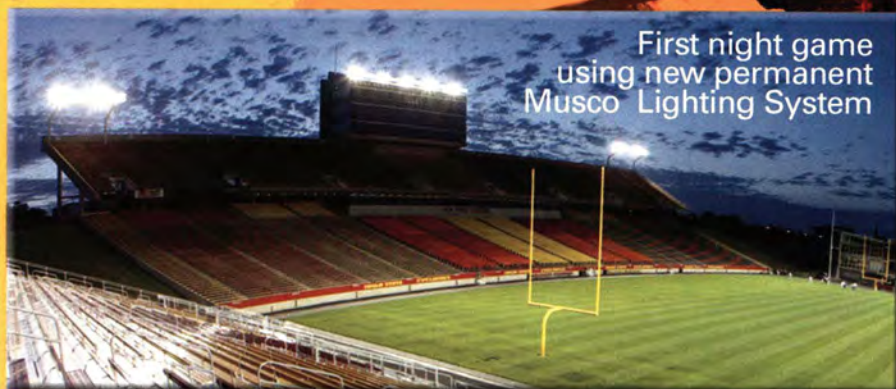

IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

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For more than 133 years, Iowa State University has been providing a high quality education to students, conducting important research, and helping improve the quality of life for people throughout the world as Iowa's land-grant university.

Today, Iowa State is a broad-based international university. Its nearly 28,000 students come from all 50 states and nearly 120 other nations, and include more National Merit Scholars than all but six other public universities in the nation and more National Achievement Scholars than all but four other public universities. Students can choose from 200 programs of study leading to baccalaureate degrees in the colleges of Agriculture, Business, Design, Education, Family and Consumer Sciences, and Liberal Arts and Sciences, many of which are ranked among the top 10 nationally. The College of Veterinary Medicine offers the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree and students seeking advanced degrees can choose from among 200 fields of study leading to master's, doctor of philosophy and specialist degrees.

Students who come to Iowa State discover a university community that is both supportive and filled with opportunities. Features include: a national-award-winning lectures program; nearly 500 different student clubs and organizations for campus and community involvement and leadership development; and an extensive intramural program that boasts one of the highest participation rates in the nation, offering all popular sports as well as such unique activities as inner tube water basketball and broomball.

Facilities are second to none. New buildings are under construction for the colleges of Business and Engineering. A modern Student Health Center provides comprehensive medical services as well as rehabilitation, nutrition, wellness and health education programs. The three-level, 220,000-square-foot Lied Recreation Facility includes 20 basketball courts, nine racquetball courts, a 300-meter ground-level track, an elevated jogging track, and extensive weight and aerobics training facilities. The Ames/ISU Ice Arena, a cooperative venture involving Iowa State and the city of Ames to support the rapid growth of recreational and competitive skating, including ISU's very successful club hockey program, opened in the fall of 2001. Golf enthusiasts can enjoy Iowa State's championship-caliber Veenker Memorial Golf Course.

Iowa State's residence hall system, which is undergoing a \$100 million renovation, is nationally recognized for the high quality living environment it provides to students. The residence system is organized into individually-named, self-governing houses, which provide students greater autonomy and sense of community. Nearly half of all new freshmen now enter as part of an even more personal learning community. Learning communities consist of students with similar majors or special interests and have proven to significantly increase student success in terms of grade-point average and retention. In addition, Iowa State's Greek system is consistently ranked as one of the top in the nation and the Cy-Ride bus service makes off-campus apartment living as close to the campus as the residence halls.

Iowa State has a comprehensive computing network with thousands of computer workstations located in labs throughout the campus and residence halls and network support for students no matter where they live. The university is consistently ranked among the top wired Universities by Yahoo!Internet Life magazine; its C6 and C2 virtual reality labs are among the most sophisticated in the world; and it is a national leader in computer security with its designation as a charter Center of Excellence in Information Assurance by the National Security Agency.

Often described as a park, Iowa State's central campus covers more than 1,700 acres and is recognized as one of the most beautiful in the nation by the American Society of Landscape Architects. The campus has more than 160 buildings, ranging from beautifully restored historic landmarks to striking examples of modern architecture. The university has an extensive art collection, including the largest Grant Wood murals in the nation, located in the Parks Library, and the nation's largest public collection of Christian Petersen sculptures, many of which are located throughout central campus itself. Scenic Lake LaVerne, the stately Memorial Union and the historic Campanile with its Stanton Memorial Carillon anchor the south side of central campus.

Major expansion of the campus has occurred southeast of central campus, beginning with the four-building Iowa State Center entertainment and continuing education complex which hosts top names in popular and classical music, national theater productions and international art exhibitions; Jack Trice Stadium, College of Veterinary Medicine, ISU Research Park and the rapidly growing Reiman Gardens, which has become one of the most popular garden attractions in the Midwest and whose new conservatory and butterfly gardens are scheduled to open this fall.

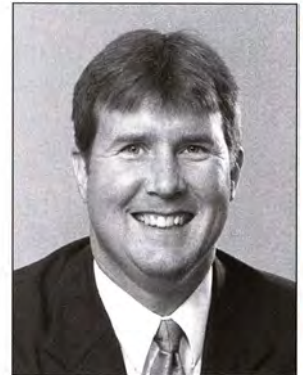

Iowa State met its first 2002 Big 12 Conference opponent in the Cyclones' home opener last weekend vs. Kansas. ISU stretched the current series streak to three with a win over the Jayhawks, 45-3. Iowa State tallied six rushing touchdowns, the most by a Cyclone team against a conference opponent since ISU tallied six running scores in a 41-3 victory over Kansas in Ames in 1977. The Cyclones notched 511 yards of total offense while holding the Jayhawks to 150 yards of total offense. ISU's 511 yards of offense is the most vs. a Big 12 opponent and the highest total vs. a league opponent since racking up 516 yards vs. KU in 1992.

QB **Seneca Wallace** had another impressive showing with 234 yards passing on 24 attempts. RB **Hiawatha Rutland** has led the team in rushing in both games this season. He gained 122 yards on 20 attempts, a career high. Redshirt freshman RB **Brian Thompson** totaled 92 yards rushing, all in the fourth quarter. WRs **Jamaul Montgomery** and **Lane Danielsen** ranked as the squad's leaders in receiving with 55 and 56 yards, respectively. **Michael Wagner**, Rutland and Thompson have each scored two touchdowns for the 2002 season.

The Cyclone defense tallied four sacks vs. Kansas: **Brandon Brown**, **Jordan Carstens**, **Beau Coleman** and **Tyson Smith**. Brown recorded 11 total tackles, Carstens and Coleman had nine stops and Smith made eight tackles. LB **Jeremy Loyd** made his third career interception in the first quarter. DBs **Ellis Hobbs** and **Nick Linder** each made the second interceptions of their careers in the fourth quarter.

PK **Adam Benike** was good on all six PAT attempts and went 1-of-2 on field goal attempts. P **Tony Yelk** averaged 33.5 yards on two punt attempts. **Todd Miller** ran three punt returns for 22 yards and **Lance Young** ran one kick return for 22 yards.

Tennessee Tech goes into its second of back-to-back road games against Div. I-A opponents. The Golden Eagles fell to Bowling Green in the season opener 41-7. Tech totaled 332 yards in total offense vs. Bowling Green.

QB **Robert Craft** made his first career start and threw for 256 yards on 23 attempts. WR **Derek Lee** scored the team's only touchdown while notching 132 yards on nine receptions, a career high. WR **Stevland Sills** gained 19 yards rushing and 50 yards receiving. LBs **Greg Hunnicutt**, **Daniel Wentzel** and **John Ruff** led the Golden Eagles in tackles with nine, eight and seven, respectively.

LB **Maurice Harris**, DL **D.J. Bleisath** and Wentzel each notched a sack vs. Bowling Green. Bleisath, a Buck Buchanan Award candidate, marked his 20th-straight game with at least one tackle-for-loss. LG **Burt Shurette** and RT **Jeremy McDonald** are the only two returning offensive line starters from the 2001 season.

