SENATE RESOLUTION 99-008R

TITLE: ALL IS NOT LOST

WHEREAS: The Catt Hall Review Committee has concluded its business, giving a detailed list of recommendations which have not yet been endorsed by this or the 98-99 Senate, and

WHEREAS: After talking to several university administrators and students, two of the recommendations are viewed as fair and impartial to all sides and will mark the significance of student activism and diversity on campus, and

WHEREAS: By endorsing these recommendations the Government of the Student Body (GSB) can finally put closure on this issue, be it therefore

RESOLVED: That the GSB Senate endorse recommendations #4 and #13 from the Catt Hall Review Committee's final report of November 18, 1998, as listed below:

#4. Generic bricks in the Plaza of Heroines were used to replace bricks removed by those who chose to bear witness in that way during the controversy. The committee recommends that those generic bricks be replaced by bricks of black granite (or a good substitute) and that an official letter from the university be sent inviting the individuals involved to insert a personal statement on the official roster of those honored (as the honorees have done) and, if they choose to do so, a statement concerning the removal of those bricks. We further suggest that the letters addressed to these individuals apologize for any misunderstanding and express as assurance that it should go without saying that Iowa State University supports the right of any member of the university community to petition and seek redress.

#13. The committee recommends that a plaque be placed at Catt Hall with the following quote from Alice Walker's *Anything We Love Can Be Saved*: "...it is the awareness of having faults, I think, and the knowledge that this links us to everyone on Earth, that opens us to courage and compassion."

,and be it further

ORDERED: That the GSB Senate establish a Recommendations Enacted committee to put these recommendations into reality, and be it further

RESOLVED: That copies of this resolution be sent to President Martin C. Jischke, Vice President for Student Affairs Thomas Hill, Dean of Students Kathleen MacKay, and all appropriate print and broadcast media.
