard touchdown, his second of the day. After three quarters, Missouri led 31-24, and Davis had 25 carries for 203 yards.

The fourth quarter was Troy's time to shine. A 30-yard carry set up the game-tying touchdown with 11:17 to play. After a short Missouri punt, Davis scored on a 40-yard run to put ISU ahead, 38-31. Missouri punted again, and ISU took over with 4:51 to play. On the next drive, Davis carried the ball eight times for 79 yards, scoring the final touchdown from 30 yards out. When the dust had settled, Troy Davis had carried 41 times for 378 yards on the day, and had scored four touchdowns. His 378 yards is a school record, and ranked third at the time in Division I-A history.

Oct. 12, 2002 - No. 11 Iowa State 31, Texas Tech 17

The second Homecoming night game at Jack Trice Stadium brought all of the hype that the 1984 game did, and more. Iowa State entered the game with a record of 5-1, led by Heisman Trophy candidate Seneca Wallace. Texas Tech countered with gunslinging QB Kliff Kingsbury. A national TBS audience saw perhaps the greatest individual play in stadium history. A cool, breezy night slowed the start of both offenses. The two teams traded field goals in the first quarter, and neither team was able to generate points in the second quarter. The 3-3 score was surprising, as the Cyclones and Red Raiders came into the game averaging 80 points per game combined.

Wallace warmed up the ISU faithful in the third quarter. On second down and 11 from the Texas Tech 12, Wallace dropped back to pass. Finding no receivers, he dropped back, rolled right, avoided the onrushing Tech defenders, dropped back past the 25, turned upfield along the right sideline, cut back across the field at the 10, got a crushing block from running back Michael Wagner, and crossed the goal line near the left pylon. In all, the incredible 12-yard run took 17 seconds and covered 135 yards. Texas Tech tied the game at 10-10 on the next drive, but ISU drove another dagger in the Tech defense on the Cyclones' next possession.

On the first play, Lane Danielsen took a reverse 79 yards to paydirt to give ISU the 17-10 lead. Wagner added a touchdown run and Wallace passed to Lance Young to make the score 31-10 before Tech added a late score. Wagner finished with 102 rushing yards. Wallace passed for 148 yards and a touchdown in addition to his rushing score. The ISU defense, led by Brandon Brown's 15 tackles, forced four turnovers. Ellis Hobbs had an interception and broke up four passes. Anthony Forrest, Harold Clewis and Jeremy Loyd each recovered fumbles.

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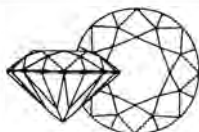


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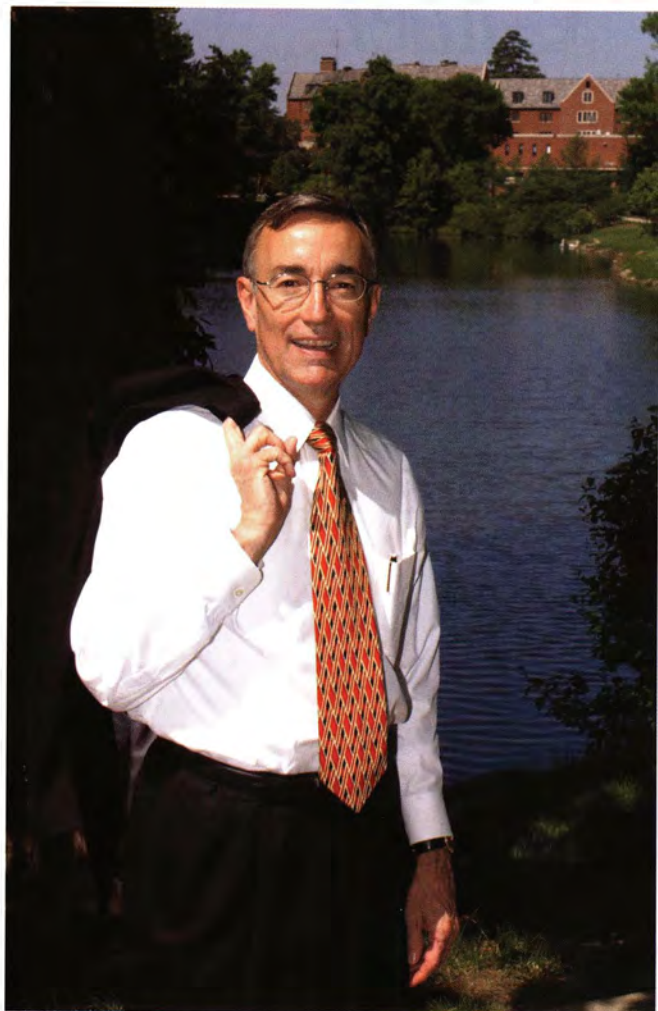
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President Gregory L. Geoffroy



Gregory L. Geoffroy has been a faculty member and top administrator at three of the nation's leading universities. He became president of Iowa State University on July 1, 2001, and he also holds the rank of professor of chemistry.

Dr. Geoffroy began his academic career at the Pennsylvania State University in 1974. He served as head of the Department of Chemistry in 1988 and dean of the Eberly College of Science at Penn State from 1989 to 1997. In 1997, Dr. Geoffroy was appointed senior vice president for academic affairs and provost at the University of Maryland, College Park, where he served until joining Iowa State in 2001.

Dr. Geoffroy has outlined three priorities in leading Iowa State University toward its aspiration of becoming the best university in fulfilling its land-grant responsibilities of learning, discovery and engagement to the people of Iowa and the nation. Those priorities are:

- * providing the best possible education to Iowa State's students, through outstanding academic programs and learning environment;
- * pursuing academic excellence with the goal of having more of the university's academic programs recognized as among the very best in the nation;
- * becoming a fully "engaged" university with the people of Iowa, through expanded distance education, economic development, and community development initiatives.

To these ends, Dr. Geoffroy has made recruitment and retention of top faculty, staff and students a major focus. Under his leadership, the university surpassed its goal of \$50 million in the "Investing in People" campaign to raise private funds for endowments to support faculty positions, graduate assistantships and student scholarships.

Only the second of Iowa State's 14 presidents to come from a chemistry background, Dr. Geoffroy is a nationally acclaimed researcher in organometallic chemistry. He has published more than 200 research articles in refereed journals; presented more than 200 invited lectures in the United States and nine other nations; is co-author of the book *Organometallic Photochemistry*, and has directed the work of 37 Ph.D. students and 15 post-doctoral scholars.

