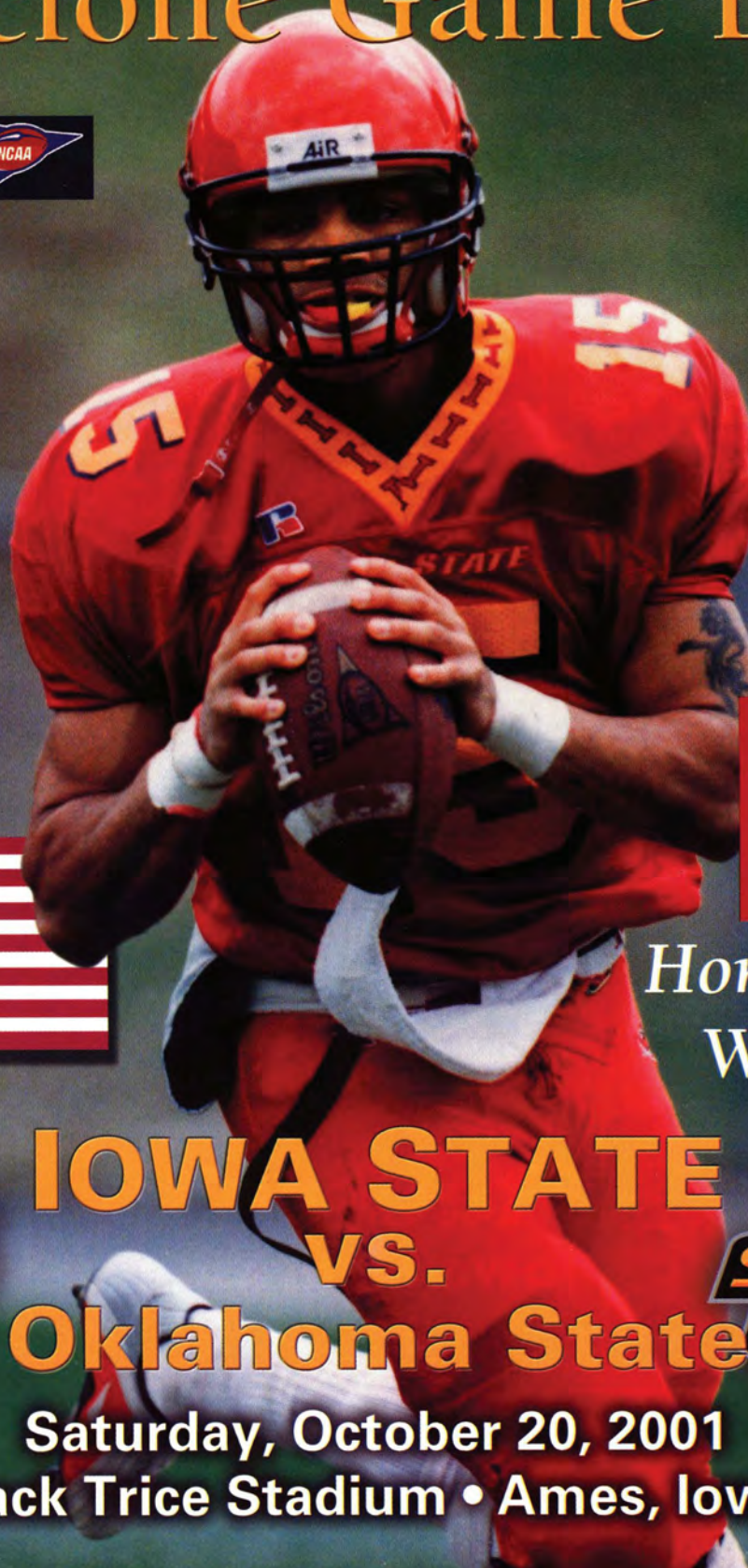

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ISU Campus Life

Since it opened in 1869 as Iowa's land-grant university, Iowa State University has worked to bring educational, economic, social and cultural progress to our state, nation and world.

Today, Iowa State is a broad-based university of international stature, whose more than 26,000 students come from all 50 states and nearly 120 other nations, and include more National Merit Scholars than all but six other public universities in the nation. Students can choose from among more than 200 programs of study leading to baccalaureate degrees in the colleges of Agriculture, Business, Design, Education, Engineering, Family and Consumer Sciences and Liberal Arts and Sciences, including many ranked among the top 10 nationally. The College of Veterinary Medicine offers the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree and graduate

students can choose from among 200 fields of study leading to master's, doctor of philosophy and specialist degrees.

With more than 14,000 computer workstations, Iowa State has one of the most extensive campus computing systems in the nation and is one of Yahoo!Internet Life magazine's top 20 "Wired Universities." In addition, Iowa State is significantly expanding the number of opportunities students have to study and live abroad as part of their academic programs.

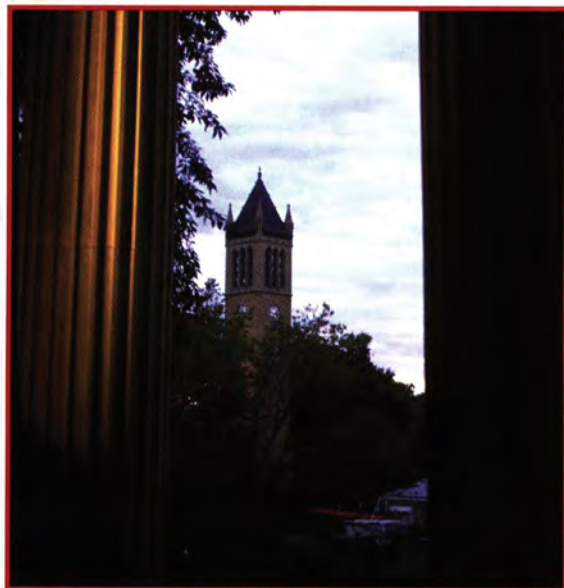
Students who come to Iowa State also discover a university community that is both supportive and filled with opportunities, so much so that Iowa State was one of 14 colleges and universities included in a national study of factors contributing to a high quality of student life.

The Greek system is nationally recognized, as is the residence hall system, which is organized into a series of individually-named, self-governing "houses," providing students with a more autonomous and personalized living setting. The residence hall system is undergoing a \$100 million improvement and renovation program to provide a higher quality living environment for students. The lectures program has won national awards, and Iowa State offers nearly 500 clubs and organizations for students to pursue interests and develop leadership skills. An extensive intramural program boasts one of the highest participation rates in the nation, offering all popular sports and such unique activities as innertube water basketball, broomball and mud volleyball.