PK **Tyler Parsons** hit on his only extra point attempt. P **Chris Cummings** averaged 31.2 yards on four punting attempts. **Donnel Horton** tallied 82 yards on six kick returns.

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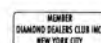

A: It is a family name that has been passed down to me.





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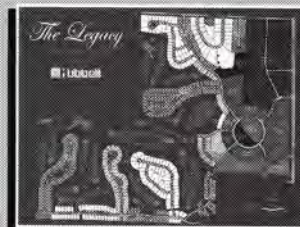

In 2002, six Cyclone teams qualified for NCAA post-season competition, including the football team, which was invited to participate in its second-straight bowl game, the Independence Bowl. The wrestling team, led by Cael Sanderson, the first undefeated four-time national champion in collegiate history, crowned three national champions and five All-Americans en route to a second-place NCAA Tournament finish. The women's basketball team played host to the 2002 NCAA Midwest Regional. The gymnastics team and the women's track program were both nationally ranked as top 20 programs.

Individually, Iowa State student-athletes qualified for NCAA competition in cross country, indoor and outdoor track, gymnastics, swimming and wrestling.

Recognizing that program continuity and leadership have been major contributors to Iowa State's competitive success, athletics director Bruce Van De Velde has signed football coach Dan McCarney, men's basketball coach Larry Eustachy, women's basketball coach Bill Fennelly, wrestling coach Bobby Douglas and gymnastics coach K.J. Kindler to new contracts, ensuring the stability of the most successful lineup of coaches in school history.

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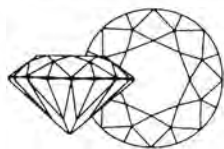
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Terry Allen, an Iowa City native who was head coach at Northern Iowa and Kansas the past 13 seasons, joined the Iowa State football coaching staff in March as associate head coach and tight ends coach.

As a head coach the last 13 years, Allen owned a 95-59 record. His Northern Iowa teams, which won seven-straight conference titles, made the NCAA Division I-AA semifinals in 1992 and 1996.

Allen spent 22 years at Northern Iowa as a player, assistant coach and head coach. An all-conference quarterback at Iowa City West, he went on to UNI, where he was a three-year starter at quarterback. He was named head coach at Northern Iowa in 1989 and led his 1992 squad to a Division I-AA No. 1 ranking. Allen was named conference coach of the year five times and Region IV Coach of the Year twice.

Allen and his wife, Lynn, have a daughter Angela (6) and sons Chase (4) and Alex (2).

Tony Alford returns as assistant head coach to the Iowa State coaching staff after a year at Washington. He will be back tutoring the ISU running backs. Under Alford, Iowa State produced a 1,000-yard rusher from 1997-2000.

Alford earned honorable mention honors at Colorado State on USA Today's 1989 All-America team and was named to the WAC first-team all-conference squad. The 1992 CSU graduate with a bachelor's degree in exercise and sport science set a then-conference single-game rushing record with 310 rushing yards against Utah and was nominated for the

1989 Doak Walker Award.

Alford went on to play for the NFL's Denver Broncos and the Birmingham Fire of the World League prior to entering the coaching profession.

The running backs coach at Kent in 1996, Alford was the running backs coach at Mt. Union College in 1995. He has also served as an assistant coach at high schools in Lake Wales, Fla., and Fort Collins, Colo. Alford and his wife, Trina, reside in Ankeny with their son, Rylan.

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ASSISTANT COACHES

In just two seasons in Ames, Steve Brickey has coached two different quarterbacks to a pair of the finest seasons ever enjoyed by any Iowa State signal caller in Seneca Wallace and Sage Rosenfels. He will assume duties as the Cyclones' offensive coordinator this season while continuing to tutor ISU's quarterbacks. Wallace compiled 2,519 yards of total offense in 2001, en route to Big 12 Offensive Newcomer of the Year honors. The total ranks No. 3 behind Rosenfels on the all-time ISU single-season list.

Brickey was an assistant coach at Texas from 1987-91 after tutoring quarterbacks at Texas Tech in 1986.

He moved on to serve as quarterbacks coach at Texas Christian from 1993-97. Brickey has coached in four bowl games and helped the Indiana State football team to its only NCAA I-AA playoff berths (1983, 1984). Brickey was a member of the Sycamore staff from 1978-85.

Brickey played both quarterback and defensive back and received his degree in 1976 from Missouri, where he began his coaching career as a graduate assistant with the Tigers from 1976-77. He and his wife, Patti, have three sons: Chris (28), John (17) and Mike (15).

John Skladany has engineered major defensive reversals of fortune at Iowa State. His aggressive style of defense forced 23 turnovers in 2000 and 26 turnovers in 2001. ISU, which ranked 108th nationally in turnover margin in 1999, improved to 34th nationally in 2000 and then to eighth last season. Iowa State's 18 interceptions in 2001 were most by an ISU defense since 1976.

2001 Cyclone defenders posted ISU's best total defense numbers since 1992, dropping its yards allowed per contest by 60 yards in one season. Iowa State recorded a pair of shutouts

in a single campaign for the first time since 1978.

Skladany, a Haverhill, Mass., native, played a key role in turning Colorado State into a WAC defensive leader. He has coached several student-athletes who went on to the NFL.

Skladany had NFL free agent tryouts as a defensive lineman with the New England Patriots (1972) and the Washington Redskins (1973). He played for the WFL's Birmingham Americans and spent the 1975 exhibition season with the CFL's Ottawa Roughriders. Skladany and his wife, Sharon, have two daughters, Laura (19) and Stephanie (15).



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Marty Fine joined the Iowa State coaching staff as offensive line coach and special teams coordinator before spring practice. In his five years at Indiana, Fine coached offensive tackles and tight ends, served as special teams coordinator and did stints as passing game coordinator while overseeing the running game. Indiana was fourth nationally in rushing last season and led the Big Ten, averaging 269.5 yards per game on the ground.

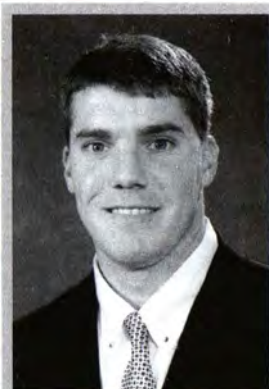
A former linebacker at Union College in New York State, Fine went to Indiana from Colgate, where he spent the 1996 campaign as the Red Raiders' offensive line coach. Fine spent six years as the offensive coordinator (1993-95) and offensive line coach (1990-92) at Indiana State.

Prior to his six-year stint at Indiana State, Fine was the head coach at the U.S. Naval Academy Prep, Sonoma State, linebackers coach at Western New Mexico (1983) and offensive line coach and offensive coordinator at Westchester Community College (1981-82).

A 1983 graduate of Western New Mexico University with a degree in history, Fine and his wife, Betsy, have three children: Sarah, Lydia and Joseph.

ASSISTANT COACHES

Chris Ash, formerly the defensive coordinator at Drake, joined the Iowa State coaching staff in February 2000 and works with the ISU secondary. His efforts helped Iowa State's defenders post their best total defensive numbers in a decade last season.

In Ash's first year as defensive coordinator at Drake, the Bulldogs won the 1998 Pioneer Conference title. Drake ranked eighth nationally in 1999 NCAA Division I-AA total defense in his second Bulldog season as four Drake defenders earned all-conference honors.

A native of Ottumwa, Iowa, Ash lettered twice as a safety at Drake. The 28-year-old Ash earned a bachelor's degree in secondary education from Drake in 1996. After working two years as a graduate assistant with the Drake secondary, he moved on to Princeton in the spring of 1997, where he worked with the Tiger secondary.

Ash and his wife, Jessica, live in Ames with their son, Tanner.



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ASSISTANT COACHES

DeMontie Cross, the all-time leading tackler in Missouri history, made an immediate impact on Iowa State's improved defense last fall, after joining the Cyclone coaching staff in March 2001. He had started his coaching career at his alma mater and at Sam Houston State.