Dr. Geoffroy's teaching and research have earned him fellowships from the Alfred P. Sloan and John Simon Guggenheim Foundations, visiting professorships to major universities in Germany and France, the Dreyfus Foundation Teacher-Scholar Award, and, in 1991, election as a Fellow in the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He has served in various leadership capacities in the Association for Universities for Research in Astronomy and in the American Chemical Society's Division of Inorganic Chemistry. In 1997 he was named an Alumni Fellow of the University of Louisville.

Dr. Geoffroy earned the B.S. With Honors from the University of Louisville in 1968. He served as an officer in the U.S. Navy from 1969 to 1970 and then earned his Ph.D. in chemistry in 1974 from the California Institute of Technology. He and his wife, Kathleen Carothers Geoffroy, have four children.

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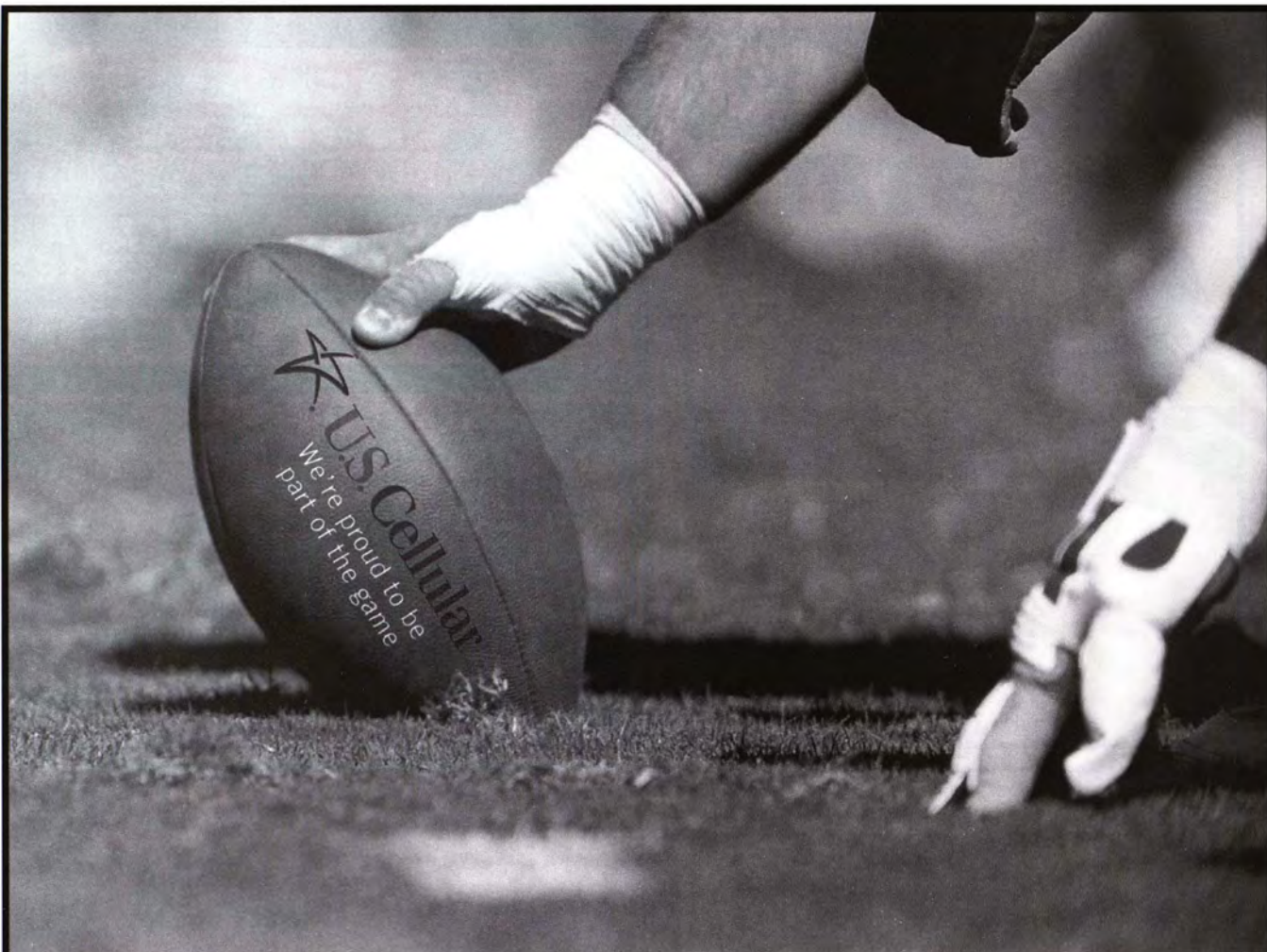
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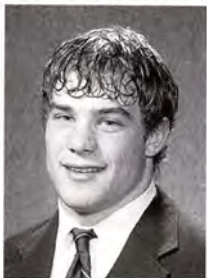

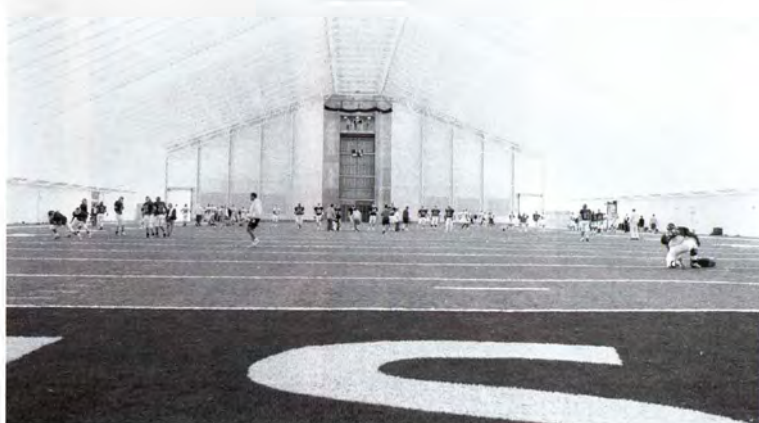
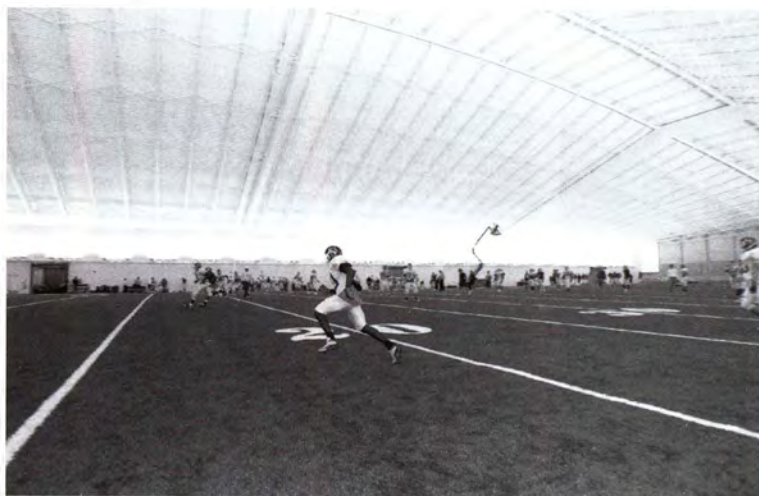
Throughout the 2003-04 school year, progress was steadily made on the construction of the newest addition to Cyclone athletics, the Steve and Debbie Bergstrom Indoor Training Facility. The newly constructed building, which opened in March of 2004 and was officially dedicated on Sept. 3, is another example of Iowa State University's continued commitment to excellence in athletics.