Student facilities are among the best at any university. The three-level, 220,000-square foot Lied Recreation Facility includes 20 basketball courts, nine racquetball courts, a 300-meter ground-level track, an elevated jogging track and extensive weight and aerobics facilities. In 1997, Iowa State opened a new Student Health Center to provide improved and expanded medical and rehabilitation services, nutrition and wellness programs and health education for its students. A new indoor ice arena opened its doors in April, a cooperative effort between the city of Ames and Iowa State University to support the rapid growth of recreational and competitive ice skating.

Iowa State's park-like central campus is recognized as one of the most beautiful in the nation. It includes nearly 125 major buildings and structures, from beautifully restored historic landmarks to striking examples of modern architecture; hundreds of interior and exterior art works, including the largest Grant Wood murals and the nation's largest public collection of Christian Petersen sculptures; and the recently renovated Lake LaVerne.

Iowa State's south campus, where much of the university's recent expansion has occurred, includes the College of Veterinary Medicine, Jack Trice Stadium, the Reiman Gardens, the ISU Research Park, and the Iowa State Center, a four-building entertainment and continuing education complex that attracts some of the top names in popular and classical music, national theater productions and international art exhibitions.



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Cyclones vs. Cowboys

After two weeks on the road, Iowa State returns to Jack Trice for a homecoming match-up with Oklahoma State. The Cyclones are 33-49-6 in homecoming games, earning their last homecoming victory over Baylor, 24-17, in 1997. ISU is 3-0-1 vs. OSU in homecoming battles and looks to improve upon that mark today.

The Cowboys (2-4, 0-3) come to Ames looking for their first Big 12 Conference win of the season after falling to then No. 8 Texas, 45-17, Oct. 13. Oklahoma State jumped out to a 10-0 lead vs. the Longhorns but then gave up 45 unanswered points in the loss.

The Cyclones (4-1, 2-1) are coming off a 20-14 win over Missouri Oct. 13 in Columbia. The win is ISU's seventh in its last 11 conference games.

Oklahoma State's offense is led by sophomore QB **Aso Pogi**, who made his first start for the Cowboys against Iowa State last season in Stillwater, passing for an OSU freshman-record 328 yards. Pogi is off to good start this season, averaging 184.2 yards passing per game. His six touchdown passes and three TD runs account for nine of OSU's 14 TDs in 2001.

Sophomore WR **Rashaun Woods** is OSU's top receiver, catching 47 passes for an average of 95.5 yards per game. He caught eight passes for 81 yards, including a nine-yard TD pass vs. Texas and has scored at least one touchdown in the past three games.

The Cowboys only average 98.7 yards rushing per game and sophomore TB **Tatum Bell** accounts for 73.8 of them. Bell averages 3.8 yards per carry and has found the end zone three times this season for Oklahoma State.

Iowa State's offense, which averages 404 yards total offense per game, only managed 282 yards total offense at Missouri. The Tigers held the Cyclones to their lowest offensive output in nine games, dating back to a 30-7 loss vs. Texas A&M in 2000.

ISU junior QB **Seneca Wallace** will aim to put the Cyclone offense in high gear, returning to Jack Trice for the first time since his Big 12 record-setting performance Sept. 29 vs. Baylor. Wallace went 22-for-24 and completed 18 straight passes, including four TDs, to break the conference record for consecutive passes completed. He continues to demonstrate his versatility, putting up big passing numbers as well as ranking second on the team in rushing, averaging 61.6 yards per game. Wallace ran for 73 yards on 13 carries in last week's win at Missouri.

Senior RB **Ennis Haywood** ran for 100 or more yards for the ninth time in his career at Missouri, racking up 120 yards on 27 carries. He scored his fifth and sixth touchdowns of the season on runs of 21 and four yards vs. the Tigers.

Haywood was sidelined with an injury last season when the Cyclones and Cowboys met, but sophomore RB **Michael Wagner** stepped up and set an ISU freshman record, rushing 26 times for 170 yards and two touchdowns in the Cyclone victory.

Sophomore WR **Lane Danielsen** has become a favorite target of Wallace, leading the team with 22 receptions for 331 yards. He caught three passes for 25 yards at Missouri.

Danielsen was the hero in ISU's win last season over Oklahoma State in Stillwater, catching a Sage Rosenfels 33-yard touchdown strike with 18 seconds left in the game.

Sophomore S **Elbert Craig** leads the OSU defense after finishing second on the team in tackles a year ago. He has 65 total tackles on the season, including 14 vs. Texas.

Senior LB **Dwayne Levels** is one of the best linebackers in the Big 12. Levels ranks second on the team in tackles with 54 and has totalled six tackles for a loss of 17 yards this season.

Doubts have surrounded the Iowa State defense since the season began, but the young group showed its potential at Missouri, putting up a goal-line stand in the final seconds to preserve a Cyclone victory.

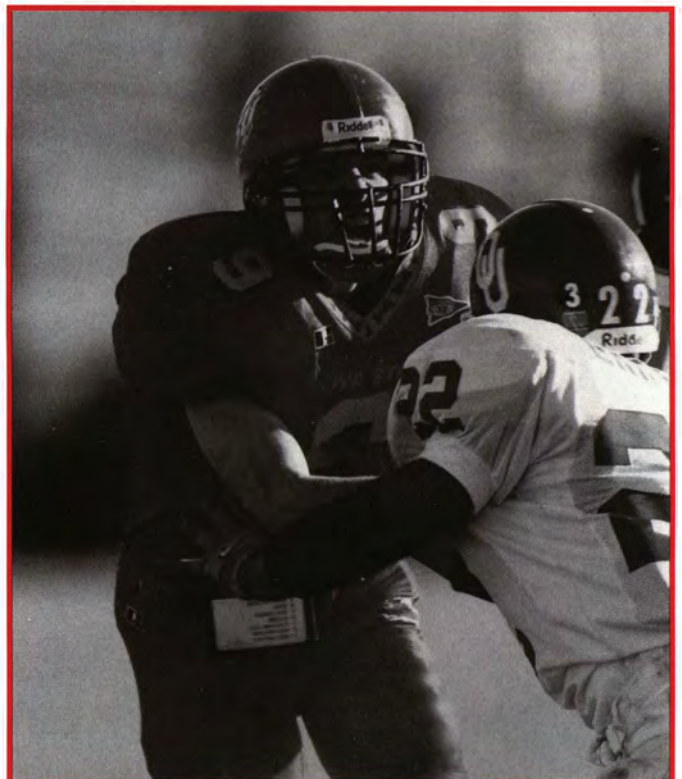
Senior DB **Adam Runk** batted away a fourth-and-goal pass with three seconds remaining to give ISU its third straight win over the Tigers. Iowa State's pass defense ranks third in the nation with an average of 139.6 yards allowed per game.

Cyclone redshirt freshman PK **Tony Yelk** leads the Big 12 in PATs, going 19-for-19 on the season. Yelk connected on field goals of 21 and 24 yards in the fourth quarter at Missouri to put ISU ahead.