Cross' Sam Houston State pass defense ranked second among 122 NCAA Division I-AA teams in 2000, allowing just 121 passing yards per game. At Missouri, Cross' outside linebackers were part of a Tiger defense that consistently ranked among the NCAA's top 25 in total defense. Missouri's 1998 squad earned the Insight.com bowl championship.

Mike Grant, formerly a key factor in Iowa State's dramatic defensive improvement, made a profound impact as Cyclone running backs coach last fall and turns his efforts to the ISU wide receivers this season. With Grant overseeing the Cyclone backfield, first-team all-Big 12 tailback Ennis Haywood became the seventh Iowa Stater to post at least two 1,000-yard rushing seasons, finishing the 2001 campaign with 1,169 yards on the ground. Iowa State's tailbacks went the entire season without losing a fumble.

Grant came to ISU from James Madison University, where he coached the Dukes' tight ends and wide receivers.

The native of Tampa, Fla., was an academic all-Big Eight signal-caller at Nebraska. Grant earned a pair of bachelor's degrees from Nebraska. Grant was a graduate assistant coach from 1994-96.

Grant and his wife, Nina, were married in December 1998. She is the director of minority programs in ISU's College of Agriculture.



IOWA STATE FOOTBALL

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The work of strength and conditioning coach Matt McGettigan received the ultimate affirmation in February when he earned recognition as the 2001 National Collegiate Strength and Conditioning Coach of the Year by the Professional Football Strength and Conditioning Coaches Society.

McGettigan previously served as assistant strength and conditioning coach at Notre Dame.

Prior to working at Notre Dame, McGettigan was strength and conditioning coordinator from 1987-90 for the University of Wisconsin-Platteville, where he earned his master's degree in 1989.

McGettigan graduated from Luther College in Decorah, Iowa, in 1987. He is a member of the National Strength and Conditioning Association, and in January 1989, McGettigan received his certification as a Strength and Conditioning Specialist.

Mike Nelson's impact on the Iowa State defense was immediate and has remained constant. In 1997, his first season at ISU, Nelson's defensive line figured prominently by racking up 21 sacks, the highest Cyclone single-season total in 10 years. In 1998, ISU sacked opposing quarterbacks a school-record 32 times. Defensive tackle James Reed earned all-Big 12 honors and defensive end Reggie Hayward earned all-league recognition in 1999 and 2000.

Nelson has coached at Wisconsin and Stanford, and tutored the defensive lines at Missouri and Kansas State. Nelson

started his coaching career at Southern Illinois before spending one season in the Ohio high school ranks. He worked as defensive coordinator at Norfolk State (1972) before returning to his alma mater, Dayton, in 1973. He later coached at Virginia, Ball State, San Diego State, Rutgers and Oregon State.

Nelson earned his bachelor's degree in 1969 from Dayton, where he was a four-year football letterwinner and also lettered in hockey. He earned his master's degree at Southern Illinois in 1970. Nelson and his wife, Betsy, have three sons: Kurt, Eric and Mark.



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ASSISTANT COACHES

Waterloo native Mike Woodley is in his eighth season working with the ISU football program. He is in his first season as an administrative assistant in the athletic department, working with the football program. His responsibilities include direct oversight for Cyclone football camps.

Woodley coached Iowa State's tight ends for the fourth season in 2001 after three years of coaching the Cyclone linebackers.

The former head coach at West Des Moines Valley High School graduated from Northern Iowa in 1974 with a bachelor's degree in physical education. He worked for one season (1975) with McCarney as a graduate assistant on Bob Commings' Hawkeye football staff.

After a successful career in the Iowa prep ranks at Waterloo East, Osage and Fort Dodge, Woodley moved on to serve a successful tenure as both assistant and head coach at St. Ambrose University in Davenport.

Knock was captain of the 1975 Central College football team, earning his bachelor's degree in 1976. 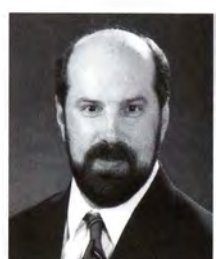

Carry-in Packages & Articles

Please do not bring into the stadium video cameras, bottles, cans, apples, oranges, toilet tissue, etc. Items thrown onto the field can result in a penalty for the home team and removal from the stadium.

Coolers & Chairs

As a courtesy to neighboring guests, spectators are asked NOT to bring stadium chairs, lawnchairs or coolers into the stands. Back chairs made for Jack Trice Stadium seats are accepted.

Pass Out Checks

Persons leaving the stadium will be issued a pass out coupon for re-admission to the stadium. In addition, they must have a ticket stub for re-entry. No pass outs will be allowed before kickoff.

Public Telephones

Pay telephones are located behind the east and west stands along the concourse walkway.

Field Access

The athletic department asks that all fans refrain from going on the playing field at any time. Any person(s) entering the playing field will be subject to arrest and prosecution.

Stadium Sign Policy

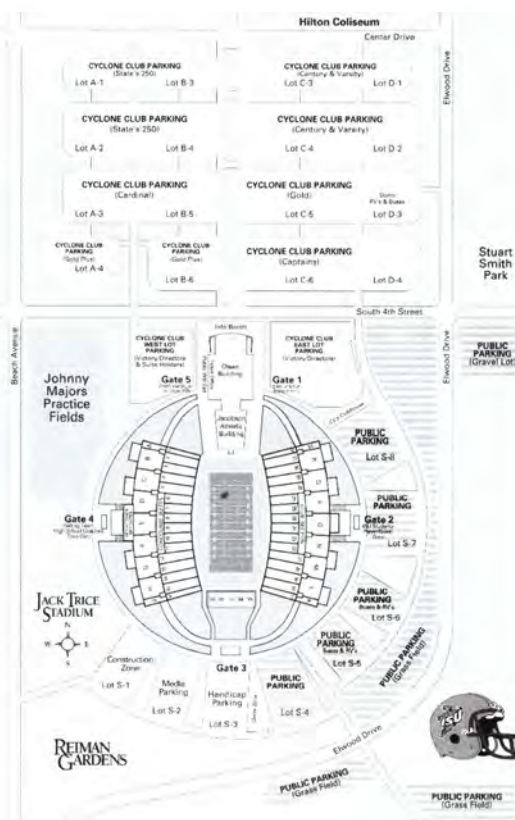
Iowa State promotes and encourages the display of signs. All signs must be in good taste and supportive of Iowa State University. In no case may the sign obstruct vision or endanger fans. Signs must be stationary. All signs must be approved by Assistant Athletic Director Frank Randall (Jacobson Building) before noon on the day prior to the game. The athletic department reserves the right to move or remove any signs not meeting these specifications.

Restrooms

Restrooms are located throughout the stadium behind each concession stand.

Smoking Policy

In accordance with Iowa State's smoking policy, there will be no smoking in areas where the general public congregates at Jack Trice Stadium. There is no smoking allowed in the seating areas or by the concession stands, but some designated smoking areas are located near restrooms.



Distractions

We want to make football a totally enjoyable experience and want to encourage fans to be respectful of those around them in the stadium. In the event there is an unreasonable distraction, please take the following steps to help control the undesirable behavior:

- Note the seating section, row and seat numbers and inform the usher in the section of the disturbance. The usher will observe the conduct and take appropriate action.
- If the conduct continues, the usher will get assistance from a uniformed police officer to request improvements of behavior or to remove the fan(s) from the stadium.
- An additional occurrence is cause for removal from the stadium and could be grounds for relocation.

Courtesy Carts

Iowa State offers courtesy cart service from Gates 1, 3 and 5 beginning one and one-half hour before kick-off until 10 minutes into the first quarter and resuming midway through the fourth quarter. Anyone needing transportation during the game should go to the NE entrance of the Club Section (east side) or the main entrance of the Concourse Suites (west side) for assistance.

Wheelchairs

Special areas in sections 16, 18 and 19 are available for spectators in wheelchairs. In addition, wheelchair seating is available on the field level behind the goal posts. Please notify the ticket office prior to game day to obtain tickets.

Ambulance Service

An ambulance is parked in the first aid quarters on the west side of the stadium.