The facility encompasses 92,000 square feet and provides a weather-proof environment to the entire athletic department.

"It's a benefit to the entire athletic department," said Bruce Van De Velde, ISU's Director of Athletics. "With an 120-yard indoor practice field, it can be used for football practice, soccer and other sports programs for practice, training and conditioning. And it certainly will assist Dan McCarney and our other head coaches while recruiting student-athletes nationally."

"It's one of the real final pieces we've been missing at this program and university," said McCarney. "It will have an unbelievable impact on our ability to prepare in regards to the weather. It has been worth the wait, and it is as good a facility that anyone has in the country, college or pro."

Funding for the project was done through private gifts and donations to the ISU Foundation. Lead donors for the project are Steve (BS '79) and Debbie Bergstrom of Montgomery, Texas. In all, over \$10 million was raised, yet another example of the loyal support ISU alumni, donors and friends have for its intercollegiate athletics program.





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Terry Allen Associate Head Coach/ Tight Ends

Terry Allen, an Iowa City, Iowa, native who was head coach at Northern Iowa and Kansas for 13 seasons before coming to Ames, is in his third year as the Cyclones' associate head coach and tight ends coach.

Allen owned a 95-59 record as head coach at Northern Iowa and Kansas. His UNI teams won seven-straight conference titles and made the NCAA Division I-AA semifinals in 1992 and 1996.

An all-conference quarterback at Iowa City West, he went on to UNI, where he was a three-year starter at quarterback. Allen spent 22 years at Northern Iowa as a player, assistant coach and head coach.

Allen was named head coach at Northern Iowa in 1989 and guided his first team to an 8-3 record and a national ranking of 20th in the final I-AA poll. The 1979 graduate of Northern Iowa started his string of seven consecutive conference first-place finishes in his second season and also a streak of seven-straight qualifications for the I-AA national playoffs. Allen was named conference coach of the year five times and Region IV Coach of the Year twice. He was also recognized throughout the country when he was selected as a finalist for the national coach of the year in 1996.

Allen and his wife, Lynn, have a daughter, Angela, and two sons, Chase and Alex.

Assistant Coaches



Tony Alford Assistant Head Coach/ Running Backs

Tony Alford has played a major role in solidifying ISU's reputation as one of the nation's most successful programs nationally rushing the football.

Alford was on the Cyclones' 2000 Insight.com Bowl championship team staff that claimed the first bowl victory in ISU history en route to a 9-3 record. First-team all-Big 12 tailback Ennis Haywood ranked 10th nationally in rushing and led the league with 1,237 yards. Cyclone

tailback Darren Davis passed the 1,000-yard rushing barrier in Alford's first three seasons in Ames and finished his career as the No. 2 rusher in school history. During Alford's initial four years in Ames, Iowa State improved from 103rd to 17th nationally in rushing, averaging more than 200 yards per game on the ground in 1999, 2000 and 2002.

Alford earned honorable mention honors at Colorado State on *USA Today's* 1989 All-America team and was named to the WAC first-team all-conference squad. The 1992 CSU graduate with a bachelor's degree in exercise and sport science set a conference single-game rushing record with 310 rushing yards against Utah and was nominated for the 1989 Doak Walker Award.

Alford went on to play for the NFL's Denver Broncos and the Birmingham Fire of the World League prior to entering the coaching profession.

Alford and his wife, Trina, reside in Ankeny with their son, Rylan.



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Assistant Coaches



Barney Cotton Offensive Coordinator/ Offensive Line

Barney Cotton, the coordinator of a Nebraska offense that ranked seventh nationally in rushing last season, joined the Iowa State coaching staff in January as offensive coordinator and offensive line coach.

Cotton was a three-year letterman at Nebraska from 1976-78 and started on both the offensive and defensive lines for head coach Tom Osborne. He earned his degree from Nebraska in 1983 and a master's degree from St. Cloud State in 1994. After a brief NFL career and assistant coaching stops, Cotton gained experience as a head coach at Hastings College in 1995 and 1996. In 1995, the Broncos won the Nebraska-Iowa Athletic Conference championship.

Cotton was the offensive coordinator at New Mexico State for six seasons prior to his stint with NU. Under his direction, the Aggie offense ranked in the top 25 nationally in total offense three times (13th (1998), 17th (2000) and 23rd (2002)). The NMSU offense ranked among the top 25 teams nationally in rushing offense in each of Cotton's six seasons.

In Cotton's only season as offensive coordinator/line coach with Nebraska, the Huskers rushed for more than 250 yards in seven games in 2003 and averaged 235.6 rushing yards per game, while four Husker linemen earned all-Big 12 honors.

Cotton and his wife Christine have three sons, Ben, Jake and Sam.



John Skladany Defensive Coordinator/ Linebackers

John Skladany has engineered major defensive reversals of fortune at Iowa State, a significant factor in the ISU football program's trio of bowl appearances in the last four years. ISU's performance against the run has improved every season since Skladany's arrival. During Dan McCarney's first season (1995), the Cyclones allowed 296.6 rushing yards per game; the figure

stood at 174.6 yards in 2002 against a schedule that included nine bowl teams. His aggressive defense forced 26 turnovers in 2001, ranking eighth nationally. Skladany played football at Central Connecticut State, earning a bachelor's degree in 1972. The Haverhill, Mass., native had NFL free agent tryouts as a defensive lineman with the New England Patriots in 1972 and the Washington Redskins in 1973. He played for the WFL's Birmingham Americans and spent the 1975 exhibition season with the Ottawa Roughriders of the CFL.