Sophomore PK **Luke Phillips** has also been on fire for Oklahoma State, going 14-for-14 on PATs and 9-for-11 on field goals this season. His 48-yard field goal vs. Texas was the longest of his career.

Junior SS **Chris Massey** is also a threat on special teams for the Cowboys, averaging 35.7 yards per kick return. Against the Longhorns he returned a kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown.

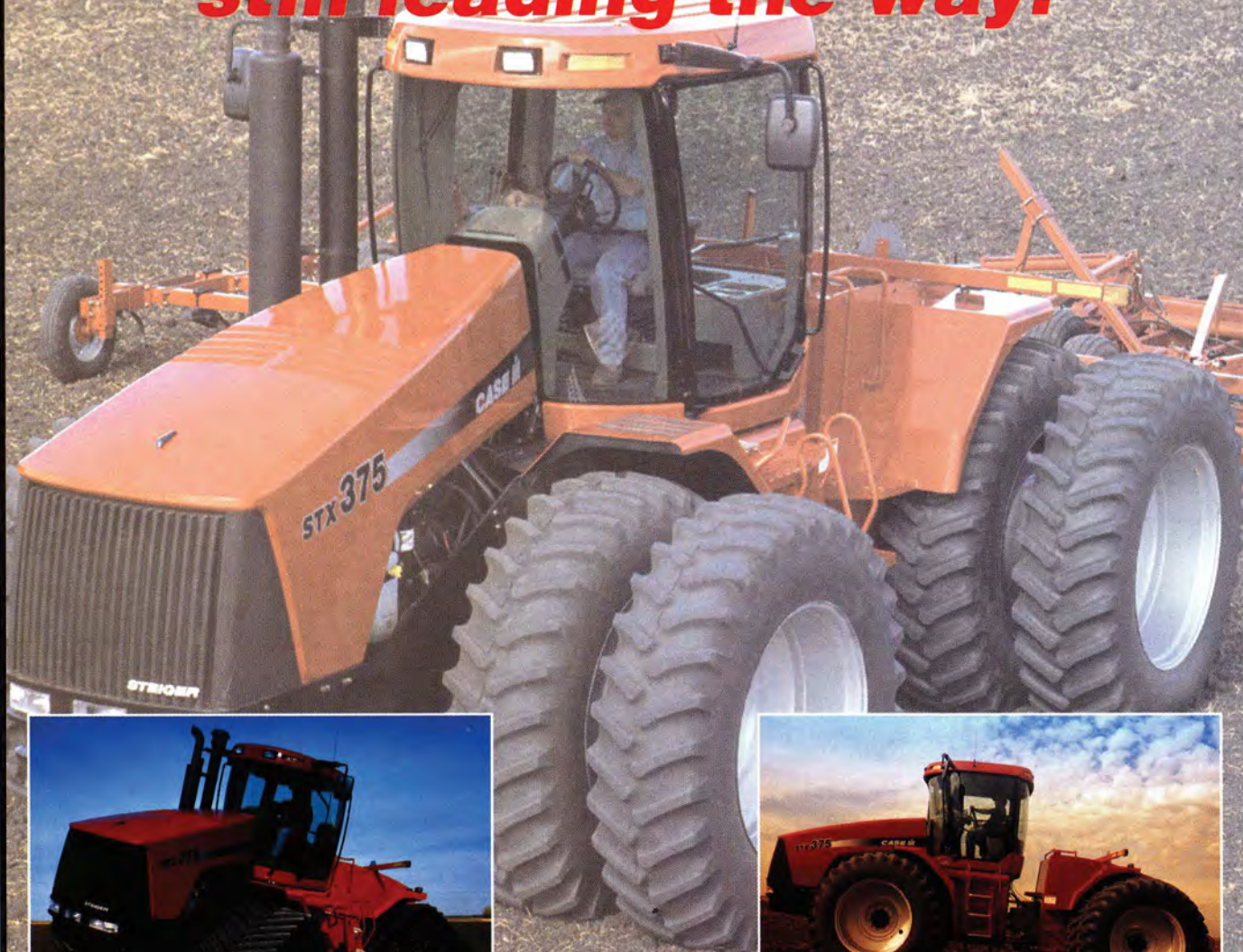

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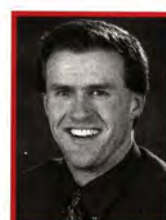

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Located in the north endzone of Jack Trice Stadium, the Jacobson Athletic Building provides a spectacular view of ISU's natural grass field. The building and field projects were financed by a \$12 million fund-raising effort -- the largest athletic capital campaign in Iowa State history. The Jacobson Athletic Building

Underscoring Iowa State's commitment to a winning football program is the \$10.6 million Jacobson Athletic Facility, which opened to rave reviews in 1996. The Jacobson Athletic Building provides the ISU football program with a state-of-the-art office and training complex. The facility is located on the north end of Jack Trice Stadium.

The facility includes:

- a football office complex
- expanded strength and conditioning work areas
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- a football equipment unit

The Jacobson Building also houses almost all of Iowa State's athletic department staff, including offices for Olympic sport coaches, camps, development, marketing, media relations, ticket operations and ISU's athletics hall of fame. The construction included a substantial face lift to the Olsen Building, renovating its space to create the strength and conditioning facility and the R. Earl Feldman Athletic Health Care Center.



The Jacobson Athletic Building is a state-of-the-art facility large enough to house the Iowa State football program offices, a computer-generated video center, football student-athlete academic counselors' offices and coaches' meeting rooms.



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Q&A With Lorenzo White

Q Do you feel there has been a change of attitude on the team with the success of last season?

A. There has been a big change. Everybody is more confident and we know we can win now.

Q. How are the newcomers on the offensive line coming around?

A. Zach (Butler) has had a little bit of experience before and had tremendous shoes to fill at center in replacing All-American Ben Bruns. But we haven't missed a step. Zach has done a great job in everything. Bob (Montgomery) is doing a great job as well. He really surprised me on how strong he is. I mean he has tremendous strength. Those two have really made our line not drop-off whatsoever.

Q. What's your most memorable moment in a Cyclone uniform?

A. For me, it was the first time I walked into Jack Trice Stadium on game day. I never pictured myself playing Division I football, especially in the Big 12. That first moment when I stepped out on the field with the crowd hollering, it made me feel real proud.

Q. What is it like to have such a great runningback (Ennis Haywood) and quarterback (Seneca Wallace) to block for?

A. Those two really make my job easy. If you make a mistake, they have the talent to make up for it. If you get beat, they will just juke that dude and go on like nothing happen. When Seneca is sitting back in the pocket, he can pick people apart with his passing and running.