First Aid Station

Emergency medical treatment is available for spectators in special first aid quarters located under both the east and west stands. Contact an usher to request medical assistance.

Parking Lot Facilities

The ISU Athletic Department provides portable toilets for its patrons in the parking lots. These are located throughout the stadium parking areas.

Public Parking

Public lots open six hours before kickoff. Overnight parking is available. Contact Frank Randall. RV parking is available in lot S-5. See map for location. Parking prices are as follows: automobiles (\$7), R.V.s (\$25), buses (\$30).

National Cyclone Club Parking

Cyclone Club members who contribute at the Varsity level (\$50) and above receive a season parking pass for football in the lots north of the Jacobson Building. Club members wanting to park in the general lots will be required to pay the public rate. Donor parking for R.V.s is in lot D-3.

Handicap Parking

Lot S-3, south of Jack Trice Stadium by Gate 3, is available for people who have a handicap parking permit issued by the Iowa Department of Transportation. This lot is open on a first-come, first-served basis.

Lost & Found

Lost and Found is in the Ticket Office, outside Gate 5 on the west side of the Olsen Building. Items that are lost or found should be reported to ushers.

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2002 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

Dick Barker Football/Wrestling

Dick Barker became Iowa State's first football All-American in 1919, being named to the second team of the Chicago Tribune's All-America squad.

Barker was the first Cyclone to play in the NFL, signing with the Chicago Staleys under head coach George S. Halas in 1921. The Staleys, which changed their name to the Bears the following season, notched a 9-1-1 mark in Barker's only season.

Barker was also a top-notch wrestler, finishing his career with a 10-1-1 mark, including five pins.

Barker, who started wrestling at Cornell College in Mt. Vernon, Iowa, became known as one of the pioneers of collegiate wrestling. He helped draft the first collegiate rules and helped plan the first NCAA tournament in 1928. He was inducted into the College Wrestling Hall of Fame as a coach in 1991.



Bill Cain Basketball

Bill Cain's three-year ISU career ranks among the best in the annals of Cyclone basketball. Cain, who finished his career with a 19.5 ppg scoring average, was an outstanding rebounder. Cain has the second-best career rebounding average in ISU history at 12.4 rpg. In 1970, Cain grabbed 396 caroms for a 15.2 rpg average, both single-season school records Cain still holds today. His 396 boards in 1970 ranks only behind Wilt Chamberlain for the most single-season caroms in Big Eight history. Cain owns ISU's single-game rebounding standard, snaring 26 boards against Minnesota. He led the Big Eight in rebounding twice.

Cain ended his career at ISU in 1970 as a two-time first-team all-Big Eight selection (1969, 1970), one of only 13 Cyclones in school history to earn first-team all-league honors twice. He was honored as the 1968 Big Eight Newcomer of the Year.



Carol Cook Cross Country/Track & Field

Carol Cook was an important cog in ISU's dominant women's track & field and cross country teams in the 1970s. Cook won the Big Eight Conference title in cross country and finished second at the AIAW national championship, helping ISU win conference and national team titles.

Cook won outdoor Big Eight titles in the 5,000 meters and 2-mile run in 1977 and was the 1977 Big Eight indoor 2-mile champion. She still holds ISU's school record in the 5,000 meters with a time of 16:14.10.



Diane Doles Volleyball/Track & Field

Diane Doles' leadership and talent provided Iowa State volleyball with a smooth transition from the AIAW to the NCAA in the early 1980s. Doles hit a school-record 319 (408k-104e-953a) from the floor en route to first-team all-Big Eight accolades in 1982 and led the Cyclones to their highest conference finish at the time (T-3rd).

She earned first-team all-Big Eight honors in 1983, becoming one of only two Cyclones in school history to earn first-team all-conference honors twice in their respective career. Doles shattered ISU's single-season block assist and solo block marks as a senior, recording 60 solo blocks and 117 block assists, records that still stand today. She ended her Cyclone career earning ISU's Female Athlete of the Year and Big Eight Medal of Honor Awards in 1983.



Brent Simmons Gymnastics

Brent Simmons was one of the most decorated ISU gymnasts in school history, pacing the Iowa State gymnastics team to the first of its three national championships from 1971-74. Simmons had his first major success in 1970, where he won a trio of Big Eight titles in the vault, high bar and all-around as a junior.

Simmons came back for his senior season in 1971 and produced one of the most outstanding performances in gymnastics history. Simmons' all-around dominance helped propel ISU to the 1971 Big Eight and NCAA Championship, the program's first national title in school history. Simmons, who won three Big Eight titles again, was an All-American in four events (vault, high bar, parallel bars, all-around) and won NCAA titles in the parallel bars and the high bar. His dominating performance at the 1971 NCAA Championship earned him the Nissen Award, presented annually to the nation's outstanding senior gymnast.



Jim Gibbons Wrestling

From 1977-92, Jim Gibbons was a fixture in Iowa State's storied wrestling program, making his mark as a competitor and coach for the Cyclones.

Gibbons earned All-America honors three times at 134 pounds (1980, 1981, 1982) and won two 134-pound Big Eight titles (1980, 1982). He won the 134-pound national title in 1981. After his ISU

career was over, Gibbons immediately moved into coaching, assisting Harold Nichols for two years until succeeding him after his retirement in 1985.

Under Gibbons' tutelage (1986-92), the Cyclones were 96-32-1, compiling 23 individual Big Eight champions and seven individual NCAA champions. Gibbons' 1987 squad was one of the best in school history, capturing ISU's eighth NCAA wrestling championship, ending Iowa's nine-year run of consecutive national titles. Four Cyclones won national titles in 1987, helping Gibbons earn national coach of the year honors.



Keith Krepfle Football

Iowa State was blessed to have the services of one of the best tight ends in collegiate football in the early 1970s in Keith Krepfle. From 1971-73, Krepfle was one of the best tight ends in the nation, amassing 94 receptions, 1,368 yards and 15 touchdowns.

Krepfle led ISU to two bowl games (1971 Sun Bowl; 1972 Liberty Bowl) and was named first-team all-Big Eight twice. His 15 career touchdown receptions is tied for No. 1 all-time in the Cyclone football annals and his 1,368 career receiving yards is seventh all-time.

Krepfle later went on to excel at the next level, playing seven seasons in the NFL. He caught 152 passes for 2,425 yards and 19 scores in his NFL career. Krepfle was the starting tight end for the Philadelphia Eagles in Super Bowl XV in 1981, becoming the first Cyclone to score a touchdown in a Super Bowl.



Mal Schmidt Football/Swimming/Administrator

Malcolm "Mal" Schmidt lettered a total of six times in football and swimming, earning All-America honors in swimming as a senior. Schmidt lettered in football from 1948-51, playing defensive end his first two seasons until being moved to receiver in his senior campaign, where he led the Big Seven in receiving and earned first-team all-Big Seven.

Schmidt was also a standout swimmer for legendary Cyclone coach and ISU Hall of Famer Jack McGuire. He was the Big Seven's 100-yard freestyle champion twice and swam a leg on the 400-yard relay team that earned All-America honors. For his two-sport achievements, Schmidt was honored as ISU's Athlete of the Year in 1952.

Schmidt returned to ISU in 1965, becoming a key player in developing the National Cyclone Club. In 1973, he became director of the Cyclone Club, helping it grow into one of the most successful ventures of its kind in the United States.



Sunday Uti Track & Field

Sunday Uti was not only one of the best track athletes in the nation during his time at ISU, he was one of the best in the world. Uti, a native of Lagos, Nigeria, earned All-America honors eight times during his career while establishing himself as one of the top-rated 400-meter runners in the world.

Uti was a four-time runner-up finisher at the NCAA Championships. He was the Big Eight Conference outdoor champion in the 440-yard dash in 1983 and the indoor 440-yard Big Eight champion in 1984, earning the meet's most valuable performer award. Uti was also a member of ISU's 4x400-meter relay team that finished third at the 1985 NCAA Championship. Uti competed in three Olympic Games for Nigeria. He was a member of the 4x400-meter relay team that won a bronze medal at the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles.