Skladany played a key role in turning the Colorado State defense into a unit that led the Western Athletic Conference after serving two seasons as the defensive backs coach at Northern Arizona (1990-92) and one campaign coaching the Lumberjack defensive line. Skladany coached at Ohio University from 1985-89, as secondary coach (1985-87) and then as defensive coordinator (1988-89). Skladany owns a master's degree from Ohio.

Skladany and his wife, Sharon, have two daughters, Laura and Stephanie.



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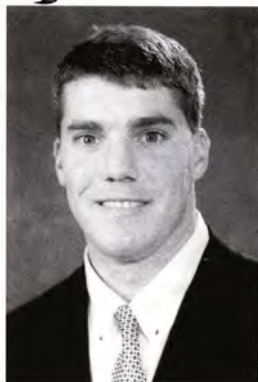
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Chris Ash Secondary

Chris Ash joined the Iowa State coaching staff in February 2000 and works with the ISU secondary. His efforts helped Iowa State's defenders post its best total defensive numbers in a decade in 2001. Ash's defensive backs the past two seasons included strong safety Ja'Maine Billups, who earned all-Big 12 honors after switching from tailback to safety during fall

two-a-day football practices. Cornerback Ellis Hobbs earned all-Big 12 recognition in 2003.

Ash was formerly defensive coordinator at Drake, when the Bulldogs won the 1998 Pioneer Conference title. Drake ranked eighth nationally in 1999 NCAA Division I-AA total defense in his second season as four Drake defenders earned all-conference honors.

A native of Ottumwa, Iowa, Ash lettered twice as a safety at Drake. The 30-year-old Ash earned a bachelor's degree in secondary education from Drake in 1996. After working one year as a graduate assistant with the Drake secondary, he moved on to Princeton in the spring of 1997, where he worked with the Tiger secondary.

Ash and his wife, Jessica, live in Ames with their son, Tanner, and daughter, Jacey.

Assistant Coaches



DeMontie Cross Outside Linebackers

DeMontie Cross, the all-time leading tackler in Missouri history, has made an immediate impact on Iowa State's defense after joining the Cyclone coaching staff in March 2001. Cross' linebackers contributed to Iowa State's best total defensive effort since 1992, as the Cyclones ranked 34th nationally in 2001. He also developed Jeremy Loyd from a junior college player into an all-conference performer who now plays for the St. Louis Rams of the NFL.

Loyd was named co-defensive MVP in 2001 and 2002.

Cross spent the 2000 season coaching a defensive backfield at Sam Houston State that ranked second nationally. Cross' Sam Houston State pass defense ranked second among 122 NCAA Division I-AA teams in 2000, allowing just 121 passing yards per game.

As a player at Missouri, Cross was team captain in 1996 and was named the team's defensive player of the year that season. He was selected to play in the 1996 Blue-Grey All-Star Game.

A 1997 Missouri graduate with a bachelor's degree in business management, Cross made 415 career stops at free safety for the Tigers from 1994-96. He received second-team all-conference honors from the Big Eight in 1995 and the Big 12 in 1996. Cross, who played prep football at Hazelwood East High School in St. Louis, Mo., received the Athletic Director's Leadership Award in 1996.

He lives in Ames with his wife, Erika, and daughter, Jadyn.



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Assistant Coaches



Todd Fitch
Quarterbacks

Todd Fitch, who has worked under legendary head coaches Don Nehlen, Earle Bruce and most recently Lou Holtz at South Carolina, joined the Iowa State coaching staff as quarterbacks coach in January.

Fitch was the South Carolina quarterbacks coach in 2003 after a year as running backs coach and three seasons as the Gamecocks' wide receivers coach — all under Holtz. During Fitch's tenure at USC, the

Gamecocks appeared in the 2001 and 2002 Outback Bowls.

A pair of Gamecock players coached by Fitch -- fullback Andrew Pinnock and tailback Ryan Brewer -- both played in Senior Bowl games and wide receiver Brian Scott prospered under Fitch's coaching, winning the team's MVP honors in 2001.

Fitch came to the Gamecock program from the University of Connecticut, where he worked under Skip Holtz. Fitch was on the staff at UConn for five seasons and coordinated the offense for the Huskies in his final three years there. In 1998, UConn won a school-record 10 games and was nationally ranked four of the five years Fitch was there. Under Coach Fitch's tutelage in 1998, UConn quarterback Shane Stafford finished his career eighth on the list for passing efficiency in the history of Division I-AA.

Fitch is an 1986 graduate of Ohio Wesleyan, where he was a three-year starter at defensive back and an all-league performer. He and his wife, Julie, have a son, Curtis, and a daughter, Peyton.



Mike Grant
Wide Receivers

Mike Grant has coached wide receivers at Iowa State the past two seasons and his crew of pass catchers have broken a slew of Cyclone school records. Under Grant, wide receivers Lane Danielson, Jack Whitver, Lance Young and Jamaul Montgomery finished their careers in 2003 as the most prolific receiving corps in Iowa State history. That quartet finished their careers with a total of 433 receptions for 6,373 yards

and 37 touchdowns.

Grant joined the Iowa State staff as assistant secondary coach in 1998 and was the running backs coach in 2001, mentoring Ennis Haywood, who rushed for 1,169 yards that season. Grant, who lettered at quarterback on three Nebraska bowl teams, came to ISU from James Madison University, where he coached tight ends and wide receivers.

Grant was an academic all-Big Eight quarterback on Nebraska teams that earned three Orange Bowl berths, in addition to Fiesta and Citrus Bowl appearances, during his playing career. The native of Tampa, Fla., earned a pair of bachelor's degrees from Nebraska. Grant was a graduate assistant coach working with the Husker tight ends and wide receivers from 1994-96. This experience included being a part of two Nebraska national championship teams. Grant assisted the Nebraska recruiting coordinator in 1993.

Grant, his wife, Nina, and daughter, Mireia, reside in Ames.

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The stature of Iowa State's football program has literally grown by leaps and bounds since Dan McCarney came to Ames. Most of the credit for those

improvements must go to Cyclone strength coach Matt McGettigan. McGettigan came to Iowa State with head coach Dan McCarney after serving as assistant strength and conditioning coach at Notre Dame since 1990.

Prior to his work with the Fighting Irish, McGettigan served as the strength and conditioning coordinator for the University of Wisconsin-Platteville from 1987-90. McGettigan earned his master's degree in 1989.