Q. Does Seneca or Ennis take the offensive line out for dinner for their efforts?

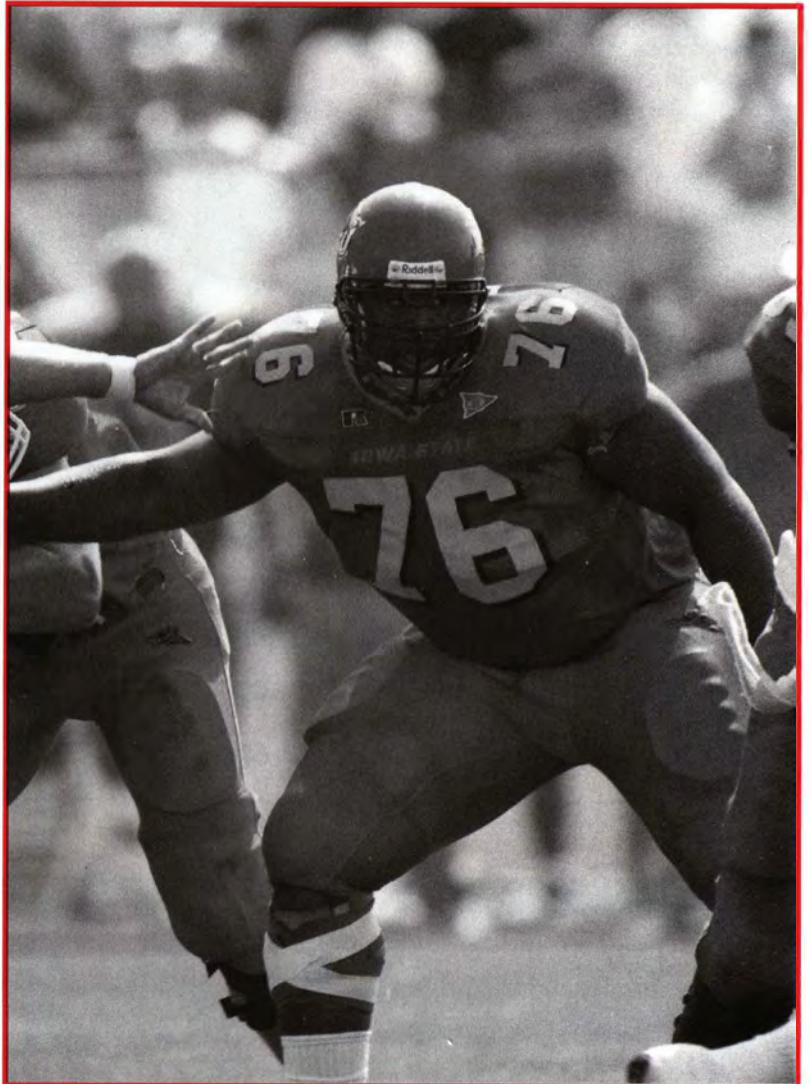
A. Nah, Nah, they are too cheap. But seriously, we are really good friends and we hang out together outside of practice.

Q. How tough is it for you big offensive lineman to travel?

A. Those planes seats are pretty small. The seniors get priority on where to sit and usually take the aisle seats because you can stretch out more. This year as a senior, I get an aisle seat, so it is not so bad.

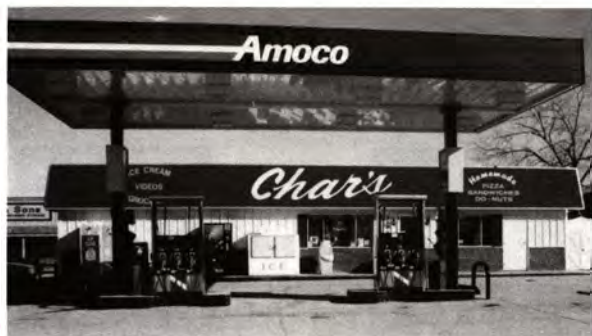
Q. Tell us about the Big Sexy tatoo.

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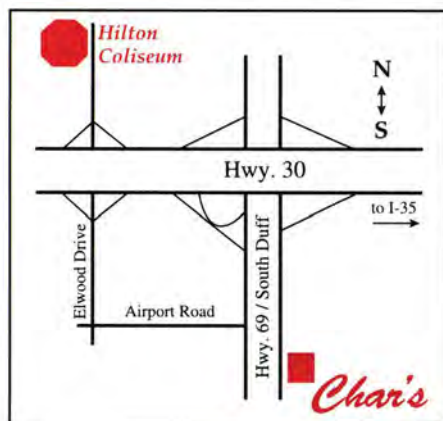

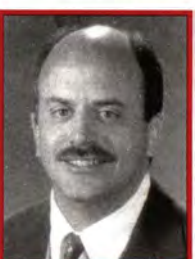

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Secondary/Special Teams

Underscoring Dan McCarney's ability to attract top-flight coaches to Iowa State, Bob Elliott, universally respected as a coach, mentor and teacher in Iowa and across the country, joined the Cyclone coaching staff in March 2000 as associate head coach, secondary coach and special teams coordinator. That move paid immediate bowl-bound returns.

Under Elliott, Iowa State defensive backs intercepted 10 passes last fall, the highest total in eight years. Defensive back Jamarcus Powers and safety Dustin Avey earned all-Big 12

recognition. Freshman safety Marc Timmons was one of the league's best freshman and J.J. Moses was a all-conference kick returner.

Elliott was an Iowa State coach during the 1981-82 seasons under head coach Donnie Duncan. He moved on to North Carolina, where he coached from 1983-87. The former academic All-American defensive back coached at Iowa, his alma mater, for 12 seasons.

The 48-year-old Elliott and his wife, Joey, have a son, Grant (19), and a daughter, Jessica (16).

Nick Quartaro • Assistant Head Coach



Receivers

Nick Quartaro has played a key role in the success of Iowa State football. He helped build winning programs at ISU and Kansas State as an assistant coach and at Fordham and Drake as a head coach.

At ISU, he has tutored first-team all-Big 12 honorees J.J. Moses and Chris Anthony, both of whom rank among the Cyclones' all-time leading receivers. He joined Iowa State's coaching staff as assistant head coach in February of 1998, renewing a bond he forged with ISU head coach Dan McCarney when both played at Iowa.

Quartaro, who was a place-kicker for Iowa, finished his career as the Hawkeyes' second all-time leading scorer. The 1977 Iowa graduate went on to assist at Northwestern and later started Drake's NCAA Division III football program, coaching the Bulldogs from 1986-88.

Born Oct. 5, 1955, Quartaro and his wife, Stephanie, have two children, Andria (21) and Tony (17).

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Assistant Coaches

Steve Loney • Offensive Coordinator



Offensive Line

Iowa State's record-breaking offensive success underscores the leadership of offensive coordinator Steve Loney. Loney is in his fourth tour of duty with his alma mater (1974), and his second stint as ISU's offensive coordinator and offensive line coach after a pair of successful seasons as offensive coordinator at Minnesota.