Tom Watkins Football

Tom Watkins was the perfect running back for Clay Stapleton's single-wing attack, racking up 1,605 yards in his three-year (1958-60) Cyclone career. Watkins was a two-time first-team all-Big Eight selection (1959, 1960), ranking second nationally in 1959 with 843 yards rushing. He earned All-America honors in 1960.

Watkins continued his football career after graduation, finding his niche as a dependable running back and punt and kickoff returner in seven NFL seasons. He led the league twice in punt return yardage (1963, 1964) and once in kickoff return yardage (1965) as a member of the Lions.

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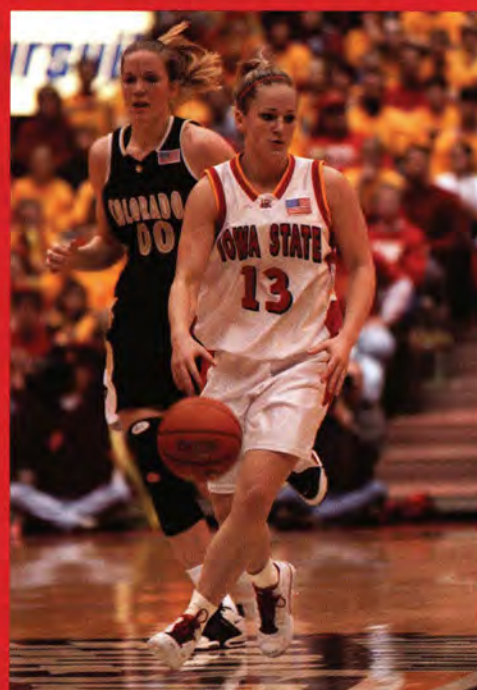


WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Iowa State head women's basketball coach Bill Fennelly has built the women's basketball program into a national powerhouse. Aiming for its seventh-straight NCAA Tournament appearance, the 2002-03 ISU team will continue its exciting brand of play this season.

Senior Lindsey Wilson, a second-team all-Big 12 pick last season, returns to direct the Cyclone attack. Along with returning starters Erica Junod and Mary Cofield, Iowa State has a solid base to go along with the addition of outstanding newcomers. An All-America candidate, Wilson averaged 19.1 ppg and 6.3 apg last season.

Gregory L. Geoffroy has been a faculty member and top administrator at three of the nation's leading land-grant universities. He became president of Iowa State University on July 1, 2001, and he also holds the rank of professor of chemistry.

Dr. Geoffroy began his academic career as an assistant professor of chemistry at the Pennsylvania State University in 1974, advancing to associate professor in 1978 and professor in 1982. He was appointed head of the Department of Chemistry in 1988 and dean of the Eberly College of Science at Penn State in 1989.

In 1997, Dr. Geoffroy was appointed senior vice president for academic affairs and provost at the University of Maryland, College Park where he was responsible for the academic development of the campus. He administered the university's strategic planning and budgeting processes, and in July and August of 1998 he served as interim president of the university.

Iowa State University's aspiration is to become the best land-grant university in the nation, through excellence in learning, discovery and engagement. In leading Iowa State on this quest, Dr. Geoffroy has outlined three top priorities:

- raising the academic quality of the university, with more of its programs recognized as among the best in the nation;
- providing the best possible education to Iowa State's students, through outstanding academic programs and learning environment; and
- becoming a fully *engaged* university with the people of Iowa, through expanded distance education, economic development and community development initiatives.

To these ends, Dr. Geoffroy has made recruitment and retention of top faculty, staff and students a major focus, and he is personally leading a private fund-raising initiative called "Investing in People" with a goal of raising \$50 million in endowments for faculty positions, graduate assistantships and student scholarships.

Only the second of Iowa State's 14 presidents to come from a chemistry background, Dr. Geoffroy is a nationally acclaimed researcher in organometallic chemistry. He has published more than 200 research articles in referenced journals; presented more than 200 invited lectures in the United States and nine other nations; is co-author of the book *Organometallic Photochemistry* and has directed the work of 37 Ph.D. students and 15 post-doctoral scholars. He also has made special efforts to involve undergraduate students in research by providing opportunities for more than 50 undergraduate students to join his research group.

Dr. Geoffroy's teaching and research have earned him fellowships from the Alfred P. Sloan and John Simon Guggenheim Foundations, visiting professorships to major universities in Germany and France, the Dreyfus Foundation Teacher-Scholar Award, and, in 1991, election as a Fellow in the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He has served in various leadership capacities in the Association for Universities for Research in Astronomy and in the American Chemical Society's Division of Inorganic Chemistry. In 1997 he was named an Alumni Fellow of the University of Louisville.

Dr. Geoffroy earned his B.S. With Honors from the University of Louisville in 1968. He served as an officer in the U.S. Navy from 1969 to 1970 and then earned his Ph.D. in chemistry in 1974 from the California Institute of Technology. He and his wife, Kathleen Carothers Geoffroy, have four children.

Junior Jake Sullivan

Iowa State head men's basketball coach Larry Eustachy has a lot to be excited about for the 2002-03 season. Eustachy and his coaching staff corralled a recruiting class that has been ranked as high as No. 2 nationally. The new recruits will join an already solid core of returning players that will continue to make Hilton Coliseum one of the toughest places to play in the nation.

Eustachy, the 2000 and 2001 Big 12 Coach of the Year, welcomes back one of the best shooters in the nation in junior sharpshooter Jake Sullivan. A third-team all-Big 12 selection last season, Sullivan ranked third and fifth in the nation, respectively, in three-point and free throw shooting. Sullivan already holds ISU career three-point and free throw percentage records.

Bruce Van De Velde's impressive administrative resumé in intercollegiate athletics attracted the attention of the Iowa State University search committee charged with hiring a leader who would guide ISU's athletic program into the 21st century. His documented success at each career stop since graduating from Iowa State in 1981 earned him an interview. But it was his vision for the future of athletics at Iowa State and personable style that made him the perfect leader for an ISU program that continues to prosper under Van De Velde's leadership.

Iowa State's former interim president Richard Seagrave affirmed Van De Velde's place among the nation's most respected intercollegiate athletics administrators at a press conference introducing him as ISU's new athletics leader Nov. 1, 2000. Van De Velde's efforts since that day have been recognized.

Van De Velde's tenure at Iowa State already includes successive bowl appearances. The ISU men's and women's basketball teams made NCAA Tournament appearances in his first year in Ames and were crowned Big 12 champions in 2001.

The Sporting News in 2001 rated Iowa State as the seventh-best athletic program among more than 115 NCAA Division I-A programs nationally. The ranking considered competitive success, graduation rates, fan support and NCAA compliance to determine national rank. Iowa State joined Wisconsin, Florida and Notre Dame as the only schools nationally to have its football and men's and women's basketball teams ranked in their respective final 2000-2001 polls by The Associated Press.

Iowa State's graduation rate of 90 percent for student-athletes that complete their eligibility, ranks second in the Big 12 Conference. In 2002, a total of 177 student-athletes earned a 3.0 grade-point average or higher in at least the term prior to competition. Underscoring their academic excellence, 22 Iowa State student-athletes earned academic All-America honors during the 2001-02 school year.

Van De Velde's vision has led to the development of an athletic facility master plan. Recent projects include a partnership with Musco Lighting of Oskaloosa to install permanent lights in Jack Trice Stadium and the Cyclone Soccer Complex. A state-of-the-art video board, new scoreboard and expanded parking lots were introduced with the 2002 season. Current projects include construction of a \$9 million indoor practice facility that will break ground in the Fall of 2002. Other successful areas of emphasis include a COED TEAM program (Cyclones on Educated Decisions, Together Everyone Achieves More), as well as diversity and reading programs.

Annual giving by the 4,760 members of the National Cyclone Club reached \$3.3 million in 2002. Including major gifts and scholarship endowments, \$14 million has been raised for ISU student-athletes during Van De Velde's short tenure. Fundraising has been completed for the \$9 million indoor training facility. Van De Velde has also negotiated a \$9.4 million, five-year multimedia marketing rights contract with ESPN/Clear Channel Sports.