McGettigan completed his undergraduate work in physical education at Luther College in Decorah, Iowa, in 1987, where he was a member of the football team. He is a member of the National Strength and Conditioning Association. In January 1989, McGettigan received his certification as a Strength and Conditioning Specialist.

A native of Darlington, Wis., McGettigan is married to the former Darla Hook of Charles City, Iowa. They have a daughter, Mariah, and a son, Colin.

Assistant Coaches



Mike Nelson Defensive Line

Mike Nelson's impact on the Iowa State defense was immediate and has remained constant. That fact was affirmed last season, when true freshman Jason Berryman was named Big 12 Defensive Newcomer of the Year. A pair of his former players, defensive tackle James Reed and defensive end Reggie Hayward, earned all-league recognition in 1999 and 2000 and are in the NFL.

Nelson has served as defensive line coach at Missouri (1985-86) and Kansas State (1989). He also spent three seasons coaching linebackers and the defensive line for Edmonton of the Canadian Football League. Nelson began coaching at Southern Illinois before spending one season in the Ohio high school ranks. He worked as defensive coordinator at Norfolk State (1972) before returning to, Dayton, in 1973. He then moved to Virginia (1975-76) as the secondary coach and Ball State, where he was outside linebackers coach. Nelson spent five seasons as outside linebackers coach at Wisconsin.

Nelson jumped to the CFL for three seasons before moving to Missouri and then San Diego State, where he coached inside linebackers and the defensive line. He was the defensive line coach at Rutgers (1993-95) for three seasons before going to Oregon State.

Nelson earned his bachelor's degree from Dayton in 1969. He was a four-year letterwinner for the Flyer football squad. He earned his master's degree at Southern Illinois in 1970.

Nelson and his wife, Betsy, have three sons, Kurt, Eric and Mark.

Don Knock
Director of Operations

Don Knock, a member of the Iowa Football Coaches Hall of Fame, returned to Iowa State in 2002 as director of football operations after a year at Nebraska-Omaha. Knock coached Cedar Rapids Kennedy to six state playoff berths at the Cougar helm and coached Grundy Center to the 1984 Iowa Class 2A state high school title.

Knock played on Central's 1974 NCAA Division III national title squad and was a captain of the 1975 Central squad. He earned a bachelor's degree in 1976. Knock signed a free agent contract with the Oakland Raiders after graduation and joined the Central College coaching staff later that fall.

Knock began coaching at Rockwell-Swaledale in 1977, where he taught and was head football coach for three years. Knock then spent one academic year at South Dakota, where he was graduate assistant while earning a master's degree.

Knock moved to Grundy Center in 1981, where his teams compiled a 48-11 record and twice qualified for the state playoffs under Iowa's old eight-team bracket formula. He moved on to Cedar Rapids Kennedy in 1987, where his teams were 66-61.

Knock and his wife Cindy have four children; Kyle, a former tight end for ISU; Scot, a student administrative assistant to the ISU football staff; Beau and Jordan.

Graduate Assistant (Offense)

Sean Coughlin, a former three-time all-Pioneer Conference offensive guard at Drake, joined the Iowa State football staff in January 2004 after coaching three seasons at his alma mater. Coughlin earned All-America honors from the *Football Gazette* his final two seasons at Drake. The Kildeer, Ill., native earned his bachelor's degree in 2001.

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Athletics Director Bruce Van De Velde



Bruce Van De Velde's progressive leadership has spanned four years of athletic and academic achievement at Iowa State University. His vision for the future of Cyclone athletics is affirmed by the success of Iowa State student-athletes in collegiate competition, the classroom and by the continued improvement of Iowa State's athletic facilities.

"Iowa State University's Athletic Department is making great strides under Bruce's leadership," ISU President Gregory L. Geoffroy said.

"We're very proud of the accomplishments of our Cyclone student-athletes, coaches and staff, and Bruce and his staff work very hard to create an environment that supports and encourages high achievement in athletics and academic work."

Van De Velde's tenure at Iowa State already includes an unprecedented three-straight bowl appearances and the highest national AP football poll ranking (ninth) in school history. Total attendance in 2002 and 2003 home football games exceeded 300,000, the highest ISU watermark since 1985. The emergence of the Cyclone football program on a national level with Van De Velde at the department helm was affirmed in 2002, when Iowa State was chosen to play Florida State in the Eddie Robinson Classic. The game marked the Cyclones' first ever preseason classic appearance in school history.

In 2001, *The Sporting News* rated Iowa State as the seventh-best athletic program among more than 115 NCAA Division I-A programs nationally. The ranking considered competitive success, graduation rates, fan support and NCAA compliance to determine national rank. Iowa State joined Wisconsin, Florida, Oklahoma and Notre Dame as the only schools nationally to have its football and men's and women's basketball teams ranked in their respective final 2000-01 polls by The Associated Press.

Recent success under Van De Velde's leadership has positioned ISU for future achievement. During Van De Velde's tenure at Iowa State the men's and women's basketball teams have won Big 12 Conference Championships and reached the NIT Final Four in 2004. The ISU football, gymnastics, wrestling, women's track and women's and men's basketball teams have received national recognition.

Iowa State received full NCAA certification in 2003, affirming Van De Velde's commitment to managing the Cyclone athletic program with the highest of standards and integrity.

Van De Velde has focused on generating new revenue for the department and has balanced Iowa State's annual operating budget in each of the last four fiscal years. Iowa State's actual operating revenue increased 43 percent, from \$19.6 million in fiscal year 2000 to \$28 million in fiscal year 2004. Revenue generated from television and radio, ticket sales, annual donations, licensing, concessions, marketing and sponsorships reached an all-time high in 2004.

Iowa State's graduation rate of 89 percent for student-athletes that complete their eligibility ranks second in the Big 12 Conference. Minority student-athlete graduation rates have doubled. During Van De Velde's tenure, 42 Cyclone student-athletes have been honored as academic All-Americans and 402 student-athletes have been recognized on the Big 12 Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.

Each year, the ISU athletic department honors student-athletes for academic achievement, including earning grade-point averages of at least 3.0. This past spring, 184 student-athletes received special department recognition. Iowa State has also honored several NCAA post-graduate scholarship award winners.