The 49-year-old Loney was responsible for an offense that gained 424.4 yards per game last season, the third-best mark in school history. Iowa State offensive linemen have blocked for a 1,000-yard rusher the last six seasons, the second-longest streak nationally. ISU center Ben Bruns earned All-America honors last fall.

Loney was an offensive lineman on ISU's 1971 Sun Bowl and 1972 Liberty Bowl teams.

The Marshalltown native and his wife, Terri, a former collegiate golf coach, have three children: Matt (24), a law student at Iowa; Katie (22), a senior at ISU; and Kylan (19), a freshman basketball student-athlete at Arizona State.

John Skladany • Defensive Coordinator



Linebackers

John Skladany, who made over Iowa State's defense in his first two seasons in Ames, focused his unit's sights on forcing more take-aways. His defense responded, forcing 23 turnovers in 2000. Iowa State, which ranked 108th nationally in turnover margin in 1999, improved to 34th last season.

Skladany had already engineered major defensive reversals of fortune in Ames. Iowa State's defensive scoring average has dropped 20 points since 1997. The 51-year-old Skladany played a key role in turning Colorado State into a WAC defensive leader. He has coached several student-athletes who went on to the NFL.

A Haverhill, Mass., native, Skladany played football at Central Connecticut State and for the New England Patriots, Washington Redskins, the NFL's Birmingham Americans and the CFL's Ottawa Roughriders. Skladany and his wife, Sharon, have two daughters, Laura (18) and Stephanie (14).

Assistant Coaches

Steve Brickey • Passing Game Coordinator



Steve Brickey is in his second season at Iowa State after coaching quarterback Sage Rosenfels to one of greatest seasons by a Cyclone signal-caller in school history. Rosenfels rolled up 2,679 yards of total offense last season. His 2,298 passing yards rank third in the ISU single-season record books. He came to Ames after 12 years in the Lone Star state, most recently at North Texas.

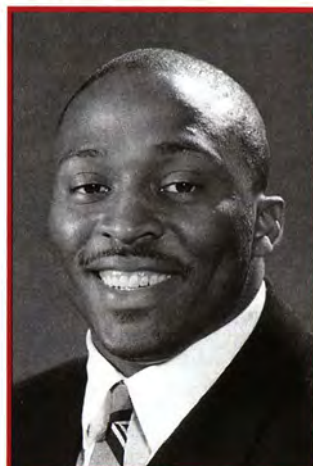
Brickey was an assistant coach at Texas from 1987-91 after tutoring quarterbacks at Texas Tech in 1986. He moved on to

serve as quarterbacks coach at Texas Christian from 1993-97.

Brickey has coached in four bowl games and helped the Indiana State football team to its only NCAA I-AA playoff berths (1983, 1984). Brickey was a member of the Sycamore staff from 1978-85.

Brickey played both quarterback and defensive back and received his degree in 1976 from Missouri, where he began his coaching career as a graduate assistant with the Tigers from 1976-77. He and his wife, Patti, have three sons: John (16), Mike (14) and Chris (27).

DeMontie Cross • Outside Linebackers



DeMontie Cross, the all-time leading tackler in Missouri history, joined the ISU coaching staff in March, after starting his coaching career at his alma mater and at Sam Houston State.

Cross' Sam Houston State pass defense ranked second among 122 NCAA Division I-AA teams last season, allowing just 121 passing yards per game. At Missouri, Cross' outside linebackers were part of a Tiger defense that consistently ranked among the NCAA's top 25 in total defense. Missouri's 1998 squad earned the Insight.com bowl championship.

As a player at MU, Cross was team captain in 1996 and was named the team's defensive player of the year that season. He received second-team all-conference honors from the Big Eight in 1995 and the Big 12 in 1996.

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Mike Grant • Running Backs

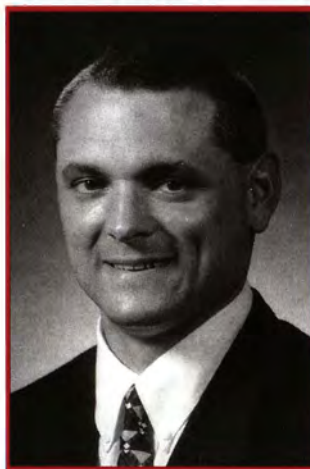

Mike Nelson • Defensive Line

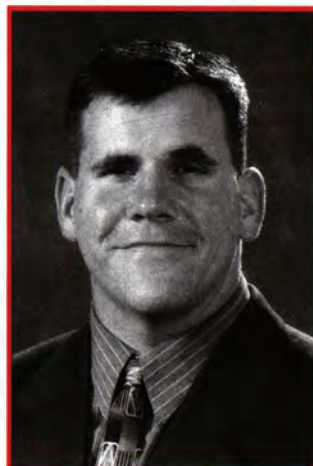


Mike Nelson came to ISU in 1997 and immediately made an impact on the Cyclone defensive line. Four defensive lineman from Iowa State's 2000 Insight.com Bowl team earned spots in NFL camps this summer, including defensive end Reggie Hayward, a third-round draft pick by the Denver Broncos.

Nelson has coached at Wisconsin and Stanford, and tutored the defensive lines at Missouri and Kansas State. Nelson started his coaching career at Southern Illinois before spending one season in the Ohio

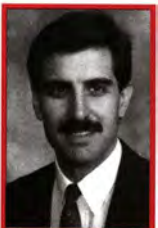

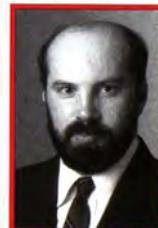

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Football Gameday Information

Carry-in Packages and Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium video cameras, bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team and removal from the stadium.

Coolers, Chairs

As a courtesy to neighboring guests, spectators are asked NOT to bring stadium chairs, lawnchairs or coolers into the stands. Back chairs made for Jack Trice Stadium seats is accepted.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be issued a pass out coupon for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-entry. No pass outs will be allowed before kickoff.

Public Telephones

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands along the concourse walkway.

Restrooms

Restrooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Field Access

The athletic department asks that all fans refrain from going on the playing field at any time. Any person(s) entering the playing field will be subject to arrest and prosecution.

Stadium Sign Policy

Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Assistant Athletic Director Frank Randall (Jacobson Building) before noon on the day prior to the game. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Lost and Found

Lost and Found is in the Ticket Office, outside Gate 5 on the west side of the Olsen Building. Items that are lost or found should be reported to ushers.

Smoking Policy

In accordance with Iowa State's smoking policy, there will be no smoking in areas where the general public congregates at Jack Trice Stadium. There is no smoking allowed in the seating areas or by the concession stands, but some designated smoking areas are located near restrooms.