Van De Velde has served on the NCAA Division I-A Athletics Directors Strategic Planning Committee, the NCAA Committee for Financial Aid and peer review team for NCAA certification. He currently serves on the Big 12 Conference Television, Administrative and Finance Committees.

Van De Velde's last stop before returning home to Ames was at Oklahoma, where he served as senior associate director during the Sooners' 2000 national football championship run. Van De Velde directed the Campaign for Sooner Sports, a \$100 million capital campaign to fund facility improvements and scholarship endowments.

Van De Velde, a Sterling, Ill., native and his wife, Debbie, have a daughter, Ashley, born May 12, 2000. Debbie is a graduate of Kansas State University. An Iowa State graduate, Van De Velde earned a master's degree from the University of Iowa and has completed course work toward a doctorate in education from Kansas State.

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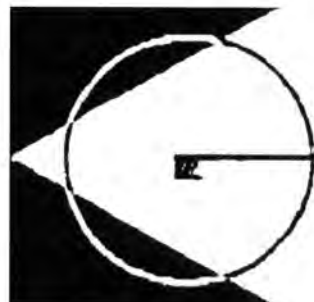
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GAMEDAY SCOUTING REPORT

IOWA STATE FOOTBALL

THE SERIES: Tonight marks the first meeting between Iowa State and Tennessee Tech. The Cyclones have faced one team in the Ohio Valley Conference and lead the series 1-0. ISU defeated OVC member Eastern Illinois in Jack Trice Stadium 42-13, on Sept. 7, 1991.

OFFENSIVELY: QB Seneca Wallace has thrown for 547 yards and has completed 38-of-57 pass attempts in the first two games of Iowa State's 2002 season. Against Kansas, Hiawatha Rutland led the squad in rushing with a career-high 122 yards. Jamaul Montgomery gained 55 yards on four receptions.

Tennessee Tech QB Robert Craft boasts a passing percentage of 74.2 with 256 yards in the air on 31 attempts. RB Stevland Sills rushed for 19 yards against Bowling Green while WR Derek Lee gained 132 yards on nine receptions.

DEFENSIVELY: Brandon Brown led the Cyclones in tackles against Kansas with 10, including one sack for a six yard loss. Jordan Carstens and Beau Coleman tallied nine tackles each while Tyson Smith notched eight.

Golden Eagles Greg Hunnicutt, Daniel Wentzel and John Ruff led the Tech defense vs. Bowling Green, tallying nine, eight and seven total tackles, respectively.

SPECIAL TEAMS: PK Adam Benike has hit 10-of-10 extra point attempts this season and 2-of-3 field goal attempts.

TTUs Chris Cummings punted for 125 yards for a 31.2 average in the season opener. PK Tyler Parsons was good on his only extra point attempt.

COACHES: Today's game is the first meeting between ISU head coach Dan McCarney and Tennessee Tech head coach Mike Hennigan.

When 2001 Big 12 Coach of the Year Dan McCarney laid out his vision for the future of Iowa State football at a press conference to announce his arrival in Ames seven years ago, he stressed that the program's transformation would not occur overnight. McCarney possessed enthusiasm, unwavering optimism and a seemingly endless source of energy. His background in college football programs that had gone from perennial losers to consistent winners made him a perfect choice for the Cyclone helm. There were more than a few skeptics. Iowa State was coming off a winless season, hadn't had a winning campaign since 1989 and the Cyclones' last bowl trip was in 1978.

Seven years later, Iowa State will begin the 2002 season having played in consecutive post-season bowl games. McCarney's program is more than a one-hit wonder. ISU enters the 2002 campaign having won 16 of its last 24 games, one of 27 teams nationally to reach the 16-victory plateau during the 2000-2001 campaigns.

Powered by a singular sense of purpose, McCarney steadily molded Iowa State's football program, bringing in a top-notch coaching staff and the best recruiting classes in recent memory. Backed by a university administration committed to providing state-of-the-art facilities, McCarney relentlessly exorcised the demons that had plagued Cyclone football. After his first teams laid a foundation for success, the 2000 Iowa State unit, led by 25 seniors who had bought into McCarney's vision, remained undeterred by the skeptics. Following McCarney's blueprint, head coach and players went where no Cyclone team had gone, winning nine games, including a 37-29 victory over Pittsburgh in the Insight.com Bowl. Under McCarney, the 2000 AP Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year runner-up, that success continued last season, despite the loss of 15 starters. At 7-5 Iowa State earned an Independence Bowl berth, marking the school's first back-to-back bowl appearances since the 1977-78 seasons. The list of historical superlatives is long:

- Iowa State's 16 wins in its last 24 games is ISU's best record over that span since Iowa State was 16-8 from Sept. 24, 1977 to Sept. 22, 1979.
- McCarney's 2000 Cyclones were the first Iowa State team in 94 years to win nine games. The win over Pittsburgh in the Insight.com Bowl was ISU's first-ever bowl victory and the Cyclones' first bowl appearance since 1978.
- Iowa State's 17-14 win over Iowa on Nov. 24 was the Cyclones' fourth-straight victory against the Hawkeyes, a series first. The Cyclones' 1998, 27-9 win at Iowa snapped a 31-game winless streak on the road and was Iowa State's first win over its in-state rival in 15 years.
- Iowa State averaged 45,172 fans per game at six home games in 2001, the best overall mark in 17 years.

Anyone who has watched McCarney's rise in the coaching ranks would not be surprised by the effort of his national-caliber coaching staff. A native of Iowa City, McCarney was instrumental in rebuilding efforts that produced Big Ten titles and Rose Bowl berths at both Iowa and Wisconsin, two schools that regularly finished near the bottom of the league before his arrival.

McCarney, 49, coached at Iowa for 13 seasons (1977-89), including 11 years under Hayden Fry, before becoming the defensive coordinator at Wisconsin under Barry Alvarez in 1990.

McCarney's defense was the foundation of the Wisconsin rebuilding effort. In the four seasons prior to his arrival in Wisconsin the Badgers had a 9-36 record, and attendance was at its lowest mark since World War II.

In 1993, Wisconsin went 10-1-1, claimed its first Big Ten title in 31 years and scored a 21-16 win over UCLA in the Rose Bowl. Attendance at Wisconsin's Camp Randall Stadium climbed more than 30,000 a game, and sellouts of more than 77,000 were the norm.

