Roll Call

30 out of 38 Seated Senators were present. Senators Ammann, Eipers, Flaherty, Gillot, Hassan, Keister, Kerr and Raschke were absent.

Approval of the Minutes

Minutes to the September 18, 1996 meeting were approved with no changes.

Presentations

September 29, Movement by Senators McGriff and Nosworthy.

Senator Henry: What would you like to do instead of just changing the name? McGriff: Find a way to start talking to each other more, have a solid cultural studies program. Unfinished Business

Senate Bill #96-018F (Healing Racism in America)

Blackburn: YWCA program on Diversity, they set aside money towards trying to achieve this goal. Same group of people will agree to meet at set times. Nimmer: Went to the meeting at the Baptist Church on Lynn, was unimpressed, would like his name taken off the bill. Juhl: Agree with Nimmer, not happy with the way the meeting was handled and felt like the person running the meeting had his own agenda. Juhl also had his name removed. Blackburn: YWCA would like to train people who go into these workshops, add name to bill. President Gold: 10 to 15 people may have not have been students of ISU, our student fees money shouldn't go. Chattopadhyay: Motion to table bill until it is known how many students will be attending. Hansen: motion to postpone for 1 week. Seconded by Obrecht. Passes to postpone for 1 week.

Senate Bill #96-019F (Continuing the Excellence)

Wall would like to add her name. Dummermuth would like to be the second on the bill. Obrecht: amendments to the bill- Hotel Room 675, Registration 300, Total Expenses 1280, Remaining expense 785. The first enacted clause read 785 also. Amendment to the Bill accepted as friendly. Johnson: Why did the numbers change? Obrecht: Accounting reasons. Dummermuth called the question. Seconded by Powers. Bill Passes 27-0.

Senate Bill #96-20F (Big 12 Student Government Conference)

Powell to be the second, Hamilton add name. Amendment to the Bill by Vice President Jones to change papoose to people. Powers called the question. Seconded by Hamilton. Bill passes 28-1.

New Business

Bill #96-021 (The 20th Annual Big Eight Conference) and Senate Resolution #96-001R (A Proper Home for a Cyclone Hero) were read. Hamilton: everyone with an affirmative at the next meeting to have their name added to the Resolution. Meyer: are we going to using GSB funds to help this happen? Gold: Undecided