Courtesy Carts

Iowa State offers courtesy cart service from Gates 1, 3, and 5 beginning one and one-half hour before kick-off until 10 minutes into the first quarter and resuming midway through the fourth quarter. Anyone needing transportation during the game should go to the NE entrance of the Club Section (east side) or the main entrance of the Concourse Suites (west side) for assistance.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 16, 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts. Please notify the ticket office prior to game day to obtain tickets.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked in the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact an usher to request medical assistance.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located throughout the stadium parking areas.

Public Parking

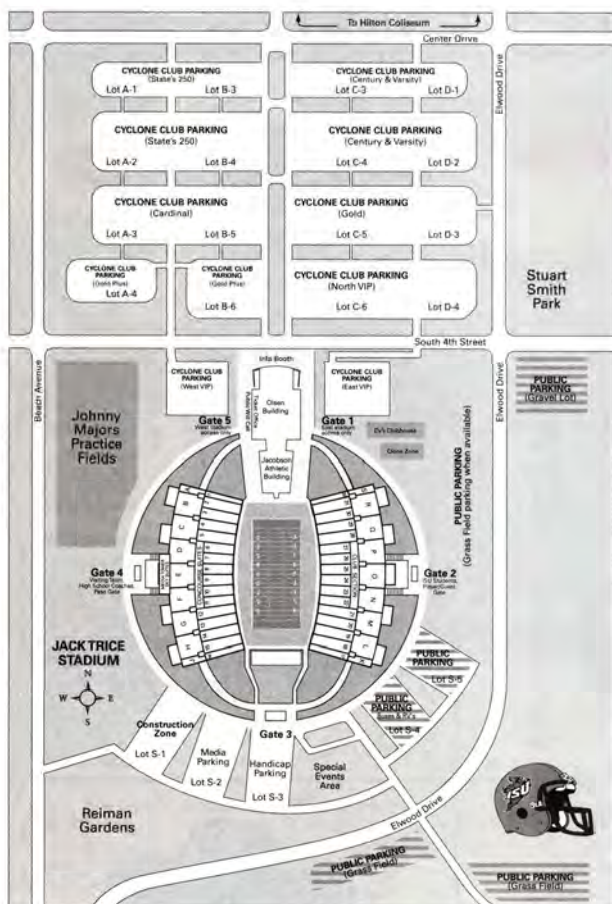

Handicap Parking

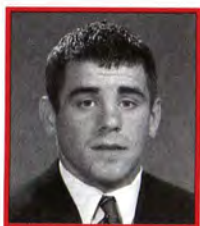

Iowa State Golf

A youth movement would be the appropriate and familiar theme for the Iowa State men's and women's golf programs in 2001-02. Both squads possess rosters laden with underclassmen and no seniors. For most teams, this would be a major concern. However, for head men's coach Jay Horton and head women's coach Julie Manning, it allows an opportunity to build a solid foundation for the future.

The Cyclone men's golfers have competed in two tournaments this fall, finishing eighth at the Nebraska Invitational and 17th at the Southern Methodist Invitational.

"We have a fairly young team with three freshmen and sophomores in our top six, but our juniors have had playing experience," Horton said. "All nine guys display a work ethic that is great. They have a passion for the game and they know how to improve on their mistakes. I definitely see our scores improving and peaking in the spring season."

Redshirt sophomore Jeremy Lyons, a native of Glenwood City, Wis., has emerged as one of the leaders on the young Cyclone squad. Currently owning a team-low 73.2 stroke average, Lyons tallied the best finish of his career earlier this season, tying for third at the Nebraska Invitational by carding a 70-75-72. Even more impressive is the fact he has not shot higher than a 76 in six competitive rounds this season.

"I am glad to have Jeremy back off his redshirt season," Horton said. "He is a special player. He has the game, mentality and work ethic to succeed at this level and beyond."

Juniors Greg Stephanson and Kevin Oswald will also figure significantly in the Cyclone fortunes. Stephanson, a native of Edmonton, Alberta, is currently second on the team with a 75.5 stroke average. Stephanson fired a career-low 70 in the second round of the Nebraska Invitational, helping him finish tied for 17th. Oswald has the most competitive Division I playing experience on the team. The Duluth, Minn., native was a regular in the ISU lineup his first two seasons, finishing second on the team in stroke average last year as a sophomore at 75.9. Oswald, who was the team's top finisher at the 2000 Big 12 Championship, currently has a 77.3 stroke average in the first two meets.

Rounding out ISU's lineup is junior Clark Smith (Rantoul, Ill.), freshman Chad Kovaleski (New Richmond, Wis.) and freshman Corey Schultz (Denison, Iowa).

The Iowa State women golfers have one tournament remaining on its fall schedule this week at the Kansas Invitational. Head coach Julie Manning is pleased with the results so far of her young squad, especially with the performance at the Big 12 Invitational. The Cyclones finished eighth out of 16 teams at the star-studded field, beating all but three Big 12 teams, losing only to perennial powers Oklahoma State, Oklahoma and Texas.

"Finishing fourth among the Big 12 teams at the Big 12 Invitational was a major statement for our young team," Manning said. "I think it is a great indicator of how good this team can be. We have a small squad (eight players), but our team chemistry is great. From spot one through five, we have as much talent as we ever had."

Junior Laura Wells had a fantastic start to the 2001-02 season, leading the team in stroke average (75.5) and finishing in the top 10 in two of the four tournaments. The Dumfries, Scotland, native was a top-five finisher at the Big 12 Invitational, outplaying some of the best players in the nation, placing third with a three-round total of 224 (74-77-73). She also tied for sixth at the Nebraska Invitational, carding rounds of 75-74-74.

"Laura has surfaced as a leader on this team," Manning said. "Her showing at the Big 12 Invitational was an excellent performance. I rank Laura as one of the better players in the Big 12, so I was not at all surprised by her performance."

Sophomore Lisa Meshke and freshman Louise Kenney have been consistent performers for ISU as well. Meshke, who hails from Blooming Prairie, Minn., is recovering from back surgery over the summer that has halted her progress. Meshke posted the lowest stroke average (77.7) for ISU as a freshman last season.

"Lisa needs to get back into the flow of competition," Manning said. "She did not play any competitive rounds since April and she still plays with a little pain. However, her surgery was successful and she is coming along."

Kenney, a native of Dunfermline Fife, Scotland, is currently second on the team with a 77.6 stroke average. Kenney has one top-10 finish to her credit in her brief ISU career, tying for ninth at the Highlands Ranch Invitational after firing rounds of 76-74 to lead ISU.

Leanne Owens, a junior from Creston, Iowa, and Sarah Gilbert, a junior from Ankeny, Iowa, complete ISU's top five. Both have played in all four tournaments, averaging an 80.0 and 80.2 stroke average, respectively.