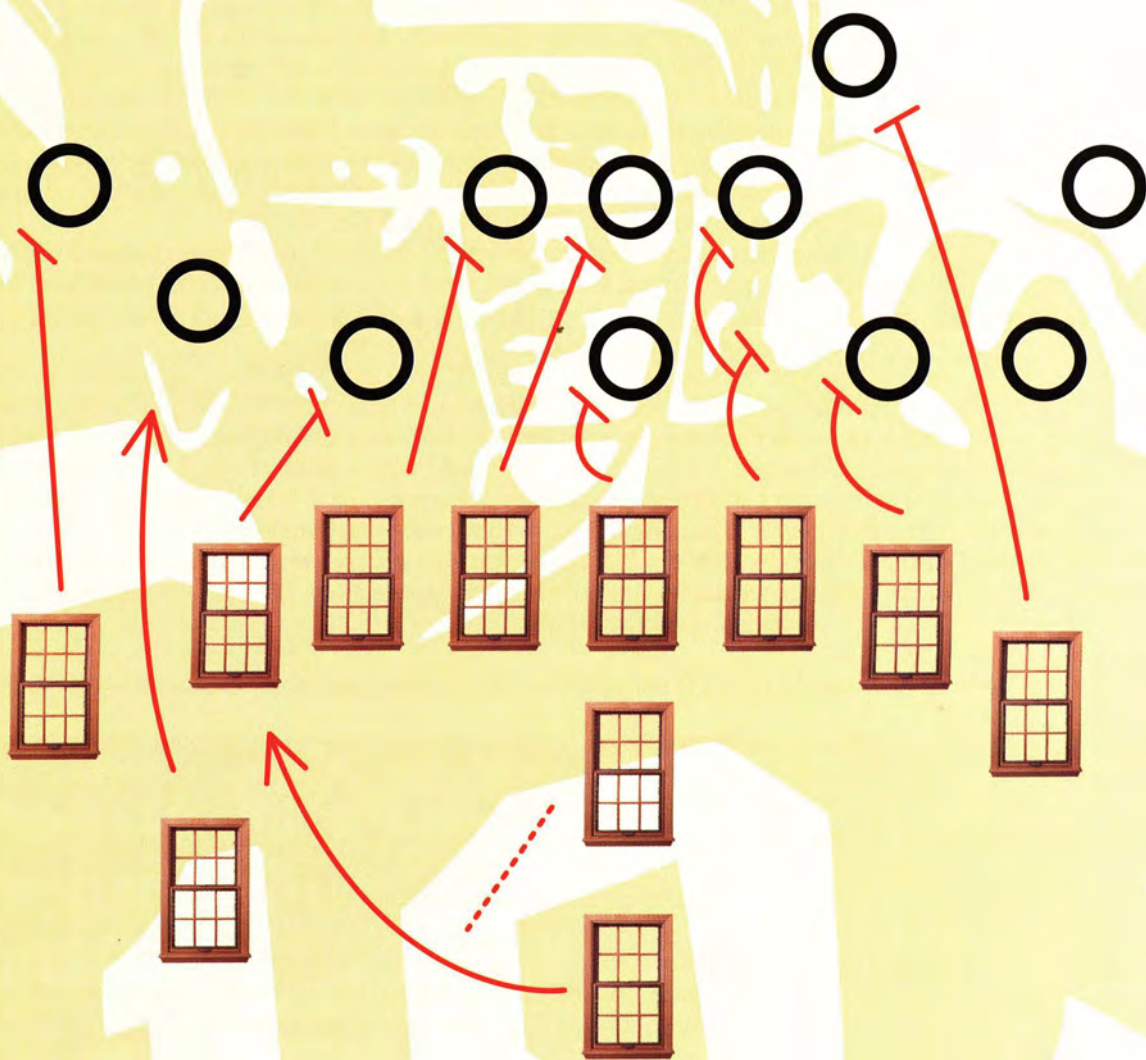
During Wisconsin's Rose Bowl season, the Badgers ranked 19th nationally against the rush, allowing just 130.3 yards per game, the sixth-best mark in school history. The team allowed an average of 16.3 points per game, its best effort in 30 years. The Badger defense also intercepted a NCAA-best 23 passes and created 34 turnovers, including six against UCLA in the Rose Bowl.

A 1975 graduate of Iowa, McCarney coached the Hawkeyes in eight consecutive bowl games, including the 1982 and 1986 Rose Bowls. The three-year letterman on the offensive line for Iowa (1972-74) was captain of the 1974 Hawkeye squad. A member of the American Football Coaches Association for 25 years, McCarney is a past member of the AFCA's rules committee.

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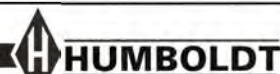
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Mike Banks **Tight End** **Arizona Cardinals**

A seventh-round choice of the Arizona Cardinals, Mike Banks started at tight end on Iowa State's Insight.com and Independence Bowl teams. The three-year starter finished his career with 59 receptions for 584 yards. A ferocious blocker, the Ogden native was a team captain as a senior and twice earned honorable mention all-Big 12 honors.



Kevin DeRonde **Defensive End** **Dallas Cowboys**

One of the first big-name recruits from the state of Iowa signed by Dan McCarney, DeRonde went on to affirm the collegiate potential seen by ISU coaches. He signed a free agent contract with the Dallas Cowboys. The Pella native was a member of Iowa State's Insight.com and Independence Bowl teams, finishing his collegiate career with 188 tackles and 14 stops behind the line of scrimmage. He was a team co-captain as a senior.



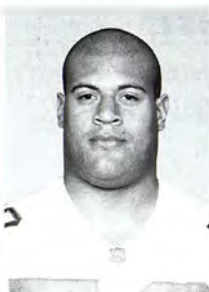
Reggie Hayward **Defensive End** **Denver Broncos**

A third-round pick of the Denver Broncos in the 2001 NFL Draft, Hayward had three sacks in his first professional season. Hayward led Iowa State with 90 tackles, 10 tackles for loss and seven sacks as a senior and was the defensive MVP of the 2000 Insight.com Bowl.



Ennis Haywood **Running Back** **Dallas Cowboys**

A Doak Walker Award semifinalist as a senior, Haywood was a two-time first-team all-Big 12 running back who finished his career with 2,862 rushing yards and 27 TDs. He ranks fourth in school history with 3,468 all-purpose yards. The 2001 team co-captain, a member of Iowa State's Insight.com and Independence Bowl teams, signed a free-agent contract with the Dallas Cowboys.



Marcel Howard **Offensive Tackle** **Detroit Lions**

Howard was a second-team all-Big 12 offensive lineman as a senior. He started the final 23 games of his Iowa State career, including the 2000 Insight.com Bowl and 2001 Independence Bowl. The Davenport native signed a free agent contract with the Detroit Lions.



J.J. Moses **Receiver/Kick Returner** **Kansas City Chiefs**

Moses, a Waterloo native, led NFL Europe in 2002, averaging 11.2 yards on 25 punt returns for the Scottish Claymores. A current member of the NFL's Kansas City Chiefs, he was third in NFL Europe in kickoff returns, averaging 24.6 yards per return. A huge factor in Iowa State's Insight.com Bowl season, Moses finished his ISU career ranked 10th on the all-time ISU career charts with 82 receptions and 10th in all-purpose yards (2,992).



James Reed **Defensive Lineman** **New York Jets**

Reed, who made 333 career tackles at Iowa State, was a seventh-round draft pick in 2001 of the NFL's New York Jets. He made a pair of sacks as a NFL rookie, making two starts and seeing action in 16 games.



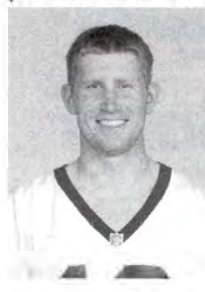
Marcus Robertson **All-Pro Safety** **Seattle Seahawks**

Marcus Robertson is in his 12th NFL season, his second with the Seattle Seahawks. A two-time first-team all-Big Eight standout, he was the first Houston Oiler safety to earn first-team all-Pro honors in 14 years. He was a member of the 1999 Tennessee Titans' AFC championship team. Earning a starting spot in his second pro season, Robertson has played in 147 games in his first 11 NFL campaigns, with 24 career interceptions. He finished his ISU career in 1990 with 257 total tackles.



Oliver Ross **Offensive Lineman** **Pittsburgh Steelers**

The Dallas Cowboys drafted lineman Oliver Ross in 1998. Last season, Ross played in all 16 games for the NFL's Pittsburgh Steelers. Ross, a native of Los Angeles, Calif., who played in the defensive line in junior college, didn't start in ISU's offensive line until his senior season. His play that fall impressed pro scouts and he was drafted by the Cowboys in the fifth round.



Sage Rosenfels **Quarterback** **Washington Redskins**

Rosenfels is in his second season with the Redskins after being a fourth-round draft pick in 2001. The Maquoketa native led Iowa State to a 9-3 season in 2000, and was the offensive MVP of the Insight.com Bowl. He ranks third on the all-time Iowa State career list with 4,164 passing yards.