Van De Velde's 21st century vision for the future of Iowa State athletics can be seen in the continued funding and construction of first-class facilities to support ISU's program. The \$10 million Steve and Debbie Bergstrom Indoor Training Facility opened in March 2004. Van De Velde crafted a partnership with Musco Lighting to install permanent lighting in Jack Trice Stadium and in the Cyclone Soccer Complex. A state-of-the-art video board, new scoreboard, renovated restroom and concession stands and expanded seating and parking lots made their debut with the 2002 season and dramatically enhanced the gameday atmosphere at Jack Trice Stadium. The men's and women's basketball locker rooms and offices in Hilton Coliseum have been remodeled. Improvements have been made to the basketball and volleyball practice facilities. New permanent seating and stadium upgrades for the ISU softball complex are currently underway as is the planning and fund raising for a new academic success center for student-athletes. Van De Velde is also currently overseeing the addition of a short range golf and heated bay practice facility at Veenker Golf Course.

Van De Velde negotiated a \$9.4 million, five-year multimedia marketing rights contract with ESPN/Clear Channel Sports and Cyclone Sports Marketing. The contract strengthened the Cyclone Radio and Television Network including the addition of KCRG-TV and KWKB-TV in Cedar Rapids and KMA-AM in Shenandoah in Southwest Iowa. The Cyclones opened the 2002 college football season on national television in the Eddie Robinson Classic against Florida State. The Cyclone Capital City Classic, an annual basketball doubleheader to be played in the new Wells Fargo Arena in Des Moines and televised by ESPN will tip off in 2005. Over 30,000 ISU fans have traveled to bowl games with the Iowa State football team over the last four years.

Recognizing that program continuity and leadership have been major contributors to Iowa State's competitive success, Van De Velde renegotiated the contracts of football coach Dan McCarney and head women's basketball coach Bill Fennelly. Van De Velde hired men's basketball coach Wayne Morgan, who won 20 games in his first season, and head women's soccer coach Rebecca Hornbacher.

Van De Velde currently serves on the NCAA Championships and Competition Cabinet and the NCAA Football Issues committee. He has served on the NCAA Division I-A Athletics Directors Strategic Planning Committee, the NCAA Committee for Financial Aid and on peer review teams for NCAA certification. He currently serves on the Big 12 Conference Finance, Bowl and Administrative Committees.

Van De Velde's last stop before returning home to Ames was at the University of Oklahoma, where he served as Senior Associate Director during the Sooners' 2000 national football championship run. Van De Velde directed the Campaign for Sooner Sports, a \$100 million capital campaign to fund facility improvements and scholarship endowments. Van De Velde has also held senior administrative positions at the University of Missouri, Kansas State and Utah State Universities.

Van De Velde, a Sterling, Ill., native and his wife, Debbie, have a daughter, Ashley, born May 12, 2000. Debbie is a graduate of Kansas State University. An Iowa State graduate, Van De Velde earned a master's degree from the University of Iowa and has completed course work toward a doctorate in education from Kansas State.



ISU Football Gameday Information

Carry-in Packages & Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium video cameras, bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team and removal from the stadium.

Coolers, Chairs & Umbrellas

As a courtesy to neighboring guests, spectators are asked NOT to bring lawnchairs, strollers, umbrellas or coolers into the stands.

Re-Entry Policy

Patrons leaving the stadium during the game will be given a handstamp for re-admission. Patrons must have a ticket stub and their hand stamped for re-admission into the stadium. Re-entry will only be allowed at gates 2 and 4. No pass outs will be allowed before kickoff.

Public Telephones

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands along the concourse walkway.

Field Access

The athletic department asks that all fans refrain from going on the playing field at any time. Any person(s) entering the playing field will be subject to arrest and prosecution.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by the Director of Event Management, Joe Swingle (Jacobson Building) before noon on the day prior to the game. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Restrooms

Restrooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Smoking Policy

In accordance with Iowa State's smoking policy, there will be no smoking in areas where the general public congregates at Jack Trice Stadium. There is no smoking allowed in the seating areas or by the concession stands. The designated smoking areas are behind the restrooms along the grass area.

Distractions

We want to make football a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage fans to be respectful of those around them in the stadium. In the event there is an unreasonable distraction, please take the following steps to help control the undesirable behavior:

- Note the seating section, row and seat

numbers and inform the usher in the section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and take appropriate action.

- If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from an uniformed police officer to request improvements of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.
- An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation in the next season's ticket assignments.

Courtesy Carts

Iowa State offers courtesy cart service from Gates 1, 3 and 5 beginning one and one-half hours before kick-off until 10 minutes into the first quarter and resuming midway through the fourth quarter. Anyone needing transportation during the game should go to the Guest Services table behind the Club Section (east side) or Guest Services table near the elevator tower (west side) for assistance.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 16, 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available in the south endzone bleachers. Please notify the ticket office prior to game day to obtain tickets.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked in the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact an usher to request medical assistance.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located throughout the stadium parking areas.

Public Parking

Lots open six hours before kickoff. Parking prices are as follows: automobiles (\$8-\$10), RVs (\$20-\$30), buses (\$20-\$30).

National Cyclone Club Parking

Cyclone Club members who contribute at the Varsity level (\$50) and above receive a season parking pass for

football in the lots north of the Jacobson Building. Club members wanting to park in the general lots will be required to pay the public rate. Donor parking for RVs and buses are in lot D-3 and S-8.

Handicap Parking

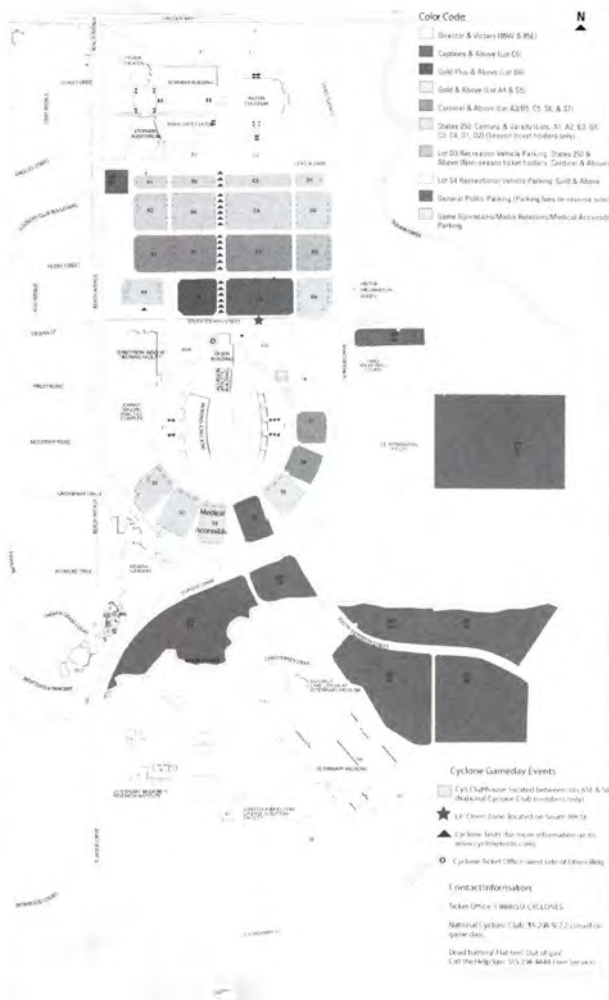

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Head Coach Dan McCarney



When 2001 Big 12 Coach of the Year Dan McCarney laid out his vision for the future of Iowa State football at a press conference to announce his arrival in Ames nearly 10 years ago, he stressed that the program's transformation would not occur overnight. McCarney possessed enthusiasm, unwavering optimism and a seemingly endless