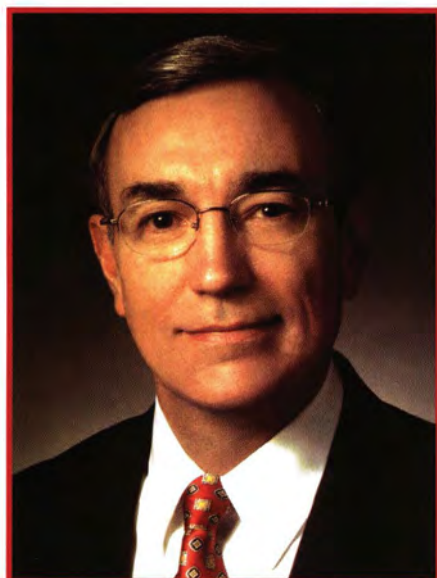

President Dr. Gregory L. Geoffroy



In becoming Iowa State University's 14th president on July 1, 2001, Gregory L. Geoffroy brought more than 25 years of experience as a teacher, researcher and administrator at two of the nation's leading land-grant institutions to Iowa State's ambitious quest to become the nation's best land-grant university.

As Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs at the University of Maryland, College Park, for four years beginning in 1997, Geoffroy was responsible for the academic development of a campus of 32,800 students and 11,300 faculty and staff, as well as faculty and student recruitment, organized research and budgetary responsibility for all academic and related programs. In addition, Geoffroy chaired the University of Maryland's most recent strategic planning process, and from July to September of 1998 he served as interim president of the university, providing additional leadership in overall campus development, fundraising, government and other external relations.

Geoffroy began his academic career in 1974 at The Pennsylvania State University as an assistant professor, advancing to associate professor in 1978 and professor in 1982. In 1988 he was named head of Penn State's Department of Chemistry, and the next year he was appointed dean of Penn State's Eberly College of Science.

Only the second of Iowa State's 14 presidents to come from a chemistry background, Geoffroy is a nationally acclaimed researcher in organometallic chemistry. He has published more than 200 research articles in reference journals, presented more than 200 invited lectures in the United States and nine other nations, is co-author of the book *Organometallic Photochemistry* and has directed the work of nearly 60 graduate, doctoral and post-doctoral students. He has also made

special efforts to involve undergraduate students in research by providing opportunities for more than 50 undergraduate students to join his research group.

Geoffroy's teaching and research have earned him fellowships from the Alfred P. Sloan and John Simon Guggenheim Foundations, visiting professorships to major universities in Germany and France, the Dreyfus Foundation Teacher-Scholar Award, and, in 1991, election as a Fellow in the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

Geoffroy has served in various leadership capacities in the Association for Universities for Research in Astronomy and in the American Chemical Society's Division of Inorganic Chemistry. Prior to moving into academic administration, he chaired four national or international symposia in organometallic chemistry.

A native of Honolulu, Hawaii, Dr. Geoffroy earned a bachelor's degree with honors from the University of Louisville in 1968. He served as an officer in the U.S. Navy from 1969-70, then pursued graduate study at the California Institute of Technology, earning his doctorate in 1974. He and his wife, Kathleen Carothers Geoffroy, have four children.

Athletics Director Bruce Van De Velde

Bruce Van De Velde's impressive administrative resumé made him uniquely qualified to lead the Iowa State University athletics department into the 21st century. The department's unprecedented success subsequent to his arrival last November affirms his vision for the continued rise of Cyclone athletics on the national stage. This summer, *The Sporting News* ranked ISU's athletic department seventh overall among more than 100 NCAA Division I-A athletics departments nationally. That ranking considered athletic success, student-athlete graduation rates and fan support among its criteria.

Van De Velde's leadership is steering Iowa State intercollegiate athletics through a period of absolute achievement. Football season-ticket sales are the highest in recent memory after the Cyclones' record-breaking 9-3 football season, including a 2000 Insight.com Bowl victory. Since Van De Velde's arrival in Ames, Cyclone Club membership has increased nearly 20 percent and giving is at an all-time high. Iowa State was one of five schools nationally to place its football, women's basketball and men's basketball teams in the final Top 25 Associated Press national polls in their respective sports. With ISU joining Oklahoma, Notre Dame, Wisconsin and Florida in that elite group, Van De Velde has positioned his alma mater firmly among the nation's top athletic programs. It should come as no surprise. His vision for the future of athletics at Iowa State and his personable style underscore his reputation across the country as a respected leader in intercollegiate athletics. He continues to serve on several NCAA committees.

Van De Velde's last stop before returning home to Ames was at Oklahoma, where he supervised the area of external affairs and assisted with the supervision of football and men's basketball. His reorganization of the Sooner Club fund-raising program increased annual contributions by 80 percent. He directed the Campaign for Sooner Sports, a \$100 million capital campaign to fund facility improvements and scholarship endowments and implemented a new multi-media contract that generated \$1.8 million in annual revenue.

Van De Velde went to Oklahoma from Utah State, where as athletics director he developed a master plan for \$10 million in renovations. He hired head basketball coach Stew Morrill, who led Utah State to a perfect 19-0 conference record and was named Big West Conference Coach of the Year in his second season as head coach.

At the University of Missouri, as executive director of the Tiger Scholarship Fund, Van De Velde directed the Tiger Development Program. Under his supervision, fund raising reached an all-time high in three areas: annual giving, total giving and scholarships.

Van De Velde is also highly regarded for his work with athletic teams after five successful years at Kansas State University. He joined KSU in 1992 as assistant athletics director and was promoted to associate athletics director for football operations in 1994 under head coach Bill Snyder. During Van De Velde's tenure as Kansas State's primary football administrator, the Wildcats posted four consecutive nine-win seasons and four consecutive bowl game appearances.

Van De Velde spent one year as assistant athletics director at Tulane University prior to his tenure at Kansas State and also served as football recruiting coordinator at the University of Iowa under head coach Hayden Fry from 1988-91.

From 1980-88, Van De Velde worked as an assistant football coach at Iowa State, Nebraska Wesleyan University and Dana College.

Van De Velde, a Sterling, Ill., native and his wife, Debbie, have a daughter, Ashley, born May 12, 2000. A 1981 Iowa State graduate, Van De Velde earned a master's degree in athletic administration from Iowa and is completing course work toward a doctorate in education administration from Kansas State.

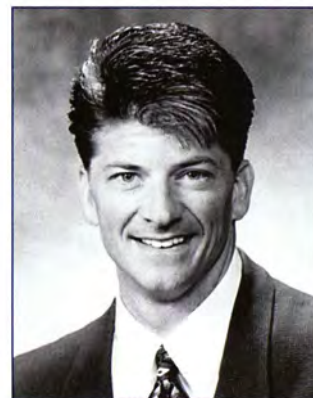

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Gameday Scouting Report

THE SERIES: Oklahoma State leads the 40-game series, 22-15-3. The last time the Cyclones and Cowboys met was Oct. 14, 2000, with ISU prevailing in Stillwater, 33-26. Cyclone quarterback Sage Rosenfels hit on 19-of-38 passes for 290 yards, including a 33-yard scoring strike to Lane Danielson with 18 seconds left in the game as Iowa State won its third-straight road game for the first time since 1978 and opened a season with three road wins for the first time since 1971.