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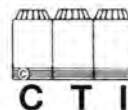

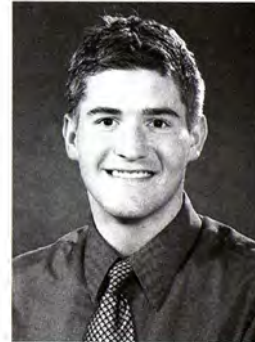

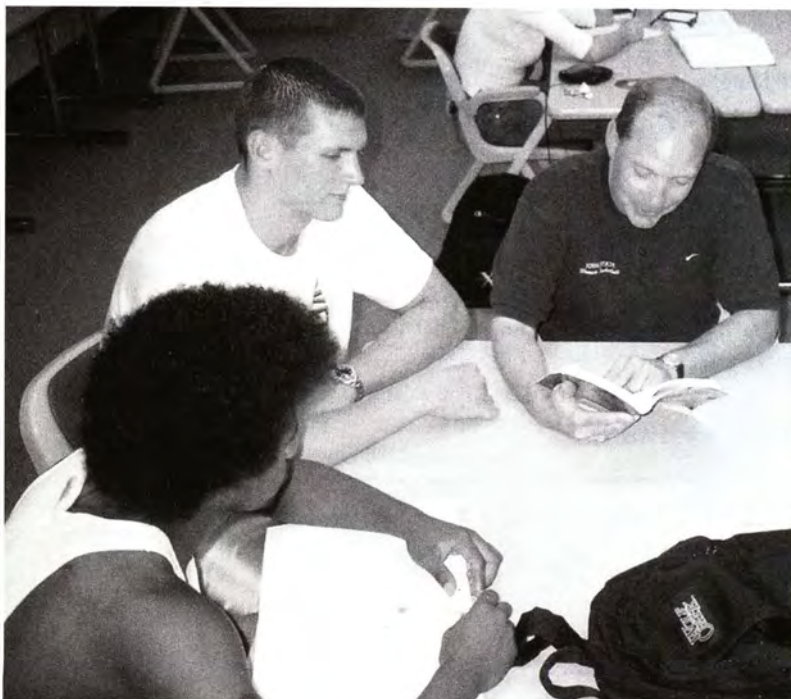

FOOTBALL ENDOWMENT PROGRAM

"Investing Today to Insure Tomorrow"

The Iowa State Athletic Department's new initiative, "Investing Today to Insure Tomorrow," is a program designed to develop scholarship endowments for all 18 sports at ISU. Endowments to underwrite the costs of tuition, room, board, books, academic support and other student services for every sports program are a key source of funding for the athletic department. These expenses are not options and they continue to rise on an annual basis. Listed below are endowments established to benefit the Cyclone Football program.

Endowments can be named in honor or memory of an individual with an initial gift or pledge of \$25,000. Gifts of any amount are welcome for new or currently established endowments. For more information regarding endowments, deferred gifts, trusts or bequests, please contact the Athletic Development Office (515-294-5022) or Frank Nogel (515-294-6463).

Ralph L. Aulmann Memorial Scholarship (Established by Eagle Iron Works)

The Ralph L. Aulmann Memorial Fund is awarded annually to a student-athlete that participates in football. Preference for the award is given to an engineering student who is eligible for enrollment as a senior. This award began in 1964.

Lowell and Geraldine Mattox Memorial Athletic Scholarship (Established by Geraldine Mattox)

Established in 1979, the Lowell and Geraldine Mattox Memorial Athletic Scholarship is awarded annually to a member of the football, basketball or wrestling teams, Lowell Mattox's three favorite sports.

Richard S. Grant Endowed Scholarship (Established by Richard Grant)

The Richard S. Grant Scholarship Fund is awarded to a student-athlete who is an undergraduate in the College of Engineering. First awarded in 1990, the scholarship is available to members of the football, men's basketball, wrestling or track teams.

Engel Football Scholarship Endowment (Established by Raymond and Kathryn Engel)

Established in 1991, the Engel Football Scholarship Endowment is awarded to a member of the football team annually. The late Raymond (B.S. '29) and Kathryn Engel are longtime supporters of ISU athletics.

Jordan L. Larson Jr. Endowed Quarterback Scholarship (Established by Jordan Jr. and Colleen Larson)

Started in 1992, the Jordan L. Larson Jr. Quarterback Endowed Scholarship is awarded annually to the starting quarterback by Colleen & the late Jordan (B.S. '47) L. Larson Jr.

William Vinson Bibb Endowed Scholarship (Established by Vincent Beacom)

Established in 1993, the award is given annually to an African-American student-athlete who plays football and is majoring in engineering. This award is established to honor William Vinson Bibb, who befriended 1950 Iowa State football captain Vincent Beacom.

Mike Michalske Endowed Football Scholarships (Established by Lawrence and Mary Tollenaere)

Started in 2000, the Mike Michalske Football Scholarships are awarded annually to one offensive player and one defensive player. The scholarships are named in honor of "Iron" Mike Michalske, Lawrence Tollenaere's (B.S. '44) football coach at ISU.

Barney Simmons Memorial Scholarship (Established by Patricia Simmons, Zeidlers and the Northeast Iowa Cyclone Club)

Established in 2001 in memory of Barney Simmons, a 1950 alum and longtime Cyclone supporter. The scholarship benefits the football and men's basketball teams, which were Barney's two favorite sports.

Ed and Ruth Bock Endowed Athletic Scholarship (Established by Edward and Ruth Bock)

Established in 2002, this scholarship is awarded annually to a student-athlete majoring in engineering or family and consumer sciences. Ed, who is member of the College Football Hall of Fame, was Iowa State's first consensus football All-American in 1938.

Al and Sara Sorensen Football Scholarship Fund (Established by Al and Sara Sorensen)

Established in 1991 by longtime Cyclone supporters Al and Sara Sorensen, the fund will provide five endowed football scholarships for offensive and defensive line positions (2 offensive tackles, 2 defensive tackles, center).

Max and Shirley Rogers Athletic Scholarship Endowment (Established by Max and Shirley Rogers)

Established in 1993, the endowment will provide a scholarship in both football and men's basketball. Max and Shirley Rogers are longtime supporters of ISU athletics.

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INDOOR PRACTICE FACILITY



Iowa State has announced plans and a budget for an indoor athletic training facility approved by the Board of Regents of the state of Iowa. The 92,000-square-foot building will be constructed over the existing artificial turf practice field west of Jack Trice Stadium. Construction will begin at the conclusion of the 2002 football season and will be completed a year later. Funding for this project was from private gifts by the athletic department and the ISU Foundation.

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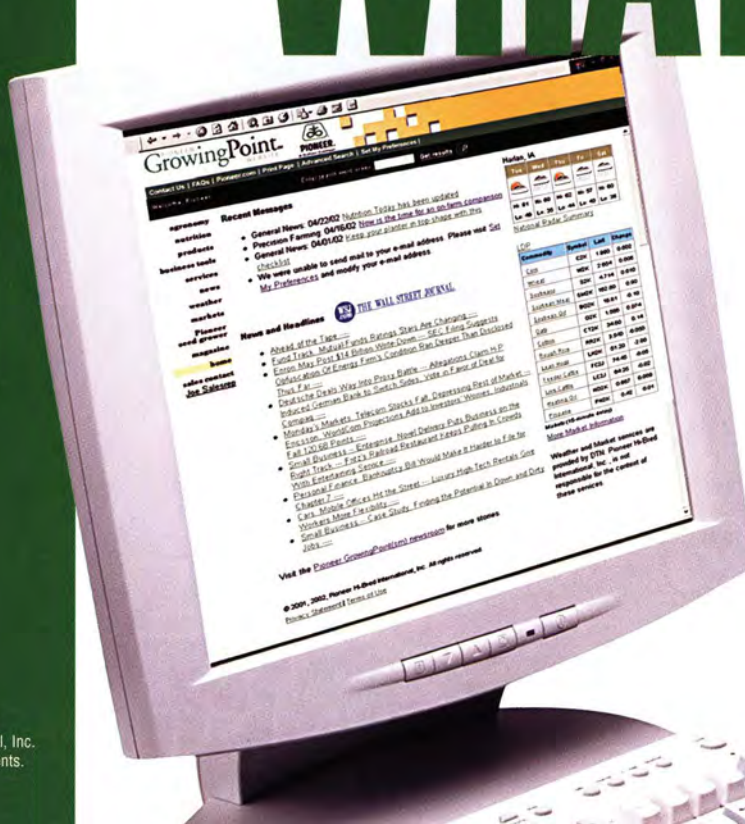
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