source of energy. His background in college football programs that had gone from perennial losers to consistent winners made him a perfect choice for the Cyclone helm. There were more than a few skeptics. Iowa State was coming off a winless season, hadn't had a winning campaign since 1989 and the Cyclones' last bowl trip was in 1978. McCarney has brought winning and stability to Iowa State as the longest-serving Cyclone head football coach in school history, taking ISU to three straight bowl games. Only Kansas State head coach Bill Snyder has a longer tenure in the Big 12 Conference as the 2004 season marks McCarney's 10th year at the Cyclone helm.

In 2002, McCarney took Iowa State where it had never been before, a third-straight bowl game despite playing the toughest schedule in school history. Iowa State's 23 victories between 2000 and 2002 was the second-best three-season mark in school history. Underscoring its new national status, the Cyclones opened the 2002 season in the Eddie Robinson Football Classic against Florida State. The 2002 campaign was one to remember. The Cyclones beat intrastate rival Iowa for the fifth-straight season and third-straight time in Iowa City. Iowa State's 36-14 win over Nebraska was the Cyclones' biggest margin of victory in the series since 1899. ISU's No. 9 position in The Associated Press poll in October was the highest in school history. The Cyclones' eight-week tenure in the AP top 25 equaled ISU's longest stay in Iowa State history. They said it couldn't be done at Iowa State. The naysayers didn't know Dan McCarney.

Powered by a singular sense of purpose, McCarney steadily molded Iowa State's football program, bringing in a top-notch coaching staff and the best recruiting classes in recent memory. Backed by a university administration committed to providing state-of-the-art facilities, McCarney relentlessly exorcised

the demons that had plagued Cyclone football. After his first teams laid a foundation for success, the 2000 Iowa State unit, led by 25 seniors who had bought into McCarney's vision, remained undeterred by the skeptics. Following McCarney's blueprint, coaches and players went where no Cyclone team had gone; winning nine games, including a 37-29 victory over Pittsburgh in the Insight.com Bowl. Under McCarney, the 2000 AP Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year runner-up, that success continued in 2001, despite the loss of 15 starters. A 7-5 Iowa State squad earned an Independence Bowl berth, marking the school's first back-to-back bowl appearances since the 1977-78 seasons.

Anyone who has watched McCarney's rise in the coaching ranks would not be surprised by the effort of his national-caliber coaching staff. A native of Iowa City, Iowa, McCarney was instrumental in rebuilding efforts that produced Big Ten titles and Rose Bowl berths at both Iowa and Wisconsin, two schools that regularly finished near the bottom of the league before his arrival.

McCarney, 50, coached at Iowa for 13 seasons (1977-89), including 11 years under Hayden Fry, before becoming the defensive coordinator at Wisconsin under Barry Alvarez in 1990.

McCarney's defense was the foundation of the Wisconsin rebuilding effort. In the four seasons prior to his arrival in Wisconsin the Badgers had a 9-36 record, and attendance was at its lowest mark since World War II.

In 1993, Wisconsin went 10-1-1, claimed its first Big Ten title in 31 years and scored a 21-16 win over UCLA in the Rose Bowl. Attendance at Wisconsin's Camp Randall Stadium climbed more than 30,000 a game, and sellouts of more than 77,000 were the norm.

During Wisconsin's Rose Bowl season, the Badgers ranked 19th nationally against the rush, allowing just 130.3 yards per game, the sixth-best mark in school history. The team allowed an average of 16.3 points per game, its best effort in 30 years. The Badger defense also intercepted an NCAA-best 23 passes and created 34 turnovers, including six against UCLA in the Rose Bowl.

A 1975 graduate of Iowa, McCarney coached the Hawkeyes in eight consecutive bowl games, including the 1982 and 1986 Rose Bowls. The three-year letterman on the offensive line for Iowa (1972-74) was captain of the 1974 Hawkeye squad.