OFFENSIVELY: ISU junior QB Seneca Wallace will aim to put the Cyclone offense back on track after Iowa State was held to its lowest offensive output of the season at Missouri. Wallace returns to Jack Trice for the first time since his Big 12 record-setting performance Sept. 29 vs. Baylor. He went 22-for-24 and completed 18 straight passes, including four TDs, to break the conference record. Wallace ran for 73 yards on 13 carries in last week's win at Missouri. Oklahoma State's offense is led by sophomore QB Aso Pogi, who made his first start for the Cowboys vs. Iowa State last season in Stillwater, passing for an OSU freshman-record 328 yards. Pogi is off to good start this season, averaging 184.2 yards passing per game. Sophomore WR Rashaun Woods is OSU's top receiver, catching 47 passes for an average of 95.5 yards per game. He caught eight passes for 81 yards including a nine-yard TD pass vs. Texas and has scored at least one touchdown in the past three games.

DEFENSIVELY: Doubts have surrounded the Iowa State defense since the season began, but the young group showed its potential at Missouri, putting up a goal-line stand in the final seconds to preserve a Cyclone victory. Iowa State's pass defense ranks third in the nation with an average of 139.6 yards allowed per game. The Cowboy defense gives up an average of 326 yards per game. Sophomore S Elbert Craig leads the OSU defense after finishing second on the team in tackles a year ago. He has 65 total tackles on the season, including 14 vs. Texas.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Cyclone redshirt freshman PK Tony Yelk leads the Big 12 in PATs, going 19-for-19 on the season. Yelk connected on field goals of 21 and 24 yards in the fourth quarter at Missouri to put ISU ahead. Sophomore PK Luke Phillips has also been solid for Oklahoma State, going 14-for-14 on PATs and 9-for-11 on field goals this season. His 48-yard field goal vs. Texas was the longest of his career.

THE COACHES: Today's game is the first meeting between ISU head coach Dan McCarney and Oklahoma State head coach Les Miles. Miles is in his first season as OSU's head coach after spending the past three seasons as a tight ends coach for the Dallas Cowboys. McCarney is in his seventh season at the ISU helm and holds a 2-2 record vs. the Cowboys.

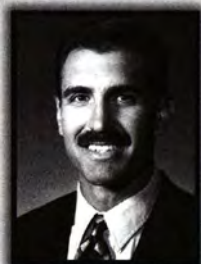
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Head Coach Dan McCarney

W

hen 2000 Big 12 Coach of the Year runner-up Dan McCarney laid out his vision for the future of Iowa State football at a press conference to announce his arrival in Ames seven years ago, he stressed that the program's transformation would not occur overnight. McCarney possessed enthusiasm, unwavering optimism and a seemingly endless source of energy. His background in college football programs that had gone from perennial losers to consistent winners made him a perfect choice for the Cyclone helm. There were more than a few skeptics. Iowa State was coming off a winless season, hadn't had a winning campaign since 1989 and the Cyclones' last bowl trip was in 1978.

Powered by a singular sense of purpose, McCarney steadily molded Iowa State's football program, bringing in a top-notch coaching staff and the best recruiting classes in recent memory. Backed by a university administration committed to providing state-of-the-art facilities, McCarney relentlessly exorcised the demons that had plagued Cyclone football. After his first teams laid a foundation for success, a 2000 Iowa State unit, led by 25 seniors who had bought into McCarney's vision, remained undeterred by the skeptics. Following McCarney's blueprint, head coach and players went last fall where no Cyclone team had gone, winning nine games, including the first bowl game victory in school history. Perhaps only a coach of such total faith in his methods was necessary to create believers in a program that hadn't been to a bowl in 22 years and had last won nine games in 1906. Now, ISU's 37-29 victory over Pittsburgh in the Insight.com Bowl, the biggest home crowds in 16 years and a series of program milestones affirm McCarney's vision for Iowa State's football program - on and off the field:

- **McCarney's Cyclones were the first Iowa State team to win nine games in 94 years. The win over Pittsburgh in the Insight.com Bowl was ISU's first-ever bowl victory and the Cyclones' first bowl appearance since 1978. It had been 11 years since Iowa State's last winning season. Iowa State's new national standing was affirmed by its No. 25 national ranking on the final Associated Press poll, the Cyclones' first AP poll appearance in more than 19 years. McCarney's team also finished 23rd on the USA Today/Coaches poll.**
- **Iowa State posted a 4-1 record on the road last season, the school's first winning record away from home since 1989. This from a program that was 6-43-1 away from home during the 1990s and went nearly seven years (31 games) without a road victory.**
- **Iowa State's win at Iowa last season was the Cyclones' eighth-straight non-conference victory, the longest such string since the 1975-77 campaigns. The victory marked ISU's third-straight win over the Hawkeyes after 15 straight losses to its intrastate rival.**

Anyone who has watched McCarney's rise in the coaching ranks would not be surprised by the effort of his national-caliber coaching staff. A native of Iowa City, McCarney was instrumental in rebuilding efforts that produced Big Ten titles and Rose Bowl berths at both Iowa and Wisconsin, two schools that regularly finished near the bottom of the league before his arrival.

McCarney, 48, coached at Iowa for 13 seasons (1977-89), including a decade under Hayden Fry, before becoming the defensive coordinator at Wisconsin under Barry Alvarez in 1990.

McCarney's defense was the foundation of the Wisconsin rebuilding effort. In the four seasons prior to his arrival in Wisconsin the Badgers had a 9-36 record, and attendance was at its lowest mark since World War II.

In 1993, Wisconsin went 10-1-1, claimed its first Big Ten title in 31 years and scored a 21-16 win over UCLA in the Rose Bowl. Attendance at Wisconsin's Camp Randall Stadium climbed to more than 30,000 a game and sellouts of more than 77,000 were the norm.

During Wisconsin's Rose Bowl season, the Badgers ranked 19th nationally against the rush, allowing just 130.3 yards per game, the sixth-best mark in school history. The team allowed an average of 16.3 points per game, its best effort in 30 years. The Badger defense also intercepted a NCAA-best 23 passes and created 34 turnovers, including six against UCLA in the Rose Bowl.

A 1975 graduate of Iowa, McCarney coached the Hawkeyes in eight consecutive bowl games, including the 1982 and 1985 Rose Bowls. The three-year letterman on the offensive line for Iowa (1972-74) was captain of the 1974 Hawkeye squad. A member of the American Football Coaches Association for 24 years, McCarney is on the AFCA's rules committee.