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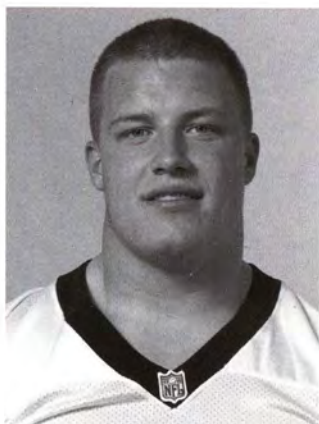
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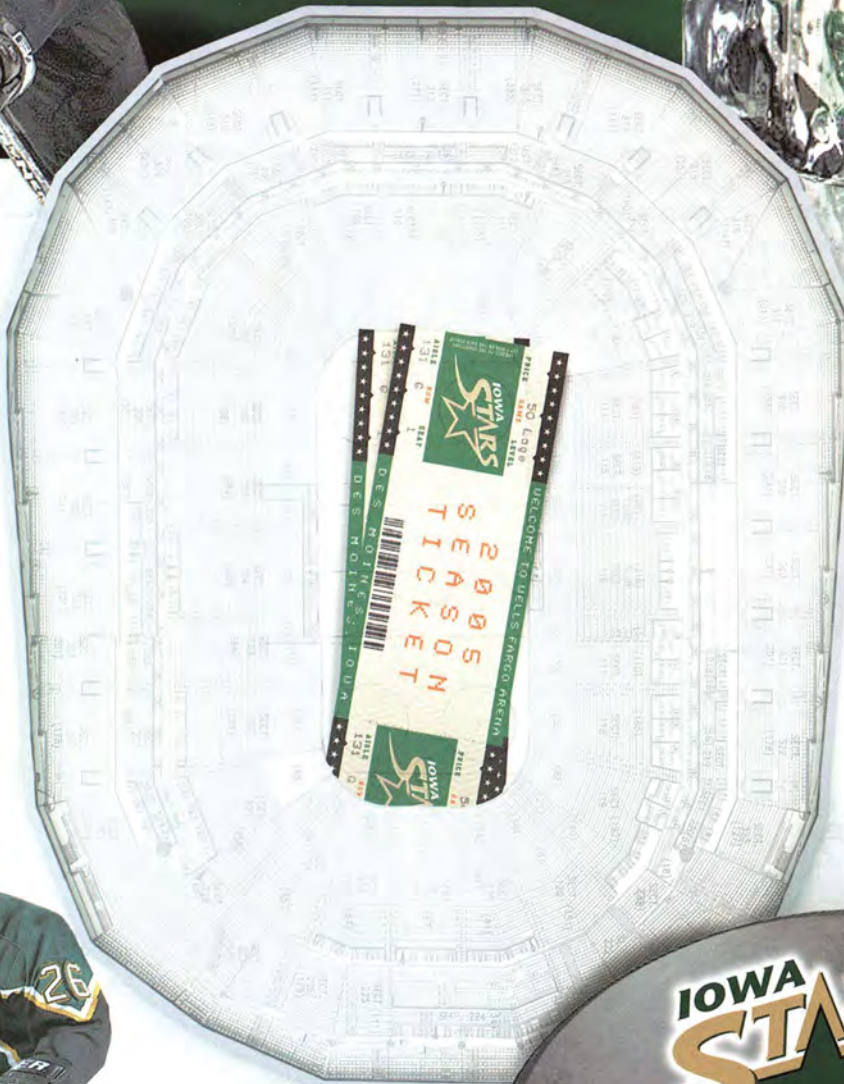
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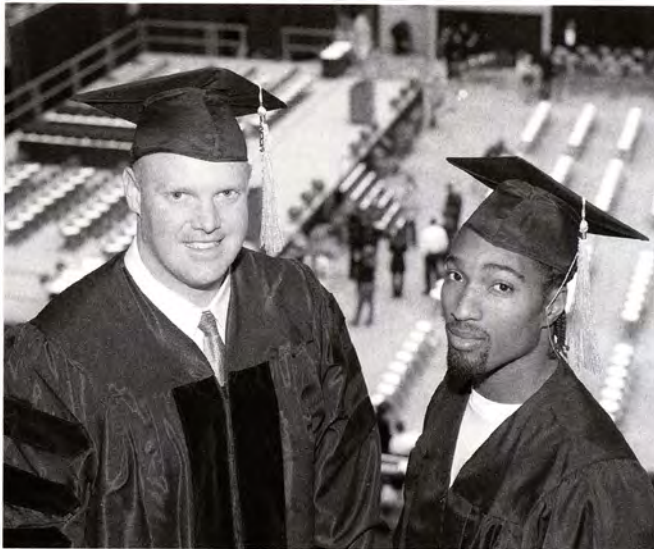
ISU Student-Athlete Services

Tutorial Services

Student-Athlete Services collaborates with the ISU Academic Success Center to provide tutorial services to all student-athletes. The ASC tutorial staff is introduced to NCAA rules and regulations, and closely monitored to insure that student-athletes are receiving quality services. The intent of the tutoring program is to supplement and support all of the sound education practices that are imperative for academic success for all student-athletes. The tutors and students work together to develop the independent thinking and learning skills necessary to achieve positive results without compromising the integrity of the education process.

Learning Center

SAS provides educational and study environments for its student-athletes in the form of "learning centers." Student-athletes are strongly encouraged to utilize the learning centers as often as necessary to develop the appropriate study and learning skills to become better students. Study groups and learning strategists are also available at these learning centers. Learning strategists help students to develop their study and learning techniques. 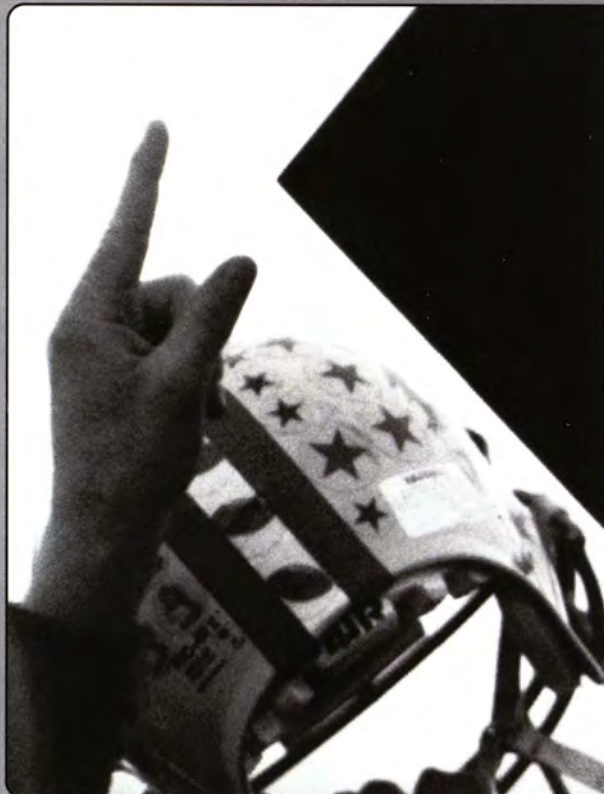
Referral Services

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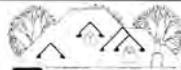
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Steve and Debbie Bergstrom Indoor Training Facility

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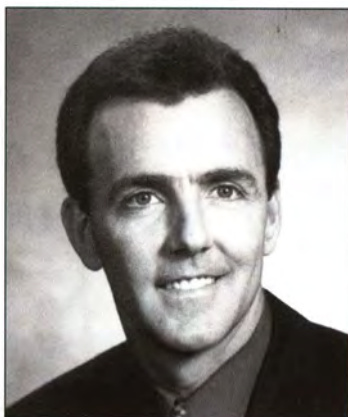
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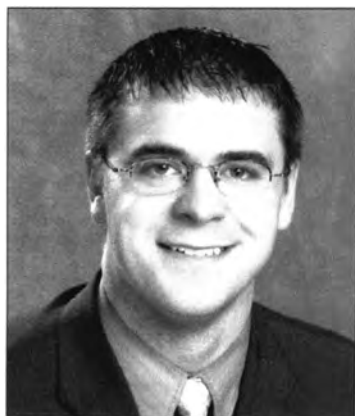
